#### PLAYER OF THE WEEK - BRETT AUCKLAND, PRESBYTERIAN, OF, SR. (CHAPIN, S.C.)

Auckland finished 9-for-18 (500) headlined by a pair of three-hit games with two home runs in Presbyterian's series sweep of Charleston Southern last weekend. The outfielder totaled seven RBI, scored six runs and swiped a base, as he has reached base safely in 17 straight games. On Sunday, he went 3-for-4 with three runs and a pair of RBI in PC's 10-8 win to seal the series sweep in Game 2.

#### PITCHER OF THE WEEK - COLTON RENDON, WINTHROP, RHP, FR. (JUPITER, FLA.)

Rendon shined in his start on Sunday, as he completed seven innings, struck out nine and issued just one walk in Winthrop seriesclinching 3-2 home triumph over Campbell. The freshman scattered just six singles and one earned run in the outing for his sixth victory on the hill this season.

#### COME READY NUTRITION FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - ANTWAUN TUCKER, LONGWOOD, OF, (CHASE CITY, VA.)

Tucker recorded at least one hit in all four of Longwood's games last week, headlined by a 3-for-4 performance at the plate with a triple and three runs scored in the Lancers' 15-6 road win at Norfolk State on Wednesday. In a series at UNC Asheville, the outfielder reached base six times, scored twice, stole a base and drove in a run to conclude the four-game stretch.

He picked up two more hits and knocked in a run in games two and three of the set For the season Butler hits .301 with .49 runs scored and .24 RBI.

#### CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern closed out Big South Conference play this past weekend as the Buccaneers fell in a threegame series against Presbyterian at the CSU Ballpark. The Bucs close out the 2017 season this weekend at home against the Air Force with Senior Day recognizing NATE BLANCHARD, BRANDON GRAGILLA, and KYLE DYSON prior to Saturday's first pitch. Interim head coach ADAM WARD was named the new permanent head baseball coach of the Buccaneers this past Thursday after leading CSU to a strong start that included receiving votes in two different major national polls.

#### **GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb was in action this weekend at West Virginia, the longest road trip the team has taken since the 2008 A-Sun Tournament in Deland, Fla. On Saturday, GWU fell by a 15-5 score and on Sunday dropped a 4-3 decision. **COREY HOWARD** had a stellar weekend returning from injury, batting .625 with two doubles and a home run, the first of his collegiate career. GWU closes the regular season, hosting UNC Ashville this weekend.

#### HIGH POINT

#### LIBERTY

Liberty completed a four-game homestand with a 3-1 mark after a 16-6 win over Elon on Tuesday. Currently, the Flames are among the top three teams in the nation with 312 walks. On Sunday, outfielder **DJ. ARTIS** broke his own Liberty record for walks in a season, leading off the game with his 53rd walk in the Flames' 8-6 victory at VCU. Artis has averaged 1.08 walks per game to lead the country. Liberty has hit a home run in each of its last four games. Liberty continues to hold leads. The Flames are 24-0 when leading after seven innings.

#### LONGWOOD

With a series loss at UNC Asheville paired with a Charleston Southern sweep at the hands of Presbyterian, the Lancers are alive for a spot in the Big South Tournament. #### **PRESBYTERIAN**

In addition, Hrbek collected his 200th collegiate hit. Radford's pitching staff continues its dominate showing in in league games, lowering the ERA to 3.16.

#### **UNC ASHEVILLE**

When senior **JOE TIETJEN** stole second in the bottom of the fifth inning Friday afternoon, it marked the 18th time this season the senior center fielder has swiped a base, moving him up into sole possession of eighth all-time for stolen bases in a single season. It was also the 41st stolen base of his career. Tietjen is currently fifth all-time in career stolen bases and needs just four more to reach fourth. Tietjen rocketed a triple off the fence in right-center field during the game to earn his fourth three-bag hit of the season. He now has seven for his career and is tied for sixth all-time in the program history.

#### WINTHROP

Winthrop went 3-2 on the week. The Eagles are still in first in the Big South and will have four games this week. Winthrop will finish at home on Tuesday against Charlotte then travel to Radford to finish off the season.
