
PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Omar Prewitt • William & Mary

Sr., G/F, 6-7, 195 - Mount Sterling, Ky./Montgomery Co. Prewitt filled the stat sheet in William & Mary's 2-0 week, averaging 18.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 6.0 assists. The senior wing scored a season-high 28 points on 12-of-17 FG shooting and grabbed a team-high seven rebounds as the Tribe knocked off first-place UNCW, 96-78, on Saturday. He also had nine points, a career-high eight assists and no turnovers in an 82-58 victory over Delaware. For the week, Prewitt shot 59.3% from the floor.



PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Tyler Seibring • Elon

So., F, 6-8, 225 - Normal, Ill./Normal Community Seibring repeats as Player of the Week after averaging 19.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists in a pair of Elon road victories. The sophomore forward scored a team-high 15 points with eight rebounds as the Phoenix handed Northeastern its first home loss of the season, 51-49, on Thursday. He followed with a team-best 23 points and six boards in an 84-70 win at Hofstra on Saturday. For the week, Seibring shot 53.6% from the floor.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK: Grant Riller • College of Charleston Fr., G, 6-3, 185 - Ocoee, Fla./Ocoee

Riller receives his third Rookie of the Week honor after contributing 27.5 points and 4.5 steals as Charleston split two road games last week. The freshman guard poured in a career-high 30 points with a career-best six steals in a 90-76 win at Drexel on Saturday, and contributed a team-high 25 points in an overtime setback at Towson last Thursday. For the week, Riller shot 58.6% from the floor, including 6-of-11 from three, and was 15-for-15 at the free throw line.

CONFERENCE NOTES:

W&M ENDS UNCW WINNING STREAK: Behind 28 points from Omar Prewitt and 27 from Daniel Dixon, **Willliam & Mary** handed **UNCW** its first CAA loss on Saturday, 96-78. The Seahawks' 9-0 conference start matched the 4th-best in league history and was only two wins shy of the 11-0 marks compiled by Delaware (2013-14), VCU (2006-07) and Richmond (1985-86). It was UNCW's first setback to a CAA foe since Feb. 15, 2016.

PILING UP THE WINS: UNCW's 20 overall wins are tied for the third-most of any Division I team in the nation through games of Jan. 31. The Seahawks (20-3) only trail #1 Gonzaga (22-0) and New Mexico State (21-2) and are tied with #2 Baylor (20-1), #4 Villanova (20-2), #5 Arizona (20-2), #12 North Carolina (20-4), #17 Maryland (20-2) and #22 Creighton (20-3).

FOUR CAA TEAMS IN TOP 100 IN LATEST RPI REPORT: UNCW is ranked #31 in the latest RPI rankings released by *Collegiate Basketball News* (rpiratings.com) through games of Jan. 31. The Seahawks (20-3) have captured 17 of their last 19 games, with the only losses coming on the road at Clemson and William & Mary. College of Charleston (17-6) is #76 in the RPI and has won 14 of its last 17 contests. Towson (13-10) is #95 in the RPI and has won five of its past six games. William & Mary (12-9) has moved up to #99 thanks to a three-game winning streak. Only nine other conferences (American, ACC, Atlantic 10, Big 12, Big East, Big Ten, Pac 12, SEC and West Coast) have four teams in the top 100 of the RPI. The CAA is ranked #11 among the nation's 32 Division I leagues.

WILLIAMS, WRIGHT-FOREMAN MAKE BIG SCORING JUMPS: Northeastern guard **T.J. Williams** and Hofstra guard **Justin Wright-Foreman** are two of the nation's most improved scorers this season according to STATS LLC. Williams leads the nation with a jump of 14.7 ppg, going from 6.8 ppg last season to a league-best 21.5 ppg this year. Wright-Foreman ranks third with an improvement of 13.8 ppg, going from 1.6 ppg last season to 15.4 ppg in 2016-17.

AUTISM AWARENESS GAMES SET FOR THIS WEEKEND: Coaches throughout the country will be raising money for autism this weekend through *Coaches Powering Forward for Autism* benefiting Autism Speaks. Towson head coach **Pat Skerry**, whose son Owen has autism, developed the campaign along with TCU assistant coach Tom Herrion. The program has gained national attention, with coaches across the country wearing the blue puzzle piece lapel pins on their jackets. Towson's game against William & Mary on Saturday will be televised by Comcast SportsNet and the Tigers will be wearing special blue uniforms courtesy of Under Armour.

UNCW RECEIVES VOTES IN NATIONAL POLLS FOR 6TH STRAIGHT WEEK: UNCW was once again among other teams receiving votes in the national Top 25 rankings. The Seahawks (20-3) received 8 points in the USA Today Coaches poll, which placed them 31st.

CBS SPORTS NETWORK TO TELEVISE CHAMPIONSHIP GAME: The CAA has signed an agreement with CBS Sports to have the title game of the 2017 CAA Men's Basketball Championship televised live on CBS Sports Network. The contest will tip-off at 7 p.m. on Monday, March 6 from the North Charleston Coliseum in North Charleston, S.C.

W&M's PREWITT AMONG SENIOR CLASS AWARD CANDIDATES: William & Mary senior guard/forward **Omar Prewitt** is one of 30 candiates nationally for the men's basketball Senior CLASS Award, which recognizes student-athletes in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition. The list will be trimmed to 10 in February and the winner will be announced at the Final Four.

CAA LEADS THE NATION IN ROAD VICTORIES: CAA teams have won 27 true road games and are 9-8 on neutral courts against non-conference foes this season. The 27 road wins are the most of any Division I conference. Eight CAA teams recorded multiple road victories in non-conference play, led by UNCW, Northeastern and Drexel with four each.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS: CAA teams concluded regular-season non-conference play with a combined 72-55 record. Eight of the league's 10 teams posted .500 or better overall records against non-league foes.

CAA COACHES TELECONFERENCES EACH TUESDAY The CAA will conduct its coaches media teleconference each Tuesday morning throughout the remainder of the regular season. All 10 coaches will participate on the call beginning at 10 a.m. and a complete schedule and call-in information can be found on Page 5 of this release. The teleconference will be streamed live on CAASports.com and the calls will also be archived on the website.

UNCW's CACOK AND INGRAM, NU'S WILLIAMS AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS: UNCW forward **Devontae Cacok** leads Division I in field goal percentage (78.7%) and ranks 14th in rebounding (10.7 rpg) according to the latest NCAA stats through games of Jan. 31. Northeastern guard **T.J. Williams**, who has tallied 20+ points 14 times this season, ranks 15th nationally in scoring (21.5 ppg) and 48th in assists (5.2 apg). UNCW guard **Denzel Ingram** is 14th in 3-pointers per game (3.3), 22nd in assists (5.7 apg) and 23rd in assist/TO ratio.

HOFSTRA'S GUSTYS RANKS 4TH IN DIVISION I IN REBOUNDS: Hofstra junior Rokas Gustys ranks fourth nationally with 12.0 rebounds per game as of Feb. 1. He grabbed 25 rebounds in the Pride's 65-57 win over South Dakota on Nov. 23, which is the 2nd-most by any NCAA Div. I player this season, and had 23 rebounds in a season-opening victory over Coppin State. Last season, Gustys had six games with at least 20 boards and ranked second nationally with 13.0 rpg. He's had 10 or more rebounds 14 times this season and has eight double-doubles. The 25 rebounds tied Navy All-American David Robinson (1986) for the second-most rebounds in a game in CAA history and was just one off the conference mark of 26 set by William & Mary's David Cully in 1996.

CLEANING THE GLASS: Eight of the CAA's 10 teams are out-rebounding their opponents this season. Towson leads the league with a +7.5 rebound margin, while James Madison is second with a +4.7 margin.

CHARLESTON AMONG NATION'S TOP DEFENSIVE TEAMS: Charleston is 4th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage defense (28.2%) and ranks 10th in Division I in scoring defense (61.7 ppg). The Cougars also lead the CAA in FG percentage defense (40.9%).

NORTHEASTERN SETS CAA MARK FOR 3-POINTERS: Northeastern set a CAA record for three-pointers in a game with 21 in a victory over Delaware on Jan. 5. The Huskies went 14-of-18 in the first half and finished 21-of-33 from beyond the arc. The previous CAA treys record was 20, set by VCU in 2010 and Navy in 1990. On the same night, Elon sophomore **Steven Santa Ana** tied a school record for threes in a game by going 9-of-11 from beyond the arc at William & Mary. The nine threes are tied for the third-most in CAA history.

SIX CAA PLAYERS NOMINATED FOR GOOD WORKS TEAM: Six CAA men's basketball players are nominees for the Allstate NABC Good Works Team. Nominees are CofC's Evan Bailey, Elon's Luke Eddy, Hofstra's Rokas Gustys, UNCW's Chris Flemmings, Towson's Eddie Keith II and W&M's Paul Rowley. The Allstate NABC Good Works Teams® recognize players at all levels of college basketball whose charitable involvement and altruistic acts stand out amongst all other student-athletes participating in the sport.

FRESHMEN MAKE IMMEDIATE IMPACT: The future appears to be bright based on performances from freshmen around the conference. Delaware guard Ryan Daly ranks among the top 10 in the CAA in scoring (14.7 ppg) and rebounding (6.8 rpg) and has scored double figures in 13 of his last 15 games. Drexel guard Kurk Lee has scored double figures in 19 games this season and ranks 13th in the league in scoring (14.0 ppg) and 4th in assists (5.1 apg). Hofstra guard Eli Pemberton has reached the 20-point mark six times and ranks 16th in the CAA with 13.2 ppg. CofC guard Grant Riller is averaging 12.7 ppg and has scored double figures in seven straight games. W&M's Nathan Knight (7.0 ppg/4.3 rpg) had 14 points and seven rebounds against Louisville and 11 points at Duke. Drexel's Kari Jonsson is 5th in the CAA with 2.2 treys per game. Northeastern's trio of freshmen Shawn Occeus, Max Boursiquot and Bolden Brace have combined to average 16.2 ppg and 9.5 rpg.

THREE CAA TEAMS RANKED IN LATEST MID-MAJOR POLL: UNCW was ranked #6 and College of Charleston was ranked #18 in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll that was released on January 30. **Elon** was among other teams receiving votes.

UNCW PICKED TO WIN CAA TITLE: UNCW, which returned three starters from last year's 25-win team that captured its first CAA championship since 2006, was picked to win the CAA men's basketball championship in 2016-17 according to a vote of the league's coaches, media relations directors and media members. The Seahawks were followed in the voting by Towson, William & Mary and College of Charleston. Chosen fifth was James Madison, followed by Hofstra, Northeastern, Elon, Drexel and Delaware.

EIGHT ALL-CONFERENCE PLAYERS RETURN: The CAA welcomes back eight players who earned all-conference honors in 2015-16, including three first-team honorees in UNCW guard **Chris Flemmings**, Hofstra forward/center **Rokas Gustys** and William & Mary guard/forward **Omar Prewitt**. Back from the second team is Towson forward **William Adala Moto**. Returning from the third team are College of Charleston forward **Jarrell Brantley**, UNCW guard **Denzel Ingram**, College of Charleston guard **Cameron Johnson** and Towson guard **Mike Morsell**.

CAA WELCOMES NEW COACHES: The CAA has three new head coaches this season. **Zach Spiker** takes over at Drexel after spending the past seven seasons as head coach at Army West Point. With the Cadets, he compiled 102 victories, including a 19-14 mark in 2015-16. **Louis Rowe** returns as head coach James Madison, where was an All-CAA player for the Dukes (1993-94 and 1995-96) and also served as an assistant coach. He was most recently an assistant at Bowling Green. Delaware is led by **Martin Ingelsby**, who spent the past 13 years as an assistant at Notre Dame for former Blue Hens' coach Mike Brey. During his time with the Irish, Ingelsby helped guide the team to eight NCAA Tournament appearances.

VARIETY OF CHAMPIONS: Six different schools have won the CAA Men's Basketball Championship over the past six years. The most recent champions are Old Dominion (2011), VCU (2012), James Madison (2013), Delaware (2014), Northeastern (2015) and UNCW (2016).

CAA SHOWS OVERALL STRENGTH: Showing its overall quality and depth, all 10 CAA members have competed in post-season play over the last five years. The list with the most recent appearance is as follows: College of Charleston (2013/CIT), Delaware (2014/NCAA), Drexel (2012/NIT), Elon (2013/CIT), Hofstra (2016/NIT), James Madison (2015/CIT), UNCW (2016/NCAA), Northeastern (2015/NCAA), Towson (2016/Vegas) and William & Mary (2015/NIT).

CAA MEN'S BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP MOVES TO CHARLESTON: The CAA Men's Basketball Championship moves to the North Charleston Coliseum in North Charleston, S.C. on March 3-6. It's the first year of a three-year agreement for the CAA to bring its showcase event to the Lowcountry after a three-year run in Baltimore, Md. Known for rich history, well-preserved architecture, a celebrated restaurant community and mannerly people, the Charleston area has been recognized as a world-class top travel destination by a number of publications, including Condè Nast Traveler and Travel + Leisure. Most recently, it was recognized as the No. 1 Small U.S. City by Condè Nast Traveler 2015 Readers' Choice Awards. Tickets are currently on sale at TicketMaster.com.

OUTSTANDING BROADCAST PACKAGE: The CAA features an outstanding broadcast package again this season. The conference will have more than 80 televised games thanks in large part to the conference's agreements with the NBC Sports Regional Networks, which includes CSN Mid-Atlantic, CSN Philadelphia, CSN New England, The Comcast Network and SNY, and the American Sports Network. CAA fans will also be provided with internet broadcasts of hundreds of additional games through CAA.TV, the conference's digital network. CAA.TV will provide coverage of any non-televised conference games. Games can also be viewed via the CAA.TV channel on the Roku platform.

- Went 1-1 on the road last week, falling 83-77 in OT at Towson before winning 90-76 at Drexel. The 90 points were a season-high.
- Grant Riller scored a career-best 30 points with a career-high 6 steals at DU and tallied 25 points at TU. He's reached double digits in 7 straight games and is averaging 19.9 ppg over that stretch.
- Joe Chealey scored 25 points at TU and 23 points at DU, which was his 7th 20-point effort of the season. He's tallied double figures in 12 of his last 13 games and ranks 4th in the CAA in scoring and 8th in assists.
- Jarrell Brantley added 18 points and 7 boards at DU. He's scored double digits in 20 games and has five double-doubles. He's 3rd in the CAA in rebounding (8.0 rpg).
- CofC shot a season-best 53.8% from the floor at Towson and 51% at Drexel.
- CofC went 30-of-31 at the free throw line at Drexel and is shooting 74.9% from the charity stripe in CAA play.

- Split games last week, losing 82-58 at W&M before winning 66-61 over JMU.
