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PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - MAY 7

PLAYER OF THE WEEK - JOSH LITCHFIELD, CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, OF, JR. (SUMMERVILLE, S.C.)

Litchfield recorded multi-hit performances in three of Charleston Southern's four games last week, headlined by a 3-for-4 mark with a double and a stolen base in CSU's 2-1 walk-off win to clinch the series win over Winthrop on Sunday. For the three-game set, the outfielder was 6-for-14 (.429) with a pair of doubles and two RBI, as the Buccaneers took two games from the Eagles. Earlier in the week, he finished 2-for-4 with a walk in a non-conference meeting with Davidson.

STARTING PITCHER OF THE WEEK - ALLAN WINANS, CAMPBELL, RHP, R-Sr. (BAKERSFIELD, CALIF.)

Winans tossed the conference's fifth complete game this season and struck out a career-high 12 High Point hitters to lead the Camels to key 4-2 victory on Friday. The right-hander allowed a pair of runs in the first inning, but bounced back and held the Panthers hitless and allowed just three base runners over the final eight frames. The complete game marked CU's first this season.

RELIEF PITCHER OF THE WEEK - WES NOBLE, CAMPBELL, RHP, Sr. (LEBANON, OHIO)

Noble entered Sunday's rubber game in the sixth inning following a three-hour lightning delay and retired all nine High Point hitters in order to help seal the series win. The senior struck out four and did not issue a walk in the outing, as he claimed his fifth win on the year.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK - WILL HARLESS, RADFORD, C, Fr. (ABINGDON, VA.)

Harless posted a hit in every game of the series at Georgia Tech last weekend. After a 1-for-3 mark in Friday's walk-off setback, he knocked a two-run single that tied the ballgame up at 7-7 in the top of the eighth on Saturday. The freshman also walked twice in both Saturday and Sunday's contests to give him the fifth-highest on-base percentage in the conference last week at .583.

CAMPBELL

The Camels went 3-1 on the week, upsetting No. 5 NC State in Raleigh before taking two-of-three in a crucial Big South series against High Point. The win against the Wolfpack was Campbell's first victory over a top-5 opponent since defeating No. 2 North Carolina on April 17, 2007. Campbell's pitching staff held High Point to a season-low two hits twice over the weekend, including a complete-game effort from right-handed senior **ALLAN WINANS** on Friday night. The Bakersfield, Calif. native tallied 12 K's for CU's first nine-inning outing of the season.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern was involved in three walk-offs this past week with the Buccaneers falling midweek to Davidson, 5-4, before taking the final two games of the series against Winthrop with **RYAN RIZK** and **DEREK HORTON** home runs on Saturday and Sunday. The Bucs have five walk-off wins on the season following the weekend, including three by home run with **JOSH LITCHFIELD** providing the game-winner back on April 17 against The Citadel (7-6). Litchfield dominated the plate on the week with a .444 batting average with multiple hits in three of the four games.

GARDNER-WEBB

Gardner-Webb stepped out of Big South Conference play this past weekend, taking on No. 13 Duke in a double-header on Sunday afternoon. The Blue Devil bats were too much for the Runnin' Bulldogs to overcome, as Duke took both games by scores of 13-4 and 10-4. Freshman **TABER MONGERO** led the team at the plate for the day, going a combined 3-for-5 with one RBI, while **CHANDLER REDMOND** and **MICKEY DUGAN** each drove in multiple runs.

HIGH POINT

High Point picked up an ACC win in the mid-week over Wake Forest, its fifth straight year with a victory over a power five opponent. Despite dropping two of three to Campbell over the weekend, the Panthers still hold the best record through 21 conference games in program history at 13-8. Senior **HUNTER LEE** reached base safely in all four games for the Panthers, extending his on-base streak to 36 consecutive games.

LIBERTY

Liberty is in the midst of five consecutive non-conference games. The Flames played their first ever games in the state of New York, when they visited No. 20 St. John's in Queens, as part of the span this past weekend. Junior outfielder **DJ. ARTIS** collected his 200th career hit with his fourth hit of the game, Saturday at St. John's. With the single, Artis posted his first four-hit game of the season and the third of his career. Shortstop **CAM LOCKLEAR** enters the week with a seven-game hitting streak. He has hit .440 over the span. Liberty enters the week with a 19-5 record when scoring first.

LONGWOOD

Over the weekend Longwood took on the Patriot League regular season champions, Navy, and took the final game of the three-game set Sunday after the Midshipmen swept Saturday's doubleheader. Longwood received quality starts from all three starters and saw the offense burst out to an 11-hit performance in Sunday's 10-2 win.
