PLAYER OF THE WEEK

NICOLE ENABOSI | DELAWARE JUNIOR | FORWARD | GAITHERSBURG, MD./OUR LADY OF GOOD COUNSEL

Junior Nicole Enabosi helped the Blue Hens to a 2-1 week by averaging 22.0 points and 13.7 rebounds per game while shooting 70 percent (24-34) from the field. She also had six blocks and 10 assists on the week. Enabosi opened the week by going 8-of-9 (.889) from the field and 6-of-7 from the charity stripe for 22 points with six assists and 17 rebounds, which tied a career best in the win at Hartford. In UD's win over American, she led all scorers with 25 points. Against Boston University, she notched a double-double with 19 points and 17 rebounds in the overtime loss.



PLAYER OF THE WEEK

GABBY GIACONE | NORTHEASTERN JUNIOR | FORWARD | DELMAR, N.Y./BETHLEHEM CENTRAL

Junior Gabby Giaccone averaged a double-double with 18.3 points and 11.0 rebounds to help Northeastern to a 2-1 week. She also collected six blocks and five steals. Giaccone opened the week with her first career 20-point game against Providence, grabbed nine rebounds and blocks two shots against the Big East foes. She notched her sixth career double-double with 16 points and 15 rebounds along with two blocks in the victory over Fairfield. She narrowly missed another double-double in the win over Marist, finishing with 19 points on 9-of-14 shooting and nine rebounds to go along with three steals and two blocks.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

STELLA CLARK | NORTHEASTERN FRESHMAN | GUARD | SEA GIRT, N.J./MANASQUAN

Freshman Stella Clark continued to impress, averaging 16.3 points, 3.7 rebounds and 2.7 assists to help the Huskies to a 2-1 week. She shot 42.9 percent from the floor, 45.0 from downtown and 71.4 percent from the free throw line. She scored a season-high 28 points in the overtime loss to Big East foe Providence, shooting 60 percent from the field (9-of-15) and the perimeter (6-of-10), in 41 minutes of action. In the win over Fairfield, she posted six points and a season-best four steals. She wrapped up the week with 15 points and three rebounds in the win over Marist. Clark is averaging a team-best 16.3 points per game and leads the Huskies with seven steals and a .440 three-point field goal percentage with 11 treys.

#CAAHOOPS REWIND

- **Charleston (1-3):** The Cougars were in Michigan last week for a pair of contests. CofC fell at Central Michigan on Friday before falling to (RV) Michigan State on Sunday afternoon. **Darien Huff** averaged 8.5 points and shot 50 percent (5-10) from three-point range last week.
- **Delaware (2-2):** The Blue Hens went 2-1 on the week, topping Hartford and American before being edged by Boston University in overtime. Junior **Nicole Enabosi** had another big week, averaging 22.0 points and 13.7 rebounds per game while shooting 70 percent (24-34) from the field. **Samone DeFreese** averaged 15.0 points and 5.7 rebounds off the bench.
- **Drexel (2-1):** The Dragons won back-to-back games last week, topping La Salle and Bucknell at home. Drexel held each opponent to just 54 points. **Aubree Brown** averaged 12.0 points while **Kelsi Lidge** averaged 5.0 points and 3.0 steals per game. **Hannah Nihill** made her collegiate debut against La Salle after recovering from a procedure to donate bone marrow to her sister with leukemia. She scored 12 points and has five assists in that debut.
- **Elon (3-0):** The Phoenix remained undefeated with a pair of wins last week over North Carolina A&T and Hampton. Senior **Shay Burnett** averaged 15.0 points, 7.5 rebounds and 10.0 assists while classmate **Malaya Johnson** shot 73.7 percent (14-19) from the field and averaged 14.0 points while rookie **Jailyn Powell** averaged 9.0 points per game, including a 13-point effort against North Carolina A&T.
- **Hofstra (1-2):** The Pride had a pair of losses to Stony Brook and Hartford last week. Senior **Ashunae Durant** averaged 13.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 3.5 blocks over two games.
- **James Madison (1-2):** The Dukes dropped both games last week, falling at No. 13 Tennessee before being edged by Saint Joseph's at home. Sophomore **Kamiah Smalls** averaged 16.0 points and 6.0 rebounds, including a career-best 22 points against the Hawks.
- **UNCW (2-1):** The Seahawks split games last week, clipping East Carolina before falling at Coastal Carolina. **Jenny DeGraaf** averaged 14.5 points and 7.5 rebounds.
- **Northeastern (2-2):** The Huskies went 2-1 on the week. After falling to Providence in overtime, NU topped a pair of MAAC foes in Fairfield and Marist. All five Huskies starters averaged double digits for the week, including junior **Gabby Giaccone**, who averaged 18.3 points and 11.0 rebounds, and rookie **Stella Clark**, who posted 16.3 points per game.
- **Towson (0-3):** The Tigers had a pair of tough losses, falling to George Washington at home and at Pitt. **Raine Bankston** averaged 12.5 points per game while **Nukiya Mayo** grabbed 9.0 rebounds per game over the two games.
- **William & Mary (2-1):** The Tribe split games last week, posting a 10-point win over Fairfield before falling at St. John's. Center **Abby Rendle** averaged 16.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 6.0 blocks per game.

CAA IN NON-LEAGUE PLAY

- The CAA is 16-18 in non-league play.
- Last season, the CAA went 69-49 against non-league opponents. From November 14-20, the CAA went 13-7, notching victories over 11 different conferences.

IN THE POLLS

- **USA Today WBCA Coaches Poll:** Elon received votes in the Preseason Poll.
- **College Insider Mid-Major Poll:** Elon was ranked eighth while James Madison was tenth in the poll released on November 14.

#CAAHOOPS HOT SHOTS

- Six CAA teams open play at various tournaments this week, including Drexel at the Paradise Jam and Elon at the Puerto Rico Clasico.
- Delaware has posted four straight games of 70-plus points; Delaware only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the past two seasons.
- Blue Hen guard **Abby Gonzales** had 10 assists against Boston University on November 19, marking the first time a Hen hit double-digit assists for the first time since 1999.
- James Madison has opened the season 1-3 for the first time in 14 seasons.
- Northeastern has had five Huskies score in double figures in a single game twice this season.
- Elon has had at least 22 assists in every game this season. **Shay Burnett** dished out 11 assists against Hampton on November 17, the most in the CAA this season.
- Entering 2017-18, Elon has the sixth-youngest roster in the nation with 75 percent of its players freshmen or sophomores. The roster rounds out with just three seniors and zero juniors.
- William & Mary forced Howard into 31 turnovers, including 10 steals, on November 11.
- Towson was strong from the free throw line at UMass on November 12, making 10 of 11 chances.

BIG BLOCKER

- William & Mary center **Abby Rendle** has 13 blocks in three games this season, including seven against Fairfield on November 14.
- Rendle's brought her career total to 235 and is one away from tying George Mason alumna **Trish Halpin** for third (236) and 20 away from tying William & Mary alumna **Tiffany Benson** for second (255).
- Former Delaware Blue Hen and current WNBA superstar **Elena Della Donne** holds the conference record with 273 blocks.

KATRINA MCCLAIN AWARD WATCH LIST

- Hofstra senior **Ashunae Durant** was named one of 20 candidates for the Katrina McClain Award, which recognized the top power forward in women's basketball.
- The list will be fluid, with players able to be added or removed from the list throughout the season. It will be narrowed to 10 in mid-February before the five ultimate finalists are announced in March. Katrina McClain and the selection committee will then choose the winner. The award will be presented at an inaugural awards ceremony at the NCAA Women's Final Four in Columbus.

#CAAHOOPS INTERNATIONALLY SPEAKING

- There are 15 international players hailing from 10 different countries in the CAA this season.
- Hofstra's roster features eight international players in sophomores **Marianne Kalin** and **Sandra Karsten** (Finland), **Ana Hernandez Gil** (Canary Islands) and **Petja Krupenko** (Slovenia); freshman **Mie Hoff** (Norway), junior transfer **Sica Cuzic** (Romania), junior **Kayla Minott** (Canada) and senior **Aleana Leon** (Puerto Rico).
- Drexel has the second most at three international players in sophomore **Ana Ferariu** (Romania) and juniors **Tereza Krackova** (Czech Republic) and **Eline Maeschalk** (Belgium).

HELLO, COACHES

- There will be three new coaches on the sidelines, two of which are familiar faces.
- Head Coach **Karen Barefoot** takes the helm of UNCW. She was previously in the league as the leader of ODU.
- Head Coach **Natasha Adair** returns to the CAA sidelines, taking over the helm of Delaware. Adair led College of Charleston during its first season in the CAA.
- Head Coach **Diane Richardson** will guide Towson this season. Richardson was a longtime assistant coach at West Virginia.

SOME POINTS & LOTS OF BOARDS

- Only six of the top-20 leading scorers from last season return for the respective teams. Yet, 11 of the top-20 leading rebounders from one year ago will be back to clean the glass.

TOP HONORS RETURN

- Only four of the 15 All-CAA honorees from last year return for the 2017-18 season, including All-CAA First Team selections **Shay Burnett** (Elon) and **Nicole Enabosi** (Delaware), All-CAA Second Team pick **Ashunae Durant** (Hofstra) and All-CAA Third Team honoree **Claudia Ortiz** (Northeastern). James Madison returns the last two CAA Rookies of the Year in **Kamiah Smalls** and 2015-16 CAA Rookie of the Year **Kayla Cooper-Williams**, who missed the entirety of 2016-17 with an injury.

2017 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- James Madison was predicted to capture the 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship while Elon senior **Shay Burnett** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in a vote of the league's 10 head coaches.
- The Dukes had 78 points, including six first-place votes while Elon, the defending champs, was second with 74 points, including three first-place votes. Rounding out the top-seven was William & Mary (58), Drexel (51), Delaware (48), Northeastern (47) and Hofstra (43). Towson and UNCW were tied for eighth while CofC was tenth.

2018 CAA CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

- The 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship tournament will be held March 7-10 at the Daskalakis Athletic Center (DAC) in Philadelphia, Pa. and will be hosted by Drexel.
- The opening round, quarterfinals and semifinals will be streamed exclusively on CAA.tv. The final will be aired on NBC Sports Washington & Philadelphia and SNY and streamed via CollegeSportsLive, as part of the conference's partnership with CBSi.
- All-Session tickets are on sale now by visiting DrexelTickets.com.
- The CAA Women's Basketball Championship returned to campus last season with James Madison hosting at the Convocation Center in Harrisonburg, Va. Delaware will host the 2019 CAA Championship at the Bob Carpenter Center in Newark.
