Miller batted .500 (10-for-20) with two doubles, a homer, six runs scored and 10 RBI's in Towson's 3-2 week. The sophomore third baseman came up big in all three victories, going 3-for-5 against George Mason, 3-for-4 with three runs and two RBI's in the opener vs. Hofstra and 2-for-3 with a career-high five RBI's against the Pride on Saturday.

CAA BASEBALL PITCHERS OF THE WEEK:

Alex Royalty, UNCW

Royalty surrendered just three hits over 8.0 shutout innings and struck out a career-high 12 batters with no walks in UNCW's 3-0 win over N.C. Central on Friday. The sophomore (4-2) retired the first 10 batters of the game and posted the most K's by a Seahawks' pitcher since 2014.

Brandon Walter, Delaware

So., LHP, New Castle, Del./Hodgson Vo-Tech
Walter gave up just one run over 8.0 innings and struck out 11 as Delaware edged Northeastern, 2-1, on Friday. The sophomore lefty (3-5) scattered eight hits and walked only one to lower his ERA to 3.75 for the year. He leads the CAA with 60 K's.

CAA BASEBALL ROOKIES OF THE WEEK:

Kyle Brnovich, Elon

Fr., RHP, Milton, Ga./Kings Ridge Christian
Brnovich struck out a career-high 15 batters in 8.1 innings to lead Elon past William & Mary, 7-6, on Sunday. The freshman right-hander allowed just four hits and one run over the first eight frames before the Tribe rallied in the ninth. The strikeout total was the highest for an Elon pitcher since 2007.

Brandon Raquet, William & Mary

Fr., OF, Boalsburg, Pa./State College
Raquet batted .692 (9-for-13) with two doubles, a triple, five runs scored and three RBI's in William & Mary's 3-1 week. He went 7-for-8 in the Tribe's series win over Elon, including a 3-for-4 effort with two runs scored in a victory on Friday and a 3-for-3 outing with a double, triple, two runs and three RBI's in Saturday's triumph.

DIAMOND NOTES:

COL. OF CHARLESTON (16-16, 7-2 in CAA)

The Cougars took over sole possession of first place in the CAA after a pair of victories at JMU highlighted a 3-1 week on the road. CofC's offense piled up 45 runs in the four games. **Bradley Dixon** batted .467 with two doubles, seven runs scored and four RBI's. Freshman **Ari Sechopoulos** homered twice and drove in nine last week, including a grand slam at North Florida and a go-ahead 3-run shot in Saturday's 8-4 win at JMU. **Erven Roper** had a three-run triple and tied his career-high of four RBI's in Sunday's 12-11 victory. **Carter Love** didn't allow a hit over the final 3.0 innings to earn his second save at JMU on Sunday. **Evan Sisk** upped his record to 4-0 on Saturday after giving up three earned runs over 8.2 frames.

DELAWARE (16-14, 4-5 in CAA)

The Blue Hens suffered a pair of one-run setbacks in a 1-4 week. UD edged Northeastern 2-1 on Friday behind an excellent pitching effort from **Brandon Walter** (3-5), who held the Huskies to one run on eight hits while striking out 11. He leads the CAA with 60 K's for the year. **James Meeker** tossed 3.2 shutout frames out of the bullpen in Sunday's 3-2 loss at NU. **Ron Marinaccio** struck out the side in the ninth to earn his second save on Friday at NU. Offensively, **Doug Trimble** recorded three multi-hit games last week and leads the CAA with a .393 batting average. **Diaz Nardo** extended his on-base streak to 22 games last week, but **Nick Tierno** had an 11-game hitting streak snapped on Sunday.

ELON (16-16, 6-3 in CAA)

The Phoenix dropped three-of-four last week, but picked up a 7-6 victory at William & Mary on Sunday to stay within a game of the lead in the CAA standings. Freshman pitcher **Kyle Brnovich** (3-2) fanned a career-high 15 batters over 8.1 innings to get the win. He allowed just four hits and one run over the first eight frames and is now 3-0 with a 1.20 ERA over his last four starts. Brnovich was named a National Player of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball*. **Ryne Ogren** went 5-for-9 over the final two games at W&M and ranks second in the CAA with a .380 batting average. He tops the league in hits (49) and doubles (14). **Kyle Jackson** was 5-for-12 at W&M and is hitting .342 with a team-high 30 RBI's for the year. **Zach Evers** drove in four runs over the final two games.

HOFSTRA (8-21, 2-4 in CAA)

The Pride topped Towson 11-5 on Sunday to close out a 1-3 week. **Vito Friscia** went 2-for-4 with a double, homer, three runs scored and three RBI's in the victory. Friscia, who reached base safely in all four games last week, batted .429, drove in five runs and scored five times. Also chipping in offensively were **Nick Bottari** (.385) and **Mikey Riesner** (.357), who each hit home runs. On the mound, **John Rooney** struck out eight over 6.0 innings to get the win vs. Towson and **John Ryan** closed the game with three scoreless frames to earn his first save. **Matt Weissheier** gave up just two hits and no runs over 5.2 innings in a pair of relief appearances last week.

JAMES MADISON (17-13, 3-6 in CAA)

The Dukes went 1-3 in a week that featured three one-run games. JMU edged first-place Charleston, 6-5, in Friday's series opener on **Mike Sciorra's** walk-off solo homer in the 12th. The Dukes' bullpen contributed 5.2 shutout innings in the victory, with **Michael Evans** striking out seven over three frames. Evans added 2.0 shutout innings on Sunday to lower his season ERA to 2.45. He has 28 strikeouts in 18.1 innings. JMU nearly overcame an 11-2 deficit on Sunday before falling 12-11. **Ky Parrott** was 2-for-5 with a double, homer and four RBI's

in the series finale. Freshman **Fox Semones** was 3-for-5 with a pair of runs scored on Sunday and leads the Dukes with a .387 batting average. **Adam Sisk** is a perfect 14-for-14 on stolen bases, which leads the CAA.

UNCW (13-17, 2-4 in CAA)

The Seahawks split four games last week, including a weekend series win over N.C. Central. Pitcher **Alex Royalty** allowed just three hits over 8.0 shutout innings and struck out a career-high 12 in Friday's 3-0 win over NCCU. It was the most strikeouts for a Seahawks' pitcher since 2014. UNCW rolled past NCCU 16-8 on Sunday for their first road victory of the year. **Brian Mims** was 3-for-6 with a homer and three runs scored and **Ryan Jeffers** doubled twice and drove in three. Pitcher **Zarion Sharpe** recorded his first collegiate victory after giving up two runs over the first 5.0 innings. **Kennard McDowell** went 6-for-10 in the NCCU series as UNCW batted .321 as a team. Freshman **Riley Zayicek** homered in back-to-back games over the weekend.

NORTHEASTERN (13-16, 6-3 in CAA)

The Huskies moved into a tie for second place in the CAA after taking the final two games of their series with Delaware. **Cam Hanley's** solo homer in the fifth was the difference in NU's 3-2 victory over the Hens on Sunday. Pitcher **Brian Christian** improved to 4-0 after throwing the first five frames and **Kyle Murphy** and **Tyler Robinson** didn't allow a hit over the final 4.0 innings. Robinson recorded his CAA-best fifth save. **Jimmy Hand** provided a two-run triple in Saturday's 7-4 victory over UD. Pitcher **Mike Fitzgerald** limited the Hens to one run over 6.0 innings and struck out seven on Friday, but didn't get a decision in a 2-1 loss. Fitzgerald (3-1) lowered his ERA to 3.75 and has fanned 46 in 48 innings this season. NU hosts first-place College of Charleston this weekend.

TOWSON (12-16, 2-4 in CAA)

The Tigers picked up a pair of CAA road wins at Hofstra to cap a 3-2 week. Towson scored 55 runs last week, including tallying 10+ runs in four straight games for the first time since 2010. **Richard Miller** led the onslaught, batting .500 (10-20) with two doubles, a homer, six runs scored and 10 RBI's. He had a pair of three-hit efforts and posted a career-best five RBI's in Saturday's 12-6 win over HU. **Richie Palacios** hit .435 with three doubles, a homer and nine runs scored last week. **Dean Stramara** (2-3) held the Pride to two runs on six hits over a career-long 8.0 innings and struck out six in Friday's 10-2 triumph. **David Mariggi** tossed 4.0 no-hit innings in a start vs. George Mason and then threw 1.2 shutout frames and recorded his third save at Hofstra on Saturday.

WILLIAM & MARY (18-14, 4-5 in CAA)

The Tribe went 3-1 last week, which included a series victory over CAA foe Elon. Freshman **Brandon Raquet** batted .692 (9-13) with two doubles, a triple, five runs scored and three RBI's. He was 7-for-8 in the Elon series with a pair of three-hit games in the Tribe's two wins. **Ryder Miconi** had two hits in all three games against the Phoenix and batted .500 (7-14) with four runs and three RBI's for the week. On the mound, **Daniel Powers** evened his record at 3-3 after giving up two runs on five hits over 8.0 innings and fanning seven in an 8-2 win over Elon on Friday. **Nick Raquet** lowered his league-best ERA to 1.98 by holding Elon to one run and striking out eight in 7.0 innings on Sunday. Six pitchers combined to limit VCU to three hits in a 5-1 victory last Tuesday.
