Casey Golden, UNCW

Sr., OF, Siler City, N.C./Jordan-Matthews

Golden batted .500 (7-for-14) with three homers, a double, five runs scored and seven RBI's in UNCW's three-game sweep of VCU over the weekend. The senior outfielder had multiple hits, including a homer, in all three victories to increase his hitting streak to eight games and his home run streak to four. Golden is batting .316 and leads the Seahawks with seven homers and 14 RBI's for the season.

CAA BASEBALL PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

Brandon Walter, Delaware

Walter allowed just one hit over 8.0 shutout innings and struck out a career-high 17 batters in Delaware's 6-1 victory over Penn State last Saturday. The sophomore left-hander took a no-hitter into the seventh before giving up a single, walked only one and had multiple strikeouts in seven of his eight frames. Walter improved to 2-3 on the season and lowered his ERA to 1.97.

Making the first starts of his career for injured Josh Wyatt, Semones batted .538 (7-for-13) with two doubles, five runs scored and four RBI's as JMU took three-of-four from NJIT over the weekend. The freshman second baseman, who entered the series wth four career at-bats, went 2-for-3 and drove in two in Saturday's 9-8 victory and was 3-for-4 with two runs scored and two RBI's in Sunday's 14-2 triumph.

DIAMOND NOTES:

COL. OF CHARLESTON (8-12)

The Cougars dropped all four games last week, including three at Big Ten foe Nebraska over the weekend. **Logan McRae** went 3-for-6 with a pair of RBI's against the Huskers and belted his team-leading sixth homer. He ranks second in the CAA with 23 RBI's for the year. **Luke Manzo** was 3-for-4 in a setback to UNF last Tuesday. He's second in the league with a .413 batting average and tops the conference with 31 hits. Reliever **Justin Baker** tossed 2.0 shutout innings on Sunday at Nebraska, dropping his season ERA to 1.42 in nine appearances. CofC opens an eight-game homestand this week against nationally ranked Clemson before hosting CAA foe Hofstra.

DELAWARE (11-7)

The Blue Hens went 3-1 last week, including a three-game weekend sweep of Big Ten member Penn State. UD out-scored PSU 19-1 in recording a sweep of a Power 5 foe for the first time since 2001. The Blue Hens' pitching was outstanding as they posted back-to-back shutouts for the first time since 2013. Lefty **Brandon Walter** allowed just one hit over 8.0 scoreless innings and struck out a career-high 17 in the opener. In Saturday's nightcap, **Nick Spadafino** and **Matt Hornich** combined on a 3-hit shutout. **Kevin Milley** continued the dominance on Sunday, giving up three hits over 7.0 shutout frames and fanning a career-best nine. Offensively, **Kevin Mohollen** batted .500 (7-14) with five RBI's, and **Doug Trimble** batted .412 with three doubles and a homer while extending his hitting streak to 14 games. **Diaz Nardo** hit .545 with four doubles and five runs, and **Jordan Glover** upped his RBI total to 20 after a grand slam on Sunday.

ELON (9-11)

The Phoenix split four games last week, rebounding from a setback to NC State by winning two-of-three from VMI. Shortstop Ryne Ogren batted .556 (10-18) with four doubles last week, including seven hits in the final two games vs. the Keydets. He's riding an 8-game hitting streak and is batting .500 during that stretch. James Venuto was 3-for-4 with a homer and four RBI's in Sunday's win and 2-for-4 with two RBI's in Friday's triumph over VMI. Kyle Jackson hit a game-winning solo homer in the 8th vs. VMI on Friday. On the mound, Ryan Conroy (3-0) threw his first career complete game on Friday, limiting VMI to five hits and one earned run while matching his career-high with nine strikeouts. On Sunday, freshman Kyle Brnovich earned his first career win after giving up just one run on three hits over 6.0 innings and fanning a career-high tying nine. He retired the first 10 batters he faced in the game.

HOFSTRA (4-14)

The Pride lost three games by a total of four runs in a weekend series with UAlbany in Salem, Va. after getting snowed out of its regularly scheduled contests. **Steven Foster** batted .583 (7-12) in the series with two doubles, a triple and four runs scored. He also stole two bases. **Vinnie Costello** hit .375 with a homer and **Nick Bottari** batted .333 and drove in three. Hofstra's pitching staff held UAlbany to a .218 batting average and struck out 25 in 23.2 innings. **John Rooney** fanned seven on Sunday and became the 2nd-fastest in school history to reach 100 career strikeouts, reaching the mark in 100 innings. **Jorge Marrero** held the Danes to one earned run on three hits over 6.0 innings on Saturday.

JAMES MADISON (14-4)

The Dukes scored 48 runs and took three-of-four from NJIT over the weekend. **Brett Johnson** led the JMU offense, batting .438 (7-16) with two homers and nine RBI's. He had a game-tying two-run shot on Friday and another two-run

blast on Sunday and leads the CAA in both homers (8) and RBI's (26) for the year. **Adam Sisk** drove in five runs on Friday, had a game-winning 2-run double on Saturday and went 3-for-3 on Sunday. He's batting a team-best .412 with 20 RBI's and is 11-for-11 on stolen bases. Freshman **Fox Semones** batted .538 (7-13) with four RBI's in the NJIT series in the first significant action of his career. Pitcher **Brandon Withers** moved to 4-0 with a victory over NJIT on Friday. **Christian Bourne** didn't allow an earned run over 3.0 innings to get a save on Friday and tossed 2.0 shutout frames on Sunday.

UNCW (8-9)

The Seahawks swept a three-game weekend series from VCU, out-scoring the Rams 25-9. The Seahawks batted .362 while holding VCU to a .226 clip. **Casey Golden** batted .500 (7-14) with seven RBl's in the series, including a home run in each game. He's riding an 8-game hitting streak and has gone deep in four straight contests. **Brian Mims**, who has a 9-game hitting streak, was 3-for-5 on Saturday. **Kennard McDowell** was 3-for-4 with three RBl's in Sunday's win, while **Nick Feight** smacked his fifth homer. Five UNCW pitchers combined for 8.0 shutout frames on Sunday. **Luke Gesell** allowed only three hits over the first four innings in his second career start. The Seahawks gave up just three extra base hits in the series and posted a 3.00 team ERA.

NORTHEASTERN (7-10)

The Huskies edged Cincinnati 6-3 in 12 innings last Saturday to open a 3-game series but dropped the final two contests. Five NU players had two hits in the Game 1 win. **Scott Holzwasser** was 2-for-4 with three RBI's, including a 2-run single in the 12th. Starter **Mike Fitzgerald** gave up just one earned run over the first 7.0 innings, **Brian Rodriguez** (2-0) followed with 4.0 shutout frames to get the win and **Tyler Robinson** closed the 12th to get his third save. **Cam Hanley** hit his first homer of the year - a two-run shot - for NU's only runs in a 4-2 set-back on Sunday. The Huskies play their first home game of the season against Boston College on Tuesday before starting CAA play at Elon.

TOWSON (8-5)

The Tigers were forced to move games to Norfolk, Va. due to snow and suffered neutral site setbacks to UMass Lowell (10-8) and Iona (3-1). **A.J. Gallo** and **Logan Burke** both had a pair of hits against UML, while **Jay Sanford** provided a 3-run double that gave Towson a 5-4 lead in the second. **Colin Dyer** had two of the Tigers' four hits against Iona. Starter **Kevin Ross** held Iona to two hits over 5.2 shutout innings, but didn't get a decision. The effort dropped Ross' ERA for the season to 2.14. The Tigers lead the CAA in team ERA (3.57) and have three hurlers in the top six in individual ERA. TU has a challenging week ahead with two games at Virginia followed by a 3-game weekend series at East Carolina.

WILLIAM & MARY (11-7)

The Tribe capped a 2-1 week with back-to-back victories over Rhode Island. Ryan Hall batted .571 (8-14) for the week with five runs scored and four RBI's. He was a perfect 5-for-5 and drove in a pair in Friday's 11-2 victory. Hunter Smith was 3-for-6 with five RBI's against the Rams, while Cullen Large was 5-for-9 vs. URI to raise his season-best average to .400. Freshman Brandon Raquet also had four RBI's in the URI series. On the mound, sophomore Bodie Sheehan improved to 4-1 after allowing just one run on four hits over 6.2 innings and tying his career-high with 11 strikeouts on Saturday. Nick Brown (2-1) also threw well on Friday, giving up one run on four hits over 6.0 frames. Robert White recorded his league-leading fourth save.
