Northeastern freshman Stella Clark scored 16 points during her collegiate debut against Boston University. Clark scored all 16 points in the second half, including 10 points during the fourth quarter and helped NU nearly overcome an 11-point deficit at the start of the fourth quarter. Clark went 5-of-10 from the field and 2-of-5 from three-point range and led the Huskies with five assists during 25 minutes of action.

#CAAHOOPS REWIND

- Charleston (1-1): The Cougars split games against Lipscomb and Furman. Senior Tanisha Brown got off to a great start, averaging 19.5 points, 8.5 rebounds and 5.5 assists over the two games.
- Delaware (0-1): The Blue Hens had their comeback fall just short as they dropped the season opener at Buffalo, 87-73, in Natasha Adair's UD debut. Three different Blue Hens scored in double-figures, including junior Nicole Enabosi, who led all scorers with 18 points and sophomore Samone DeFreese who had a career-high 12 off the bench.
- Drexel (0-1): The Dragons fell on the road to Penn State despite an impressive comeback effort in the fourth quarter. Sophomore Aubree **Brown** had a career day with 16 points and six assists in the loss.
- Elon (1-0): The defending CAA champion Phoenix opened the season with a 61-point win over Winthrop. Sophomore Ra'Shika White had a career-high 29 points on 12-of-17 from the floor while CAA Preseason Player of the Year Shay Burnett just missed a triple double, finishing with 17 points, nine rebounds and nine assists.
- Hofstra (1-0): Stepping into a much larger role as the Pride's starting point guard, E'Lexus Davis nearly posted a triple-double in Hofstra's 71-55 season-opening victory over UMBC. Davis recorded career highs in points (17), rebounds (8) and assists (9), playing 37 minutes.
- James Madison (1-1): The Dukes split games, falling to Rutgers in the opener before downing Wagner on Sunday. Lexie Barrier averaged 14.0 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists over the two games, including 23 points against the Scarlet Knights.
- UNCW (1-0): Senior Madison Raque posted the third 20-point game of her college career as the Seahawks opened the Karen Barefoot Era with a 73-64 victory over UNC Pembroke. Raque tallied 24 points on 8-of-14 shooting from the field, including a 5-for-10 showing from long range, while grabbing seven rebounds.
- Northeastern (0-1): The Huskies made a furious fourth-quarter comeback but fell just short of the win, falling at Boston University, 74-73. Junior Jess Genco led Northeastern with 18 points while rookie Stella Clark had 16 points, all in the second half.
- Towson (0-1): Sophomore Nukiya Mayo dropped in a career-high 19 points but it was not enough as the Tigers fell at UMass in Diane Richardson's coaching debut.
- William & Mary (1-0): Junior Bianca Boggs had a career-night as helped the Tribe to an 83-71 season opening victory at Howard. Boggs notched her second career-double with careerhighs of 26 points and 11 rebounds to go along with four steals. Freshman Gabby Rogers had a solid start to her career with nine points and grabbed four rebounds in 19 minutes.

CAA IN NON-LEAGUE PLAY

- The CAA is 6-6 to start non-league play.
- Last season, the CAA went 69-49 against nonleague opponents. From November 14-20, the CAA went 13-7, notching victories over 11 different conferences.

IN THE POLLS

- Elon received votes in the USA Today Preseason Coaches Poll.
- JMU was ranked eighth in the College Insider Mid-Major Poll while Elon was tenth. Drexel and William & Mary received votes.

#CAAHOOPS HOT SHOTS

- Drexel's loss to Penn State marked its first loss in a season opener since the 2011-12 season.
- Entering 2017-18, Elon has the sixth-youngest roster in the nation with 75 percent of its players freshmen or sophomores. The roster rounds out with just three seniors and zero juniors.
- William & Mary forced Howard into 31 turnovers, including 10 steals, on November 11.
- William & Mary posted its 25th road win since the 2014-15 season in the contest at Howard on November 11.
- Towson was strong from the free throw line at UMass on November 12, making 10 of 11 chances.

KATRINA MCCLAIN AWARD WATCH LIST

- Hofstra senior Ashunae Durant was named one of 20 candidates for the Katrina McClain Award, which recognized the top power forward in women's basketball.
- The list will be fluid, with players able to be added a removed from the list throughout the season. It will be narrowed to 10 in mid-February before the five ultimate finalists are announced in March. Katrina McClain and the selection committee will then choose the winner. The award will be presented at an inaugural awards ceremony at the NCAA Women's Final Four in Columbus.

HELLO. COACHES

- There will be three new coaches on the sidelines, two of which are familiar faces.
- Head Coach Karen Barefoot takes the helm of UNCW. She was previously in the league as the leader of ODU.
- Head Coach Natasha Adair returns to the CAA sidelines, taking over the helm of Delaware. Adair led College of Charleston during its first season in the CAA.
- Head Coach Diane Richardson will guide Towson this season. Richardson was a longtime assistant coach at West Virginia.

SOME POINTS & LOTS OF BOARDS

• Only six of the top-20 leading scorers from last season return for the respective teams. Yet, 11 of the top-20 leading rebounders from one year ago will be back to clean the glass.

TOP HONORS RETURN

• Only four of the 15 All-CAA honorees from last year return for the 2017-18 season, including All-CAA First Team selections Shay Burnett (Elon) and Nicole Enabosi (Delaware), All-CAA Second Team pick Ashunae Durant (Hofstra) and All-CAA Third Team honoree Claudia Ortiz (Northeastern). James Madison returns the last two CAA Rookies of the Year in Kamiah Smalls and 2015-16 CAA Rookie of the Year Kayla Cooper-Williams, who missed the entirety of 2016-17 with an injury.

2017 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- James Madison was predicted to capture the 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship while Elon senior Shay Burnett was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in a vote of the league's 10 head coaches.
- The Dukes had 78 points, including six firstplace votes while Elon, the defending champs, was second with 74 points, including three firstplace votes. Rounding out the top-seven was William & Mary (58), Drexel (51), Delaware (48), Northeastern (47) and Hofstra (43). Towson and UNCW were tied for eighth while CofC was
