PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - MAY 21

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - LUKE WISE, RADFORD, OF, R-Sr. (LOCK HAVEN, PA.)

Wise finished 5-for-12 (.417) with a pair of triples, a double and walked six times in last week's four-game span. The redshirt-senior was the only player to finish in the conference top-10 in slugging percentage (.833) and on-base percentage (.632), as he also scored five times and drove in one. His week was headlined by a 2-for-3 performance with a triple and a pair of walks in the first game of a doubleheader against regular-season champion Campbell on Saturday. The outfielder also swiped three bases last week, including two steals in a win at Appalachian State on Tuesday.

STARTING PITCHER OF THE WEEK - VINNIE TARANTOLA, LIBERTY, LHP, Sr. (TUCSON, ARIZ.)

Tarantola tossed a season-high six complete, struck out seven hitters and did not issue a walk or a run in Liberty's 5-1 win over Winthrop on Saturday. In just his third start of the season, the senior held the Eagles without a hit until the fourth inning and allowed just a pair of singles in the outing. He did not permit a runner past first base on the day.

RELIEF PITCHER OF THE WEEK - ANDREW NARDI, RADFORD, LHP, Jr. (MORGANVILLE, N.J.)

Nardi allowed just one single and struck out a season-high eight Campbell hitters in Radford's narrow 3-2 win on Thursday. The junior tossed four innings in relief, as he extended his scoreless innings streak to eight straight.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - BRANDON JENKINS, CAMPBELL, RHP, Fr. (GLENORA, N.J.)

Jenkins shined in his final start of the regular season, as he tossed three complete and struck out five Radford hitters en route to the Camels' 7-2 to win. The right-hander allowed just one hit and one walk in the outing and eventually claimed the win in the predetermined short start. Radford hit just .100 off the freshman, as he led the Camels to their eighth conference series win on the year.

CAMPBELL

Campbell (31-23, 21-6 Big South) reached 30-plus wins for the first time since 2015 and the fifth time in the last seven seasons with a doubleheader sweep over Radford on Saturday. The Camels ended the regular season with 21 wins in conference play, breaking the program record of 19 set in 2013. CU topped the Highlanders 6-4 in Saturday's opener before claiming the series finale 7-2 to earn its third doubleheader sweep of the season.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CHRISTIAN MAGGIO extended his hitting streak to nine games. The 12 runs scored on Saturday was the most the Bucs have scored all season and the most since April 14, 2017. This is the Bucs' first trip to the Big South Conference Baseball Championship since 2015. **MIKE SCONZO** played his 158th career game for the Bucs, giving him the 19th most games played in school history. **DANIEL JOHNSON** finishes his final regular season with 171 strikeouts, good enough for 7th most all time at CSU. **CODY SMITH** now has 17 career saves, which is the 3rd most saves in CSU history.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb begins its postseason on Tuesday against No. 4 Winthrop. That game is scheduled for 45 minutes after Game #3.

HIGH POINT

High Point finished its regular season with a 3-1 week, sweeping Presbyterian in dramatic fashion on a walk-off home run from senior **JORDAN SERGENT** in the 10th inning Saturday night. The Panthers are the No. 2 seed, tying for the highest finish in program history. HPU set a new program record with its 19th league win and recorded its third series sweep of the conference campaign. High Point's pitching staffed tossed back-to-back shutouts against Presbyterian, its first-ever consecutive shutouts against a league opponent. HPU allowed just three runs in 28 innings vs PC (0.96 ERA)

LIBERTY

Liberty snapped an eight-game losing skid to Winthrop on Friday. The Flames then won on Saturday and will enter the 2018 Big South Championship having won three of their last four. The Flames are 22-6 when scoring first. With two hits on Saturday, OF **D.J. ARTIS** reached base safely in every Liberty game during the 2018 regular season. Artis has the longest active reached base streak in the nation of 66 straight games. Left-handed pitcher **VINNIE TARANTOLA** pitched six scoreless innings in his last regular season start in a Liberty uniform in the Flames' 5-1 win over Winthrop on Saturday.

LONGWOOD

Longwood took the middle game of the rain-altered three-game set against Gardner-Webb – the first of a doubleheader Sunday – by a 10-3 final to clinch the final spot in the 2018 Big South Baseball Championship. The postseason berth is the third under fourth-year head coach **RYAN MAU** and the first for the Lancers since making a run to the semifinal before the eventual College World Series Champion Coastal Carolina ousted Longwood in 2016. The Lancers open the tournament with No. 1 Campbell Tuesday at 4:30 p.m.

PRESBYTERIAN COLLEGE

The Blue Hose played in 19 one-run or extra inning games this season including three against No.1 Campbell and two against No. 2 High Point. Senior RHP **TANNER CHOCK**'s 25 strikeouts looking ranks second in PC's modern era while his 8.53 strikeouts per 9 innings ranks 10th. Junior **JONATHAN WHITE** currently ranks inside the program's career top-10 for batting average (.358) and slugging pct (.441). He also led the team this season with 25 multi-hit games, 76 hits and 110 total bases. Senior **AJ PRIAULX** posted career bests in batting average (.350), hits (75), doubles (14), slugging pct (.500) and total bases (107). Senior RHP **RYAN HEDRICK** ranks second in PC's modern era with 12 career saves.

RADFORD

Radford went 2-2 in the final regular season week of the season. The Highlanders defeated Appalachian State 3-2 on Tuesday to finish 10-17 in non-conference play. Looking for its sixth straight Big South series win, Radford dropped a Saturday doubleheader after taking game one of the series. Radford finished Big South play with a 14-13 record. On the week, **LUKE WISE** went 5 for 12 with six walks and five runs. **SPENCER HORWITZ** increased his hit streak to 14 straight with six hits on the week. **ANDREW SZAMSKI**, **KYLE BUTLER** and **MATT ROTH** led the team with three RBIs each.

UNC ASHEVILLE

DANNY WILSON paced the UNC Asheville offense in the three-game series at Charleston Southern, as he had a .545 batting average. He tallied six total hits, which was highlighted by a single-game career-best five-hit game in the series opener versus the Bucs. **BRANDON LANKFORD** and **GREG GASPARRO** each contributed four hits in the series. On the hill, **BLAKE BROWN** was phenomenal in Thursday's series opener. The sophomore earned single-game career highs in innings pitched (seven) and strikeouts (seven). He scattered just three hits, allowed one run and didn't surrender a walk.

WINTHROP

Winthrop dropped a home series to Liberty and enter the 2018 Big South Baseball Championship as the No. 4 seed. The Eagles will face No. 5 Gardner-Webb in Game #4 on Tuesday.
