#### PLAYER OF THE WEEK - ANTHONY PAULSEN, WINTHROP, OF, R-SR. (COLUMBIA, S.C.)

Paulsen hit .500 (9-for-18) with seven runs scored, five RBI and a home run as he led Winthrop to a perfect 4-0 record last week. After he drove in a run and scored once in the Eagles' 6-4 victory over The Citadel on Tuesday, the outfielder finished 9-for-15 (600) with four RB and six runs scored in Winthrop's three-game road sweep at Liberty to close the week. The redshirt-senior's week was highlighted by a 5-for-6 performance at the plate with a fifth-inning three-run home run to propel the Eagles to an 11-4 triumph on Friday.

#### CO-PITCHER OF THE WEEK - CODY WAGER, LONGWOOD, RHP, SR. (WEST PALM BEACH, FLA.)

Wager went the distance for the first time in his collegiate career and recorded a season-high 13 strikeouts in Longwood's narrow 2-1 home victory over Presbyterian College on Thursday. The senior did not allow an earned run or a walk in nine innings, as he retired the final 11 hitters to earn his fourth win on the year.

#### COME READY NUTRITION FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - AARON MILLER, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, 1B, (SUMMERVILLE, S.C.)

Miller posted multi-hit performances in all five of Charleston Southern's games last week, as he finished 13-for-22 (591) at the plate with five RBI, five runs scored and a pair of home runs. After he finished with a pair of hits against both nationally-ranked Clemson and College of Charleston, the first baseman closed a three-game series against Gardner-Webb 9-for-14 (643) with four RBI, five runs scored and two home runs. The freshman finished the week with a .909 slugging percentage and a .560 on-base mark.

#### CAMPBELL

**DREW BUTLER** led the Camels on the week, batting 474 (9-19) with four RBI and three runs scored. The senior also was a perfect 3-for-3 on the base paths, remaining the country's leader in stolen bases with 26. On the week, Butler picked up at least one hit in each game, starting with a 3-for-5 effort against Duke, where he scored twice. He went 3-for-5 again in game two of the Radford series, including a bases loaded, three RBI triple, also scoring a run. He knocked in another run on Saturday, going 2-for-5 at the plate. For the season, Butler bats 311 with 32 runs scored and 24 RBI.

#### **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern's offense came to live over the past week as the Buccaneers hit 371 as a team over the five games. Eight starters hit over .300 on the week paced by AARON MILLER's scoring .591 batting average from the plate to pace CSU. NATE BLANCHARD (3), AARON MILLER (2), and CHRIS SINGLETON (2) all homered multiple times on the week for the CSU offense as a part of the Bucs' offensive onslaught over the past week. DANIEL JOHNSON and TYLER WEEKLEY turned in dominant relief outings on the mound for the Bucs. Johnson struck out nine in 5.0 scoreless innings, while Weekley picked up the win on Saturday afternoon with four strikeouts over 5.2 innings while allowing three hits.

#### **GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb earned its second-straight Big South series win, taking two of three contests at Charleston Southern this past week. On Thursday evening, **PAUL TRICK** went 4-for-5 with two doubles and **DANNY SULLIVAN** hit his Big South-leading eleventh home run of the season to give GWU a 6-3 win. Friday, the Runnin' Bulldogs had their four-game win streak snapped, falling to CSU by a score of 18-2. GWU bounced back Saturday afternoon, earning a 7-5 win to take the series. **MICKEY DUGAN** led the team, going 3-for-5 with one RBI.

#### **HIGH POINT**

AUSTEN ZENTE hit .385 (5-13) with four RBI and three runs scored as the Panthers went 3-1 on the week, including a series win over UNC Asheville. The outfielder had a double and his team-best eighth HR of the season against the Bulldogs.

#### LIBERTY

Liberty set team-highs for most runs and most hits in a 26-1 victory at James Madison, Tuesday. The Flames pounded out 21 hits in the contest Liberty scored 10 runs in the second inning and 14 in the fourth inning. Right-hander **JACKSON BERTSCH** recorded his first win at Liberty at James Madison. For the first time this season, Liberty was swept in a three-game series when it fell this past weekend to Winthrop. Outfielder **DJ. ARTIS** has reached base in 23 straight game, the longest such streak for a Liberty player this season.

#### LONGWOOD

The Lancers took the first game of the series against Presbyterian before falling in game two, 2-1, and game three, 10-2. Longwood's starting pitchers all had quality starts against Presbyterian, combining for two runs allowed in 220 innings and 32 strikeouts, led by a complete game and 13 strikeouts by **CODY WAGER** Thursday. Overall, Longwood pitching struck out 37 batters in the three games. Longwood heads on the road to face No. 12 Virginia before returning home for a weekend set against Winthrop.

#### **PRESBYTERIAN**

PC won its third straight conference series, taking two of three from Longwood on the road. It is the first time PC has won three straight Big South series since 2012 when it also won three straight series against Big South foes. The Blue Hose now sit at 8-4 in Big South play, its best mark through 12 games since joining the Big South. The previous best through 12 games was 7-5 in 2013. PC starting pitchers continue to excel in conference play, recording a 191 ERA and holding opposing hitters to a 228 average against them. The three hurlers have combined to record 74 strikeouts against 24 walks. Since moving in to the leadoff spot, GLEN CASACELI is batting 313 (10-for-32) with five walks and five runs to go with a 436 on-base percentage.

#### RADFORE

A week removed from being swept, Radford picked up a much needed three wins over Campbell over Easter Weekend. The sweep moved the Highlanders from ninth in the Big South standings to fifth place. The Highlanders hold a 12-7 record over the Fighting Camels since they reentered the league in 2012, winning five straight series. Radford totaled 17 runs on 24 hits over the weekend. Radford's bullpen shined allowing only two runs over 11.1 innings, surrendering six hits and striking out 11 batters. **DANNY HRBEK** led the team on the week with six hits and five runs scored. **JONATHAN GONZALEZ** hit two home runs on the week and collected five RBIs.

#### UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs have now turned 35 double plays on the year, two more than all of last year and an average of 1.0 per game which has the Bulldogs among the best in the nation. Between Friday and Saturday, **CARMINE PAGANO** went 4-for-8. He has now recorded multiple hits in two straight games and it is the 10th time this season the sophomore shortstop has accomplished the feat. Dating back to last weekend, **SPENCER ORR** went 14 straight innings without giving up a run, earned or unearned. Over the last two games, Orr has pitched 14.2 innings, striking out 13 batters while giving up just one run and four walks. In the last three games, Orr has given up three runs in 19.0 innings and has struck out 17 batters.

#### WINTHROP

After a midweek win over The Citadel on Tuesday, Winthrop added a road sweep of league-leading Liberty.
