PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - APRIL 2

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - MICKEY DUGAN, GARDNER-WEBB, INF/OF, Sr. (JACKSONVILLE, FLA.)

Dugan closed a four-game span 8-for-16 (.500) at the plate with two home runs, a double, six runs scored and five RBI, as the utility player led Gardner-Webb to a series sweep of Radford last week. After he posted a pair of hits with a stolen base in a non-conference home setback to Appalachian State on Tuesday, the senior went 6-for-12 with five runs scored and four RBI against the Highlanders. His week was headlined by a three-hit day, including a homer, in GWU's 20-10 win on Thursday. His .938 slugging percentage tied for the highest mark in the league last week, while his .619 on-base percentage ranked second.

STARTING PITCHER OF THE WEEK - EVAN NATIONS, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, RHP, Sr. (CARY, N.C.)

Nations tossed seven complete, struck out five and did not allow a run in Charleston Southern's 6-0 series-clinching win over Longwood on Saturday. The right-hander allowed just six singles and did not issue a walk in the outing, as he claimed his first victory of the season.

RELIEF PITCHER OF THE WEEK - RION MURRAH, HIGH POINT, RHP, Sr. (BAINBRIDGE, GA.)

Murrah tossed a career-high six innings in Thursday's one-hit victory over Winthrop. The right-hander inherited a bases-loaded jam in the fourth inning and after a sacrifice fly, forced an inning-ending double play to close out the frame. Following the fourth, he held the Eagles without a hit until the ninth inning. Within the span, the senior recorded nine strikeouts and allowed just one walk to eventually earn the win.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - LOGAN MATHIEU, LIBERTY, 1B, Fr. (HOWARD, PA.)

Mathieu went 7-for-16 (.438) with six RBI, four runs scored and a pair of doubles last week. After a two-hit performance in a non-conference extra-inning victory over Virginia Tech on Tuesday, he finished a three-game set at Presbyterian College 5-for-11 (.455) with a double and four runs scored. The freshman closed the four-game span with a .550 on-base percentage.

CAMPBELL

The Camels are off to their best start to conference play in program history with an 8-1 record in the Big South. CU most recently took two of three in a road series at UNC Asheville, defeating the Bulldogs 10-1 on Thursday, March 29 and 9-5 on Saturday, March 31. Senior infielder **CHRISTIAN JONES** crushed three homers over the last four games, moving his season total to nine which leads the Big South. **ALLAN WINANS** turned in another quality performance for the Camels, allowing just one earned run over 7.0 innings at Asheville to lower his conference-best ERA to a 1.59 on the year.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU is ranked second in Division 1 in Strikeout-to-Walk ratio (3.43). They're also ranked 40th in strikeouts per nine innings (9.6) and 10th in walks allowed per nine innings (2.79). Entering the weekend, the Bucs had six home runs on the season. They hit three on Thursday night. CSU pitchers now have 15 double-digit strikeouts game this season. The Bucs posted double-digit hit totals every game over the weekend series.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb opened the week by falling to Appalachian State on Tuesday evening, 8-4, for its fifth straight loss, but bounced back with a 20-10 win to open the weekend at Radford. GWU picked up two more wins, 5-4 and 8-4, to earn its first Big South series win of 2018, and its first sweep of a Big South opponent on the road since taking all three at UNC Asheville May 13-15, 2016.

HIGH POINT

High Point went 2-2 in four games, claiming its third straight Big South series to open conference play. Junior **ANDREW GOTTFRIED** and senior **RION MURRAH** came within one out of a combined no-hitter on Thursday night as HPU held Winthrop to one run on five hits in the first two games of the series. Senior **HUNTER LEE** hit safely in all four games to extend his hitting streak to a career-best 19 games. The Panthers belted a season-best four homers in Friday's 12-0 shutout, their first whitewash of the campaign.

LIBERTY

Shortstop **CAM LOCKLEAR** had three hits on Saturday in a win over Presbyterian, raising his batting average to .302. He has at least one hit in 17 of his last 19 games. Second baseman **TREY McDYRE** also is swing a hot bat. McDyre has hit .385 over his last 10 games. The sophomore has two or more hits in five of the games. Outfielder **D.J. ARTIS** stole five bases this week. With 62 career stolen bases, the junior has moved into fourth on Liberty's all-time list. In addition, Artis has reached base in every game this season.

LONGWOOD

Through three weekends in conference play, senior captain outfielder **SAMMY MILLER** is hitting .395 (15-for-38) with five stolen bases. The lead-off hitter and center fielder leads the Lancers with a .284 batting average. Longwood returns off a road trip at Charleston Southern to begin a five-game homestand with games Tuesday against VMI and Wednesday against George Mason before hosting a weekend series with Commonwealth conference rival, Radford.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

JONATHAN WHITE has 11 multi-hit games on the year after collecting three more this weekend against Liberty. He trails **AJ PRIAULX** by one for the team lead. PC hit a solo, 2-run, 3-run, and a grand slam home run against Liberty over the weekend. The Blue Hose entered game one with 14 home runs on the season and added seven more. Priaulx recorded a hit in every game last week, raising his total to 49 on the season.

RADFORD

Radford went 1-3 on the week, falling to Gardner-Webb in a weekend sweep. The Highlanders were outscored 33-18 in the series. Through 26 games, **ANDREW SZAMSKI** has crossed the 40-hit plateau as he is one of two Big South players with 40-plus hits. Szamski continues to lead the Big South with 16 extra-base hits. His .381 average is currently 63rd in the country, while ranking ninth with four triples. As a team, Radford is 12th in the country with 11 three-baggers.

UNC ASHEVILLE

DANNY WILSON, **JOE ZAYATZ**, **JAKE MADOLE** and **CARMINE PAGANO** - hit over .300 this weekend. The foursome combined for 21 of the team's 33 hits this past week, including knocking five extra-base hits, nine RBIs and 14 runs. Madole and Wilson each connected with six hits, while Madole posted two doubles, a home run and five RBIs. **JORDAN FULBRIGHT** and **ERIC WHITECAVAGE** had strong relief appearances this week for Asheville. Fulbright earned his first career save, while totaling six innings of two-hit ball. Whitecavage twirled four innings, where he made three appearances and allowed just one run on two hits.

WINTHROP

Winthrop is 8-4 when recording double-digit hits and 5-12 when failing to record 10 or more hits. In its first six conference games, Winthrop recorded double-digit hits in five of six, and posted nine in the sixth, winning all six games. In the series at High Point, the Eagles belted just a combined five hits in the first two games, both losses, but bounced back for 11 hits and 11 runs and a victory in game three.
