CAA BASEBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Nick Patten, Delaware

So., 1B, Butler, Pa./IMG Academy (Fla.)

Patten batted .667 (8-for-12) with two doubles, a triple, two homers, six runs scored and nine RBI's as Delaware took two-of-three from Charleston last week. The sophomore became just the fourth player in UD history to hit for the cycle in Thursday's 17-4 victory, going 5-for-5 with a pair of homers and seven RBI's. Patten tallied at least one hit, one run and one RBI in all three contests, and leads the Hens with 13 homers and 45 RBI's for the season. He was also named National Player of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball*.

CAA BASEBALL PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

Alex Royalty, UNCW

So., RHP, Raleigh, N.C./Millbrook

Royalty allowed just four hits over 8.0 shutout innings in UNCW's 8-0 victory at Towson last Thursday. The sophomore right-hander, who matched the longest outing of his career, struck out eight and didn't issue a walk to improve to 8-2 on the season. In his last seven starts spanning 50.2 innings, Royalty has struck out 61 and walked only seven.

CAA BASEBALL ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Rob Weissheier, Hofstra

Weissheier batted .417 (5-for-12) with two homers, three runs scored and six RBI's in Hofstra's three games last week. The freshman first baseman went 3-for-5 with a two-run homer in a 5-4 setback to William & Mary in the series opener and provided all of the Pride's offense with a three-run homer in a 5-3 loss in the finale. Weissheier contributed a hit, run and RBI in all three contests.

DIAMOND NOTES:**COL. OF CHARLESTON (26-29, 13-11 in CAA)**

The Cougars went 2-2 last week, beating local rival Charleston Southern, 9-5, before taking the series finale at Delaware, 11-7. **Tommy Richter** went 4-for-6 with a double, homer and five RBI's in the win over the Hens. He currently leads the CAA with a .368 batting average. **Danny Wondrack** also had a big game, going 3-for-5 with three RBI's. Wondrack and freshman **Ari Sechopoulos** each homered in the victory over CSU, while **Logan McRae** was 4-for-4 with two RBI's to increase his league-leading total to 58. **Dupree Hart** had two hits in three of the Cougars' four games last week and finished with four RBI's. CofC will be the #5 seed in the CAA Tournament and faces Delaware in the opening game of the event.

DELAWARE (30-21, 15-9 in CAA)

The Blue Hens won two-of-three over Charleston and will be the #4 seed for the CAA Tournament. **Nick Patten** had a huge week offensively, batting .667 (8-12) with nine RBI's. He was 5-for-5, homered twice and became the fourth player in UD history to hit for the cycle in Thursday's 17-4 win. **Kevin Mohollen** was 4-for-5 with two doubles, a homer, three runs scored and four RBI's in the victory. **Jordan Glover** went 3-for-4 with a homer and two RBI's in Friday's 6-1 triumph and was 2-for-5 on Saturday. **Nick Spadafino** let up one run over the first 5.0 innings and improved to 6-3, while **Burk FitzPatrick** closed with 4.0 shutout frames to earn his fifth save. **Calvin Scott** recorded three hits in the finale and will take a 21-game hitting streak into the CAA Tournament.

ELON (24-30, 12-12 in CAA)

The sixth-seeded Phoenix built momentum heading into the CAA Tournament after posting two wins over Bowling Green. Elon overcame an early six-run deficit and earned a 12-11 victory as **Cam Devanney** smacked a pinch-hit, three-run walk-off homer. It was the first walk-off homer for the Phoenix since 2012. Catcher **Hayden Platt** homered in each game of the series, including a three-run shot in Friday's 9-2 victory. **Kyle Jackson** was 4-for-8 over the two games and drove in three, while **Will Nance** went deep twice and had three RBI's on Friday. On the mound, **Jordan Barrett** evened his record at 4-4 after limiting BGSU to an unearned run on four hits over 7.0 innings. He struck out nine and didn't issue a walk. Barrett increase his season strikeout total to 98.

HOFSTRA (14-37, 7-17 in CAA)

The Pride lost three games by a total of five runs and was swept in their season-ending series against William & Mary. Freshman **Rob Weissheier** paced the offense, batting .417 (5-12) with two homers and six RBI's. He went 3-for-5 with a two-run homer in the opening game and then provided all of Hofstra's offense in the finale with a three-run blast. Senior **Chris Hardardt** batted .400 for the series. **Teddy Cillis** fanned six batters in his final start on Saturday and finished with a school-record 96 K's for the season. **John Rooney** took a no-decision in the opener after allowing three runs over 7.0 frames and recording a season-best 11 strikeouts. As a team, the Pride set new school record with 412 K's. **Steven Foster** finished the year with a .317 batting average and 17 doubles.

JAMES MADISON (24-27, 7-17 in CAA)

The Dukes dropped three close games in their season-ending series at Northeastern, including a pair of one-run setbacks. **Adam Sisk** batted .417 (5-12) in the series and belted his 11th homer. Sisk leads the CAA with 55 runs scored and is ranked among the league's top 10 in batting (.337), homers (11), RBI's (41) and steals (14). **Kyle McPherson** had a pair of two-hit games and led off

Saturday's finale with a solo homer. McPherson hit .330 for the year with 46 runs scored. On the mound, **Colton Harlow** struck out 10 batters over 7.0 innings on Friday. He finished with a team-high 70 K's in 75.1 innings this season. Closer **Michael Evans** saw action in two games and moved up to second on JMU's career appearances list with 91. He had four saves in 2017 and 13 for his career.

UNCW (28-27, 16-8 in CAA)

The Seahawks secured the #2 seed and an opening round bye in the CAA Tournament after taking two-of-three at Towson last week. UNCW won the opener, 8-0, as **Alex Royalty** (8-2) allowed just four hits over 8.0 shutout innings and struck out eight with no walks. He has fanned 61 batters over his last seven starts. UNCW recorded a season-high 19 hits in the victory, with all nine starters having at least one. **Cory Gantz** (3-0) tossed 3.1 scoreless frames out of the bullpen as the Seahawks won Game 2, 7-6. **Casey Golden** went deep in the first two games of the series to increase his CAA-best home run total to 18. **Ryan Jeffers** batted .500 (5-10) at Towson, while **Nick Feight** hit .364 (4-11), smacked his 14th homer and drove in four. Feight tops UNCW with 46 RBI's.

NORTHEASTERN (28-23, 16-7 in CAA)

The Huskies captured their first CAA regular-season title and the #1 seed in the CAA Tournament after sweeping a three-game series with James Madison. NU rallied for a 7-6 victory in Saturday's finale on **Cam Hanley's** sac fly in the 8th. **Jimmy Hand** was 2-for-3 with a two-run homer in the finale and went 2-for-4 with a homer and two RBI's in Thursday's 4-3 victory. **Ryan Solomon** came up big in Saturday's 6-2 triumph, going 2-for-4 with a double, homer and five RBI's. **Brian Christian** turned in another strong effort on the mound, limiting the Dukes to one run on three hits over a career-long 8.0 innings while fanning four. He improved to 7-2 for the year and dropped his ERA to 3.45. **Mike Fitzgerald** didn't allow an earned run over 2.1 innings and picked up a pair of saves to extend his NU career saves record to 21.


TOWSON (20-34, 6-18 in CAA)

The Tigers dropped two-of-three to UNCW, but posted a 4-2 victory in Saturday's season finale. In his final outing, **Kyle Stricker** earned the win after scattering seven hits and allowing two runs in the first complete-game outing by a Towson pitcher since 2015. He struck out five and upped his record to 3-2. Offensively, **Richie Palacios** batted .636 (7-11) with a double, homer, four runs scored and three RBI's. He had at least two hits in all three games and drove in two of the Tigers' four runs in Saturday's win. Freshman **Bo Plagge** batted .625 (5-for-8) in the series, highlighted by a 3-for-4 effort on Saturday. Towson announced on Sunday that coach **Mike Gottlieb** concluded his career. He won 733 games over 30 seasons and guided the Tigers to three NCAA appearances.

WILLIAM & MARY (31-23, 15-8 in CAA)

The Tribe is the #3 seed as they begin defense of their CAA title after sweeping a three-game series at Hofstra. **Kyle Wright** batted .308 (4-13) with four RBI's at HU, including his first two-homer game in a 5-4 win in the series opener. **Patrick Ryan** also batted .308 with at least one hit in each contest and scored twice. **Ryder Miconi** and **Matthew Trehub** both homered in a 7-5 triumph in Game 2. Closer **Nick Brown** saved two games to increase his league-best total to seven. He threw 2.1 shutout innings and struck out five. Five W&M pitchers limited the Pride to two hits in a 5-3 victory in Saturday's finale. **Daniel Powers** gave up one hit over the first 4.0 frames. **Bodie Sheehan** picked up his team-leading sixth win after holding the Pride to two hits and one run over 5.1 innings.
