PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - MAY 14

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - JEFF HAHS, CAMPBELL, OF/DH, Sr. (O'FALLON, IL.)

Hahs posted a hit in all five of Campbell's games last week, headlined by a 3-for-4 performance with three runs scored and a home run in a series-opening home win over Winthrop on Friday. Earlier in the week, he posted three hits, including a pair of doubles, as the Camels split a two-game set at Ohio State. In the series against the Eagles, he recorded five hits and helped CU to at least a share of the Big South regular-season title. The senior finished with the fourth-highest slugging percentage in the conference in last week's games with a .762 clip.

STARTING PITCHER OF THE WEEK - WES NOBLE, CAMPBELL, RHP, Sr. (LEBANON, OHIO)

Noble tossed a complete game two-hit shutout in Sunday's regular-season title clinching win over Winthrop. The senior, in his final home game, struck out a season-high eight hitters and did not issue a walk, as the complete game was the first in his collegiate career. After he gave up a one-out double in the third, he bounced back and retired the next 20 Winthrop batters to seal the win.

RELIEF PITCHER OF THE WEEK - COLTON SPRINGS, PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE, RHP, Jr. (BLENHEIM, S.C.)

Springs tossed four hitless innings over a span of three games and struck out eight en route to a victory and a save. After he completed an inning of work and struck out one Davidson hitter on Wednesday, he shined in the series win over Longwood last weekend. The junior earned the save in a 5-3 victory on Friday, as he struck out all three hitters he faced to seal the triumph. On Saturday, he tossed two complete, struck out four and did not issue a walk in his lone win of the week.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - TANNER WELLS, HIGH POINT, UTIL, Fr. (GOLDSBORO, N.C.)

Wells recorded a hit in all four of High Point's victories last week, including three multi-hit contests. The freshman started the week with three hits, headlined by a pair of two-out doubles, to go along with three RBI and a pair of runs scored in HPU's narrow 6-5 road win at Elon on Tuesday. In the series sweep at UNC Asheville, he was 5-for-14 (.357) with a double, three runs scored and two RBI.

CAMPBELL

Campbell (29-21, 19-5 Big South) blanked Winthrop 5-0 Sunday afternoon behind a complete game shutout from senior RHP **WES NOBLE**, clinching the Big South regular season title as well as CU's seventh conference series win in 2018. In Friday's opener, redshirt-senior righty **ALLAN WINANS** tossed seven innings of one-run ball with 11 K's as Campbell won 6-1. The Camels split a two-game midweek set at Ohio State, winning Wednesday's matchup 13-8 with a five-run top of the ninth that was capped off by a grand slam from **CHRISTIAN JONES**.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

WIL HARTSELL and **EDDIE HIOTT** now have 26 appearances on the mound this year, which is more than any CSU pitcher last season. Three CSU pitchers combined for 10 strikeouts on Sunday, marking the 19th double-digit strikeout game of the year. CSU pitchers now have 12th games with one or fewer walks allowed. Weekley made his longest appearance of the season and the second longest of his career on Saturday. His complete game in 2014 is the only longer outing.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb returned to action this weekend after taking a break for final exams, earning a 7-4 win over Charleston Southern on Friday night before dropping the remaining two contests. Friday night, **CHANDLER REDMOND** hit a three-run home run in the bottom of the ninth to give GWU the walk-off win, his 14th home run of 2018. Saturday, GWU fell by a 4-1 score, and lost Sunday, 7-2. **COREY HOWARD** led the team for the week, batting .583 with three RBI, extending his reached-base streak to 25 games.

HIGH POINT

High Point posted a perfect week, going 4-0 to match its longest winning streak of the season. In the process, HPU secured its fifth straight winning season, the longest stretch in the school's DI history. At 16-8 in conference play, the Panthers have won the second-most league games in school history, trailing only the 2014 team (18-9). HPU has secured a top-4 seed in the conference tournament thanks to its sweep of Asheville, the second Big South sweep of the year. High Point batted .354 as a team against Asheville, outscoring the Bulldogs 25-8 while racking up 40 hits.

LIBERTY

Shortstop **CAM LOCKLEAR** will enter the week with an 11-game hitting streak (16/41, .390). The streak is the longest by a Liberty player this season. Previously this season, Locklear had a 10-game hitting streak. This past Saturday, outfielder **D.J. ARTIS** became only the third player in school history to record over 200 hits, score over 165 runs and steal over 65 bases in his career (206 hits - 169 runs - 68 SB). The junior enters the week third in program history in runs scored and stolen bases.

LONGWOOD

Longwood dropped two out of three at Presbyterian, but took the final game behind four players with multi-hit games and 41 shutout innings out of the bullpen from freshman right-hander **TOMMY GREEN** to top the Blue Hose, 9-3, Sunday. Longwood plays at James Madison Tuesday before concluding the regular season with a series at home against Gardner-Webb. Longwood enters the series tied for seventh place in the Big South standings.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

The Blue Hose have played in 17 one-run or extra inning games this season. After hitting just 14 home runs over the first 26 games, the Blue Hose have heated up for 32 home runs over the last 25 games. **JONATHAN WHITE** leads the team with 23 multi-hit games and 71 hits this season. He also has a team-high 40 runs, 22 walks, .515 slugging, .434 OBP, and 104 total bases.

RADFORD

Radford snapped its four-game skid with a series win at Liberty, outscoring the Flames 14-7 in the first two games of the series to earn its first series win in Lynchburg since 2011. The Highlanders series win over the Flames is the first since 2015. Radford's offense totaled 24 runs on 27 hits with all 24 runs coming as RBIs in the series. **WILL HARLESS** finished the series with seven RBIs, including a career-high four RBIs on Friday night. **SPENCER HORWITZ** and **STRATON PODARAS** finished with four RBIs each in the series. Radford's bullpen tossed 11.1 frames without allowing a run until the fifth inning on Sunday.

UNC ASHEVILLE

In the four-game week last week, UNC Asheville had four hitters leading the team - **GREG GASPARRO**, **BRANDON LANKFORD**, **JOE ZAYATZ** and **JOE GRUSZKA**. Gasparro earned a three-hit game on Sunday's contest, while Zayatz tallied a pair of doubles and a home run in the four-game week. Lankford also cracked a double and a homer, while Gruszka tallied his team-leading fourth triple of the year. **NICK BOYLES** was the best starting pitcher for Asheville, where he started two games - at NC Central and versus High Point. He totaled six innings, allowed two runs and struck out four.

WINTHROP

Winthrop dropped a road series at Campbell over the weekend after the Eagles posted a non-conference win over UNCG on Tuesday. Winthrop jumps back into its non-conference schedule on Tuesday when it hosts Charlotte before hosting Liberty in a three-game series to close the regular season.
