Do-it-all midfielder Tyler Young had himself a day on Senior Day as he went a perfect 4-for-4 in the No. 16 Tigers' 10-8 win over No. 9 Hofstra. Young, who plays offense, defense and lines up on the wings for draws, had his first career hat trick with a four-goal day on just four shots. He added a pair of ground balls on the faceoff, helping Towson go 14-of-22 as the Tigers locked up the No. 1 seed in the upcoming #CAACHamps.

During his first collegiate start, freshman Jesse Leung tallied a career-high five goals on only six shot attempts in the 14-8 win over Drexel. Leung scored at least once in each quarter, with two posted in the second to net the hat trick before reaching halftime. Leung tallied the first UMass goal of the day, evened the game at 4-4 with his first of the second quarter and put the Minutemen up for good, 6-5, with his third of the half. He later pushed the lead to 11-5 in the third and potted his fifth with the final goal of the game. Leung also notched a career-high four ground balls. His five goals were more than Leung had during the entirety of the season entering the game (4). He has scored all nine of his goals on the year during CAA play.

## #CAALAX ROUNDUP

- **Drexel 8, UMASS 14:** Jesse Leung scored a career high five goals, the most by a Minuteman in one game this season as UMass downed Drexel, 14-8, to secure the No. 3 seed. Leung scored on five of his six shots and scooped up four ground balls. **D.J. Smith** totaled 15 saves in between the pipes, including 11 during the second half when UMass held Drexel scoreless into the final quarter. **Marshal King** and **Jake O'Donnell** each had three points for Drexel. **Jimmy Joe Granito's** string of seven straight games with at least 10 saves was broken as he made seven stops on Friday night.
- **Delaware 7, FAIRFIELD 11:** The Stags capped off the 2017 campaign on Friday evening with an 11-7 Senior Night victory over visiting Delaware. **Colin Burke** racked up a season-best six points for the Stags – eclipsing the 100-point mark in the process – and **Dylan Beckwith** netted a hat trick that included the game-winner. In the cage, **Tyler Behring** posted his third straight double-digit save outing to cap his season and collegiate career. Delaware finishes the year at 7-8 overall and 0-5 in the CAA in the final season for 39-year Head Coach **Bob Shillinglaw**. The Blue Hens were led by a **Joe Eisele** hat trick and four assists from **Andrew Romagnoli**. **Matt DeLuca** made 11 saves for the visitors.
- **Hofstra 8, TOWSON 10:** The 16th ranked Tigers upended No. 9 Hofstra, 10-8, at Johnny Unitas Stadium, to secure the CAA Regular Season Championship and top seed in the tournament. The Tigers put up 15 points in the game on 10 goals and five assists, with all 15 of those points coming from the Class of 2017. **Tyler Young** had a career afternoon with four goals while **Joe Seider** had a hat trick as well. Towson controlled the faceoff X all day as **Alex Woodall** won 14 of his 22 chances. **Dylan Alderman** led the way for the Pride with three goals and an assist.

## IN THE RPI

- As of May 1, the CAA is rated third as a league in the NCAA RPI.
- Three teams were rated in the top-25: Towson (11), Hofstra (13) and UMass (25).

## IN THE POLLS

- **Maverik Media Poll:** Hofstra fell out of the top-10 for the first time since March 6, coming in at No. 14. Towson jumped up six spots to No. 13.
- **USILA/Nike Coaches Poll:** Towson moved up for spots to No. 12 while Hofstra dropped out of the top-10 to No. 14.
- **Nike/US Lacrosse Top-20:** Hofstra and Towson traded places. The Pride moved down to No. 12 while Towson cracked the top-10 for the first time this season, coming in at No. 9.
- Towson has played 32 consecutive games as a ranked program, the longest such streak under Head Coach Shawn Nadeln and the longest run since 41 games from 2001-March 21, 2004 (excluding preseason polls).
- Hofstra's No. 2 ranking in the USILA Poll on April 10 was its highest since 2006 when they were rated as the second best team in the nation for the final six weeks of the season. It was the highest ranking for a CAA team since 2012 when Penn State earned the No. 1.

## TEWAARATON AWARD NOMINEES

- Hofstra goalie **Jack Concannon** and attack **Josh Byrne** are two of the top-25 nominees for the Tewaaraton Award.
- Concannon and Byrne were two of six CAA men's lacrosse players that were named to the Tewaaraton Watch List.
- Towson had short stick defensive midfielder **Jack Adams**, faceoff specialist **Alex Woodall** and attack **Ryan Drenner** earn the honor while Fairfield's **Colin Burke** listed among the top-50 contenders for the prestigious award.

## #CAALAX QUICK HITS

- After the win over No. 15 Towson, Fairfield has defeated at least one nationally-ranked opponent (USILA) in eight of **Andy Copelan's** nine seasons as head coach.
- Towson is the only team in the CAA to hold all five opponents to single digits in 2017.
- Tigers **Joe Seider** and **Ryan Drenner** are the only 100-point duo in the CAA.
- Hofstra's **Josh Byrne** has recorded four or more points 10 times and has five or more points in eight games of 13 games this season. Nationally, Byrne is ranked tenth in goals per game (2.77) and 13th in points per game (4.96).
- Hofstra is in ranked in the top-20 in nine national statistical categories. Namely, the Pride is eighth in clearing percentage (.900) and third in fewest turnovers per game (10.62). The Pride is 12th in scoring defense (8.46) and 16th in man-up offense, connecting 41.5 percent of the time.
- Hofstra goalie **Jack Concannon** is fifth in save percentage (.581), 16th in saves per game (11.54) and 13th in GAA (8.47). Drexel's **Jimmy Joe Granito** is seventh in saves per game (12.23).
- Towson's **Tyler Mayes** tied a CAA single game record with six caused turnovers at Drexel on April 1. He's the first player since 2009 to reach that mark. Mayes is currently ranked fourth in the nation in caused turnovers per (2.75).
- UMass faceoff specialist **Noah Rak** is 11th in the nation with a .609 faceoff percentage. Towson's **Alex Woodall** is 13th at .603.
- UMass sophomore **Isaac Paparo** is seventh with 2.08 caused turnovers per game.
- As a league, the CAA went 28-22 in non-conference play. Nine of those wins came against opponents receiving recognition in the national polls.

## MOVING ON UP

- Senior **Josh Byrne** recorded his 100th career point in just two seasons with the Pride on April 22.
- Towson senior **Joe Seider** became the tenth player in CAA history to score 100 career goals, doing so against Johns Hopkins on March 11. With 114 goals, Seider stands fifth all-time in CAA history.
- Drexel's **Cole Shafer** became the 11th CAA player to hit the century mark in goals doing so against Saint Joseph's. With 118 goals, Shafer stands fourth all-time in CAA history. With 160 points, he is tied for ninth all-time.
- Towson's **Ryan Drenner** is seventh all-time in assists with 71. Drenner is tied for 11th all-time in CAA history with 156 career points.
- Fairfield sophomore **Colin Burke** eclipsed the 100 point mark in the season finale against Delaware. In his young career, Burke has tallied 104 points on 72 goals and 32 assists.

## GOING STREAKING

- Towson senior **Ryan Drenner** has registered a point in 25 consecutive games for the Tigers.
- UD sophomore **Andrew Romagnoli** has now registered a point in 19 straight games.
- Senior **Josh Byrne** has scored a goal in nine straight games and has notched a point in 18 straight games.
- Fairfield sophomore **Colin Burke** had his streak of 26 consecutive games with at least one point snapped against Hofstra on April 1. It is the first time in Burke's career in which he did not record a point.

## FAREWELL, COACH

- Delaware Head Coach **Bob Shillinglaw** coached in his final game on April 28 at Fairfield. Shillinglaw announced that the 2017 season will be his final one at the helm of the Blue Hens.
- Shillinglaw has been on the sidelines for more than 600 games in his career, compiling 334 wins, including 310 at UD, and leading the Blue Hens to 16 conference championships, and six NCAA Tournament appearances.

## CAA TEAMS TO HOST NCAA EVENTS

- The road to Gillette runs through Delaware and Hofstra as both institutions were selected to host the quarterfinals of the 2017 NCAA Men's Lacrosse Championship, May 20-21.
- Future sites were also announced by the NCAA.
- Drexel has been selected to host the 2019 and 2020 NCAA Division I, II, and III Men's Lacrosse Championships at Lincoln Financial Field.
- Fairfield will host the 2021 and 2022 NCAA Men's Lacrosse Championships at the 38,000-seat Rentschler Field in East Hartford, Conn. Fairfield will also host the 2019 NCAA Division I Men's Lacrosse Quarterfinals at Rentschler Field.
- Hofstra will each host the 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2022 NCAA Men's Lacrosse Quarterfinals on campus at James Shuart Stadium.

## USILA/BSN SPORTS NATIONAL DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Delaware rookie **Matt DeLuca** was named the USILA/BSN Sports National Defensive Player of the Week on March 29. DeLuca, who also earned CAA Rookie of the Week honors that same week, was brilliant in the net and played a key part in Delaware's upset of No. 1 Rutgers. DeLuca turned back a career-high 19 shots against the Scarlet Knights, the highest save total by a UD netminder since Tommy Scherr had 19 vs. Lehigh in 2008.

## USILA/BSN SPORTS NATIONAL OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Drexel freshman **Reid Bowering** was named the USILA/BSN Sports National Offensive Player of the Week on April 19 after powering the Dragons to an upset of the previously undefeated No. 2 Hofstra Pride. Bowering had career-highs of five goals and seven points in Drexel's come-from-behind win at No. 2 Hofstra. Three of his five goals came during the Dragons' fourth-quarter comeback. His most crucial point of the day came with 1:02 left in regulation as he set up Jake O'Donnell's game-winner. Bowering also added four ground balls.

## FOUR NAMED AS INSIDE LACROSSE MID-SEASON ALL-AMERICANS

- Four players from the CAA were named as Inside Lacrosse Midseason All-Americans.
- Towson short stick defensive midfielder **Zach Goodrich** landed a spot on the First Team
- Three from Hofstra were on the Second Team: senior attackman **Josh Byrne**, junior defender **Brett Osman** and goalie **Jack Concannon**.

## NO. 1 AND NO. 2 STUNNERS

- Delaware recorded its first-ever win over an opponent ranked no. 1 in the nation with a 13-9 decision over Rutgers on March 25. Delaware's win over then No. 2 Virginia in the first round of the NCAA Tournament in 2007 was the previous highest-ranked opponent UD ever defeated.
- The last CAA team to knock off a No. 1 opponent was Hofstra when they topped Johns Hopkins, 8-7, on March 8, 2008.
- Drexel's win over No. 2 Hofstra on April 15 was only the second time in program history that the Dragons defeated a team ranked as high as number two in the nation. Drexel upset No. 1 Virginia back in 2007.

## PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- Towson was picked to three-peat as CAA champions in 2017, receiving 25 points and five first place votes. Fairfield was picked to finish second in the poll with 21 points and was followed by Hofstra (15) in third and Drexel (11) in fourth. Rounding out the order of finish was the University of Delaware (10) in fifth and the UMass (8) in sixth.
- Fairfield sophomore **Colin Burke** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year.

## PRESEASON RANKINGS/AWARDS

- Towson was ranked 12th in the Maverik/Inside Lacrosse Preseason Media Poll while Hofstra and Fairfield received votes.
- In the Nike/USILA Coaches Poll, Towson checked in at No. 12 while Fairfield was No. 20.
- In the Nike/US Lacrosse Top-20, Towson was 14th while Fairfield received votes.
- Seven CAA men's lacrosse players picked up Inside Lacrosse Faceoff Yearbook Preseason All-America honors. Towson short stick defensive midfielder **Jack Adams** was named to the Second Team while Fairfield attackman **Colin Burke** and Hofstra goalie **Jack Concannon** landed spots on the Third Team. Towson's **Joe Seider** and **Ryan Drenner** and Fairfield's **Andrew Eidenshink** and **Tyler Behring** earned Honorable Mention.
