## **Brett Johnson, James Madison**

Sr., 1B, Charlottesville, Va./St. Anne's-Belfield

Johnson batted .357 with four homers, a double and nine RBI's in JMU's three victories over the weekend. The senior first baseman went deep three times and tied a careerhigh with eight RBI's as the Dukes crushed UNC Asheville 25-9 last Saturday. He also had a homer in a 5-1 triumph over Wofford on Friday and contributed a double in a 2-1 victory over USC Upstate on Sunday. The effort earned him National Player of the Week accolades from Collegiate Baseball newspaper.

# CAA BASEBALL PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Jordan Barrett, Elon

Sr., LHP, Margate, Fla./Coral Springs

Barrett went 1-0 and struck out 16 batters in 8.1 innings of work during two appearances last week. The senior left-hander allowed just two hits and one run over 7.0 innings while fanning a career-best 13 in Elon's 10-1 victory over Radford last Tuesday. In a relief effort against #12 Clemson on Sunday, he gave up just one hit over 1.1 innings and struck out three.

# CAA BASEBALL ROOKIE OF THE WEEK: Sean Rausch, Hofstra

Fr., OF, Middle Island, N.Y./Longwood

Rausch batted .455 (5-for-11) with two runs scored and two RBI's as Hofstra split four games. The freshman recorded multiple hits in two of his three starts, going 3-for-4 with a double and an RBI in a win over Nicholls and 2-for-4 with an RBI vs. Grambling.

# CAA BASEBALL ROOKIE OF THE WEEK: Patrick Ryan, William & Mary

# **COL. OF CHARLESTON (4-3)**

The Cougars went 2-2 last week, falling to Coastal Carolina (16-7) before taking two-of-three from Cincinnati. Infielder **Luke Manzo** batted .636 (7-for-11) for the week and had multiple hits in three games. **Joey Mundy** hit a go-ahead 2-run homer as CofC beat UC 4-3 in Friday's opener and then went 2-for-4 with two RBI's in Sunday's 5-3 victory. **Logan McRae** raised his league-best RBI total to 14 and is batting .522. Lefty **Evan Sisk** made his debut on Sunday and gave up only two hits over 5.0 shutout innings and struck out six. **Bailey Ober** improved to 2-0 after allowing two runs over 6.1 innings and striking out six in Friday's opener. **Nathan Ocker** got the save after fanning four in 1.2 innings.

# **DELAWARE (2-5)**

The Blue Hens went 2-1 at the ODU Tournament, falling 2-1 to the host Monarchs before beating St. Joseph's (10-8) and SEC foe Kentucky (4-3). Starter **Brandon Walter** allowed two runs over 6.1 innings against ODU and starter **Kevin Milley** gave up two earned runs over 6.2 innings in the Kentucky win. **Ron Marinaccio** had 2.2 shutout innings from the bullpen. **Nick Patten** was 2-for-4 with two RBI's against Kentucky including a game-winning RBI double to cap a four-run 8th inning. It was UD's first victory over an SEC opponent since 1983. **Jordan Glover** and **Doug Trimble** each had three RBI's in the victory over St. Joe's.

# **ELON (3-4)**

The Phoenix rolled past Radford, 10-1, but were swept in a three-game series at #12 Clemson. Lefty **Jordan Barrett** earned the win vs. RU after giving up one run on two hits over 7.0 innings and striking out a career-high 13 batters. He carried a no-hitter into the sixth. **Ryan Conroy** limited Clemson to six hits over 8.0 shutout innings in the series opener, but Elon fell 1-0 in 13 innings. **Will Nance** belted a three-run homer in Saturday's game at Clemson. **Ryne Ogren** was 2-for-5 with a double, homer and five RBI's in the victory over Radford. **Kyle Jackson** is batting .400 for the season with four doubles and five RBI's.

# HOFSTRA (2-5)

The Pride fell 8-1 to national power LSU, but went 2-1 at the Mardi Gras Invitational with victories over Nicholls (10-3) and Southern (4-2). Shortsop **Mikey Riesner** batted .467 for the week with two doubles, a homer, three RBI's and six runs scored. Freshman **Sean Rausch** posted a .455 (5-11) average and had multiple hits against Nicholls and Grambling. **Nick Bottari** had seven hits last week, including three doubles. **John Rooney** threw 5.0 innings of no-hit ball vs. Nicholls, while **Jorge Marrero** scattered five hits over 7.0 shutout innings to get the win against Southern. **Michael James** got the save vs. Southern after striking out five in 1.2 innings.

# **JAMES MADISON (6-1)**

The Dukes are on a five-game winning streak for the first time since 2015 after defeating Longwood (4-3) Wofford (5-1), UNC Asheville (25-9) and USC Upstate (2-1) last week. Senior **Brett Johnson** tied a school-record with three homers and matched his career-high with eight RBI's vs. UNCA and also had a homer against Wofford. **Mike Sciorra** is batting a team-best .429 for the season, while **Adam Sisk** is hitting .385 with eight runs scored and nine RBI's. Closer **Michael Evans** gave up just one hit over 4.0 shutout innings and struck out six in three appearances last week and earned two saves. Freshman **Michael Bechtold** earned the win vs. Longwood after tossing 5.1 shutout innings.

## **UNCW (3-3)**

The Seahawks were swept in a three-game series at nationally ranked Ole Miss over the weekend. All-America catcher **Nick Feight** led the Seahawks' offense with two homers, a double and five RBI's. He's driven in a team-best eight runs for the season. **Robbie Thorburn** had his career-best 14-game hitting streak snapped on Friday, but responded with two hits in each of the next two games. He leads UNCW with a .320 average for the season. Pitcher **Josh Roberson** struck out a career-high eight over 5.0 innings on Saturday and gave up only two runs. He has a 2.70 ERA through his first two starts of the year.

# **NORTHEASTERN (2-5)**

The Huskies split a four-game series at North Florida. Junior **Max Burt** batted .375 (6-16) for the series, but was 5-for-8 with five RBI's in Saturday's double-header. Freshman **Scott Holzwasser** had at least one hit in three of the four games, including a 2-for-4 effort with a homer and three RBI's in Friday's win. He's batting .320 for the season. **Mason Koppens** continues to swing a hot bat, hitting .407 with five runs scored for the season. Pitcher **Mike Fitzgerald** earned his first career win as a starter on Friday, allowing one run on five hits over 6.0 innings while striking out four.

# **TOWSON (3-1)**

The Tigers got off to a great start with a 3-1 mark in a season-opening series at Cal State Northridge. Towson scored six runs with two outs in the 7th to rally for a 6-5 victory in the finale. Senior **A.J. Gallo** batted .375 (6-16) in the series with two doubles, a homer and seven runs scored. He had five hits in the first two games. **Logan Burke** batted a team-best .400 at CSUN and **Colin Dyer** hit .316 and drove in four. On the mound, closer **Kyle Stricker** earned a pair of saves after two dominant efforts. He allowed just one hit over 4.0 shutout innings on Friday and gave up one run over the final 3.0 frames on Sunday.

## WILLIAM & MARY (3-3)

The Tribe swept a three-game series from Lafayette, winning 5-4, 16-1 and 6-5. Junior **Cullen Large** batted .667 (8-for-12) in the series with four doubles, four RBI's and three runs scored. He had multiple hits in all three contests and is batting .522 with five doubles and seven RBI's for the season. Freshman **Patrick Ryan** had at least one hit in each game and batted .444 with four RBI's vs. LC. Freshman **Michael Goldak** had a walk-off single in the 10th on Friday. **Ryan Hall** homered on Friday and Saturday for the Tribe. On the mound, **Bodie Sheehan** picked up his first win of the year after giving up just one run on three hits over 6.0 innings and striking out four.
