PLAYER OF THE WEEK - DJ ARTIS, LIBERTY, OF, So. (GREENSBORO, N.C.)

Artis hit .500 (6-for-12) in Liberty's conference-opening series win over preseason favorite High Point last weekend, headlined by his first collegiate grand slam, a double, three runs and a pair of RBI. The outfielder posted a slugging percentage of .833 with an on-base percentage of .600, as he also swiped two bags. On Friday, he put the game out of reach with a grand slam in the Flames' 11-1 win. On Saturday, he finished a perfect 3-for-3 with two walks and two runs scored in a three-run setback. In the rubber game on Sunday, the sophomore posted two hits and scored once to help clinch the series with a 14-2 triumph.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK - CODY WAGER, LONGWOOD, RHP, Sr. (WEST PALM BEACH, FLA.)

Wager tossed 8.1 innings and struck out 10 in Longwood's narrow 1-0 home victory over Charleston Southern on Saturday. The senior held a no-hitter through 72 innings before it was broken up on a single to right field for CSU's first hit. The 10-strikeout outing was his second in as many games.

COME READY NUTRITION FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - SPENCER HORWITZ, RADFORD, INF. (TIMONIUM, Md.)

Horwitz tallied a team-high six hits, including a 4-for-4 performance in the series finale, in Radford's three-game home sweep of Rider last weekend. The first baseman led the Highlanders with a .600 batting average for the weekend, in addition to a .700 slugging percentage and .636 on-base percentage. The outfielder also had a three-hit performance in the series opener with the Purple Aces on Friday.

CAMPBELL

Campbell finished 2-3 last week with nonconference wins over Rider and Richmond.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

JASON MILLER extended his team-best nine-game hitting streak on Sunday afternoon as the redshirt sophomore infielder connected on a season-high four hits in the contest. He added his team-high sixth double of the season in the game and has hit safely in 14 of CSU's 17 games in the 2017 season. CSU ended its losing streak at two games and prevented the series sweep for the second time in the 2017 season. The Bucs also fell in their first two games at Florida International before taking the Saturday series finale. CSU improves to 2-0 in extra-inning contests in the 2017 season with the Bucs picking up their second free baseball win of the year on Sunday. CSU previously took an 8-7 decision over Hofstra on March 5th in 11 innings with Miller providing the game-winning walk-off single scoring CHRIS SINGLETON. NIK CONSTANTAKOS became the third CSU pitcher this season to strike out the first four batters he faced in a contest with the freshman RHP starting off Saturday's game with four consecutive punch-outs. He joins EDDIE HIOTT and WIL HARTSELL who both achieved the mark previously this season.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb went 3-1 this past week, defeating Quinnipiac 5-2 on Tuesday evening and taking two of three against Georgetown over the weekend. Tuesday evening, freshman LONDON MITCHELL earned his first collegiate victory on the mound, lasting 6.0 innings with four strikeouts while allowing two runs. Redshirt junior WIL SELLERS moved from the starting rotation and back to the closer role, earning his first save of the season. Friday evening, GWU had an early offensive outburst to cruise to a 8-1 win, with five players collecting multiple hits, while junior ZACH MOSAY scattered three hits in 7.0 innings to earn the win. Saturday, GWU rallied from a 3-2 deficit in the bottom of the ninth to earn a 4-3 walkoff win in 10 innings. Senior DANNY SULLIVAN drove in the game winning run, going 2-for-5 on the day. Sunday, the Runnin' Bulldogs saw their four-game winning streak get snapped, falling by a 4-2 score.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers finished 1-3 last week with their lone win coming on Saturday over Liberty, 7-4.

LIBERTY

Liberty scored a season-high 14 runs in capturing the final game of its three-game series with High Point, Sunday. With the victory, the Flames took the Big South series, 2-1. Outfielders D.J. ARTIS and WILL SHEPHERD each hit his first home run of the season in Liberty's win over High Point, Friday. Artis hit the first grand slam of his career, while Shepherd hit a three-run home run. JAKE BARBEE had a career-high four hits, Saturday. On Sunday, Liberty did not allow an extra base hit in their games.

LONGWOOD

The Lancers took the first conference series of the season against Charleston Southern, taking the first two games, 7-2 and 1-0, before the Buccaneers took Sunday's game, 8-7 in 10 innings. Picked to finish fifth in the league, Longwood comes out of the first weekend tied for first place in the Big South. Longwood got quality starts from right-handers DEVIN GOULD and CODY WAGER, who each picked up wins against Charleston Southern. Junior shortstop MICHAEL OSINSKI drove in four runs in the weekend series, putting his conference-leading mark to 24 RBI.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC homered five times in four games last week, after having five home runs total in its previous 18 games entering the week. PC managed multi-homer games at Georgia on Wednesday and in the series finale against Army on Sunday. NICK WISE had two home runs on the week to take the team lead with three on the year. The Blue Hose are now 4-1 in Friday games this season, after going 4-10 on Friday a year ago. After a big weekend at the plate, PC leads the Big South in batting average at .273 and hits with 199. PC is also atop the league in sac bunts (21) and fielding percentage (.968). PC has three players in the top 10 in the Big South in batting average, tied for the most by one team, led by AJ PRIAULX with a .378 average, good for third-best in the league. BRETT AUCLAND is ninth with a .350 average, while NICK GUIMBARDA is 10th with a .347. BRIAN KEHNER ranks fourth in the Big South in strikeouts with 31 to date and ERIC MILES is tied for the league lead in wins with 3.

RADFORD

Radford collected its first non-conference home sweep since 2015. In the sweep, Radford's offense scored 32 runs on 43 hits. The Highlanders have won five straight, scoring 49 runs on 62 hits during the streak. Committing 36 errors on the season, Radford has limited its miscues to six during the winning streak. Freshman SPENCER HORWITZ led the way with a 6 for 10 performance at the dish with five RBIs and two runs scored. He went 4 for 4 on Sunday with four RBIs. The sweep saw MATT ROTH and JONATHAN GONZALEZ extend their hitting streaks to 10 games.

UNC ASHEVILLE

With his stolen base in the bottom of the first inning on Sunday, senior Joe Tietjen moved into a tie for seventh all-time in program history for bases stolen in a career. He has now stolen 34 bases over his career. BRANDON LANKFORD and KYLE CARRUTHERS both went for extra bases on Saturday against Winthrop. Lankford now has 13 extra-base knocks on the year, including eight doubles (tied for second in Big South). He leads the team in both categories. Saturday's home run was the first of the season for Carruthers and his first extra-base hit of 2017.

WINTHROP

This past week Winthrop went 2-3 record while going 2-1 in the Big South. The Eagles had two starters REECE GREEN and COLTON RENDON go 8 innings each against UNC Asheville while both getting the win and both being shutouts. MITCH SPIRES is on a 14 game hitting streak, while getting 9 hits this past week with 7 runs. This week Winthrop will be on the road against Wofford on Wednesday and will be at home for a weekend series against High Point.
