CAA BASEBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Nick Patten, Delaware

So., 1B, Butler, Pa./IMG Academy

Patten batted .500 (10-for-20) with two doubles, three home runs, 18 runs scored and 13 RBI's in Delaware's 6-0 week. The sophomore first baseman homered in three straight games against Rider, UMBC and Wagner and scored at least two runs in all six contests. He also walked nine times to increase his on-base percentage to .688 for the week and stole three bases.

CAA BASEBALL PITCHERS OF THE WEEK:

Michael Adams, Towson

Jr., RHP, Mechanicsburg, Pa./Cumberland Valley

Adams allowed only four infield singles over 6.0 shutout innings in Towson's 5-0 victory over Norfolk State on Sunday. The junior fanned seven, with at least one strikeout in five of the six frames, and combined with Kyle Stricker on the Tigers' first shutout since 2014.

Colton Harlow, James Madison

Jr., LHP, Mount Jackson, Va./Stonewall Jackson

Harlow threw a complete-game, five-hitter with a career-high 15 strikeouts in James Madison's 12-1 victory over Coppin State last Friday. The junior left-hander, who more than doubled his previous career-best for strikeouts, didn't issue a walk and surrendered his only run with two outs in the ninth.

CAA BASEBALL ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Sean Mellen, Northeastern

Fr., LHP, Norwood, Mass./Norwood

In his first collegiate start, Mellen threw 6.2 innings of no-hit baseball and picked up the win in Northeastern's 9-2 victory over Toledo last Tuesday. The freshman left-hander, who struck out four, lost the no-hitter and shutout on a two-run double with two outs in the seventh.

DIAMOND NOTES:

COL. OF CHARLESTON (8-8)

The Cougars went 1-4 last week, dropping a pair against East Carolina and two-of-three vs. Kent State over the weekend. CofC topped KSU 10-7 in the first game of a twinbill on Saturday as **Erven Roper** went 4-for-5 with a homer and three RBI's and **Bradley Dixon** was 2-for-4 with two runs scored and two RBI's. **Carter Love** picked up the victory out of the bullpen, allowing just one hit over 4.2 shutout innings while striking out eight. **Jakob Frishmuth** didn't give up a run over the final 2.1 frames to earn his first save. Roper also hit .500 (5-for-10) and scored five times in the ECU series, while Dixon was 4-for-9 and drove in four. CofC hosts North Florida on Tuesday before a weekend trip to Nebraska.

DELAWARE (8-6)

The Blue Hens posted a 6-0 mark last week, which included victories over Rider, Delaware and UMBC and a three-game sweep of Wagner. UD's offense batted .406 and exploded for 95 runs over the six games and set a program record by scoring 10+ runs in five consecutive contests. Sophomore **Nick Patten** led the offensive charge, batting .500 (10-for-20) with two doubles, three homers, 18 runs scored and 13 RBI's. **Diaz Nardo** was 3-for-3 with five RBI's on Sunday, while **Kevin Mohollen** and **Jeremy Ake** each went 3-for-3 and drove in four. On the mound, **Brandon Walter** limited Wagner to one run on five hits over 6.0 innings and struck out a career-high nine last Friday. Head coach **Jim Sherman** recorded his 700th career win on Sunday.

ELON (7-9)

The Phoenix fell 12-8 at UNCG last Tuesday before dropping two-of-three to Georgia Southern over the weekend. Shortstop **Ryne Ogren** batted .438 (7-for-16) for the week with two doubles, three runs scored and three RBI's. **Cam Devanney** went 3-for-3 with a double, triple, two runs scored and three RBI's in Elon's 8-6 win over GSU last Friday. **Ryan Conroy** (2-0) picked up the victory after allowing just eight hits and two earned runs over 7.0 innings while striking out a career-high nine. He has fanned seven or more batters in three of his four starts this season. **James Venuto** was 3-for-4 with a double, homer and four RBI's in the loss at UNCG. The Phoenix host NC State on Tuesday before welcoming VMI for a three-game weekend series.

HOFSTRA (4-11)

The Pride rolled over NYIT 14-3 in their home opener last Wednesday, but lost three-of-four at Troy over the weekend. **Mikey Reisner** batted .353 with seven RBI's for the week, while **Steven Foster** hit .353 and drove in four. **Tom Archer** was 2-for-4 with four RBI's and **Vinnie Costello** knocked in three against NYIT. Freshman **Justin Smith** went 4-for-4 and scored twice in his Hofstra debut vs. Troy on Saturday. **Chris Weiss** (2-1) earned the win out of the bullpen against Troy on Saturday as he gave up just one hit over 3.2 shutout innings. **Teddy Cillis** held Troy to one run on two hits over 5.0 innings and fanned five, but took the loss as the Pride was shutout, 4-0. Due to an impending snowstorm, Hofstra has postponed all four of its games scheduled for this week.

JAMES MADISON (11-3)

The Dukes split a pair of games at Old Dominion before coming home to sweep a doubleheader from Coppin State last week. JMU's 11-3 start is its best since 2011. **Josh Wyatt** led the Dukes offensively, batting .462 (6-for-13) with a double, two homers, five runs scored and seven RBI's. He drove in three runs in the Dukes' 4-3 victory at ODU on Wednesday. **Kyle McPherson** was 5-for-7 in the doubleheader with CSU, while **Jack Hamner** hit a home run in each game.

On the mound, **Colton Harlow** threw a complete-game, 5-hitter and struck out a career-high 15 batters vs. CSU. The effort earned him National Player of the Week honors from Collegiate Baseball newspaper. **Brandon Withers** improved to 3-0 after striking out five over 5.0 innings in the opener with CSU.

UNCW (5-9)

The Seahawks dropped an 8-5 decision to #20 NC State, but took two-of-three from Longwood over the weekend to stop an eight-game slide. **Brian Mims** led the UNCW offense by batting .500 (8-for-16) with a pair of doubles. **Robbie Thorburn** recorded five RBI's for the week, including four in Saturday's doubleheader against Longwood. **Nick Feight** went deep twice last week to up his season total to four and move into a tie for 11th in career home runs at UNCW. The Seahawks' bullpen allowed just three hits and no runs over the final 5.1 innings in an 11-1 win over LU in the series finale. For the week, the bullpen posted a 1.06 ERA and held opponents to a .167 batting average while striking out 17 over 17.0 innings. UNCW faces Coastal Carolina and VCU this week.

NORTHEASTERN (6-8)

The Huskies went 2-2 as they wrapped up play at the Snowbird Classic in Florida last week, posting victories over Toledo and Lehigh. Shortstop **Max Burt** had a big week offensively, batting .471 (8-for-17) with two doubles, a homer, nine runs scored and three RBI's. He had multiple hits in all four games and raised his average to a team-best .392 for the season. **Zach Perry** went 3-for-3 and drove in six as NU topped Lehigh, 12-6. On the mound, **Brian Christian** struck out a career-high 10 batters and gave up only one run on four hits over 7.0 innings to get the win against Lehigh. Freshman **Sean Mellen** threw a no-hitter for 6.2 innings against Toledo in his first collegiate start before giving up a two-run double. He struck out four and picked up the win.

TOWSON (8-3)

The Tigers went 2-2 last week, recording a road victory at UMBC (7-3) before splitting a Sunday doubleheader with Norfolk State. **Trey Martinez** belted a 3-run homer in the 11th to lift Towson past UMBC. **Richie Palacios** was 3-for-5 and drove in two in the win. **Logan Burke** smacked a 3-run homer and finished with four RBI's as Towson beat NSU, 5-0, in the nightcap on Sunday. **Michael Adams** gave up just four infield singles and no runs over 6.0 innings and struck out seven vs. NSU, and **Kyle Stricker** tossed 3.0 scoreless frames to earn his third save. The two combined on Towson's first shutout since 2014. **Dean Stramara** limited UMBC to one earned run on four hits and struck out nine over 7.0 innings. He retired 13 straight batters at one point.

WILLIAM & MARY (9-6)

The Tribe went 3-2 last week, which included a 19-10 triumph over ACC foe Virginia Tech and a weekend sweep of Yale. Senior **Ryder Miconi** batted .476 (10-for-21) for the week with three doubles, two homers and nine RBI's. He had multiple hits in four of the five games, including going 4-for-6 with two doubles, a homer and six RBI's in the win over Virginia Tech. **Hunter Smith** drove in four against the Hokies. Freshman **Brandon Raquet** also had a big week at the plate, batting .429 (9-for-21) with five runs scored. He was 4-for-4 and scored twice in Saturday's triumph over Yale and had two hits in Sunday's victory. Pitcher **Bodie Sheehan** improved to 3-1 after limiting Yale to two runs over 7.0 innings and striking out nine on Saturday. On Sunday, **Nick Raquet** didn't give up an earned run in 6.2 innings of work and fanned nine.
