CAA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Sophomore forward Hannah Rosenblatt scored three goals over the weekend to help Northeastern clinch the CAA regular season title with a pair of wins. Rosenblatt scored NU's second goal in the 82nd minute to round out the scoring in a 2-0 victory over Towson. She then netted both NU goals on in a 2-1 victory over James Madison that clinched the No. 1 overall seed.

Rosenblatt opened the scoring in the third minute, before firing home the eventual game-winning goal in the 36th minute. Rosenblatt's 11 goals and 26 points each rank as the fourth-highest totals in a single season in program history.

Junior forward Serenity Waters scored three of UNCW's four goals to lead the Seahawks to a 2-0-0 record and a berth in the CAA Championship. She led UNCW to first-ever home win against William & Mary by scoring eventual game-winning goal in 56th minute of UNCW's 2-0 win. She then tallied both goals in 2-1 overtime victory over Elon, scoring game-winner in 92nd

minute. Waters finished the regular season as the fourth-leading scorer in the CAA with 25 points while leading UNCW with nine goals and seven assists.

OUICK SHOTS AROUND THE CAA

- Seven of Drexel's eight wins this season were shutouts (Villanova 3-0; Monmouth 1-0; Fairfield 1-0; Hofstra 3-0; JMU 1-0; Towson 2-0: Charleston 3-0).
- James Madison's Ashley Herndon has five game-winners this season and 19 for her career.
- Delaware senior Natalie Zelenky scored in six of her final 10 games, bringing her career total to 25 goals.
- Hofstra's Jill Mulholland scored three goals, including a game-winner over Towson last weekend. Mulholland finished her season with 13 goals, including six game-winners, and eight assists and concludes her career in the program all-time top 10 in career points, goals and assists.
- Towson senior Natalia Pinkney played in her 76th career game on Sunday, tying her for third-most appearances in a Black & Gold uniform. She played in every game of her career.

ON TO THE CAA CHAMPIONSHIP

- With the victory over JMU on Sunday, Northeastern clinched the top seed for the second time in three seasons.
- Drexel secured the No. 2 seed and returns to the CAA Championship for the first time since 2012.
 The Dragons were the two seed that year.
- No. 3 Seed James Madison is making its fourth straight appearance in the CAA Championship.
- UNCW defeated Elon, 2-1 in OT to propel themselves into fourth in the standings. That game also determined the final pairings/ seeding for the entire tournament.
- William & Mary and CofC tied on Sunday. As a result, William & Mary earned the fifth seed and CofC got the sixth and final spot because of a tiebreaker over Hofstra.
- The quarterfinals are slated for October 30. JMU hosts CofC while UNCW hosts William & Mary.
- Northeastern and Drexel have byes in the quarterfinals with the Huskies hosting the semifinals and final, November 4-6.

NATIONAL NOTICE

- Delaware goalie Kailyn Rekos is seventh in saves (110) while Drexel goalie Christiana Ogunsami is 16th (101).
- Ogunsami is 11th in shutouts (9) and 18th in save percentage (.871).
- JMU freshman Haley Crawford is sixth in assists (9). Hofstra's Jill Mulholland and CofC's Laura Ortega are tied for 16th with eight helpers.
- Mulholland is also third in total points (34), eighth in goals (13), and sixth in game-winning goals (6).

CAA IN THE NCAA RPI

- As a conference, the CAA is rated 11th in the NCAA RPI released on October 24.
- Northeastern has the highest RPI in the CAA, coming in at 78.

CAA IN THE NSCAA REGIONAL RANKINGS

- For the third week in a row, Northeastern was the only CAA team ranked in the NSCAA Mid-Atlantic Region rankings. On October 18, the Huskies were No. 6 in the region.
- Previously, UNCW was ranked No. 8 on September 27, No. 2 the week before that, and No. 1 for the first four weeks of the year.

KEEPER'S CORNER

- UNCW's Carolyn Huddy posted her 17th career shutout on October 7, breaking the program record for career clean sheets. Huddy made 10 saves in the 1-0 victory against Delaware.
- Drexel, behind Christiana Ogunsami, have notched 11 clean sheets this season.
- Towson keeper Taylor Sebolao posted her 11th career shutout in the win over Delaware moving her into third all-time at Towson.
- Cougars goalie Lauren Killian did not allow a goal for the first 532:15 of the season. Jacksonville scored on Killian to break up the streak on September 15, which was the third longest in CofC history. Killian became the program record holder for career saves (225) on August 31 stopping six shots against Charleston Southern.
- William & Mary keeper Grace Smith had a career-high 13 saves at VCU on September 8.
 Her 13 saves were the most for the Tribe dating back to 2001, and just the fourth double digit save performance dating back to the same year.

COACHING MILESTONES

- William & Mary Head Coach John Daly became the sixth coach in NCAA Division I history and just the 13th women's soccer coach across all divisions to win 400 games. The Tribe gave Daly the historic win on September with a 2-0 decision over UNC Greensboro.
- James Madison Head Coach Dave Lombardo secured his 400th career victory on September 16 in the 3-2 double overtime decision over VCU. Lombardo is the seventh coach in NCAA Division I history and just the 14th women's soccer coach across all divisions to win 400 games.
- William & Mary and James Madison join UConn as the only other school to have both men's and women's coaches as 400-game winners.
- Elon Head Coach Chris Neal became the program's all-time winningest coach with the Phoenix victory over Charleston Southern on August 19. It was Neal's 75th career win at the helm.
- UNCW Head Coach Paul Cairney picked up his 200th career victory on August 31 in the 2-0 win against Campbell.

NSCAA NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

James Madison rookie forward Haley Crawford was named the NSCAA National Player of the Week on October 18. Crawford had an impressive week for the Dukes, posting two goals and three assists for seven points and helped JMU clinch a berth in the CAA Championship.

WEEKLY REPORT

SENIOR CLASS AWARD

- Northeastern senior defender Mackenzie Dowd and William & Mary defender Clara Logsdon represent CAA women's soccer as candidate for the Senior CLASS Award.
- Dowd has been outstanding in all four areas over the course of her career at Northeastern. One of the most decorated student-athletes in program history, Dowd has helped Northeastern to two CAA championships and currently ranks as the highest-scoring defender in the school history. In the classroom, Dowd owns a perfect 4.0 GPA as a dual major in criminal justice and psychology. She was named a 2015 CoSIDA First-Team Academic All-American and was tabbed as NU's first-ever recipient of the CAA's Female Scholar-Athlete of the Year last season. A team captain in 2015, Dowd has taken a leadership role as the Huskies' ambassador for Score to Cure, a charity created by NU studentathletes. In addition, Dowd has been an active participant in the Soccer Without Borders program, Playworks Boston and Operation American Soldier.
- Logsdon is a two-year starter and a team captain for the Tribe. She has started all 12 matches playing every minute on the backline. Logsdon, a 2016 Preseason All-CAA selection, played every minute last season, anchoring a defense that led the CAA with 12 shutouts and a 0.88 goals-against-average and earned an NCAA Tournament berth. Individually, Logsdon earned All-CAA First Team honors. A government major, Logsdon was chosen for an unpaid internship with Williamsburg Congressman Rob Wittman during summer 2016. She's also involved with community service projects in the Williamsburg area with both her Tribe women's soccer teammates and her sorority, Tri Delta.
- An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School (CLASS), the award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.
- In total, there are 60 men's and women's soccer candidates for the 2016 Senior CLASS Award.

NSCAA TEAM ACADEMIC AWARD

- The CAA had eight women's teams receive the NSCAA College Team Academic Award for the 2015-16 academic year. In addition, five CAA institutions had both their men's and women's programs recognized for academic excellence.
- Delaware, Drexel, Hofstra, UNCW and William & Mary were the five schools to have both their men's and women's teams honored.
- College of Charleston, Northeastern and Towson women's soccer programs also received the NSCAA Team Academic Award.

TOP DRAWER SOCCER TEAM OF THE WEEK

- Hofstra's Jill Mulholland earned a spot on the TDS Team of the Week on October 18 while JMU's Ashley Herndon earned an honorable mention. Mulholland had a goal and an assist in the upset win over NU while Herndon had two goals and an assist in a pair of wins.
- Northeastern's Hannah Rosenblatt earned a TDS Team of the Week honorable mention on October 10 after posting three goals in a pair of wins.
- Northeastern's Kayla Cappuzzo earned a TDS Team of the Week honorable mention on October 3 after posting the game-winner in the 2-1 victory over UNCW.
- UNCW's Madison Melnick received an honorable mention for Top Drawer Soccer Team of the Week on September 12 after scoring two goals in the win over Furman.
- Hofstra's Jill Mulholland earned on a spot on the Top Drawer Soccer Team of the Week on August 30. The midfielder had two goals and an assist in two games the previous weekend.

2016 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- William & Mary was selected as the preseason favorites. The Tribe received six first-place votes and 76 points in the poll while defending champion James Madison was next with 73 points, which included a pair of first-place tallies. Hofstra also picked up two first-place votes and was third with 69 points, and Northeastern was fourth with 54 points.
- JMU's forward Ashley Herndon was chosen as the Preseason Player of the Year. She posted 14 goals last season, including eight gamewinners. She was also named Most Outstanding Performer of the CAA Championship.
