PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - MARCH 27

CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK - COLLIN THACKER, GARDNER-WEBB, INF, SR. (WILMINGTON, N.C.)

Thacker finished 11-for-18 (611) at the plate with seven RBI and four runs scored in a pair of wins last week. The infielder opened the four-game stretch with a 4-for-6 effort headlined by a three-run home run that helped the Runnin' Bulldogs to a 15-13 non-conference win at Western Carolina on Wednesday. For the weekend, he was 7-for-12 (583) with three doubles, three RBI and three runs scored in a three-game home set with Campbell.

CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK - JONATHAN GONZALEZ, RADFORD, C, SR. (WINSLOW TOWNSHIP, N.J.)

Gonzalez posted a 9-for-17 performance, highlighted by three home runs, in addition to eight RBI and five runs scored. Against Appalachian State on Wednesday, the senior finished 3-for-5 and knocked his third home run of the season. In a three-game home conference series with Longwood, he went 6-for-12 (500) headlined by a two-homer game in a 16-6 win on Saturday. The catcher also scored four runs and drove in five as the Highlanders took two-of-three from the Lancers.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK - ZACK RIDGELY, RADFORD, LHP, JR. (BALTIMORE, MD.)

Ridgely shined on the hill in his Friday night start against Longwood, as he allowed just three hits in 72 innings and recorded a season-high 11 strikeouts for his third win on the year. After the left-hander sat in the dugout for almost 50 minutes during RU's five-run fifth inning, Longwood put two runners in scoring position on a walk, a catcher's interference and ground out. Ridgely then tallied back-to-back swinging strikeouts to get himself out of his only jam of the night.

COME READY NUTRITION FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - MATTHEW BAREFOOT, CAMPBELL, OF, (DUNN, N.C.)

Barefoot closed last week 7-for-16 (.438) with a pair of doubles, eight RBI and five runs scored. The redshirt-freshman got off to a hot start with a 3-for-5 effort with two doubles and a home run to lead the Fighting Camels to a hard-fought 9-8 road win at ACC foe NC State on Tuesday. In the road conference series at Gardner-Webb, he posted four hits with six RBI and scored twice, headlined by a two-run home run in the top of the ninth on Saturday.

Gardner-Webb opened the week with a 15-13 win at Western Carolina, setting season highs in runs scored (15) and base hits (17). GAGE PARHAM was a perfect 5-for-5 with a double and four RBI. The Runnin' Bulldogs opened Big South play on Friday, hosting Campbell. PAUL TRICK and CHANDLER REDMOND each hit home runs, but GWU dropped the series opener, 8-6. In the first game of Saturday's doubleheader, JARRETT THOMPSON earned his first win of the season in relief as GWU held on for a 10-9 win. In the nightcap, the Runnin' Bulldogs dropped a 7-2 decision.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers finished 1-3 last week with their lone win coming on Tuesday with a 7-0 blanking of Davidson.

LIBERTY

Liberty won their first three games of the week to run their win streak to four, before falling on Sunday at Charleston Southern. LONGWOOD

The Lancers fell in their road conference series at Radford two games to one. Longwood took the final game of the series, 7-1, ending a four-game skid. In the win the Lancers improved to 6-4 when outhitting an opponent and 6-0 when finishing a game without committing an error. Longwood returns to action Tuesday after off-days Sunday and Monday thanks to Saturday's doubleheader. Longwood plays a road game at N.C. Central before returning home to host former conference foe VMI Wednesday. Longwood has the upcoming weekend off.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC's starting pitchers combined for a 1.78 ERA in four games last week, totaling 23 strikeouts against seven walks and holding hitters to a .257 average. PC lost its first home conference series since 2014, after winning all four home series against Big South opponents last season to go 9-3 against the league at the PC Baseball Complex.
