SURVIVE AND ADVANCE -- KENNESAW STATE MOVES ON TO FCS QUARTERFINALS

Kennesaw State defeated Jacksonville State, 17-7, in the second round of the FCS Playoffs to advance to the quarterfinals -- the Big South's fourth all-time appearance in the final eight which have all come in four of the last five seasons. The Owls are the third different Big South member to reach the quarters, joining Coastal Carolina (twice) and Charleston Southern. KSU is now the second Big South member to win two playoff games in a season, while its two victories this post-season makes the squad just the third Big South member with two all-time playoff wins. The Big South is now 10-12 in the postseason, and has advanced in six of the last seven years.

BURKS ESTABLISHES NEW STANDARD

Kennesaw State QB and Big South Offensive Player of the Year **CHANDLER BURKS** is the first player in Big South history with 1,000 rushing yards and 1,000 passing yards in the same season. He ranks second in the conference with 1,060 yards rushing -- just two shy of becoming the second QB to lead the league in rushing. He has passed for 1,187 yards in 2017, and has been responsible for 25 scores this year (17 rush, 8 pass). Burks' 1,060 rushing yards are the second-most in a single-season by a Big South quarterback. That record is 1,266 set by VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** in 2008.

AVOIDING THE QUARTER BOUNCE

The Big South is looking to advance to the FCS semifinals for the first time, as the league is 0-3 in the quarterfinal round. Meanwhile, Kennesaw State is facing Sam Houston State in the quarterfinals this Saturday, the conference's second-ever postseason match-up against the Bearkats. The previous meeting was in 2011 when Stony Brook fell by seven points to SHSU in the second round.

MAKING A STATE-MENT

As mentioned above, Kennesaw State is meeting Sam Houston State this week in the FCS quarterfinals. The Owls are 4-1 all-time against fellow "State"-named schools, including 3-0 this season. In 2017, KSU has defeated Alabama State, Montana State and Jacksonville State. Kennesaw State is 1-1 all-time vs. East Tennessee State.

OH, THANK HEAVEN

Kennesaw State's 12 wins this season has tied the Big South single-season victory record. The Owls are the second team with a dozen triumphs in a season and match the mark set by Coastal Carolina in 2013 and 2014. KSU is the fifth different member to post double-digit wins in a campaign, joining Coastal Carolina (3), Charleston Southern (2), Liberty (1) and Stony Brook (1). Coupled with Monmouth's nine victories, this is the third time in five seasons and fourth time overall that two Big South football members won at least nine regular-season games in the same year.

WE'RE GOING STREAKIN'

Kennesaw State has won a program-record 12 consecutive games, which is now the longest single-season win streak in Big South history. The previous record of 11 was set by Coastal Carolina in 2014. KSU's string is the second-longest overall win streak in league annals. That record is 14 games, established by Charleston Southern from 2005-06.

BIRD'S EYE VIEW - KSU SETS TWO BIG SOUTH RUSHING RECORDS

The Kennesaw State Owls have rushed for a Big South single-season record 4,271 yards -- the first team in league history with 4,000 yards on the ground in a campaign. KSU leads the nation in rushing yards per game with 328.5, the second-highest single-season average in league history. Kennesaw State rushed for 300 yards in a Big South-record nine consecutive games during Weeks 5-13, and gained 3,205 yards in that span (356.1 average), including a conference-game record 498 in Week 7 at Liberty.

BIG SOUTH SCORES ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL NON-CONFERENCE SEASON

The Big South went 16-11 (=59.3 percent) against non-conference FCS opponents in the 2017 regular-season, marking the league's fifth consecutive winning regular-season against non-league foes. Since the start of the 2013 campaign, the Big South is 80-43 (=65.0 winning percentage) in regular-season competition and 87-50 (=63.5 when including postseason games in that span).

STRETCH ARMSTRONG

Kennesaw State R-freshman LB, Big South Co-Freshman of the Year and Jerry Rice Award finalist **BRYSON ARMSTRONG** leads the Big South with a league-record 11.0 quaterback sacks. In Week 12, he broke the previous mark of 9.5 set by Liberty's **TOBY ONYECHE** in 2014, and surpassed the Big South freshman record of 7.0 in Week 11. Meanwhile, Armstrong -- who has been the STATS National Freshman of the Week (Week 3) and four-time Honorable Mention for the weekly award (Weeks 1, 2, 6 & 12) -- ranks among the Big South leaders in fumble recoveries (1st), tackles per game (4th), TFL (4th), interceptions (T-3rd) and passes defended (8th).

RANK AND FILE

The Big South had two teams in the Top 25 national rankings during the last four weeks of the regular-season, as Kennesaw State is No. 16 in the FCS Coaches poll and No. 18 in the STATS FCS ranking. Monmouth is No. 23 in the Coaches ranking, and sits in the 28th position in the STATS poll. The Big South returned to the national rankings Oct. 30 following a four-week hiatus, and this is the 44th time overall in Big South history that two teams are ranked in the same week (six times in 2017). The conference has had a Top 25 program in 87 of the last 91 weeks -- including a streak of 83 consecutive weeks from Oct. 17, 2011 to Oct. 1, 2017.

BIRDS OF PREY

Kennesaw State ranks 12th in the nation in rushing defense, as the Owls are permitting 97.2 rushing yards per game and have held six foes to less than 100 yards on the ground. The Big South single-season record for rushing defense is 101.0 yards per game set by Stony Brook in 2011.

BURKS LOCKS UP SINGLE-SEASON QB RUSHING TOUCHDOWN RECORD

Kennesaw State QB and Walter Payton Award finalist **CHANDLER BURKS** leads the Big South with 17 rushing touchdowns -- the conference single-season record by a quarterback. He tied the league's single-game rush TD mark with four in the Big South Championship game vs. Monmouth in Week 12. Burks, whose six-game TD rush streak during the year is the second-longest by a quarterback in league history, has five career games with at least 3-TD rushes -- the most by a Big South quarterback and tied for the second-most overall in league annals.

OWL BE WATCHING

Kennesaw State leads the Big South in total defense at 287.5, which is pacing ahead of the single-season league record of 292.0 set by Charleston Southern in 2015. The Owls became the first Big South member in history to hold three consecutive conference opponents to **three points-or-less**, as KSU permitted just a field goal overall in three league contests from Oct. 21-Nov. 11. Kennesaw State is also the second team with back-to-back shutouts in Big South games, joining the 2008 Liberty Flames. Meanwhile, Kennesaw State held four consecutive opponents to less than 300 yards of offense during Weeks 8-11 (an average of just 239.5 in that timeframe).

BANK ON BURKS

Kennesaw State QB **CHANDLER BURKS** is now the Big South's all-time leader for most rushing touchdowns by a quarterback, as his 26 career scores separated him from Gardner-Webb's **TYRELL MAXWELL**, who ends his career second with 22 rush TDs. Burks, who ranks second behind Maxwell on the Big South's quarterback career rushing list with 1,857 yards, is the second Big South signal-caller with 20 career rushing (26) and 20 career passing touchdowns (22). Maxwell was the first with the 20 / 20 achievement (22 rush TDs and 25 passing TDs).

KENNESAW STATE COMPLETES UNDEFEATED BIG SOUTH SEASON

Outright Big South Champion Kennesaw State finished a perfect 5-0 in the league after winning the conference's 's second-ever "Winner Take All" Championship game vs. Monmouth in the regular-season finale. The Owls posted the league's ninth undefeated and outright championship in 16 years of Big South football -- and is just the fourth team to finish 5-0 or better in league games.

THREE-LEGGED RACE

Kennesaw State QB **CHANDLER BURKS** became the 10th quarterback in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards when he reached the milestone in Week 3, and now ranks second in league annals among quarterbacks with 1,857 -- 143 yards away from becoming the second Big South QB with 2,000 career rushing yards. Burks, who is Kennesaw State's all-time leading rusher, was the third player in the program's young history to reach the benchmark. Teammate RBs **JAKE MCKENZIE** (1,474) and **DARNELL HOLLAND** (1,386) both surpassed the milestone in Week 7 at Liberty to give the Owls three active players with 1,000 career rushing yards.

HOUSE CALLS

Kennesaw State is 7-0 at home in 2017 (6-0 during the regular-season), while Monmouth finished its home schedule a perfect 5-0, marking the second time in three years that two Big South squads went undefeated at home in regular-season games. The last time two members finished unbeaten overall at home (including playoffs) was in 2009. Meanwhile, Kennesaw State is just the third different Big South team to post a 7-0 home record, joining Coastal Carolina (2004 and 2013) and Stony Brook (2012). The Owls have won nine-straight home games, dating back to 2016.

POINT OF ORDER

Liberty departs the Big South with the league record for most consecutive games with a point scored at 144. Monmouth holds the longest active streak at 37 games, just ahead of Kennesaw State's streak of 35 games.

DOUBLE DIP -- BIG SOUTH HAS TWO PLAYOFF TEAMS FOR FOURTH TIME

For the fourth time in the Big South's eight-year AQ history, the conference sent two teams to the FCS Playoffs in the same season. Third-year program Kennesaw State earned its first postseason berth as the league's outright champion and automatic bid recipient, while Monmouth collected its first-ever playoff berth in the 25-year history of the program.

FIVE GUYS

Monmouth's at-large berth in the FCS Playoffs is the Big South's fifth at-large entry into the postseason. The previous times were 2006 (Coastal Carolina), 2012 (Stony Brook), 2014 (Coastal Carolina) and 2015 (Coastal Carolina). Meanwhile, Monmouth and Kennesaw State are the fifth and sixth different Big South members to qualify for the playoffs.

MAGIC MIKE

Monmouth DB, Big South Co-Defensive Player of the Year and Buck Buchanan Award finalist **MIKE BASILE** departs the Big South as the league's all-time leader with 285 career solo tackles -- which would rank 20th by itself on the conference's overall career tackle list. His 91 solo stops in 2017 are a Big South single-season record, and he is just the third player with three 100-tackle seasons. Basile finishes his career as the Big South's third all-time leading tackler with 433. He became just the fourth Big South player in history with 400 career tackles when he eclipsed the milestone in Week 10. Meanwhile, Basile ranks second in league history with six career blocked kicks. The all-time record is nine, which is held by Presbyterian College's and three-time NFL Pro Bowler **JUSTIN BETHEL**.

TRY TO KEEP UP WITH THIS JONES

Monmouth junior RB **DEVELL JONES** is second in the Big South with 11 rushing touchdowns. The short-yardage specialist carried the ball a total of 62 times for 307 yards in 2017 -- with long runs of 42 and 53 -- and scored on runs of 6, 6, 8, 4, 1, 3, 4, 4, 1, 2 and 1 yards for the Hawks. Jones, who is just the eighth Big South player to score a rushing TD in the first five games of a season, is the first Monmouth player to score 10 rushing touchdowns since MU joined the Big South in 2014, and is the second player in league history to score 10-plus rushing TDs in a season with less than 100 carries. Coastal Carolina's **AUNDRES PERKINS** rushed for 12 touchdowns on 68 attempts in 2005.

BIG SOUTH HAS THREE FINALISTS FOR NATIONAL FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

The Big South has three of the 20 finalists for the STATS Jerry Rice Award, as Kennesaw State LB **BRYSON ARMSTRONG**, Monmouth RB **PETE GUERRIERO** and Presbyterian College RB **TORRANCE MARABLE** are among the candidates. It is the second consecutive year that the league has three finalists for the nation's top freshman in the same season.

FAB FRESHMEN

Monmouth R-freshman RB and Big South Co-Freshman of the Year **PETE GUERRIERO** is currently the Big South's leading rusher with 1,061 yards, and is looking to become the first Hawks player and just the second Big South frosh to lead the conference in rushing. Fellow freshman RB **TORRANCE MARABLE** of Presbyterian is third with 1,038, and the two are the second and third Big South freshmen to rush for 1,000 yards. In Weeks 2-6, Marable became the first Big South freshman ever to score a touchdown in five consecutive games, as he tallied five (three rushing, two receiving) in that span.

REG-GIE, REG-GIE

Monmouth junior WR **REGGIE WHITE JR.** has posted back-to-back seasons with 60+ receptions -- the first Big South player to achieve this feat since Liberty's **DARRIN PETERSON** in 2014-15 and the seventh overall in league history. Last season's Big South leader in receptions, receptions per game and receiving yards, White ranks in the league's career Top 10 in receptions (8th - 178), receiving yards (9th - 2,240) and TD catches (T-8th - 20). White caught 10 passes for 187 yards and two scores in Week 8 vs. Liberty. It was his fifth career 10-reception game, the second-most in Big South history. The career record is eight, held by Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE**.

TV GUIDE

The Big South Conference's 2017 regular-season television slate featured 45 games spanning every week of the campaign -- nearly 90 percent of the entire schedule -- with 14 total games exclusively on **ESPN3**, **STADIUM** and **7COMM/PRINCETON MEDIA GROUP**. ESPN3's coverage was an exclusive seven-game package, including a Wildcard selection for the regular-season finale. Stadium televised three games. The Big South has received 71 total broadcast exposures this season through the second round of the FCS Playoffs.

MONUMENTAL

Monmouth entered the national rankings this season for the first time in the program's 25-year history. The Hawks debuted at No. 24 in the FCS Coaches Poll on Oct. 30, reached as high as No. 22 the following two weeks and entered the postseason No. 23 in that ranking. The squad's nine wins were its most since going 10-2 in 2006, and the team scored 30 points in eight of its nine victories this season -- a program record.

ELLIS TACKLES BIG SOUTH RECORDS

Charleston Southern DL, Big South Co-Defensive Player of the Year and Buck Buchanan Award finalist **ANTHONY ELLIS** departs the Big South as the second player with 50.0 career TFL and 20.0 career sacks. He finishes his career with the second-most TFL with 51.5, as well as second all-time with 24.0 quarterback sacks. Ellis, who recorded a Big South single-game record 5.5 tackles-for-loss in Week 10 at Gardner-Webb, ended the 2017 season with 9.0 sacks -- making him just the second Big South player with three 7.0-sack seasons.

CALL IN THE CALVERTY

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT** ended the season with a Big South single-season record 305.7 passing yards per game, and tied the all-time mark for most touchdown passes with 29. His 3,363 passing yards are second-most in league annals and 26 yards short of the record. Calvert, the third different quarterback in Big South history with 3,000 passing yards in a season, tossed a TD pass in 13 consecutive games dating back to last season -- tied for the third-longest streak in Big South history. Meanwhile, Calvert had two 400-yard passing games to his credit this year -- the first Big South player to achieve this feat in a campaign.

KING OF THE HILL

Liberty junior WR **DAMIAN KING** caught 66 passes for 669 yards in 11 games this season. In his first two years in Lynchburg, he had 24 career receptions for 206 yards in 16 appearances. King had two 10-reception games in 2017, the first Liberty player with this achievement since **DARRIN PETERSON** in 2014.

GANDY DANCER

Liberty WR **ANTONIO GANDY-GOLDEN** leads the Big South with 1,066 receiving yards, is tied for first with 10 TD catches and ranks second with 69 receptions -- all in 10 games this season. In 11 appearances as a freshman in 2016, he had 21 catches for 315 yards and three scores. Gandy-Golden had six 100-yard receiving games -- including two with at least 170 receiving yards to be the first Big South receiver with this distinction since former Flame WR **CHRIS SUMMERS** in 2011. Meanwhile, Gandy-Golden's 106.6 receiving yards per game is the third-highest single-season average in Big South history, while his receiving yards place him fourth on the season records list.

TURNING 60

Liberty receiving tandem **ANTONIO GANDY-GOLDEN** (69) and **DAMIAN KING** (66) are the first Big South teammates in history to have 60 receptions in the same season. They were already the first pair of Big South teammates with 50 receptions in the same year since 2014 and the seventh overall. It was the third time Liberty has achieved this accomplishment, the most by any school. In Week 1 at Baylor, King and Gandy-Golden became the first Big South teammates ever with at least 10 catches in the same game. Gandy-Golden posted career-highs of 13 receptions for 192 yards against the Bears, while King caught 10 balls for 66 yards. Meanwhile, Gandy-Golden and teammate **B.J. FARROW** are the first set of teammates with 10 touchdown catches in the same year.

2,000-YARD RUSHING ODYSSEY

Gardner-Webb QB **TYRELL MAXWELL** ends his career as the Big South's sixth all-time leading rusher with a quarterback-record 2,949 yards -- the only signal-caller in conference annals above the 2,000-yard threshold. Maxwell, who became the first quarterback in league history to finish as the conference's leading rusher in 2016 with 965 yards, posted his 11th career game with 100 yards rushing and 100 yards passing in the regular-season finale against Presbyterian to extend his Big South career record. He finished with 175 yards on the ground and 169 through the air against the Blue Hose. It was Maxwell's 12th career 100-yard rushing game -- tied for the seventh-most by any Big South player.

ROCK OF AGES

Presbyterian DB **ROCK YA-SIN** is tied for the Big South lead with five interceptions, as well as third with 13 passes defended for a 1.18 per game average. His two fumble recoveries are tied for second-most in the league this season.

IT'S ACADEMIC

Four Big South football student-athletes were named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District teams, and are now candidates for Academic All-America honors. Charleston Southern's **JAMES ALLEN**, Gardner-Webb's **WILL MILLIKAN**, Kennesaw State's **CHANDLER BURKS** and Liberty's **HUNTER WINSTEAD** comprise the league's most Academic All-District selections since 2014.

BIG SOUTH GETTING BIGGER

The Big South Conference announced the addition of Hampton University as a full member beginning in the fall of 2018. While efforts are underway to integrate the Pirates into the 2018 football season, Hampton's likely first year on the gridiron as part of the Big South will be 2019. Next season features the addition of Campbell University, as the school announced on Nov. 14, 2016, that it will begin scholarship football in 2018, and make the subsequent move to the Big South. Campbell is already a full-time conference member, and played its final season of non-scholarship football this year in the Pioneer Football League. Meanwhile, the University of North Alabama will join Big South Football in 2019 as an associate member, a direct result of the Big South's collaboration agreement with the ASUN Conference in which ASUN members playing scholarship football have an automatic home in the Big South.

GOOD-BYES

Liberty University played its final football game as a Big South member Nov. 18, as the Flames are transitioning to the Football Bowl Subdivision. LU is the league's all-time winningest program in conference action, as the Flames went 55-23 all-time in Big South contests (=70.5 percent). Liberty scored a point in all 78 of its Big South games, the longest such streak in league annals. Of those 78 games, the last 66 were in double digits.

BIG BROWN

Charleston Southern junior DL **SOLOMON BROWN** entered the Big South's career Top 10 for tackles-for-loss and quarterback sacks this season. He is ninth all-time with 35.0 career TFL, and ranks tied for seventh with 15.0 quarterback sacks. Brown will enter his senior year of 2018 needing five sacks to become just the fourth player with 20. His 35.0 career TFL have come in 33 career appearances, and he is approaching 100 career solo tackles and 200 career total stops.

KAMERON KAN

Charleston Southern R-sophomore WR **KAMERON BROWN** connected with R-sophomore QB **SHANE BUCENELL** on an 87-yard touchdown pass against Mississippi Valley State in Week 5, tied for the fourth-longest pass play in Big South history. In 21 career games, Brown has caught 52 career passes for 1,092 yards -- a 21.00 career yards per catch average -- and eight scores.

BUCS' RECORD FOR CONSECUTIVE BIG SOUTH ROAD WINS ENDS AT NINE

Charleston Southern's Big South-record for consecutive league road wins ended at nine in Week 11 at Kennesaw State, as the Owls blanked the Buccaneers, 38-0. The loss also ended CSU's scoring streak in Big South games at 50, as the squad was held scoreless in a conference game for the first time since Nov. 1, 2008. The Bucs began their record road win streak on Nov. 1, 2014 and surpassed the old league mark of seven in their Big South opener in Week 7 with a 7-0 win at Presbyterian.

THE FORCE IS STRONG WITH THIS ONE

Charleston Southern senior DL **ANTHONY ELLIS** is tied for the league-lead with three forced fumbles, and ends his career with seven fumbles forced, tied for the third-most in Big South history.

BIG SOUTH COLLECTS FIRST-EVER WIN OVER POWER 5 MEMBER

The Big South scored its sixth win over an FBS opponent with Liberty's 48-45 triumph over Big 12 member Baylor in Week 1. It was the conference's first-ever win over a Power 5 member, as well as the league's first FBS victory in a season-opener. The Big South's six FBS wins have all come since 2010.

HIGH FIVE

Liberty sophomore QB **STEPHEN CALVERT** became the first Big South quarterback in league history with two 5-TD pass games in the same season. He tied the conference single-game record twice this year -- first in Week 2 and again in Week 8 with five scoring strikes at Monmouth. Calvert, who is the first Big South quarterback in league history to open the season with three consecutive 3-TD pass games, as well as the second overall to throw at least three scoring strikes in back-to-back-to-back games, now shares the career record of most 5-TD pass games (2) with former Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS**.

* The Buccaneers tallied a Big South single-season record 34 quarterback sacks, besting the old mark of 31 set by Charleston Southern in 2002. CSU is the only team in conference history to record a 30-plus sack season.

* DL **ANTHONY ELLIS** remains on track to lead the Big South in tackles-for-loss for the third consecutive season, which would make him the first player with this distinction. His season total of 16.0 is 4.5 ahead of players still active in the FCS postseason.

* RB **NOAH SHULER**'s eight rushing touchdowns in 2017 moved him into a tie for sixth all-time in a single season at CSU.

* DB **SHADARIUS HOPKINS** tied the Big South single-game record with five PBUs in the season finale against Liberty. He finished the season with two interceptions and 12 breakups, giving him 14 passes defended in 2017. The total ties him for third all-time in school history with **TROY MCGOWENS** (2014) in a single season.

* PK **TYLER TEKAC**'s 42-yard game-winner over Liberty was his fifth 40-plus yard field goal of the season. It was his second game-winning kick of 2017, with his first being a 43-yarder at Gardner-Webb as time expired in the 10-9 win.
