#### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### ABBY RENDLE | WILLIAM & MARY SENIOR | CENTER | RESTON, VA./SOUTH LAKES

Senior Abby Rendle powered William & Mary to its seventh straight victory and broke a CAA career record in the process. Rendle posted a game-high 19 points, going 9-of-10 from the floor, and added nine blocks, seven boards, an assist and a steal in the victory over Old Dominion. She did not commit a turnover in 30 minutes of action. With her eighth block in the contest, Rendle became the league's all-time leading shot blocker, breaking the record of 273 held by former Delaware Blue Hen Elena Delle Donne. Rendle currently has 275 blocks and is the national leader with 53 blocks on the year. This is the second CAA Player of the Week honor for Rendle, who is averaging 13.1 points, 8.1 rebounds and 5.3 blocks per game.



# ROOKIE OF THE WEEK NYLA POLLARD | WILLIAM & MARY FRESHMAN | GUARD | VIRGINIA BEACH, VA./PRINCESS ANNE

Freshman Nyla Pollard picked up her second-straight CAA Rookie of the Week honor after a solid outing in the William & Mary's 75-58 win over Old Dominion. Pollard was in double-figures for the second straight game, posting 12 points and acareer-high five assists to go against no turnovers. She also added a steal and a rebound. Pollard has started all 10 games and is averaging 6.6 points, 1.7 rebounds, and 2.6 assists.

#### **#CAAHOOPS REWIND**

- Charleston (3-6): After a 10-day exam break, the Cougars picked up a road win at North Florida, topping the Ospreys, 73-69. Tanisha Brown posted a double-double (14pts,11reb) while Darien Huff led CofC with 15 points.
- Delaware (6-4): The Blue Hens were off for exams last week.
- Drexel (7-4): The Dragons topped Saint Joseph's, 65-58, in their lone game of the week. It was Drexel's fifth win in the last six games. Senior Megan Marecic notched a career-best 20 points while sophomore Bailey Greenberg also had a career-high with 19 points, going 7-of-10 from the field, and a career-best five steals.
- Elon (7-3): Elon's second-half comeback fell short in a 70-57 loss at NC State. Sophomore Ra'Shika White had a game-high 20 points along with a team-high eight rebounds. It was White's secondconsecutive 20-point game. Senior Shay Burnett had 14 points on 6-of-10 shooting from the floor.
- Hofstra (5-5): The Pride had just one game, falling at Columbia, 75-53, last Monday. Sophomore Marianne Kalin finished with 15 points and nine rebounds while senior Olivia Askin chipped in 13 points. Freshman Mie Hoff posted double-digit rebounds for the first time in her career, leading Hofstra with 10.
- James Madison (3-7): The Dukes fell to defending A-10 champion Dayton, 82-54, on the road. Sophomore Kamiah Smalls pushed her doubledigit scoring streak to 10 games, finishing with 22
- UNCW (6-4): UNCW used a fourth quarter surge to overtake Wofford, 65-60, for its first round win of the year. Jenny DeGraaf, Chinyere Bell and Lacey Suggs each finished with 15 points. DeGraaf and Bell also grabbed eight boards apiece.
- Northeastern (4-5): The Huskies nailed a programrecord 15 three-pointers in a 71-66 victory at Vermont, which snapped NU's three-game skid. Shannon Todd scored a career-high 22 points, which included five three-pointers, to lead the Huskies. Jess Genco finished with 18 points and drilled four three-pointers from beyond the arc, also tallying seven assists.
- Towson (4-5): The Tigers fell at Norfolk State, 86-76, in their only game. A 14-4 run to start the fourth quarter allowed Norfolk State to break open a one-point game and claim victory. Sophomore forward Nukiya Mayo led Towson with 20 points, as she was one of four Tigers to score in double figures in the contest.
- William & Mary (9-1): The Tribe won their seventh straight game by topping Old Dominion, 75-58, at Kaplan Arena. William & Mary stuffed the stat sheet, with Abby Rendle leading the way with 19 points, nine blocks and seven boards, becoming the CAA's career blocks leader in the process. Victoria Reynolds had 15 points, including a 9-for-10 effort from the free throw line. Bianca Boggs had 13 points, nine boards, six assists while Nyla Pollard had 12 points and five assists.

In the NCAA RPI released on December 13, three CAA teams were in the top-100. Drexel had an RPI of 50 followed by Elon (61) and William & Mary (76).

#### **CAA IN NON-LEAGUE PLAY**

- The CAA is 54-44 in non-league play.
- The CAA is 28-12 at home in non-league play. Four teams (UNCW, Drexel, Elon, William & Mary) are unbeaten at home.
- The CAA is averaging 68.0 points per game while opponents are averaging 66.1 points.
- The CAA is averaging 38.7 rebounds per game while holding opponents to 33.8 boards.
- Last season, the CAA went 69-49 against nonleague opponents.

#### **#CAAHOOPS HOT SHOTS**

- William & Mary is the nation leaders in blocks (84) and blocks per game (8.4). Towson is eighth nationally with 6.6 blocks per game.
- College of Charleston has made at least 11 free throws in each of its last five games, including 21 at Coastal Carolina.
- Elon was out-rebounded for the first time this season at NC State on December 16 by a margin of 40-33. The Phoenix entered the game with a +15.2rebounding margin. Their current +13 rebounding margin ranks them seventh in the nation.
- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** is nationally ranked in several categories. She's 12th in rebounds (122), eighth in rebounds per game (12.2), sixth in defensive rebounds per game (8.0), fifth in doubledoubles (8), sixth in free throws made (63) and fourth in free throws attempted (90).
- Hofstra's Ashunae Durant is the CAA's career active leader in points (1326) and rebounds (914). She's on pace to become the first player since 2012-2013 to reach 1,000 points and 1,000 boards. Elena Delle Donne (Delaware), Danielle Parker (Delaware) and Shante Evans (Hofstra) were the last two players to complete the feat.
- Drexel came away with a 20 steals against Lafayette on December 1, the most in the CAA this season. The Dragons have a league-best 120 steals this season.
- James Madison transfer Kelly Koshuta has scored in double figures seven times through 10 games.
- In the two games since becoming eligible for UNCW, junior transfer Chinyere Bell has posted 15.0 points on 11-for-22 shooting and 4.5 rebounds.
- UNCW made a season-high 34 made field goals the win over N.C. Central. The 34 made field goals were the most since March 9, 2012, when the Seahawks were 34-of-71 against Hofstra.
- William & Mary's Bianca Boggs had 33 points against Saint Francis (PA) on December 2, the most scored by a Tribe player since 2012.
- Northeastern made 15 three-pointers at Vermont on December 17, tying the Huskies for third alltime in CAA single game history.
- Five Huskies have five players averaging double figures in scoring, the only team in the CAA to do so this season: Stella Clark (12.3), Claudia Ortiz (13.8), Gabby Giacone (12.7), Jess Genco (14.3) and Shannon Todd (13.4).
- James Madison senior Hailee Barron appeared in her 111th consecutive game on December 17 at
- Hofstra senior Olivia Askin took her first career free throws at Columbia on December 11. She had played 1,118 minutes without taking one.

# **WEEKLY REPORT**

#### IN THE POLLS

- USA Today WBCA Coaches Poll: Elon received votes in the Preseason Poll as well as the poll released on November 21.
- College Insider Mid-Major Poll: Elon remained at No. 6 for the fourth straight week. James Madison, William & Mary and Drexel all received votes in the poll released on December 12.

#### **BIG BLOCKER**

- William & Mary center Abby Rendle blocked nine shots against Old Dominion on December 17 to surpass former Delaware Blue Hen and WNBA superstar Elena Delle Donne has the CAA's career blocks leader. Rendle brought her total to 275, breaking Delle Donne's record of 273 blocks.
- Rendle leads the nation with 53 blocks (5.3/g).

#### I'LL HAVE ANOTHER TRIPLE-DOUBLE

- Elon senior Shay Burnett recorded the second triple-double in the CAA this season with 10 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists. It was the first triple-double in Elon history.
- William & Mary center Abby Rendle notched her third career triple-double at East Carolina on November 21. Rendle finished with a 25 points, 17 rebounds and 10 blocks.
- This is the second consecutive season in which the CAA has had multiple triple-doubles. Former Hofstra guard Krystal Luciano and Rendle completed the feat last year.
- Rendle has all three points-rebounds-blocks triple-doubles since 2006. Rendle also had a triple-double against East Carolina last season (14pts, 11reb, 10blk). Rendle's first triple-double (and William & Mary's first) came in 2015-16. against UNCW (24pts, 15reb, 10blk).

#### HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

- With its 106-54 win over Coker on November 27, Elon recorded the first 100-point game in the CAA since March 4, 2015 when James Madison scored 107 points against College of Charleston.
- Since 1998-99, there have been 21 games in which a CAA team has scored 100+ points.

#### **HEY ROOKIE!**

- Northeastern's Stella Clark is the first player in CAA history to be awarded with the first three CAA Rookie of the Week honors of the year since the award's creation in 2002-03.
- Clark is only the second player in CAA history to earn three consecutive nods at any point in the year; Elena Delle Donne did it twice in 2009-10 en route to her record-setting 10 CAA Rookie of the Week honors.

#### **HELLO, COACHES**

- There will be three new coaches on the sidelines, two of which are familiar faces.
- Head Coach Karen Barefoot takes the helm of UNCW. She was previously in the league as the leader of ODU.
- Head Coach Natasha Adair returns to the CAA sidelines, taking over the helm of Delaware. Adair led CofC during its first CAA season.
- Head Coach Diane Richardson will guide Towson this season. Richardson was a longtime assistant coach at West Virginia.

#### THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT TIME

- Elon headed to the Puerto Rico Clasico which was relocated to Fort Lauderdale, Fla. The Phoenix opened action with a win over (RV/RV) Alabama but fell to (RV/RV) Iowa.
- Drexel traveled to Melbourne, Fla. for the relocated Paradise Jam. The Dragons fell to (RV) Virginia Tech in the opening round and No. 11/13 West Virginia on the second day but downed Butler on the final day. Sophomore Aubree Brown landed a spot on the All-Tournament Team, averaging 9.7 points and 4.0 assists per game.
- Northeastern split games at the UMass Thanksgiving Classic topping host UMass before being edged by Houston.
- James Madison headed north for the TD Bank Classic which was hosted by Vermont. The Dukes were edged by Villanova but downed the host Catamounts. Sophomore Kamiah Smalls was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 18.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals per game.
- Hofstra split games at the Lady Rebel Round-Up in Las Vegas. The Pride was clipped by host UNLV before knocking off Wake Forest. Senior Aleana Leon was named to the All-Tournament team after averaging 14.5 points and 6.5 rebounds.
- Delaware made a trip to Philadelphia for the Saint Joseph's Thanksgiving Tournament. After falling to Saint Peter's by a basket in double overtime, the Hens trounced Eastern Illinois. Nicole Enabosi was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 24.0 points and 14.0 rebounds.

#### KATRINA MCCLAIN AWARD WATCH LIST

- Hofstra senior Ashunae Durant was named one of 20 candidates for the Katrina McClain Award, which recognized the top power forward in women's basketball.
- The list will be fluid, with players able to be added a removed from the list throughout the season. It will be narrowed to 10 in mid-February before the five ultimate finalists are announced in March.

#### **#CAAHOOPS INTERNATIONALLY SPEAKING**

- The are 15 international players hailing for 10 different countries in the CAA this season.
- Hofstra's roster features eight international player in sophomores Marianne Kalin and Sandra Karsten (Finland), Ana Hernandez Gil (Canary Islands) and Petja Krupenko (Slovenia); freshman Mie Hoff (Norway), junior transfer Sica Cuzic (Romania), junior Kayla Minott (Canada) and senior Aleana Leon (Puerto Rico).
- Drexel has the second most at three international players in sophomore  $\bf Ana\ Ferariu\ (Romania)$  and juniors Tereza Kracikova (Czech Republic) and Eline Maesschalk (Belgium).

# **WEEKLY REPORT**

#### 2017 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- James Madison was predicted to capture the 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship while Elon senior Shay Burnett was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in a vote of the league's 10 head coaches.
- The Dukes had 78 points, including six first-place votes while Elon, the defending champs, was second with 74 points, including three first-place votes. Rounding out the top-seven was William & Mary (58), Drexel (51), Delaware (48), Northeastern (47) and Hofstra (43). Towson and UNCW were tied for eighth while CofC was
- Only six of the top-20 leading scorers from last season return for the respective teams. Yet, 11 of the top-20 leading rebounders from one year ago will be back to clean the glass.
- Only four of the 15 All-CAA honorees from last year return for the 2017-18 season.

#### **2018 CAA CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT**

- The 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship tournament will be held March 7-10 at the Daskalakis Athletic Center (DAC) in Philadelphia, Pa. and will be hosted by Drexel.
- The opening round, quarterfinals and semifinals will be streamed exclusively on CAA.tv. The final will be aired on NBC Sports Washington & Philadelphia and SNY and streamed via CollegeSportsLive, as part of the conference's partnership with CBSi.

- The CAA Women's Basketball Championship returned to campus last season with James Madison hosting at the Convocation Center in Harrisonburg, Va. Delaware will host the 2019 CAA Championship at the Bob Carpenter Center in Newark.
