CAMPBELL

COLE HALLUM homered three times and knocked in eight to lead Campbell on the week. The redshirt senior went 6-for-13 at the plate, also scoring five times. Reaching base at a .611 clip, Hallum walked three times and was hit by two pitches. In Tuesday's win over Virginia Tech, Hallum went 2-for-3 with three RBI and two runs, knocking a two run double in the first and a leadoff home run in the bottom of the third in a 7-2 Campbell win. He homered twice and drove in five to lead Campbell over Liberty 7-4 Saturday, registering his third multi-home run game of the season. For the season, Hallum bats .288 with 10 home runs and 47 RBI for the Camels.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern closes out the 2017 season with two home weekend series as the Buccaneers host Presbyterian and Air Force at the CSU Ballpark. Third baseman JASON MILLER has continued to pace the CSU offense on the season with a team-high .343 batting average with 61 hits, 10 doubles, and 27 RBI. NATE BLANCHARD has been the primary power hitter for the Bucs from the plate in the 2017 season with a team-high seven home runs and 29 RBI on the year. The Bucs' bullpen continues to be among the nation's best in strikeout-to-walk ratio as CSU currently leads the Big South and is 18th in the nation with a 2.93 ratio on the year.

GARDNER-WERE

Gardner-Webb went 0-4 for the week, falling to Furman by a 27-10 score on Wednesday before losing all three over the weekend at Winthrop, 7-6, 3-1, and 3-1. Friday evening, **DANNY SULLIVAN** hit his 16th home run of the year which tied the GWU all-time record for home runs in a single season set back in 2000 by **SAMMY PRUETT**. The Runnin' Bulldogs are currently in a six-game losing streak, the longest streak of the season.

HIGH POINT

Freshman right-hander **DREW DACZKOWSKI** threw his first collegiate complete game on Saturday against Charleston Southern, the top-hitting team in the Big South entering the weekend. The right-hander allowed just one run and five hits while striking out seven. The seven base runners allowed by Daczkowski in nine innings was equal to the number of strikeouts for the freshman in the contest.

LIBERTY

Liberty finished their longest road trip of the season with an 8-7 loss at No. 10 Virginia on Tuesday. Despite the setback, the Flames finished the trip at 6-2 Liberty hit .302 as a team and outscored their opponents, 86-46, during the eight-game road swing. Liberty has one of the top road records in the nation with a 14-4 (.778) mark. The Flames' bullpen did not allow a run over 10 1/3 innings during their three-game series against Campbell. **DJ. ARTIS** is four walks away from tying his program record for walks in a season of 52.

LONGWOOD

After falling in a 15-13 midweek battle against Norfolk State, Longwood rattled off three straight wins, sweeping Lehigh in the final weekend of games at Buddy Bolding Stadium in 2017. Longwood ended a seven-game losing streak with the wins. The Lancers head to Norfolk, Va, for a midweek game against Norfolk State Wednesday before wrapping up the season at UNC Asheville and Campbell in consecutive weekends, playing six straight games against two of the teams Longwood is chasing for the eighth spot in the standings.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC split its only two games last week with an 8-6 win over Davidson, followed by an extra-inning setback to USC Upstate.

RADFORD

Radford picked up its third Big South series win over the weekend, taking two games from UNC Asheville on the road. The Highlanders won the first two games of the series, before dropping game three 7-6 in 10 innings, ending its 23-game winning streak over the Bulldogs. Radford's offense scored 24 runs on 24 RBIs in the three games, collecting 34 hits in the process, 13 coming as extra base hits. **SPENCER HORWITZ** led the offensive charge, going 6 for 13 with three home runs and five RBIs, while scoring four runs. Radford connected for seven home runs in the series. **ZACK RIDGELY** dominated bats again with a 13-strikeout performance in Saturday's 13-2 win.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Sunday's series finale was the second time this season that the Bulldogs have won in walk-off fashion. Coincidentally, the last time the Bulldogs won in walk-off fashion, it was also on a Sunday and it was in the series finale with Charleston Southern when UNC Asheville won 2-1 in the ninth. The six UNC Asheville pitchers struck out 22 batters Sunday between the two games. **JOE TIETJEN** scored two runs Sunday, giving him 134 for his career. The mark has him now sitting in sole possession of sixth all-time in program history in the category.

WINTHROP

Winthrop went 3-1 this past week and went 3-0 against Big South foes. Winthrop takes over first place alone and with weekend wins over Gardner-Webb. The Eagles have a pair of non-conference matchups followed by a weekend home series with Campbell.
