### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - MARCH 26

### PLAYER OF THE WEEK - GRANT ENGLISH, WINTHROP, INF, JR. (LAURINBURG, N.C.)

English recorded a .706 (12-for-17) batting average with nine RBI and six runs scored, as he paced the Winthrop offense to four victories last week. Before the Eagles' conference series against Longwood, he finished 2-for-4 with a run scored in Winthrop's 3-0 shutout win over Davidson on Wednesday. Against the Lancers, he went 10-for-13 (.769) headlined by a 5-for-5 mark with five RBI and three runs scored in the series finale on Saturday. The junior posted the highest batting average, slugging percentage (1.118) and on-base percentage (.667) in the league last week.

### STARTING PITCHER OF THE WEEK - ZACH PEEK, WINTHROP, RHP, So. (FOREST, VA.)

Peek went the distance for the first time in his career, struck out eight and shutout Longwood in Winthrop's 8-0 win over the Lancers on Friday. The right-hander allowed just three hits and one walk in the outing, as he became the first hurler in the conference to reach 50 strikeouts on the year.

### RELIEF PITCHER OF THE WEEK - GARRET PRICE, LIBERTY, RHP, So. (EVINGTON, VA.)

Price struck out eight UNC Asheville hitters in 3.1 innings of work in a pair of appearances last week. In his first outing on Friday, the sophomore tossed 2.1 innings, struck out six Bulldogs and allowed just one hit, as the Flames allowed just one run for the game. A day later, he completed an inning and struck out a pair and eventually earned the win.

### FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - TRAVIS HOLT, HIGH POINT, INF, FR. (PLANTATION, FLA.)

Holt hit .462 (6-for-13) with three runs scored and two RBI last week. The freshman totaled a pair of two-hit performances, capped off by a 2-for-4 mark with a double in the series finale against Radford on Sunday. With his offensive performance, he recorded the fifth-highest on-base percentage in the conference last week with a .563 clip.



### CAMPBELL

Campbell swept its second-straight conference series this week, taking three games from Gardner-Webb at home by scores of 6-3, 4-3 and 12-1. CU moves to 6-0 in the Big South, which ties the best start to conference play for Campbell since 2012. The back-to-back conference sweeps were the first for the Camels since 2014, when CU claimed six-straight wins against Presbyterian and UNC Asheville (April 4-13, 2014). Additionally, Campbell did not strike out as a team Sunday against the Runnin' Bulldogs. It was the first time the Camels had accomplished that feat since April 21, 2009 in an 18-0 win against N.C. Central.

### **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

On Wednesday, the CSU pitching staff used eight pitchers (most of season) and didn't allow an earned run for the first time this season. CSU pitchers also struck out 10 or more batters in three of their four games this week and now have 13 double-digit strikeout games this year. Senior reliever **TAYLOR COX** kept his 0.00 ERA in tact this week as he made his sixth appearance on the season. Fellow senior reliever **DANIEL JOHNSON** leads the team in strikeouts (31) and holds a 12.31 strikeouts per nine innings ratio.

#### **GARDNER-WEBB**

Gardner-Webb opened the week with a 13-8 win at Wofford, before dropping a 7-4 decision the next night against Wofford and all three contests at Campbell over the weekend. Tuesday at Wofford, **MASON FOX** hit his first career grand slam as part of a six-run sixth inning to propel GWU to the win. Fox also had a double and tallied five RBI for the evening. For the week, **CHRIS CLARY** and **ERIC JONES** paced the 'Dogs offensively, batting .438 and .409 respectively. Jones is on a nine-game hitting streak, while Clary has produced a hit in his last six games, the longest stretch for both in their collegiate careers.

#### **HIGH POINT**

High Point hit .349 as a team in a 2-2 week and scored 35 runs on 52 hits. Senior **HUNTER LEE** extended his hitting streak to 15 games with nine hits in the four games. Junior **ANDREW GOTTFRIED** lowered his conference ERA to 1.35 (2 ER/13.1 IP) with five scoreless innings in the nightcap of Friday's doubleheader against Radford. Redshirt-junior **JONNY VIZCAINO** posted a scoreless long relief outing for the second straight week, earning the win in Friday's victory over Radford. Vizcaino has not allowed a run in 9.2 innings against Big South competition.

#### LIBERTY

Outfielder **TRE TODD** became the first Liberty player to hit multiple home runs in a game this season, belting two in Liberty's victory over UNC Asheville on Friday. The junior leads the Flames with five home runs. He also leads Liberty in batting average and RBI. Shortstop **CAM LOCKLEAR** has had at least one hit in 13 of his last 14 games. Outfielder **D.J. ARTIS** and second baseman **TREY McDYRE** have been swinging hot bats of late. Artis had hit .375 over his last 10 games to lead the Flames over the span. Meanwhile, McDyre has batted .357 over his last 10 contests.

### LONGWOOD

After the weekend at Winthrop, Longwood heads to play at nationally-ranked Virginia before returning to conference action at Charleston Southern. The game at Virginia is scheduled to air on the ACC Network Extra. First pitch is set for 6 p.m. Tuesday.

### PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

**JONATHAN WHITE** became the ninth player in PC's Division I era, and second of the season, to go 5-for-5 at the plate on Saturday. **AJ PRIAULX** has recorded the feat twice this season. Priaulx went 4-for-4 on Tuesday at USC Upstate and 4-for-5 on Saturday vs CSU to reach 45 hits on the season which ranks 2nd in the nation. The senior continues to lead the Big South in batting average (.446), hits (45), doubles (II), and total bases (62). The Blue Hose recorded a season-high 18 hits against CSU in a 9-1 victory on Saturday morning.

### RADFORD

Having its midweek canceled again, Radford just played a Big South weekend series. The Highlanders dropped the first two games to UNC Asheville a week ago and did the same against High Point. Radford finished the series finale with a 18-6 victory, tallying 30 runs on 26 hits in the last two Sunday contests. The 18 Highlander runs came on a day in which four Highlanders finished with multi-hit performances, including three with three-plus hits. **STRATON PODARAS** led the Highlanders with a career best four hits and five RBIs in the win.

### UNC ASHEVILLE

JAKE MADOLE had the highlight for UNC Asheville, as he hit the game-winning three-run home run in a pinch hit situation at Liberty. He appeared in all three games at Liberty and reached base safely in all three contests. CARMINE PAGANO started all three contests, as he hit at a .462 mark with six hits. DANNY WILSON, TYLER SERRICCHIO and JOE ZAYATZ also hit .300 or higher this past week, as the trio started in all three games. ERIC WHITECAVAGE, KOLE HARRIS and Wilson – all had scoreless appearances this weekend, where Whitecavage earned his first victory of the year and Harris tallied his third save of the season.

### WINTHROP

Winthrop remains unbeaten in Big South play at 6-0 and has won seven straight games overall. Winthrop has now scored 10 or more runs in three of its six conference games so far, outscoring opponents 63-25.
