CAA BASEBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Nick Feight, UNCW

Jr., DH/C, Gainesville, Va./Battlefield

Feight batted .381 (8-for-21) with four homers, a double, nine runs scored and nine RBI's in UNCW's 3-2 week. The junior catcher homered in the Seahawks' final four games, including all three in UNCW's series victory over William & Mary. Feight, who recorded multiple hits and multiple RBI's three times last week, has now reached base safely in 16 consecutive games. He's tied for the CAA lead in homers with nine.

CAA BASEBALL PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

Daniel Powers, William & Mary

Sr., RHP, Vienna, Va./James Madison

Powers picked up a win and his first career save while not allowing a run in 7.2 innings of work last week. The senior right-hander gave up just four hits over 7.0 shutout innings and struck out a career-high 11 in the Tribe's 7-0 victory over VMI last Wednesday. He also recorded the final two outs, including a game-ending strikeout, to help W&M secure a 10-9 victory over UNCW on Sunday.

CAA BASEBALL ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Joe Satterfield, Elon

Fr., IF, Greenville, S.C./J.L. Mann

Satterfield batted .438 (7-for-16) with two homers, a double, eight runs scored and three RBI's in Elon's 2-2 week. The freshman infielder went 2-for-3 and scored twice from the leadoff spot in Sunday's victory over Northeastern, including a solo homer in the 7th inning that snapped a 0-0 tie. He extended his hitting streak to seven games last week, which includes four multiple-hit contests. Satterfield leads Elon with a .377 average.

DIAMOND NOTES:

COL. OF CHARLESTON (10-14, 2-1 in CAA)

The Cougars ended a seven-game slide with a pair of victories over Hofstra in their opening CAA series. CofC's pitching staff allowed just five runs in three games with the Pride. Freshman **Jakob Frishmuth** threw 6.2 shutout innings to earn his first career win in Saturday's 12-1 triumph, while **Evan Sisk** (2-0) gave up just one run in 5.0 innings of relief in Sunday's 4-2 victory. In Friday's 2-1 setback, **Nathan Ocker** fanned a career-high nine batters over 6.0 innings in his first start of the year. **Erven Roper** batted .438 (7-16) with three doubles, a homer, and four RBI's last week. **Dupree Hart** went 2-for-3 with four RBI's in Saturday's victory. **Bradley Dixon** drove in the game-tying and game-winning runs in consecutive at-bats against Hofstra on Sunday.

DELAWARE (12-9, 1-2 in CAA)

The Blue Hens rebounded for a 10-2 victory over James Madison on Sunday to take the finale of their 3-game series. **Kevin Milley** improved to 3-0 after giving up one earned run and four hits over 6.0 innings. **Burk FitzPatrick** didn't allow a hit and fanned three over the final 3.0 frames to earn his first save. **Jordan Glover** and **Doug Trimble** each went 2-for-5 with a homer on Sunday and **Calvin Scott** drove in a pair of runs. Trimble extended his hitting streak to 17 games and leads the CAA with a .407 average. **Nick Tierno** batted .583 (7-12) in the series, including back-to-back 3-for-5 efforts on Friday and Saturday. **Diaz Nardo** is riding an 8-game hitting streak and has reached base in 14 straight contests. The Blue Hens have recorded 10 or more hits 12 times this season.

ELON (11-13, 2-1 in CAA)

The Phoenix went 2-2 at home last week, falling to #25 East Carolina before winning their opening CAA series over Northeastern. Freshman **Kyle Brnovich** (6.2 IP, 3 H, 6 K's) and relievers **Derek Pike** and **Danny Crowe** combined on a 4-hit shutout as Elon beat NU, 6-0, on Sunday. In Saturday's 11-6 triumph, **George Kirby** gave up just one run over the final 4.1 innings and fanned five. Offensively, outfielder **Kyle Jackson** batted .533 (8-15) with two doubles, a homer, four runs scored and six RBI's for the week. He was 3-for-3 with three RBI's in Saturday's victory over NU and had a career-high four hits vs. ECU. Freshman **Joe Satterfield** batted .438 (7-16) with two homers and eight runs scored. His solo shot in the 7th on Sunday snapped a 0-0 tie, and **Hayden Platt** added a grand slam in the 8th. **Shawn Blake** drove in four on Saturday.

HOFSTRA (6-16, 1-2 in CAA)

The Pride split four road games last week, picking up one-run victories over NYIT (6-5) and College of Charleston (2-1). **Teddy Cillis** didn't allow an earned run over 6.0 innings of work and struck out eight at CofC last Friday, and **Chris Weiss** followed with 3.0 shutout frames and five strikeouts to earn the win. **Mikey Riesner** drove in the game-winning run with a 9th-inning single. Hofstra also won in dramatic fashion at NYIT as **Steven Foster** smacked a deciding two-run homer in the eighth. Freshman **John Ryan** tossed 3.0 perfect innings at NYIT to get his first career victory and gave up just one run over 2.1 innings at CofC on Sunday. **Brad Witkowski** broke out of an offensive slump by batting .583 (7-for-12) last week. **Seamus Brazill** threw 3.1 hitless frames on Saturday.

JAMES MADISON (16-6, 2-1 in CAA)

The Dukes won two-of-three over CAA foe Delaware to cap a 2-2 week. **Bradley McKay** went 2-for-4 with a homer and five RBI's as JMU beat the Hens 12-8 in Friday's opener. **Brandon Withers** got the win to become the first CAA pitcher to go 5-0 and **Kevin Kelly** struck out seven over the final four frames to

record his first save. JMU rallied for a 6-5 victory on Saturday as **Josh Wyatt** hit a game-tying homer in the 8th and freshman **Fox Semones** belted a walk-off homer to lead off the ninth. Semones was 5-for-9 in the two wins over UD. **Brett Johnson** batted .400 in the UD series and hit his career-best 9th homer. Closer **Michael Evans** threw a scoreless ninth on Saturday and earned the win. He's 2-0 with three saves and a 2.45 ERA for the season.

UNCW (11-11, 2-1 in CAA)

The Seahawks went 3-2 in a busy five-game week, splitting a series with Maryland before taking two-of-three from William & Mary. **Nick Feight** led a UNCW offense that plated 42 runs by batting .381 with four homers and nine RBI's. He's tied for the CAA lead with 9 HR's and now ranks 5th on UNCW's career long ball list with 31. **Ryan Jeffers** homered and drove in five in a 10-9 setback to W&M on Sunday. **Casey Golden** extended his career-best hitting streak to 13, while **Brian Mims** had his hit streak halted at 13, but pushed his on-base streak to 17 games. **Alex Royalty** (3-1) limited W&M to a run on four hits over 6.0 innings and tied a career high seven strikeouts in Friday's 11-1 triumph. Freshman **Chris Joyner** gave up just one hit over 4.2 innings in three relief appearances last week. **Daniel Stack** had a game-tying 3-run double in the 8th on Saturday and **Cole Weiss** drove in the game-winning run in the 9th.

NORTHEASTERN (8-13, 1-2 in CAA)

The Huskies dropped three-of-four last week, but earned a 9-2 victory at Elon on Friday to open CAA play. Senior **Mike Fitzgerald** (2-1) held Elon to one run on four hits over 6.1 innings and struck out five to get the win. **Cam Hanley** paced the NU offense by going 3-for-5 with a homer, three runs scored and two RBI's in the victory. Freshman **Tom Githens** allowed just one run during a span of 6.1 innings over two relief appearances last week. Starter **Brian Christian** surrendered only one hit over 5.0 shutout frames in Sunday's 6-0 setback at Elon. **Mason Koppens** and **Pat Madigan** each drove in two as an NU rally fell short in a 10-7 setback to Boston College in the Huskies' home opener last Wednesday. Madigan also homered at Elon on Saturday.

TOWSON (8-10, 0-0 in CAA)

The Tigers came up short in a difficult five-game road swing last week, falling twice at #16 Virginia and three times at #25 East Carolina. Third baseman **Richard Miller** had a strong series at ECU, batting .455 (5-for-11) with a homer, three runs scored and five RBI's. The effort raised his batting average to a team-best .313 for the season. On the mound, **Michael Adams** held Virginia to three runs on seven hits over 6.1 innings last Tuesday, but took the loss in a narrow 3-2 setback. Starter **Kevin Ross** limited ECU to one run on two hits during 5.1 innings of work on Saturday. The Tigers are at home for four of their five games this week, including their opening CAA series against Northeastern.

WILLIAM & MARY (13-10, 1-2 in CAA)

The Tribe went 2-3 last week, blanking VMI 7-0 last Wednesday before winning Sunday's CAA series finale at UNCW, 10-9. Four players drove in a pair of runs at UNCW on Sunday, with **Ryder Miconi** and **Kyle Wrighte** each going 2-for-4 with a homer with two RBI's. Outfielder **Ryan Hall** batted .350 (7-20) for the week with four doubles, six runs scored and four RBI's. He was 3-for-5 in the victory over VMI. Senior **Daniel Powers** held the Keydets to four hits over 7.0 shutout innings and struck out a career-high 11. He also picked up his first career save at UNCW on Sunday by recording the final two outs. **Bodie Sheehan** (4-1) turned in another solid start at UNCW on Saturday, giving up three runs over 8.0 innings and fanning seven. Head coach **Brian Murphy** recorded his 100th career win on Sunday.
