BIG SOUTH IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

Winthrop is making its 10th trip to the Big Dance, the most in Big South history. The Eagles are 1-9 all-time in the NCAA Tournament.

The Big South Conference first secured an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament in 1992, sending its postseason tournament champion to the Big Dance every year since, with the exception of 1995.

Winthrop garnered the League's highest seed at No. 11 in 2007. Below is a look at the Conference's NCAA Tournament history:

SEVEN-YEAR ITCH SCRATCHED -- WINTHROP GOING DANCING FOR FIRST TIME SINCE 2010

The Winthrop Eagles are headed to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in seven years, as the Eagles last appeared in the Big Dance in 2010. Winthrop is making its 10th overall appearance in the NCAA Tournament -- extending its Big South record and the first league member with double-digit berths. The Eagles are 1-9 all-time in the NCAA Tournament and is the only Big South program to advance to the Round of 32.

BIG SOUTH GARNERS NO. 13 SEED IN NCAA's

Big South Champion Winthrop is a No. 13 seed in the 2017 NCAA Tournament, the league's second-highest seeding. The conference was a No. 13 seed in 2008 (Winthrop), while its all-time high was No. 11 (Winthrop in 2007). Meanwhile, the Eagles will face No. 4 Butler from the BIG EAST -- the same conference that the Eagles defeated in the 2007 NCAA Tournament (Notre Dame). Butler is led by former Big South Coach of the Year **CHRIS HOLTMANN**, who won the award in 2012-13 at Gardner-Webb -- which was **PAT KELSEY**'s first season as head coach at Winthrop.

BIG SOUTH LANDS THREE IN COLLEGEINSIDER.COM TOURNAMENT

A league-record three programs accepted bids into the 26-team *Collegeinsider.com* Tournament (CIT) -- Campbell, Liberty and UNC Asheville. Campbell is making its first postseason appearance since 1992. Liberty is making its second appearance in the CIT as it was the conference's first-ever representative in 2009. Asheville is making its debut in the CIT as well as its second consecutive postseason berth, as the Bulldogs were the Big South's NCAA Tournament representative in 2016. The Big South has enjoyed success in the CIT, as the league has reached the Semifinals twice in the last three years, and has advanced now five times in the seven years it has competed in the event.

BIG SOUTH HAS CO-CHAMPIONS FOR FOURTH TIME IN FIVE SEASONS

Winthrop and UNC Asheville tied for the regular-season championship, and the Eagles earned the No. 1 seed in the Big South Championship with the Bulldogs receiving the No. 2 seed, as determined by the league's tiebreaker. Winthrop was the No. 1 seed for the first time since 2007, and has captured back-to-back Big South regular-season titles for the first time since 2006-08. Asheville clinched its first regular-season crown since 2011-12. Winthrop has now won or shared nine regular-season championships, extending its Big South record. Asheville's total now stands at six, which is tied for second-most in conference history.

KELSEY FIRST BIG SOUTH COACH TO REACH CENTURY MARK FOR WINS IN FIRST FIVE YEARS

Winthrop head coach **PAT KELSEY** is 102-58 through 160 games as the Eagles' head coach, and is the first-ever Big South coach to win 100 games in his first five years in the conference. He surpassed the win totals of **GREGG MARSHALL** (99 from 1998-03) and **CLIFF ELLIS** (99 from 2007-12). Meanwhile, earlier this season Kelsey became just the sixth coach in league history to reach 50 Big South victories in less than 80 games, as he posted the benchmark win in his 79th game on Feb. 1 at Radford. Kelsey is 56-30 in 86 Big South contests, and joined Marshall (64 games), **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** (73), **RUSS BERGMAN** (74), **RON BRADLEY** (78) and Ellis (78) as the only coaches to win 50 Big South games in less than 80 games.

CHRIS CLEMONS' DAZZLING PERFORMANCE DURING BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT

Campbell sophomore **CHRIS CLEMONS** led the Camels from the First Round to the Big South Championship game with a performance for the ages. He set the Big South Tournament record for most points (140) -- including an all-time Big South single-game record 51 in the Quarterfinal win over UNC Asheville, and broke the old record of 92 points in his Semifinal outing vs. Radford. He drained eight 3-pointers against the Bulldogs to tie the single-game Tournament mark and finished with a Tournament-record 20 treys. Clemons' 48 made field goals and 93 field goal attempts also established overall Tournament bests.

KEON'S 2,000-POINT ODYSSEY

Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** became the 10th player in Big South history with 2,000 career points when he eclipsed the milestone in the Eagles' Big South Quarterfinal victory. He enters the NCAA Tournament with 2,059 in his career to rank ninth in league annals. Johnson scored a career-high 40 points at UNC Asheville on Feb. 9 -- the first 40-point effort in a Big South game since Feb. 13, 2014. Johnson, who became Winthrop's all-time leading scorer during that Asheville contest, is 12th all-time in Big South history with a school-record 292 career 3-point field goals. He is four shy of cracking the all-time Top 10.

BAKER'S DOZEN

For the first time in Big South history, three teams won at least 13 conference games in the same year. Winthrop and UNC Asheville topped the league with 15 wins, followed by Liberty with 14. The Flames set a school record for most Big South victories, while Winthrop tied its program mark of 15 first set in 2004-05. Asheville posted its second-most Big South wins in a campaign.

THOMAS THE LOCOMOTIVE

UNC Asheville junior guard **AHMAD THOMAS** became the 56th player in Big South history with 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds when he surpassed the rebound milestone in the regular season finale on Feb. 25. He enters the CIT with career totals of 1,076 points and 508 boards, and is well on his way to becoming just the sixth player in Big South history with 1,000 points, 500 rebounds and 200 steals, as his career steal total is 186.

20 ON MY MIND

Winthrop and UNC Asheville each posted 23 regular-season wins, which marked the sixth time in Big South history that two programs had at least 20 victories prior to the conference tournament. The Eagles' 26 overall wins is their most since a school-record 29 victories in 2006-07, and marks the team's 11th 20-win campaign as Big South members. Asheville's 23 wins are its most since winning 24 contests in 2011-12, and the Bulldogs have reached 20 wins in a season six times during its stay in the conference. UNC Asheville was the first Big South team with 20 wins this season, as the Bulldogs' 20-7 record through 27 games marked the program's fewest games needed to reach 20 victories as Big South members. Winthrop netted its 20th win in 26 games. Meanwhile, Liberty has recorded its first 20-win season since 2008-09.

15-FOOTERS

Gardner-Webb head coach **TIM CRAFT** is just the fourth coach in league annals to win at least 15 games in each of his first four seasons in the Big South, as he won 18, 20, 17 and 19 games in that span. UNC Asheville head coach **NICK McDEVITT** was the third with the achievement back on Jan. 26, as he has 17, 15, 22 and 23 wins in the same four-year timeframe. The two join Radford's **RON BRADLEY** (20-16-20-16) and Winthrop's **GREGG MARSHALL** (21-21-18-19). Meanwhile, Winthrop was the first team this season to win 15 games, and the Eagles accomplished the feat in 19 contests -- tied for the third-fastest in Big South history. The last time Winthrop started a season 15-4 was in 2006-07 -- the year in which the Eagles won the Big South title as well as an NCAA Tournament game. Asheville has won at least 15 games for the 10th consecutive season -- tying the Big South record first established by Winthrop from 1998-08.

BALANCE BEAM

The 90-game Big South season saw the visiting teams finish with a 43-47 record for a 47.8 winning percentage -- the highest winning percentage since 2002-03 and the fourth consecutive season at or above a 40.0 winning clip away from home. The visiting squads won their 43 games by an average of 12.53 points. In 2015-16, visiting teams finished 47-52 in league action (=47.5 percent).

MARGINAL NOTE

Through the completion of the 90-game Big South season, 43 (=47.8 percent) were decided by single digits (4.60 average margin) -- 28 of which were by 5 points or less (=65.1 percent). In 2015-16, 61.6 percent of all Big South games were decided by less than 10 points (4.28 winning average). Meanwhile, this season's overall margin of victory was 11.81 points. The 2015-16 league scoring margin was 8.72 points, compared to 10.76 points in 2014-15 and 9.83 points in 2013-14.

THE NUMBER 10

Winthrop, UNC Asheville, Liberty and Gardner-Webb all surpassed 10 Big South wins this season. For the Eagles, it was their 14th all-time season with 10-plus Big South wins, which extends their league-record. The Bulldogs have won at least 10 Big South games 13 times -- including the last 10 consecutive seasons to establish a conference record. The Flames reached double-digit Big South victories for the second straight year and 10th time overall. The Runnin' Bulldogs have now managed five consecutive 10-win Big South seasons, and their 11 wins matches their most as league members.

IT'S ACADEMIC

UNC Asheville junior **KEVIN VANNATTA** was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District III team Feb. 9. While Vannatta's selection marks the league's first selection since 2014-15, it is the 10th time out of the last 12 years a Big South men's basketball student-athlete has earned Academic All-District honors. He is the first Bulldog with the academic achievement since **RALF MELIS** in 1994-95.

FULL NELSON

Gardner-Webb senior forward **TYRELL NELSON** ends his career as one of five players in Big South history with 1,600 career points (1,664) and 850 career rebounds (874). He ranks seventh all-time in rebounding, while his scoring total is 25th -- and marks Gardner-Webb's highest-ranking player on either list. This season Nelson surpassed 600 career field goals (Jan. 28 at Charleston Southern) and 300 career made free throws (Jan. 19 at Liberty).

CLEMONS' HISTORIC SCORING - PART I

Campbell sophomore guard **CHRIS CLEMONS** became the third sophomore -- and the fastest -- to reach 1,000 career points when he eclipsed the milestone Jan. 19. Clemons hit the benchmark in his 49th career game, ahead of previous sophomores **JOHN BROWN** (56 games) and **ANDREW ROWSEY** (50 games). Clemons needed the second-fewest appearances to score 1,000 points in the Big South, as that record is 48 games, set by Charleston Southern's **BEN HINSON** in 1986-87 and tied by CSU's **DARNELL SNEED** in 1992-93.

CLEMONS' HISTORIC SCORING - PART II

During the Big South Tournament, Campbell sophomore **CHRIS CLEMONS** set the Big South record for most points scored by a player in his first two years in the conference. With 1,366 points, he shattered the old mark of 1,269 that was established by Charleston Southern's **BEN HINSON** from 1985-87. Clemons has scored his 1,366 points in 63 career games, and his 21.68 career scoring average is officially third all-time in Big South annals (based on 1,000 career points). He trails VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (22.82) and Charleston Southern's **DARNELL SNEED** (21.75).

FABULOUS FRESHMEN

UNC Asheville's **MACIO TEAGUE** and Charleston Southern's **CHRISTIAN KEELING** are among seven Big South freshmen in league history to score 500 points during their frosh season in the Big South. Keeling ranks fourth in the league with 17.3 points per game and 537 points, while Teague is at 15.7 ppg and 503 markers.

CATCH HIM IF YOU CAN

UNC Asheville junior guard **AHMAD THOMAS**, who is second in the Big South and ranks fourth in the nation with 96 steals, is the first Big South player with back-to-back 70-steal seasons since VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** from 2006-08 and just the fourth overall. Thomas was the league's leader last year with 71 thefts and is attempting to become the first player to lead the conference in total steals in consecutive years since Radford's **JAVONTE GREEN** from 2013-15.

STEALING THE SPOTLIGHT

Gardner-Webb sophomore guard **LaQUINCY RIDEAU** is the first player with 100 steals in a season since VMI's **CHAVIS HOLMES** had 105 in 2008-09. Rideau's average of 3.03 steals per game is just ahead of UNC Asheville's **AHMAD THOMAS** (3.00). Rideau and Thomas -- who are the first Big South players with at least 90 steals in a season since 2008-09 -- rank third and fourth, respectively, in the nation in total thefts. If they can maintain their averages, it would be just the second time in Big South history that two players averaged at least 3.0 steals in the same season (2008-09 was the first). Rideau collected 10 steals against Presbyterian Jan. 21, which tied the Big South record for most steals in a conference game. He was the second player this season with 10 steals in a game, as Thomas had 10 against Warren Wilson on Dec. 10.

HE GIVETH AND TAKETH AWAY

Gardner-Webb's **LaQUINCY RIDEAU** is the first player in Big South history to finish a season with 150 assists (171), 100 rebounds (189) and 100 steals (100). He is looking to conclude the year as the Big South leader in assists per game (5.18) and steals per game (3.03), which would make him the first player to lead the conference in both categories since Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** in 2002-03. With 171 assists and 100 steals this season, Rideau is just the third Big South player **EVER** with 150 assists and 100 steals in a campaign. The other two were Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** (270 assists, 114 steals in 1986-87) and Coastal Carolina's **ROBERT DOWDELL** (201 assists, 109 steals in 1989-90).

DOUBLE VISION

Campbell's **CHRIS CLEMONS** is the league's active leader for consecutive double-figure scoring games at 48 and has reached double-figure points in 62 of 63 career games. Behind Clemons' current 48-game streak is Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** (14).

LITTLE BIG MAN

Winthrop senior guard **KEON JOHNSON** is one of just TWO players in Big South history with 2,000 career points (2,059), 375 career rebounds (393), 275 career 3-pointers (292) and 250 career assists (267). Meanwhile, Johnson is the Big South's all-time leader for free throws made with 517, as he broke the league's career record during the Big South Championship game. He is now 517-of-610 in his career from the free throw line and currently ranks second all-time in Big South history with an 84.8 career FT percentage.

HE CAN SHOOT FOR MILES AND MILES

High Point's **MILES BOWMAN JR.** leads the Big South with a 90.1 free throw percentage, just the fourth different player to finish the season with at least a 90.0 percent success rate from the charity stripe -- and the third in the last five seasons. Bowman's percentage is the highest by a High Point player (based on the league minimum of 2.50 free throws made per game) since 2011-12 when **NICK BARBOUR** shot 82.9 percent from the line.

TREY-LINERS

Winthrop leads the Big South with 9.50 three-pointers per game, a category the Eagles last led in 2002-03 with 6.90. WU's current per game clip is ahead of its previous best of 8.91 threes per contest, set just last season. Liberty, which has never led the Big South in three-pointers per game, is second to the Eagles with 9.15. The Big South has had a member average at least 9.0 treys per game each season since 2012-13.

TOP CHEF

Winthrop junior forward **XAVIER COOKS** is just the 7th player in Big South history with more than 1,000 career points (1,239), 700 rebounds (714) and 150 blocked shots (157). He became the 33rd Big South player with 700 career rebounds when he reached the threshold March 3, and holds the 27th position with 714. In Winthrop's Big South opener on Dec. 29, Cooks became the 82nd all-time player with 500 career boards.

FIVE BENJAMINS

UNC Asheville's **WILL WEEKS** became the 83rd player in Big South history with 500 career rebounds when he eclipsed the milestone Feb. 11. Weeks got some company the final week of the regular season, as teammate **AHMAD THOMAS** became the 84th player with the achievement, followed by Radford sophomore **ED POLITE JR.** as the 85th during the Feb. 25 regular-season finale at Campbell. Presbyterian College's **ED DREW** also eclipsed 500 career rebounds on Feb. 25.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Winthrop and UNC Asheville are the lone Big South programs to have two players averaging at least 15.0 points this season. **KEON JOHNSON** (22.5) and **XAVIER COOKS** (16.3) are averaging a combined 38.8 of the Eagles' season average of 79.7 points (=48.7 percent). **AHMAD THOMAS** (17.8) and **MACIO TEAGUE** (15.7) are combining for an average of 33.5 points, which equates to 43.4 percent of the Bulldogs' 77.2 points per game. Thomas and Teague have scored 15 points in the same game 12 times this season, and Asheville is 10-2 in those contests. Johnson and Cooks have tallied 15 markers in the same game 13 times this year, with the Eagles posting a 10-3 record when that occurs.

20-20 VISION

Winthrop's **XAVIER COOKS** posted 21 points and 20 rebounds Feb. 15 at Longwood, the Big South's first 20-20 game since Gardner-Webb's **JEROME HILL** had 24 points and 20 boards against Campbell on Feb. 6, 2015. In fact, six of the last seven 20-point / 20-rebound games in the conference (since 2006-07) have come in the month of February.

RAINING THREES

Every Big South team has made at least 10 three-pointers in a game twice this season, and the league's top three teams in the standings -- Winthrop, UNC Asheville, Liberty -- have posted the most games making 10 treys. The Eagles are first with 17 such efforts and are 16-1 this season when hitting the benchmark. The Flames are next with 16 (13-3 record) followed by UNC Asheville with 10 (8-2 mark).

BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

UNC Asheville's **AHMAD THOMAS** became the fourth player this season and 147th overall to score 1,000 career points in the Big South when he eclipsed the milestone Feb. 15 vs. Presbyterian. Campbell's **CHRIS CLEMONS** and Winthrop's **XAVIER COOKS** became the 144th and 145th players, respectively, to break the threshold -- each doing so on Jan. 19, while Longwood's **DARRION ALLEN** became the 146th to achieve the milestone on Feb. 1. The Big South had six active 1,000-point scorers in 2016-17, with Winthrop's **KEON JOHNSON** 9th all-time at 2,059, and Gardner-Webb's **TYRELL NELSON** in 25th with 1,664. Below is a look at the six players' respective all-time scoring rankings in Big South history.

BIG SOUTH SCORES SECOND WIN OVER BIG TEN

The Big South collected its second win over the Big Ten this season with Gardner-Webb's 70-62 win at Nebraska on Dec. 18. Coupled with Winthrop's 84-80 overtime win at Illinois on Nov. 21, it is the first time the Big South has won twice over the Big Ten in the same year. In fact, the Big South has defeated a Big Ten member three consecutive years now, and owns a streak of six straight seasons with a win over Power 5 teams. The league's Big Ten string also features wins over Penn State (2015-16 - Radford over Penn State) and Purdue (2014-15 - Gardner-Webb over Purdue).

TONIGHT ON 20/20

Campbell sophomore guard **CHRIS CLEMONS** leads the Big South with 24.5 points per game, while Winthrop senior guard **KEON JOHNSON** is second at 22.5. The last time the Big South had two scorers averaging at least 22.0 points was in 2007-08, an achievement that has occurred four times in league history. Clemons' average currently ranks as the fourth-highest single-season average in Big South annals, and the highest by a Camel during CU's Big South tenure since **CLARENCE GRIER** in 1986-87 (24.6). Johnson's 22.5 scoring clip would be just the second time a Winthrop player averaged 20 points during the Big South's existence, as **FRED MCKINNON** managed a 21.1 scoring average in 1985-86. Meanwhile, Clemons has a league-high 25 20-point games -- including 16 with 25+, while Johnson is second with 22 20-point efforts -- including a league-best seven 30+ performances.

TWINNING

Winthrop juniors **DUBY OKEKE** (165) and **XAVIER COOKS** (157) are the first pair of Big South teammates with 150 career blocked shots when playing together, and the fifth overall set of teammates with 100 career blocked shots each. Okeke is 12th all-time in Big South history for career blocks, while Cooks sits 15th.

CLIMBING THE VICTORY LADDER

As previously noted, Winthrop head coach **PAT KELSEY** surpassed 100 career wins during the Big South Tournament and is now the 13th coach in Big South history with 100 overall wins (102). Meanwhile, Charleston Southern's **BARCLAY RADEBAUGH**, who is the longest-tenured active Big South coach as he is in his 12th year in 2016-17 and just the third head coach in league history with at least 10 years of service, is fifth all-time with 160 victories. High Point's **SCOTT CHERRY** is 8th in Big South history with 132 wins.

MID-MAJOR MANIA

For four consecutive weeks, two Big South members have been ranked in the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major poll in the same week, as Winthrop was No. 17 and UNC Asheville was No. 24 in the latest poll (March 6). It is the conference's first double-dip in the Mid-Major poll since March 2, 2015. The Eagles' appearance in this year's rankings is their first since 2007-08 when Winthrop was ranked five different times and as high as No. 7 the week of Nov. 19. Asheville has cracked the poll for the first time since 2007-08 as well, as the Bulldogs were rated eight different weeks that season and as high as No. 12 the week of Feb. 4.
