PLAYER OF THE WEEK

NICOLE ENABOSI | DELAWARE JUNIOR | FORWARD | GAITHERSBURG, MD./OUR LADY OF GOOD COUNSEL

Junior Nicole Enabosi logged 23 points and a career-high 20 rebounds in Delaware's win over Loyola. It was the most rebounds in the CAA this season and the most for a Blue Hen since 1989. It was just the fifth 20-20 game in school history and the first one in the CAA since the 2012-13 season. Enabosi went 9-for-13 from the floor and 5-for-5 from the free throw line. She also dished out three assists, with no turnovers, and blocked a shot in 34 minutes of action. Enabosi has posted a double-double in eight straight games, which is a school record, and has nine double-doubles in 11 games this season. This is the third CAA Player of the Week honor for Enabosi this season.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

SAADIA MUNFORD | ELON FRESHMAN | GUARD | ATLANTA, GA./JONESBORO

Rookie guard Saadia Munford's six-point, 10-assist, three-steal night helped pace Elon's 78-50 victory over NC Central. In all, Munford scored or contributed on 28 of Elon's points in the game, assisting on 22 points and scoring six of them herself. The freshman's double-digit assist night set a new career high and was the sixth in the CAA this season. Munford, who has started all 11 games this season, is averaging 3.1 assists and 5.0 points per game for the Phoenix.

#CAAHOOPS REWIND

- **Charleston (4-7):** The Cougars split games last week, topping Wofford before falling to Wake Forest. **Tanisha Brown** averaged 11.0 points over the two games while **Shiclasia Brown** averaged 7.5 assists per game.
- **Delaware (7-4):** The Blue Hens rolled over Loyola, 71-38, at the Bob Carpenter Center. Junior **Nicole Enabosi** notched her eighth consecutive double-double, finishing with 23 points and 20 rebounds. It was just the fourth 20-20 game in program history and the first since the 1983-84 season; it was the first 20-20 game in the CAA since the 2012-13 season. Freshman **Justina Mascaro** added a season-best 12 points.
- **Drexel (8-4):** The Dragons never trailed and pulled away late in the 61-39 victory over Cornell. **Aubree Brown** finished with a game-high 15 points, knocking down all four of her three-point attempts. She added four assists and three steals as Drexel came up with 11 steals as a team.
- **Elon (8-3):** The Phoenix posted a 78-50 victory against North Carolina Central. Elon, which moved to 4-0 at home, had four players score in double figures, including **Ra'Shika White's** game-high 19 points. Rookie guard **Saadia Munford** dished out a career-best 10 assists.
- **Hofstra (6-5):** The Pride rallied from a nine-point deficit with 2:27 to play to defeat St. Bonaventure, 71-68. Senior **Ashunae Durant** tallied 20 points to lead four Pride players in double-figures as Hofstra improved to 6-5 on the season with their fourth win in the last six contests.
- **James Madison (4-7):** The Dukes led wire-to-wire with a 67-36 victory over Bryant. Sophomore **Kamiah Smalls** led three Dukes in double figures with a career-high 23 points. Redshirt sophomore **Kayla Cooper-Williams** posted her first double-double (10pts, 12reb) of the season. Rookie **Tori Harris** chipped in with eight points, a season high, and four rebounds.
- **UNCW (7-4):** Redshirt senior forward **Jenny DeGraaf** scored a career-high 21 points and grabbed 10 rebounds to lead UNCW past Georgia State, 74-62, in a comeback victory. The Seahawks have won four of their last five games and are 6-0 at home this season.
- **Northeastern (5-6):** The Huskies finished as the runners-up at the Beach Classic, topping New Mexico State before falling to Illinois State in the title game. Guard **Jess Genco** averaged 13.0 points, 7.5 rebounds, and 6.5 assists during the two-day event to earn All-Tournament Team honors.
- **Towson (5-6):** The Tigers split games at the Las Vegas Holiday Hoops Classic. Towson downed Arkansas-Pine Bluff before falling to Radford. Mary Cuevas was named to the All-Tournament Team, averaging a double-double with 16.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game while shooting 68.2 percent (15-22) from the field.
- **William & Mary (9-2):** William & Mary had its seven-game winning streak snapped with an 80-74 overtime loss to Norfolk State. **Bianca Boggs** netted a team-high 22 points, going 8-for-9 from the floor.

IN THE RPI

- In the NCAA RPI released on December 23, two CAA teams were in the top-100. Drexel had an RPI of 53 followed by Elon (62).

#CAAHOOPS HOT SHOTS

- William & Mary is the national leader in blocks per game (8.3) and second nationally with 98 blocks. Towson is ninth nationally with 6.4 blocks per game and 14th in total blocks (70).
- The Tribe's nine non-conference wins are good for second most in school history since the CAA began
- Elon has only been out-rebounded once this season (NC State on December 16 by a margin of 40-33). The Phoenix currently has a +11.8 rebounding margin which ranks them 11th in the nation. The Phoenix is also 14th in rebounds per game (45.18).
- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** recorded 23 points and 20 rebounds in the non-league final against Loyola on December 22. It was the first 20-20 game in the CAA since the 2012-13 season. That year, Hofstra's Shante Evans had 33 points and 23 boards against Mason while William & Mary's Emily Correal had 24 points and 21 rebounds in the season opener against East Carolina.
- **Enabosi** is nationally ranked in several categories. She's tenth in rebounds (142), fourth in rebounds per game (12.9), third in defensive rebounds per game (9.0), third in double-doubles (9), fifth in free throws made (68) and free throws attempted (95).
- Hofstra's **Ashunae Durant** is the CAA's career active leader in points (1356) and rebounds (934). She's on pace to become the first player since 2012-2013 to reach 1,000 points and 1,000 boards. **Elena Delle Donne** (Delaware), **Danielle Parker** (Delaware) and **Shante Evans** (Hofstra) were the last two players to complete the feat.
- Five Huskies are averaging double figures in scoring, the only team in the CAA to do so this season: **Stella Clark (12.3)**, **Claudia Ortiz (11.6)**, **Gabby Giacone (12.6)**, **Jess Genco (14.1)** and **Shannon Todd (13.3)**.
- Drexel came away with a 20 steals against Lafayette on December 1, the most in the CAA this season. The Dragons have a league-best 131 steals this season.
- In the three games since becoming eligible for UNCW, junior transfer **Chinyere Bell** has posted 11.7 points on 13-for-25 shooting (.520) and 4.7 rebounds.
- UNCW made a season-high 34 made field goals the win over N.C. Central. The 34 made field goals were the most since March 9, 2012, when the Seahawks were 34-of-71 against Hofstra.
- Northeastern made 15 three-pointers at Vermont on December 17, tying the Huskies for third all-time in CAA single game history.
- James Madison senior **Hailee Barron** appeared in her 112th consecutive game on December 21 against Bryant.
- The Dukes' **Kamiah Smalls** has scored in double digits in all 11 games this season. She's second in the CAA in scoring, averaging 17.1 points per game.
- Hofstra senior **Olivia Askin** took her first career free throws at Columbia on December 11. She had played 1,118 minutes without taking one.

IN THE POLLS

- **USA Today WBCA Coaches Poll:** Elon received votes in the Preseason Poll as well as the poll released on November 21.
- **College Insider Mid-Major Poll:** Elon remained at No. 6 for the sixth straight week according to the poll released on December 26. In addition, William & Mary, Drexel and James Madison all received votes.

CAA IN NON-LEAGUE PLAY

- The CAA went 63-48 in non-league play.
- The CAA had success against the A-10, going 10-4, the American (3-1), the Patriot League (8-3) and the NEC (5-0).
- The CAA went 34-14 at home in non-league play. Three teams (UNCW, Drexel, Elon) went unbeaten.
- The CAA averaged 67.7 points per game while opponents averaged 65.1 points a contest.
- The CAA averaged 38.9 rebounds per game and held opponents to 37.5 boards.

BIG BLOCKER

- William & Mary center **Abby Rendle** blocked nine shots against Old Dominion on December 17 to surpass former Delaware Blue Hen and WNBA superstar **Elena Delle Donne** has the CAA's career blocks leader. Rendle brought her total to 275, breaking Delle Donne's record of 273 blocks.
- Rendle leads the nation with 5.0 blocks per game and is second in total blocks (55).

HELPING THEM OUT

- William & Mary senior guard **Jenna Green** is 16th in the nation in assists per game (6.5) and 19th in total assists (72).
- The Tribe is ranked 23rd in assists per game (18.0).
- There have been six 10-assist games in the CAA this season.
- Elon accounts for three of those efforts, with **Shay Burnett** doing it twice and rookie **Saadia Munford** registering one.
- Northeastern's **Jess Genco** has the most helpers in a single game this season with 12 assists against Houston on November 25.
- As a team, Drexel has the most assists in a single game this year with 25 against La Salle on November 16.

I'LL HAVE ANOTHER TRIPLE-DOUBLE

- Elon senior **Shay Burnett** recorded the second triple-double in the CAA this season with 10 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists. It was the first triple-double in Elon history.
- William & Mary center **Abby Rendle** notched her third career triple-double at East Carolina on November 21. Rendle finished with a 25 points, 17 rebounds and 10 blocks.
- This is the second consecutive season in which the CAA has had multiple triple-doubles. Former Hofstra guard **Krystal Luciano** and Rendle completed the feat last year.
- Rendle has all three points-rebounds-blocks triple-doubles since 2006. Rendle also had a triple-double against East Carolina last season (14pts, 11reb, 10blk). Rendle's first triple-double (and William & Mary's first) came in 2015-16, against UNCW (24pts, 15reb, 10blk).

HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

- With its 106-54 win over Coker on November 27, Elon recorded the first 100-point game in the CAA since March 4, 2015 when James Madison scored 107 points against College of Charleston.
- Since 1998-99, there have been 21 games in which a CAA team has scored 100+ points.

HEY ROOKIE!

- Northeastern's **Stella Clark** is the first player in CAA history to be awarded with the first three CAA Rookie of the Week honors of the year since the award's creation in 2002-03.
- Clark is only the second player in CAA history to earn three consecutive nods at any point in the year; **Elena Delle Donne** did it twice in 2009-10 en route to her record-setting 10 CAA Rookie of the Week honors.

HELLO, COACHES

- There will be three new coaches on the sidelines, two of which are familiar faces.
- Head Coach **Karen Barefoot** takes the helm of UNCW. She was previously in the league as the leader of ODU.
- Head Coach **Natasha Adair** returns to the CAA sidelines, taking over the helm of Delaware. Adair led CofC during its first CAA season.
- Head Coach **Diane Richardson** will guide Towson this season. Richardson was a longtime assistant coach at West Virginia.

THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT TIME

- Elon headed to the Puerto Rico Clasico which was relocated to Fort Lauderdale, Fla. The Phoenix opened action with a win over (RV/RV) Alabama but fell to (RV/RV) Iowa.
- Drexel traveled to Melbourne, Fla. for the relocated Paradise Jam. The Dragons fell to (RV) Virginia Tech in the opening round and No. 11/13 West Virginia on the second day but downed Butler on the final day. Sophomore **Aubree Brown** landed a spot on the All-Tournament Team, averaging 9.7 points and 4.0 assists per game.
- Northeastern split games at the UMass Thanksgiving Classic topping host UMass before being edged by Houston.
- James Madison headed north for the TD Bank Classic which was hosted by Vermont. The Dukes were edged by Villanova but downed the host Catamounts. Sophomore **Kamiah Smalls** was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 18.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals per game.
- Hofstra split games at the Lady Rebel Round-Up in Las Vegas. The Pride was clipped by host UNLV before knocking off Wake Forest. Senior **Aleana Leon** was named to the All-Tournament team after averaging 14.5 points and 6.5 rebounds.
- Delaware made a trip to Philadelphia for the Saint Joseph's Thanksgiving Tournament. After falling to Saint Peter's by a basket in double overtime, the Hens trounced Eastern Illinois. **Nicole Enabosi** was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 24.0 points and 14.0 rebounds.

KATRINA MCCLAIN AWARD WATCH LIST

- Hofstra senior **Ashunae Durant** was named one of 20 candidates for the Katrina McClain Award, which recognized the top power forward in women's basketball.
- The list will be fluid, with players able to be added a removed from the list throughout the season. It will be narrowed to 10 in mid-February before the five ultimate finalists are announced in March.

#CAAHOOPS INTERNATIONALLY SPEAKING

- There are 15 international players hailing for 10 different countries in the CAA this season.
- Hofstra's roster features eight international players in sophomores **Marianne Kalin** (Finland), **Ana Hernandez Gil** (Canary Islands) and **Petja Krupenko** (Slovenia); freshman **Mie Hoff** (Norway), junior transfer **Sica Cuzic** (Romania), junior **Kayla Minott** (Canada) and senior **Aleana Leon** (Puerto Rico).
- Drexel has the second most at three international players in sophomore **Ana Ferariu** (Romania) and juniors **Tereza Kracikova** (Czech Republic) and **Eline Maesschalk** (Belgium).

2017 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- James Madison was predicted to capture the 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship while Elon senior **Shay Burnett** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in a vote of the league's 10 head coaches.
- The Dukes had 78 points, including six first-place votes while Elon, the defending champs, was second with 74 points, including three first-place votes. Rounding out the top-seven was William & Mary (58), Drexel (51), Delaware (48), Northeastern (47) and Hofstra (43). Towson and UNCW were tied for eighth while CofC was tenth.
- Only six of the top-20 leading scorers from last season return for the respective teams. Yet, 11 of the top-20 leading rebounders from one year ago will be back to clean the glass.
- Only four of the 15 All-CAA honorees from last year return for the 2017-18 season.

2018 CAA CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

- The 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship tournament will be held March 7-10 at the Daskalakis Athletic Center (DAC) in Philadelphia, Pa. and will be hosted by Drexel.
- The opening round, quarterfinals and semifinals will be streamed exclusively on CAA.tv. The final will be aired on NBC Sports Washington & Philadelphia and SNY and streamed via CollegeSportsLive, as part of the conference's partnership with CBSi.
- All-Session tickets are on sale now by visiting DrexelTickets.com.
- The CAA Women's Basketball Championship returned to campus last season with James Madison hosting at the Convocation Center in Harrisonburg, Va. Delaware will host the 2019 CAA Championship at the Bob Carpenter Center in Newark.
