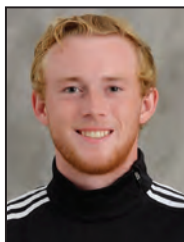

QUICK SHOTS AROUND THE CAA

- Two key league games, which are being made up after being postponed due to weather, are slated for November 1. Charleston hosts Drexel while Elon and UNCW square off.
- Hofstra clinched the CAA Regular Season Championship for the third consecutive year. The Pride, the defending CAA champion, won it out-right with a victory at Elon on October 29.
- Out of 36 conference games, 14 have been decided by a goal, six went to overtime and five matches have resulted in ties.
- Delaware has reached the 10-win mark for the fourth straight season and fifth time in the last six years.
- UNCW junior **Julio Moncada** has netted six game-winning goals this season, setting the UNCW single-season record.
- Elon has shutouts in four of seven league games and seven on the year.
- Elon's **Elijah Agu** is tied for the CAA lead with 11 goals. It is also the most for the Phoenix in a single-season since 2013. Prior to this year, Agu had one career goal in his first two seasons. He also has four multi-goal games this season.
- William & Mary picked up the CAA's first win over a Big Ten opponent this season, downing Michigan, 4-0, on October 15. **Ryder Bell** posted two goals and an assist in the non-league win.
- In Hofstra's six matches between September 4 through September 28, the Pride conceded just one goal, which came at then-ranked No. 5 Syracuse on September 13.

LOOKING AHEAD TO THE CAA CHAMPIONSHIP

- At the conclusion of the regular season, the top six teams in the standings, according to conference points, qualify for the CAA Championship.
- Hofstra clinched the No. 1 seed and the right to host the tournament.
- Delaware secured the No. 2 seed and will be making its sixth championship appearance in the last seven year.
- Elon has secured a berth for the third straight year and will be either the No. 3 or No. 4 seed, depending on the outcome of its match on November 1.
- William & Mary clinched its first berth since 2013. The Tribe's seeding is dependent on the matches to be played on November 1.
- UNCW, James Madison, and CofC are all fighting for the final two spots in the tournament. The Cougars must win to remain in contention.
- The quarterfinals are slated for November 5 and will be hosted at the home sites of the No. 3 and No. 4 seeded teams.
- The top two teams will have byes in the quarterfinals with Hofstra hosting both the semifinals and final, November 11-13.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Nine different teams have captured the CAA men's soccer championship over the past nine years. Old Dominion captured the title in 2007, followed by George Mason in 2008, UNCW in 2009, William & Mary in 2010, Delaware in 2011, Northeastern in 2012, Drexel in 2013, James Madison in 2014 and Hofstra in 2015.
- All nine current CAA teams have earned a berth in the NCAA Men's Soccer Championship at least once since 2006. The CAA had four teams earn NCAA Tournament berths in 2011, three teams made the field in 2012 and 2013, and two represented the league in 2014 and 2015.

CAA IN THE NCAA RPI

- In the NCAA RPI released on October 31, the CAA was ranked 16th as a conference.
- Hofstra had the highest RPI in the league, coming in at the 26th spot.

NATIONAL NOTICE

- William & Mary is ranked eighth in the country in total points (106), seventh in both goals (36) and assists (34) and 12th in scoring offense (2.00).
- Delaware is ranked 16th in goals (32), 16th in assists (30) and 14th in points (94).
- Individually, Delaware's **Guillermo Delgado** is tied for eighth in goals (11), tied for 13th in assists (8), sixth in total points (30) and fifth in points per game (1.88).
- Elon's **Elijah Agu** is tied for eighth in goals (11), eighth in goals per game (0.73), and 22nd in points per game (1.53). He's also 14th in game-winning goals (4).
- Hofstra's **Joseph Holland** is tied for 13th in assists (8).
- UNCW's **Julio Moncada** is third in game-winning goals (6).
- CofC's **Kevin Shields** is eighth in saves per game (5.54).

CAA IN THE POLLS

- NSCAA DI Poll:** Hofstra received votes in the poll on October 25.
- UNCW had previously come in at No. 20 on October 4 while Delaware had previously checked in at No. 22 on September 5.
- NSCAA Midwest Region Rankings:** The CAA had four of the 10 teams ranked in the Midwest Region. Hofstra was No. 5, UNCW was No. 6, Delaware was No. 8 and Elon was No. 9.
- TopDrawer Soccer National Poll:** UNCW spent two weeks at No. 13 and one week at No. 22.
- College Soccer News Top-30:** UNCW five-week stretch of being recognized in the CSN Top-30 was halted on October 31.

MOVING ON UP

- Delaware's **Guillermo Delgado** set the program record for points against William & Mary has become the first player to enter the CAA's all-time top-ten in points and goals since 2003.
- With 48 goals, he is tied for sixth with Eduardo Lima (Mason, 1996-00). Tamir Linhart (Mason, 1991-93) is next with 49.
- With 115 points, Delgado fifth all-time in CAA history. Next on the list is Eduardo Lima (Mason, 1996-00) with 119.
- Delgado is the first player with 40+ goals and 100+ points since Attila Vendegh (Old Dominion, 2000-03) completed the feat in 2003.
- He is currently the NCAA career active leader in points and goals.

COSIDA ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT

- Three CAA student-athletes earned a spot on the CoSIDA Academic All-District Teams.
- Hofstra's **Rory Murphy** earned a spot on the District 1 Team.
- Delaware's **Ben Sampson** was selected to the District 2 Team for the fourth consecutive year.
- Elon's **Matthew Jegier** was picked for the District 3 Team.
- All three are now on the national ballot for Academic All-American consideration.

SENIOR CLASS AWARD

- Midfielders **Joseph Holland** (Hofstra) and **Ben Sampson** (Delaware) are two of 60 candidates for the Senior CLASS Award.
- Sampson, who graduated summa cum laude from Delaware in May 2016 with a degree in electrical engineering, decided to return to the classroom and utilize his fifth year of eligibility following a medical redshirt. The 2014 CAA Men's Soccer Scholar-Athlete of the Year finished at the top of his class with a 3.989 cumulative GPA. A leader in the classroom, he is the point person for organizing many of the service activities UD conducts in the local community and has volunteered with Special Olympics and local youth soccer.
- Holland has accumulated an impressive list of accolades in his four years on the Hofstra men's soccer roster. A second-team NSCAA All-American in 2015, he was also named the CAA's Player of the Year and helped the Pride to a CAA title and NCAA Tournament appearance. Off the field, the philosophy major posted a 3.95 grade-point average and is a first-team NSCAA Scholar All-American. Holland has been involved in community service projects with the team, including involvement with youth soccer.
- An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School (CLASS), the award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

GOALS ON GOALS ON GOALS

- William & Mary scored seven goals against Northeastern on October 1. It was the most goals by a CAA team since 2013 when Delaware had seven against Howard.
- William & Mary also had nine assists, tying a single game high in records dating back to 2004. The Tribe had the only other game with nine assists which came against Richmond on September 23, 2009.
- The Tribe had a collective 23 points, the most by a CAA team since 2011 when George Mason had 32 against Howard.
- Since 2004, it was the most goals (7), points (23) and assists (9) registered in a single CAA game.
- Sophomore **Antonio Bustamante** came away with seven points (3g, 1a), the most by a CAA player since 2012 when ODU's Tim Hopkinson had eight points against Seton Hall.
- Bustamante's seven points were also the most by an individual player in a CAA contest since 2008 when UNCW's Devan Carroll had seven against William & Mary.

TOURNAMENT HONORS

- Elon's **Elijah Agu** and **Jonathan Coleby** were named to the John Rennie Nike Invitational All-Tournament Team. Agu had a pair of goals while Coleby started both games, anchoring the Phoenix back line. Elon went 1-1-0 at the tournament.
- Elon captured the Elon/High Point Classic on September 4. **Elijah Agu** was named the Tournament MVP after posting seven points (3g, 1a) while **Amir Berkane**, **Luke Matthews** and **Nick Adamczyk** each earned a spot on the All-Tournament Team.
- UNCW captured the SpringHill Suites Classic on September 11. Forward **Julio Moncada** was named the Offensive MVP while freshman defender **Mark Lindstrom** was named as the tournament's Defensive MVP. Moncada, Lindstrom, **Stian Sandbekkhaug** and sophomore midfielder **David Lozano** were named to the all-tournament team for the Seahawks.

NSCAA TEAM ACADEMIC AWARD

- The CAA had six men's teams receive the NSCAA College Team Academic Award for the 2015-16 academic year.
- In addition, five CAA institutions had both their men's and women's programs recognized for academic excellence.
- Delaware, Drexel, Hofstra, UNCW and William & Mary were the five schools to have both their men's and women's teams honored. The Elon men's soccer program earned recognition as well.

- UNCW transfer **Julio Moncada** earned the fan vote, being selected as the NCAA Player of the Week on September 20 via a Twitter poll. He earned the honor after posting two goals and an assist in the Seahawks victories over Hofstra and CofC.

TOP DRAWER SOCCER TEAM OF THE WEEK

- UNCW's **Mark Lindstrom** and William & Mary's **Reeves Trott** were named to the Top Drawer Soccer National Team of the Week on September 13. Lindstrom anchored the Seahawks defense in their SpringHill Suites Classic victory while Trott had two goals and two assists against Campbell.
- UNCW transfer **Julio Moncada** earned a spot on the Top Drawer Soccer National Team of the Week on September 6. He netted the first two goals of his college career as the Seahawks rallied to defeat UMBC, 3-1.
- Moncada also earned a spot on the TDS National Team of the Week on October 17 after posting two goals and an assist in the wins over Hofstra and CofC.

CSN NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Delaware's **Guillermo Delgado** was named the National Player of the Week by College Soccer News on August 29 after posting seven points (3g, 1a) in two games.

CSN NATIONAL TEAM OF THE WEEK

- JMU's **Billy Metzler** was named to the CSN Team of the Week on October 31 after a goal and assist in the 2-0 win over UNCW helped keep the Dukes postseason hopes alive.
- UNCW's **Julio Moncada** earned a spot on the College Soccer News National Team of the Week on October 16 after scoring two goals and assisting on a third to help the Seahawks remain unbeaten in CAA play.
- Delaware's **Guillermo Delgado** and Hofstra's **Joseph Holland** both landed spots on the College Soccer News National Team of the Week on August 29. Delgado, who earned National Player of the Week status, had seven points in two games. Holland scored twice in the Pride's win over Stony Brook.

MAC HERMANN WATCH LIST

- Delaware's **Guillermo Delgado** was placed on the MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List at the start of the 2016 campaign.
- The MAC Hermann Trophy is the most prestigious individual award in college soccer presented annually to the outstanding male and female players of the year.
- Near the end of the collegiate regular season, the lists will be narrowed down to the top 15 players. From that group, three will be named finalists.

2016 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- Hofstra was picked to repeat as CAA Men's Soccer champions in 2016 while the Pride's senior midfielder **Joseph Holland** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in a vote of the league's nine head coaches.
- Hofstra received eight first place votes to finish with 64 points. Delaware was picked to finish second in the poll with 55 points followed by Elon in third with 48 points and UNCW in fourth with 39 points. William & Mary rounded out the top-five with 35 points.
- Holland led the Pride on their NCAA Championship run, scoring eight goals and posting nine assists. He earned 2015 CAA Player of the Year honors and also became Hofstra's first NSCAA All-American since 2012 when he landed a spot on the Second Team.
- Hofstra and Elon received votes in the NSCAA Preseason Poll.
