PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - OCT. 10

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - TYRELL MAXWELL, GARDNER-WEBB, QB, JR (CORDOVA, S.C.)

Maxwell amassed 377 yards of offense in Gardner-Webb's 24-3 victory over Presbyterian as he became just the second quarterback in Big South history with 200 passing yards (222) and 150 rushing yards (155) in a single-game. He threw a 74-yard touchdown on GWU's first offensive play, and later scored on an 87-yard rush -- the longest rush from scrimmage by a Big South quarterback in league annals. Maxwell posted a 241.23 passing efficiency rating, averaged 14.1 yards per rush and 16.4 yards per play.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK - CHAD GETER, GARDNER-WEBB, LB, R-Sr (IRMO, S.C.)

Getter led the Runnin' Bulldogs with 10 tackles (five solo, five assisted) against Presbyterian and added a quarterback hurry. He made two stops on third down in the first half that kept PC from converting, and later pressured the quarterback on third-and-goal to cause an incompleting and force a field goal. Getter added a third down tackle that forced a punt in the 4th stanza.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - MATT MOSQUERA, MONMOUTH, P/K, Fr (MIDDLETOWN, N.J.)

In his first action of the season, Mosquera was pressed into service early in the second quarter due to an injury, and responded with a perfect 6-of-6 on extra points and 35.0 yards handling the punting duties in the Hawks' win at Howard. He placed his first punt at the HU 10-yard line, while his second punt was fair caught and not returned.

THE COME READY NUTRITION FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - JAYLAN FOSTER, GARDNER-WEBB, CB, Fr (DUNCAN, S.C.)

Foster collected a career-high seven tackles (all solo) and two key tackles-for-loss in Gardner-Webb's Big South-opening win over Presbyterian. His first TFL was a loss of four yards that caused a 2nd-and-14 situation, while his second stop behind the line was on a 1st-and-Goal play. Foster added a pass break-up on a fourth-down pass near the goal line to end PC's final drive.

SECOND-EVER THURSDAY NIGHT BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL GAME SET TO GO

The second-ever Thursday night Big South Conference game is this week, as Presbyterian hosts Monmouth Thursday evening in Clinton. Last year was the first time a Big South game was played on a Thursday night, as Liberty defeated Coastal Carolina before a national TV audience on ESPNEWS.

MONMOUTH'S MIKE BASILE ADDED TO FCS DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR WATCH LIST

Monmouth DB **MIKE BASILE** was one of four midseason additions to the STATS FCS National Defensive Player of the Year Watch List last week, and joins Charleston Southern's **ANTHONY ELLIS** among the official Big South candidates for the 2016 award. It is the fourth consecutive year that the Big South has multiple candidates for the national defensive award, and fifth time overall.

FINAL BIG SOUTH OPENER THIS WEEK

Kennesaw State and Liberty open Big South play against each other this Saturday, with the winner joining Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb atop the conference standings at 1-0. CSU and GWU are 1-0 for the second consecutive year, and will go for 2-0 starts on Oct. 22. Here is how KSU and LU have fared in their respective conference openers:

MAD MAX

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL**'s 87-yard touchdown run this past Saturday against Presbyterian was the longest rush from scrimmage by a quarterback in Big South history, bettering the old record of 77 yards. Maxwell's rush is the second-longest in league annals, but the longest against a Division I opponent. Meanwhile, Maxwell had a 74-yard completion for a TD to **KYLE HORTON** to become the first quarterback in the Big South record book with an 80-yard TD rush and 70-yard TD pass in the same game.

BURKS BUSTS THROUGH FOR BIG SOUTH RECORD

Kennesaw State QB **CHANDLER BURKS** is the first quarterback in Big South history to score three rushing touchdowns in consecutive games -- which also ties teammate **TREY WHITE** for most career 3-TD rushing games by a QB. Burks rushed for three scores in Week 5 at Furman, and scored another three TDs this past Saturday against Missouri S&T. He has rushed for a touchdown in four consecutive contests, and his eight rushing scores are the third-most in a season by a Big South quarterback.

MOVING THE CHAINS

Monmouth RB **LAVON CHANEY** became the Big South's career leader for most receptions by a running back when he broke the record this past Saturday at Howard. Chaney's 79 career catches out of the backfield surpassed the old mark of 77 that was held by **DE'ANGELO HENDERSON**. Chaney's 649 career receiving yards are also second-most among Big South running backs, and 82 away from Henderson's record of 731. Meanwhile, Chaney has thrown for three touchdowns during his time in the Big South, tied with former Liberty WR **ADRIAN HALL** for the most TD passes by a non-quarterback.

KHALIL'S GOT THE WILL

Gardner-Webb RB **KHALIL LEWIS** leads the Big South with 628 rushing yards and 10 touchdowns, and is second with 104.7 rushing yards per game. If he can maintain his current production, Lewis has a chance to become the first Runnin' Bulldog **EVER** to lead the Big South in any of those three rushing categories. His 628 rushing yards through the first six games of the season are the most by a GWU rusher since the Big South began football in 2002, and the first to surpass 600 yards in the opening six games since **JUANNE BLOUNT** had 621 in 2013. Meanwhile, Lewis is the first Gardner-Webb player with 10 rushing touchdowns in a season since **PATRICK HALL** had 12 in 2009.

DANTE'S D

Kennesaw State DB **DANTE BLACKMON** has intercepted a pass in three consecutive games and leads the Big South with 11 passes defended -- totals he has recorded just in the past three outings alone with 5 INT and 6 PBU. His six passes defended in Week 4 at Duquesne (three interceptions and three break-ups) were the second-highest single-game total in Big South history, and he posted four in Week 5 at Furman with one INT and three deflections.

RANK AND FILE

With Charleston Southern's appearance in the national polls this week, the Big South has had a football squad nationally-ranked for 71 consecutive weeks, dating back to Week 9 of the 2011 season (Oct. 24). The Buccaneers are ranked No. 8 in the FCS Coaches poll, No. 9 in the STATS ranking, and No. 8 in the Hero Sports Media poll.

LIBERTY ON CUSP OF 50 BIG SOUTH VICTORIES

Liberty begins Big South play this week, which marks their first attempt at becoming the first team to win 50 Big South games. The Flames have won a league-high 49 Big South games since the conference started football in 2002. Gardner-Webb is third with 32 league victories, followed by Charleston Southern at 31.

BEWARE OF THE DOG

Gardner-Webb is just the third team in Big South history to hold consecutive opponents to 3 points-or-less, as the Runnin' Bulldogs blanked Benedict in Week 5 and held Presbyterian to a field goal this past Saturday. GWU joins Coastal Carolina (three straight games in 2014) and Liberty (two in 2011) as the only teams to achieve this feat.

MAXWELL HOUSE

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** became just the second quarterback in Big South history with 200 passing yards and 150 rushing yards in the same game when he threw for 222 and rushed for 155 this past Saturday against Presbyterian. Former Liberty QB **MIKE BROWN** was the first with 334 passing yards and 160 rushing yards vs. Stony Brook in 2010. Meanwhile, Maxwell is fourth all-time in Big South history among quarterbacks with 1,554 rushing yards. He needs 11 to move past **ALEX ROSS** (Coastal Carolina) for third-place. Maxwell is the only quarterback in Big South history with four career 100-yard rush / 100-yard pass games.

REG-GIE, REG-GIE

Monmouth WR **REGGIE WHITE JR.** has posted two 10-reception games this season, the most by a Big South player since Liberty's **DARRIN PETERSON** had three in 2014. White recorded a career-high 11 receptions at Delaware State in Week 2, and tallied a career-high 167 receiving yards in Week 5 against Fordham. Through six contests, he leads the Big South with 40 catches and 6.7 per game, as well as 496 receiving yards. Last season in 11 games, White had 35 receptions for 432 yards.

SUPER SUMPTER

In his last two games, Kennesaw State WR **JUSTIN SUMPTER** has caught 14 passes for 334 yards and three touchdowns, with an average of 23.86 yards per catch in that span. He is the first player in Big South history to open the season with touchdown receptions in each of the first four games. Earlier this season he was the first Big South receiver with back-to-back multi-TD catch efforts since 2013 (Coastal Carolina's **MATT HAZEL**), and in just 15 career games with the Owls, Sumpter has 51 catches for 993 yards (19.47 average) and 10 TDs.

SEA SHELLS

Liberty WR **DANTE SHELLS** has 93 career receptions for 1,759 career yards. He is seven catches away from joining the Big South's 100-reception club and 241 yards away from 2,000. Shells would become the 13th player with both career milestones once he reaches each total. Meanwhile, Shells and Kennesaw State WR **JUSTIN SUMPTER** are the first players since Liberty's **DARRIN PETERSON** in 2014 with touchdown receptions in four consecutive games.

2,000-YARD RUSHING ODYSSEY

Charleston Southern RB **MIKE HOLLOWAY** became the 20th player in Big South history with 2,000 career rushing yards when he surpassed the milestone in Week 4 at Monmouth. The league's active career leading rusher with 2,227, Holloway is 14th in league annals and needs 116 yards to move into 13th. Monmouth's **LAVON CHANEY** (1,876) and Presbyterian's **DARRELL BRIDGES** (1,882) are closing in on the 2,000-yard benchmark as well. Bridges would become the second Blue Hose on the Big South's 2,000-yard rushing list, while Chaney would be Monmouth's first entry among the conference's career 2,000-yard rushers.

BLOCK-N-BASILE

Monmouth DB **MIKE BASILE** leads the nation with three blocked kicks, which is tied for second-most in a single-season in Big South history. The record is four, set by Presbyterian's **CHETYUANE REEDER** in 2008 and tied by Coastal Carolina's **MARCUS WILLIAMSON** last season. Basile has four career blocked kicks, which is tied for third all-time in league annals. He is one away from moving into a tie for second. Former PC defensive standout and current Arizona Cardinal **JUSTIN BETHEL** is the Big South career leader with nine blocked kicks.

THREE'S COMPANY

Charleston Southern has three active players with 1,000 career rushing yards, as **DARIUS HAMMOND** eclipsed the milestone in Week 4. With 1,113 career rushing yards, Hammond joins **MIKE HOLLOWAY** (2,227) and **BEN ROBINSON** (1,278) in the club. The three players have rushed for a combined 4,618 yards and 46 touchdowns on 721 carries -- a combined average of 6.40 yards per carry.

OCTOBERFEST

Gardner-Webb is the sixth team in Big South history to play four consecutive home games in a single-season, as the Runnin' Bulldogs are in the midst of a four-game homestand and are 2-0 thus far. They join the 2005 Liberty Flames, 2006 and 2014 Charleston Southern Buccaneers, 2011 Stony Brook Seawolves and 2015 Coastal Carolina Chanticleers in the group. The Runnin' Bulldogs are just the second to play all four games in the month of October, as Liberty was the first.

BLOCK PARTY

Monmouth leads the nation with seven blocked kicks this season, the most in the Big South since Presbyterian had eight in 2009. The Hawks have blocked a kick in four of their last five games, including a Big South single-game record four at Delaware State in Week 2, with **MIKE BASILE** recording two of the deflections. The Hawks blocked two punts, one field goal and one PAT attempt to break the old league record of three set by VMI in 2004 and matched by Gardner-Webb in 2009. Basile was responsible for the FG and PAT blocks, and is the first Big South player with two blocked kicks in a game since Liberty's **FRANCIS BAH** in 2012.

EXCEPTIONAL ESTES

Gardner-Webb redshirt-senior TE **MIKE ESTES** is the Big South's all-time leading receiver among tight ends. He holds the career records for receptions (98), receiving yards (1,269) and touchdowns (9). Already the only tight end in league annals with 1,000 receiving yards, he is two catches away from becoming the first with 100.

HAMMING IT UP

Charleston Southern's **DARIUS HAMMOND** is second in Big South history with 564 career punt return yards, and is 70 away from breaking the league's all-time record of 633 currently held by Coastal Carolina's **NICCOLO MASTROMATTEO**. Hammond is challenging the Big South's all-time mark for combined kick return yards. He is currently fourth with 2,323 and is 402 yards away from breaking the record of 2,724 held by Gardner-Webb's **J.J. HUBBARD**. Meanwhile, Hammond is 465 yards shy from becoming just the eighth player in conference annals with 4,000 career all-purpose yards.

GEE-WIZ

Gardner-Webb LB **CHAD GETER**, who opened the 2016 season as one of 34 FCS players named to the 2017 Reese's Senior Bowl Watch List, is 15 tackles away from becoming the 14th player with 300 career stops, and would be the fifth linebacker on the all-time list. Geter has accumulated 166 solo tackles, which is tied for 8th all-time in the Big South record book. Meanwhile, Geter has amassed 31.0 career tackles-for-loss as well as 10.5 sacks. He needs 7.0 TFL to match the Big South career TFL record among linebackers (38.0 - **MARTY PATTERSON**, Gardner-Webb), and 3.5 sacks to equal the linebacker sack record of 14.0, which is held by **MAURICE SIMPKINS** (Coastal Carolina, 2003-05).

MAGIC MIKE

Monmouth DB **MIKE BASILE** has recorded at least 10 tackles in 12 of his last 18 appearances, and has 253 career stops through 28 career games. His current career average of 9.04 tackles per game ranks sixth all-time in Big South history. Basile owns 165 career solo hits, which is 10th in the conference record book. He is second in the Big South this season with 56 tackles and third with 9.3 per game, and is attempting to become just the third player in league annals to lead the conference in tackles in back-to-back years. In 2015, Basile became just the third defensive back to lead the Big South in total tackles and tackles per game as he finished with 119 and 10.8 per game, respectively.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN WINS BIG SOUTH OPENER TO EXTEND LEAGUE WIN STREAK TO 10

Charleston Southern began its Big South title defense with a 35-7 win at Monmouth in Week 4 for its second consecutive and sixth overall 1-0 start to league play. The win was the Bucs' 10th straight Big South victory -- the third-longest conference win streak in Big South history and one victory away from second-place. The record is 16, set by Liberty from 2006-09. Charleston Southern's next opportunity for a league win is Oct. 22.

THESE LINEBACKERS ARE OUT FRONT

Gardner-Webb linebacker **AARON COOK** eclipsed 200 career tackles at Western Carolina in Week 2. He owns 9.0 career sacks, and is one away from becoming the fifth linebacker with double-digit sack totals. Meanwhile, Liberty LB **NICK NEWMAN** surpassed the 200-career tackle milestone in Week 5 against Robert Morris. Charleston Southern sophomore LB **SOLOMON BROWN** is four stops away from 100 in his career, and already has 9.5 sacks and 18.5 tackles-for-loss.

BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL RETURNS TO AMERICAN SPORTS NETWORK

The Big South Conference will make its season debut on the American Sports Network (ASN) on Oct. 22, as three games will be televised on the three-year old network. The remaining broadcast dates are Nov. 5 and Nov. 12.

EXCLUSIVE BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL ON ESPN3

The Big South Conference is again televising eight football games exclusively on ESPN3 this season. The "Game of the Week" package resumes Oct. 15 with Liberty at Kennesaw State with **EVAN LEPLER** (play-by-play) and **RENALDO WYNN** (analyst) on the call. The package features a "Wildcard" selection for the second straight year, which will be the weekend of Nov. 19. That selection will be made 14-21 days in advance.

QB STREAKS

Monmouth QB **CODY WILLIAMS** had his streak of consecutive pass attempts without an INT snapped at 134 this past Saturday. It was the fourth-longest streak in the Big South since 2012. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** has not thrown an interception in his last 102 pass attempts, a span of five games. Maxwell has thrown a TD pass in his last four outings, which is the longest streak in the Big South this season.

BIG SOUTH OFF TO ANOTHER SOLID START AGAINST NON-CONFERENCE FCS FOES

The Big South is 11-6 after 17 games against non-conference FCS opponents. Since the start of the 2013 campaign, the Big South is 63-28 (=69.2 winning percentage) in regular-season competition and 68-33 (=67.3) when including postseason games in that span. The Big South has posted at least a 60.0 winning clip in each of the previous three seasons.

BUCS SET BIG SOUTH RECORD IN DOUBLE-OVERTIME CLASSIC

Charleston Southern defeated former Big South member Coastal Carolina, 59-58 in double-overtime in Week 5, and the 117 combined points broke the conference single-game record. The previous mark was 107 points, which occurred three times. The Bucs' win over the Chanticleers pushed the Big South to 12-13 all-time in games involving a ranked Big South team against a nationally-ranked non-conference opponent. CSU is now 3-1 against Coastal Carolina in such meetings.

FRESH PERSPECTIVE

Charleston Southern's **SHANE BUCENELL** (at Coastal Carolina) and Liberty's **STEPHEN CALVERT** (vs. Robert Morris) became the fifth and sixth freshman quarterbacks in Big South history with 4 TD passes in a game when the duo achieved the feat in Week 5. Calvert added 340 passing yards in his effort against RMU, the third-highest passing total by a Big South freshman in league history.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty owns the Big South record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 127, while the second-longest active streak belongs to Charleston Southern at 51. In addition, Liberty is the Big South's record holder for most consecutive games scoring in double figures at 71. Meanwhile, Liberty has scored a point in all 68 of its Big South games, the longest such streak in league annals. Of those 68 games, the last 56 have been in double digits. Charleston Southern's current streak of 43 conference games with a point scored is third-longest all-time, just ahead of PC's active streak of 41 games.

ROBINSON NAMED SEMIFINALIST FOR NFF'S CAMPBELL TROPHY

Charleston Southern RB **BEN ROBINSON** is a Semifinalist for the National Football Foundation's Campbell Trophy. The award recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation. The NFF will announce 12-14 finalists on Nov. 1, and each honoree will receive an \$18,000 post-graduate scholarship as a member of the NFF National Scholar-Athlete Class. The Big South had its only finalist in 2013 when Coastal Carolina's **NICCOLO MASTROMATTEO** was honored.

LEGEND OF SLEEPY HOLLOW

Charleston Southern RB **MIKE HOLLOWAY** became just the second Big South player in league history -- and the first in a conference game -- to record a touchdown rush of at least 70 yards and TD reception of 60+ yards in the same game when he did so in Week 4 at Monmouth. He first scored on a 75-yard run, then added a 63-yard catch-and-run on a swing pass into the end zone. Gardner-Webb's **DAVID MONTGOMERY** was the first to achieve this feat with his 74-yard TD run and 73-yard touchdown catch against Southern Virginia on Oct. 24, 2009.

BIG SOUTH POSTS UNDEFEATED NON-CONFERENCE WEEK FOR THIRD CONSECUTIVE YEAR

The Big South Conference went 5-0 during Week 5, the third consecutive year that the league did not lose a non-conference game in the same week, based on a minimum five games. Last season, the Big South posted a 7-0 record during Week 3, while the 2014 campaign saw the league go 6-0 against non-conference foes in Week 3 as well.

FORTY IS FUN

During the 5-0 week in Week 5, the five Big South members scored at least 40 points during the same week for the first time in league history. The five combined for 239 points for an average of 47.8 points.
