## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - MARCH 19

### PLAYER OF THE WEEK - JORDAN SERGENT, HIGH POINT, UTIL, SR. (CHESAPEAKE, VA.)

Sergent posted a .462 (6-for-13) batting average with a home run, seven RBI and three runs scored last week. The senior's week was headlined by a 3-for-4 performance with a pair of doubles and two RBI in High Point's 8-2 road victory at Longwood on Saturday. He also posted a pair of hits, including a home run, with three RBI in a non-conference setback against Ohio on Wednesday. The utility player closed the four-game span with a .846 slugging percentage, the third-highest mark in the conference last week.

### STARTING PITCHER OF THE WEEK - MASON FOX, GARDNER-WEBB, RHP, Jr. (CANTON, N.C.)

Fox tossed five complete frames and did not allow a run en route to his second win on the season in Gardner-Webb narrow 1-0 victory at North Carolina on Wednesday. The two-way player allowed just three singles in the outing, a career-low, while UNC never saw a runner at third through his time on the mound.

### RELIEF PITCHER OF THE WEEK - JARRETT THOMPSON, GARDNER-WEBB, RHP, Jr. (MINT HILL, N.C.)

Thompson completed 4.0 innings, totaled eight strikeouts and allowed just one earned run in three games last week. The right-hander's week was headlined by a two-inning save against North Carolina, as the junior struck out four hitters and did not issue a walk in the appearance. He also tossed an inning against conference foe Liberty on Saturday and Sunday where he totaled a combined four strikeouts and just one hit.

### FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - LOGAN BENDER, CAMPBELL, UTIL, R-Fr. (DUNN, N.C.)

Bender made three appearances and completed 42 innings last week, capped off by his second relief win of the season on Sunday. The redshirt-freshman allowed just one hit and struck out eight to help CU to three wins. On Friday against Charleston Southern, he completed 20 innings and struck out five of the six hitters he faced to help secure a 4-3 win in the series opener.

**CAMPBELL**

Campbell went 4-1 on the week, splitting a midweek series with Rider before going on the road and sweeping Charleston Southern in a three-game series to open Big South play. The sweep over the Buccaneers was the first in conference play for Campbell since April 2-4, 2015 at Presbyterian. In the first game against Rider, Campbell's pitching staff fired a season-high 17 strikeouts, the most for CU since at least 2002. In Saturday's game at CSU, the Camels cranked six home runs, the most CU since at least 2010 and the third-most by any Division I team this season.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

The CSU pitching staff has tallied 10 double-digit strikeout performances this season. They added two this week against Clemson and Campbell. **TAYLOR COX** continued his scoreless streak on the mound. He has not allowed a run in six appearances. **DEREK HORTON** has home runs in two consecutive games and three for the season. **ALEX ANDRONICA** leads the team with 12 walks.

**GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb went 2-3 for the week, earning a 1-0 win at North Carolina on Wednesday, before going 1-2 in the first Big South series of the season against Liberty. Wednesday afternoon, **ERIC JONES** hit a solo home run to lead off the second inning to propel the Runnin' Bulldogs to a 1-0 shutout win at North Carolina. **MASON FOX** tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, while **JARRETT THOMPSON** earned his third save of the year. It was also GWU's first win over North Carolina since the 2012 season. For the weekend against Liberty, **CHANDLER REDMOND** hit a home run in each of the three games, with **MICKEY DUGAN** collecting multiple hits in each contest.

**HIGH POINT**

Junior **ANDREW GOTTFRIED** recorded the first quality start for the Panthers on Saturday at Longwood, tossing a career 8.1 innings and holding the Lancers to two runs on six hits with five strikeouts. Redshirt-junior **JONNY VIZCAINO** tossed 5.2 scoreless frames in relief on Sunday to pick up his team-leading third win of the year (t-3 Big South). High Point's pitching staff is second in the league in ERA (4.27), and tops in opponents batting average (.236). Senior **HUNTER LEE** hit safely in all four games this week to push his team-best hitting streak to 11 games.

**LIBERTY**

Outfielder **TRE TODD** enters the week fourth nationally with a .568 on base percentage and leads the nation in walks with 26. Todd's .362 batting average paces the Flames. Outfielder **D.J. ARTIS** has moved into the program's top 10 in career stolen bases. The junior is tied for seventh all-time with 56. In addition, Artis has posted four multi-hit games in his last five contests, including back-to-back three-hit games this past week. He has hit .500 (11-22) during the span. Pitcher **ZACH CLINTON** is ninth in the country with four wins. Designated Hitter **ANDREW YACYK** is three RBI shy of 100 for his career.

**LONGWOOD**

Longwood won the first game of the series against High Point, but a pair of games with late-game rallies for High Point Saturday and Sunday turned the tide of the series in favor of the Panthers, who took the series, 2-1. Longwood takes on Norfolk State Tuesday before heading to preseason-favorite Winthrop for a three-game weekend series.

**PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE**

**NICK GUIMBARDA** ended 2017 on a nine-game hit streak and has extended it to 15 games after batting .462 (6-for-13) this past weekend at Winthrop. Guimbarda leads the team in home runs (3) with only 6 games played. **AJ PRIAULX** has reached base in 17 of the last 18 games and leads the team with 10 multi-hit games this season. Priaulx ranks high in the nation for batting average (.440; 12th), hits (37; 4th), doubles (8; 39th) and total bases (51; 48th). **JONATHAN WHITE** leads the team with 16 runs scored this season and has scored in four straight games.

**RADFORD**

After having its midweek series with Manhattan canceled due to snow, Radford opened Big South play with UNC Asheville, going 1-2 in the series. The Highlanders were limited to six runs in the first two games, before exploding for 12 in the series finale, including a 11-run fourth inning. In Sunday's 12-5 win, Radford tallied the 11 runs on seven hits and three walks, sending eight players to the plate without recording an out. The 11 runs are the most in a single inning since a 16-8 win over Presbyterian on May 25, 2016 in the Big South Tournament.

**UNC ASHEVILLE**

With its two wins at Radford, it marked the first time since 2012 that UNC Asheville had won the conference-opening series. The series win over the Highlanders marked the first time the Bulldogs have won a series over Radford since the 2008 season. **BRANDON LANKFORD** led the UNC Asheville offense this week, as he hit at a .300 clip and connected with three home runs. He recorded a grand slam at nationally-ranked NC State and posted two additional home runs in back-to-back contests at Radford. **GREG GASPARRO** was the hottest starting pitcher for the Bulldogs, where he twirled 8.2 innings versus Radford and scattered seven hits, allowed three earned runs and struck out four.

**WINTHROP**

After nonconference setbacks to Furman and UNCG earlier in the week, Winthrop bounced back with a series sweep over Presbyterian College last weekend. The Eagles joined Campbell as the only teams to sweep their conference openers.
