Denver Advanced To NCAA Quarterfinals

Denver lost 15-13 in an NCAA Quarterfinal clash with second-seeded Albany at Hofstra. Senior faceoff specialist Trevor Baptiste and Albany's TD Ierlan came into the day as the top-two faceoff specialists in the country, and showed why, splitting the match-up 15-15. Denver got 10 of its 13 goals from the midfield led by four from junior Colton Jackson who tied a career-high in that category for the third time in his three-year stint. Keeper Alex Ready made 10 saves. It was Denver's seventh Quarterfinal appearance in the last eight years.

Georgetown, Denver, Villanova Rep BIG EAST In Big Dance

For the first time since 2010, the first year of BIG EAST men's lacrosse, three BIG EAST teams were invited to the NCAA tournament. Denver and Villanova joined automatic qualifier Georgetown. It was Georgetown's 13th appearance in the NCAAAs, Villanova's third and Denver's 10th. Denver advanced to the Quarterfinals with a 9-7 win on the road at Notre Dame. Georgetown lost a heart breaker in overtime, 10-9 at Johns Hopkins. Georgetown led 8-4 at the end of the third period, but JHU scored five to the Hoyas' one in the fourth to tie it up. The game-winning goal was scored with 29 seconds remaining in the OT period. Villanova fell to No. 4 seed Duke, 17-11 in the first round. Danny Seibel scored five goals to lead Villanova. Duke took advantage of an eight-goal second period for the win as the Wildcats outscored the Blue Demons 3-1 in the third.

USILA Honors Four #BIGEASTmlax Players For Academic Accomplishments

The United States Intercollegiate Lacrosse Association (USILA) released their 2018 Division I, II and III Scholar All-Americans with four BIG EAST student-athletes from four schools making the cut: Trevor Baptiste from Denver, Ryan Hursey from Georgetown, Cole Blazer from Marquette and Christian Cuccinello from Villanova. There are 48 student-athletes on the list.

Matt Behrens Selected As D1 YRL Unsung Hero Award Winner

Georgetown senior Matt Behrens was named the Division I men's winner of the Yeardeley Reynolds Love Unsung Hero Award, presented by the One Love Foundation. The award recognizes six winners, one from each division and gender, for their dedication, integrity, humility, hard work, community service, leadership, kindness and sportsmanship - all qualities that Yeardeley Love exemplified throughout her life. On the field, Behrens has played in all 61 games during his four-year tenure with the Hoyas. He has had a breakout season as a senior, moving into a starting role and more than doubling his offensive production from the midfield and attack positions. During his time on the Hilltop, Behrens has scored 30 goals to go with 15 assists for 45 points. Off the field, Behrens has dedicated himself to many different avenues of service and leadership both within and outside of athletics. As a freshman and sophomore, he participated in and then served as a peer-leader for Young Leaders in Education about Diversity (YLEAD), a Georgetown pre-orientation program.

Ten Players Earn USILA All-America Honors; Baptiste Named Lt. j.g. Donald MacLaughlin, Jr. Award

Six Players from three schools were represented in the United States Intercollegiate Lacrosse Association All-America teams; and four additional players were named honorable mention. Additionally, Denver senior faceoff specialist Trevor Baptiste was named the USILA's Lt. j.g. Donald MacLaughlin, Jr., Award for Most Outstanding Midfielder in college lacrosse. Baptiste is a four-time First Team All-American. Joining Baptiste on the First Team this season was Georgetown keeper Nick Marrocco. Denver led the way with five honorees total. Georgetown had four and Villanova had one.

#BeastBaptiste Reps #BIGEASTmIax As Tewaaraton Award Finalist

Denver faceoff specialist Trevor Baptiste was named to the list of five finalists for the Tewaaraton Award Foundation's Player of the Year. It is his second consecutive year as a finalist. Denver has had a Tewaaraton Award Finalist for the last four years. The BIG EAST had seven players on the Tewaaraton Award Watch list. On April 26, the foundation released their list of nominees: Denver senior Trevor Baptiste and sophomore Ethan Walker, Georgetown junior Daniel Bucaro and Villanova senior Christian Cuccinello. On the original watch list were also: Denver's Sean Mayle and Dylan Gaines, Providence's goalie Tate Boyce.

Inside Lacrosse Honors Five #BIGEASTmIax Players With Postseason AA Honors

Inside Lacrosse released its Division I Media All-Americans on Sunday, May 13. The BIG EAST had five players honored, two from Denver, two from Georgetown and one from Villanova. Denver's Trevor Baptiste was the lone BIG EAST first team honoree. Honorable mention accolades went to Denver's Ethan Walker (A), Villanova's Christian Cuccinello (A) and Georgetown's Ryan Hursey (SSDM) and Nick Marrocco (G).

BIG EAST Final Conference RPI, SOS

The BIG EAST finished the season with a final conference RPI of fourth highest, following the ACC, Big Ten and Ivy League, respectively. The BIG EAST was ranked third in opponent strength of schedule. There are 10 Division I Conferences who host men's lacrosse.

Georgetown Wins First-Ever BIG EAST Championship Title

No. 2 seed Georgetown defeated No. 1 seed Denver, 8-3, on Saturday, May 5 at Villanova Stadium to win the 2018 BIG EAST Men's Lacrosse Championship Presented by Jeep. It was the first BIG EAST men's lacrosse championship title for the Hoyas, which become the fourth different team to win the tournament title. Hoya senior goalkeeper Nick Marrocco won the Championship Most Outstanding Player honors, making 14 saves in the title game, 26 for the weekend. Georgetown's Lucas Wittenberg, Craig Berge and Ryan Hursey were all named to the All-Tournament team along with Marrocco. Wittenberg led the Hoyas with

three goals and two assists. Hursey held Ethan Walker, the BIG EAST Attack Player of the Year and the league's leading scorer, scoreless from the defensive midfield. Georgetown's close defense held the high-powered Pioneer offense to nine goals below their season average. The goal total for Denver was its lowest since the Pioneers lost 12-3 at No. 2 Virginia on April 28, 2003. It was Denver's first loss since March 10, 2018 - 11-9 to then-No. 10 Notre Dame on the road. Georgetown (12-4) led wire-to-wire and shut out Denver for the first 27:52 of the game.

Georgetown defeated No. 3 seed Villanova, 13-10 in the semifinals to advance. Denver defeated No. 4 seed Marquette, 10-7.

Baptiste Breaks NCAA Career Faceoff Wins Record

Denver senior faceoff specialist Trevor Baptiste won his 1,118th career faceoff to break the NCAA Division I men's lacrosse record in the closing seconds of Denver's 10-7 victory over Marquette in the first semifinal of the BIG EAST Championship Presented by Jeep at Villanova Stadium. Baptiste finished 14-of-21 on the day, winning 9-of-11 in the second half and picking up nine ground balls. Baptiste heads into NCAA play with 1,129 career faceoff wins.

Baptiste Earns BIG EAST Midfielder Of The Year Honors For Fourth-Consecutive Time

A BIG EAST major award winner since joining the Pioneer ranks in 2014, Baptiste is the only player in BIG EAST Men's Lacrosse history to win a major award four times. Baptiste was named a Tewaaraton Award nominee for the fourth time last week. A three-time USILA First Team All-America selection, Baptiste is also one of the players on the 2018 USILA Player of the Year Watch List and is a Senior CLASS Award finalist. The Denville, N.J., native is 14 faceoffs shy of setting an NCAA Division I career faceoff wins record, currently held by Kevin Mass of Bryant since 2014. Baptiste is 225-289 (.779) from the faceoff dot in 2018, picking up 128 ground balls to go with seven goals and two assists on the season. Through five conference games this year, he is 86-104 (.827) and leads the conference in faceoff win percentage by more than .200. He was named to the USILA Team of the Week three times this season. Denver has held Midfielder of the Year since joining the league in 2014. Jeremy Noble won the award unanimously that year.

BIG EAST Regular Season Honors Awarded To Denver, Georgetown, Villanova

On the eve of the 2018 BIG EAST Men's Lacrosse Championship Presented by Jeep, the league announced the regular season major award winners and All-BIG EAST First and Second teams. Denver sophomore Ethan Walker was voted Attack Player of the Year; while teammate Trevor Baptiste won his fourth-consecutive Midfielder of the Year award, holding the title since starting his collegiate career. De-

fensive Player of the Year accolades also went to the Pioneers as junior Dylan Gaines earned the title. Goalkeeper of the Year was awarded to Georgetown senior Nick Marrocco; while Freshman of the Year was awarded to Villanova's Keegan Khan. For the second time in four years, Coaching Staff of the Year honors went to Georgetown's staff, headed by Kevin Warne. Baptiste, Kahn and Warne's coaching staff were unanimous selections by the coaches, who could not cast votes for their own players. Warne was named Coach of the Year in 2015, the last time the Hoyas were in the BIG EAST Championship. BIG EAST regular season champion Denver boasted a league-best seven on the all-conference teams with five on the first team and two on the second team. No. 2 seed Georgetown and No. 3 seed Villanova had the second most with six. Fourteen players were voted to the All-Conference First Team, 10 of those players were unanimous selections, including Walker, Gaines and Baptiste. Walker was the Freshman of the Year in 2017.

Pioneers Unbeaten For Fifth Year

Since joining the BIG EAST Conference in 2014, Denver has won the BIG EAST regular season title five straight years. En route to five-consecutive titles, the Pioneers have tallied an unblemished conference record of 26-0. Marquette has been the only BIG EAST team to defeat Denver with two wins coming in the BIG EAST Tournament. The Golden Eagles won, 10-9, in the 2016 championship game and 11-8 in the 2017 semifinal match up.

#BIGEASTmIax Draws A Crowd

Five BIG EAST teams rank in the top half of the NCAA in average attendance, led by Denver which ranks 13th with 2,416 fans on average. Georgetown and Providence tie for 24th with 749. Villanova is 30th with 765 and St. John's is 33rd with 639.

Five Players Selected In MLL Collegiate Draft, Baptiste Drafted No. 1 Overall

Three-time BIG EAST Midfielder of the Year Trevor Baptiste, Denver's FOS was the No. 1 overall pick in the Major League Lacrosse Collegiate Draft. Baptiste is the first faceoff specialist to be taken No. 1 overall in the history of the draft. Drafted by the Boston Cannons, Baptiste was one of five BIG EAST seniors overall who were selected in the draft. Baptiste and his teammate Sean Mayle were first round selections. It is the second year in a row the BIG EAST had two of the nine first round picks.

To be eligible for the award, student-athletes must be classified as NCAA Division I seniors and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition.

In The Top 20

This season, all six teams in the BIG EAST have received national attention with each team having at least received votes in the USILA coaches and Inside Lacrosse media national polls. In the final polls, Denver was ranked 10th in the USILA poll, 7th in the Inside Lacrosse Media Poll. Georgetown ranked No. 12/11 and Villanova was ranked 17th/18th. During regular season non-conference play, the BIG EAST went 8-11 against ranked opponents.

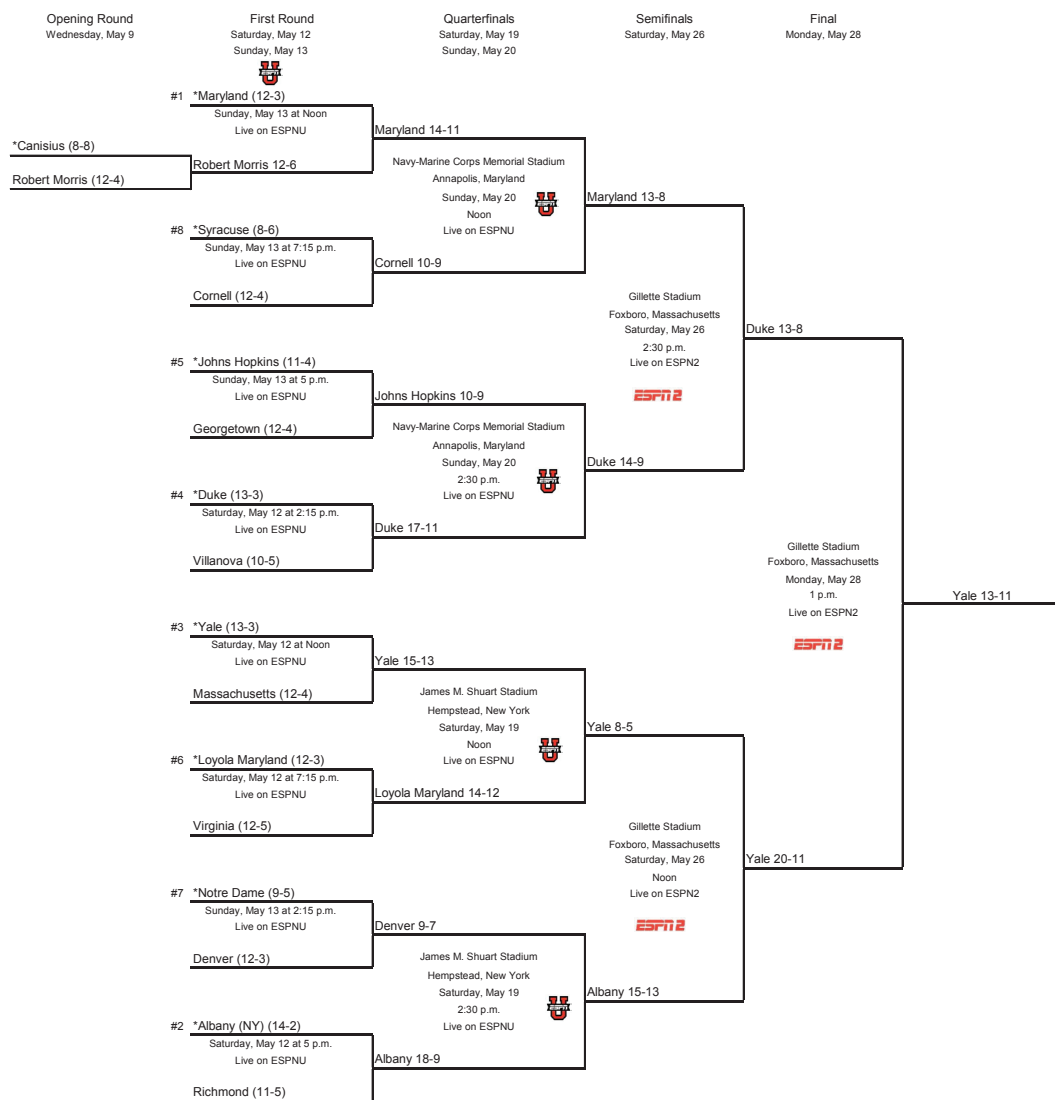
