PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KELSI LIDGE | DREXEL SENIOR | FORWARD | AURORA, COLO./REGIS JESUIT

Senior Kelsi Lidge helped Drexel to a pair of wins last week by averaging 14.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 6.5 assists. After shaking off an 0-for-8 start from the field, Lidge went 10-for-16 the rest of the week. Against the Tribe, she single-handedly erased a 44-36 deficit in the fourth quarter with eight straight points in a span of 3:29, tying the score at 44 with 2:47 to play. Lidge assisted on Drexel's two remaining field goals in regulation, including the game-tying three-pointer with five seconds to play. Playing all 45 minutes, Lidge also grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds for her second double-double of the season and tied a career-high with eight assists and added five steals and two blocks. In the win over UNCW, Lidge led all scorers with 18 points, going 8-for-14 from the floor. She added five rebounds and five assists without a turnover against the Seahawks.

Sophomore Kamiah Smalls powered James Madison to a 70-67 victory over defending CAA champion Elon with a team-high 21 points. Smalls scored the final seven points of the game, taking the Dukes from down two to winning by three and remaining perfect in league play at 5-0. Smalls reached the 20-point mark for just the fourth time in her career and extended her double-digit scoring streak to 16 games. She tied a career high with seven made free throws, going 7-for-10 at the line, including a pair with two seconds left to push the Dukes' lead to three points. Smalls added a team-best eight rebounds, including six in the second half, in JMU's only game of the week.

Guard Justina Mascaro helped Delaware to a 2-0 week by averaging 5.0 points and 3.0 rebounds and 16.0 minutes off the bench. In the 58-51 win at Hofstra on Friday, she posted five points, a rebound and a steal. In the 51-49 win over Towson on Sunday, Mascaro scored five points and grabbed five rebounds.

#CAAHOOPS REWIND

- Charleston (5-12; 1-5): The Cougars had a pair of road losses to Northeastern and Hofstra. Deja Ford was the Cougars leading scorer last week, averaging 12.0 points per game.
- Delaware (11-5; 4-1): The Blue Hens extended their winning streak to four games with victories over Hofstra and Towson last week. Delaware, which has won seven of its last eight games, improves to 4-1 in league play. Nicole Enabosi averaged 13.0 points, 12.5 rebounds and 4.0 blocked shots to pace the Hens. Rookie Justina Mascaro added 5.0 points and 3.0 rebounds.
- Drexel (12-5; 4-1): The Dragons went 2-0 last week, picking up an overtime win at William & Mary before returning home for a victory over UNCW. Kelsi Lidge averaged 14.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 6.5 assists. At William & Mary, she scored eight straight points to erase a Drexel deficit and force overtime.
- Elon (10-6; 2-3): The Phoenix dropped two road games to James Madison and William & Mary. It's the first time they've lost two games in a row since dropping three to ACC foes since 2016. Sophomore Ra'Shika White averaged 19.0 points and 12.0 rebounds while **Shay Burnett** averaged 17.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 4.0 assists on the week.
- Hofstra (9-8; 3-3): The Pride split home games, falling to Delaware before downing Charleston. Senior **Ashunae Durant** posted double-doubles in both of the Pride's games this weekend, averaging 12.5 points and 13.5 rebounds.
- James Madison (9-7; 5-0): The Dukes remained undefeated in CAA play with a victory Elon. Sophomore Kamiah Smalls delivered 21 points, including the final seven points for the Dukes in the 70-67 win, and grabbed eight rebounds.
- UNCW (7-10; 0-6): The Seahawks had a pair of road losses to Towson and Delaware. Madison Raque averaged 16.5 points for the weekend, which included a 29-point effort at Towson.
- Northeastern (8-8; 3-2): The Huskies picked up a win over Charleston in its only game of the week. Jess Genco led Northeastern in scoring for the third time in five conference games, finishing with 17 points on 58.3 percent (7-for-12) shooting. On the boards, Loren Lassiter grabbed 13 rebounds. Rookie Jasmin Watson added four points and four rebounds against the Cougars.
- Towson (7-10; 2-4): The Tigers split games, picking up a home win over UNCW before falling to the road to Delaware. Nukiya Mayo and Mary Cuevas both averaged double-doubles. Mayo posted 16.5 points and 12.5 rebounds while Cuevas had 16.0 points and 12.0 rebounds per game.
- William & Mary (12-4; 3-2): The Tribe split home games, falling in overtime to Drexel before topping Elon. Junior Bianca Boggs helped the Tribe to a 1-1 week as she averaged 18.5 points over the Green and Gold two games. Senior Abby Rendle blocked her 300th career shot against Elon on Sunday and averaged 12.0 points on .66

#CAAHOOPS HOT SHOTS

- Two CAA teams are in the top-20 nationally in blocks. William & Mary is the national leader in total blocks (131) and in blocks per game (8.2). Towson is tenth in total blocks (108) and 10th in blocks per game (6.4).
- Elon has a +10.6 rebounding margin which ranks them seventh in the nation. The Phoenix is also 13th in rebounds per game (4450).
- Drexel is yielding just 57.5 points per game. The Dragons have held their last seven opponents under 60 points.
- Drexel held Lafayette to three points in the second quarter on December 1. It is the fewest points allowed in a quarter in the CAA this season.
- Delaware's Nicole Enabosi recorded 23 points and 20 rebounds in the non-league final against Loyola on December 22. It was the first 20-20 game in the CAA since the 2012-13 season. That year, Hofstra's Shante Evans had 33 points and 23 boards against Mason while William & Mary's Emily Correal had 24 points and 21 rebounds in the season opener against East Carolina.
- **Enabosi** leads the CAA in scoring (19.1ppg) and is nationally ranked in several categories. She's 15th in rebounds (193), 12th in rebounds per game (12.1), fourth in defensive rebounds per game (9.0), sixth in double-doubles (12), 15th in free throws made (91) and sixth in free throws attempted
- Delaware has reached double figure wins in each of the last 10 seasons.
- Northeastern has held three of its first five CAA opponents to 21 points or fewer in the first half.
- The Huskies held CofC to 37 points on January 12. It was the first time NU limited its opponent to under 40 points of offense for the first time since March 10, 2004, when the Huskies held UMBC to 30 points during the first round of the America East tournament.
- Five Huskies are averaging double figures in scoring, the only team in the CAA to do so this season: Stella Clark (10.0), Claudia Ortiz (13.1), Gabby Giacone (11.8), Jess Genco (14.6) and Shannon Todd (12.1).
- Hofstra's Olivia Askin went 6-for-6 from threepoint range at Charleston on January 5. It is just the seventh time in CAA history in which a player has gone a perfect 6-for-6 from beyond the arc. She also went 5-for-5 against the Cougars on January
- Drexel came away with a 20 steals against Lafayette on December 1, the most in the CAA this season. The Dragons have a league-best 157 steals this season.
- UNCW made a season-high 34 made field goals the win over N.C. Central. The 34 made field goals were the most since March 9, 2012, when the Seahawks were 34-of-71 against Hofstra.
- Northeastern made 15 three-pointers at Vermont on December 17, tying the Huskies for third alltime in CAA single game history.
- James Madison senior Hailee Barron appeared in her 117th consecutive game on January 12 against
- The Dukes' Kamiah Smalls has scored in double digits in all 16 games this season. She's second in the CAA in scoring, averaging 16.8 points per game.

#CAAHOOPS IN THE RPI

- In the NCAA RPI released on January 15, four CAA teams were in the top-100. Drexel had an RPI of 60 followed by Elon (86), James Madison (87) and Delaware (100).
- As a league, the CAA was rated tenth.

#CAAHOOPS IN THE POLLS

- USA Today WBCA Coaches Poll: Elon received votes in the Preseason Poll as well as the poll released on November 21.
- College Insider Mid-Major Poll: Elon remained in poll for the 11th consecutive week on January 16, dropping down to No. 19. James Madison reentered the poll at No. 24 while Drexel, William & Mary received votes.

CAREER MILESTONE WATCH

- Hofstra's Ashunae Durant is the CAA's career active leader in points (1399) and rebounds (977). She's on pace to become the first player since 2012-2013 to reach 1,000 points and 1,000 boards. Elena Delle Donne (Delaware), Danielle Parker (Delaware) and Shante Evans (Hofstra) were the last two players to complete the feat.
- Delaware's Nicole Enabosi (977), Elon's Malaya Johnson (972) and William & Mary's Abby Rendle (969) are closing in on their 1,000th career points.
- James Madison's Kayla Cooper-Williams has 98 blocks. With three, she'll become the eighth Duke in program history to reach 100 blocks her career.
- Senior guard Jenna Green stands second all-time at William & Mary with 466 career assists. She needs 38 more to break the school record.

BIG BLOCKER

- William & Mary center Abby Rendle blocked nine shots against Old Dominion on December 17 to surpass former Delaware Blue Hen and WNBA superstar Elena Delle Donne has the CAA's career blocks leader. Rendle brought her total to 275, breaking Delle Donne's record of 273 blocks.
- Rendle blocked her 300th shot against Elon on January 14. She currently has 303 blocks and is one of only three players in the NCAA that have 300 career blocks. She joins Duke's Bego Faz Davalos (357) and South Carolina's A'ja Wilson (311) in the 300 club.
- This season, Rendle leads the nation with 5.06 blocks per game and 81 total blocks.

HELPING THEM OUT

- William & Mary senior guard Jenna Green is tenth in the nation is assists per game (7.0) and 16th in total assists (112).
- Northeastern's Jess Genco is 22nd in assists per game (6.0) and figth nationally in minutes per game (38.81).
- There have been eight 10-assist games in the CAA this season.
- Elon accounts for three of those efforts, with Shay Burnett doing it twice and rookie Saadia Munford registering one.
- Northeastern's Jess Genco and William & Mary's Jenna Green have the most helpers in a single game this season with 12 assists. Genco did it against Houston on November 25 while Green did it against Elon on January 14.
- As a team, Drexel has the most assists in a single game this year with 25 against La Salle on November 16.

COACHES CORNER

- Head Coach Denise Dillon became Drexel's alltime winningest coach, notching her 265th career victory. Dillon stands fourth all-time in CAA victories, posting 173 wins in CAA regular season/ tournament games.
- Hofstra Head Coach Krista Kilburn-Steveskey notched her 200th career coaching victory on January 14 with the Pride's win over Charleston. Kilburn-Steveskey is already the program's alltime wins leader and saw her record improve to 200-164 in her 12th season at Hofstra. Dillon stands sixth all-time in CAA victories, posting 112 wins in CAA regular season/tournament games.

- There have been a pair of 30-point games in the CAA this season.
- William & Mary's Bianca Boggs tallied 33 points in the win over Saint Francis (PA) on December 2.
- Northeastern's Claudia Ortiz netted 31 points at Elon on January 7, a total which included seven three-pointers.

I'LL HAVE ANOTHER TRIPLE-DOUBLE

- Elon senior Shay Burnett recorded the second triple-double in the CAA this season with 10 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists. It was the first triple-double in Elon history.
- William & Mary center Abby Rendle notched her third career triple-double at East Carolina on November 21. Rendle finished with a 25 points, 17 rebounds and 10 blocks.
- This is the second consecutive season in which the CAA has had multiple triple-doubles. Former Hofstra guard Krystal Luciano and Rendle completed the feat last year.
- Rendle has all three points-rebounds-blocks triple-doubles since 2006. Rendle also had a triple-double against East Carolina last season (14pts, 11reb, 10blk). Rendle's first triple-double (and William & Mary's first) came in 2015-16, against UNCW (24pts, 15reb, 10blk).

#CAAHOOPS IN NON-LEAGUE PLAY

- The CAA went 63-48 in non-league play.
- The CAA had success against the A-10, going 10-4, the American (3-1), the Patriot League (8-3) and the NEC (5-0).
- The CAA went 34-14 at home in non-league play. Three teams (UNCW, Drexel, Elon) went unbeaten.
- The CAA averaged 67.7 points per game while opponents averaged 65.1 points a contest.
- The CAA averaged 38.9 rebounds per game and held opponents to 37.5 boards.

HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

- With its 106-54 win over Coker on November 27, Elon recorded the first 100-point game in the CAA since March 4, 2015 when James Madison scored 107 points against College of Charleston.
- Since 1998-99, there have been 21 games in which a CAA team has scored 100+ points.

HEY ROOKIE!

- Northeastern's Stella Clark is the first player in CAA history to be awarded with the first three CAA Rookie of the Week honors of the year since the award's creation in 2002-03.
- Clark is only the second player in CAA history to earn three consecutive nods at any point in the year; Elena Delle Donne did it twice in 2009-10 en route to her record-setting 10 CAA Rookie of the Week honors.

HELLO, COACHES

- There are three new coaches on the sidelines this season, two of which are familiar faces.
- Head Coach Karen Barefoot takes the helm of UNCW. She was previously in the league as the leader of ODU.
- Head Coach Natasha Adair returns to the CAA sidelines, taking over the helm of Delaware. Adair led CofC during its first CAA season.
- Head Coach Diane Richardson will guide Towson this season. Richardson was a longtime assistant coach at West Virginia.

THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT TIME

- Elon headed to the Puerto Rico Clasico which was relocated to Fort Lauderdale, Fla. The Phoenix opened action with a win over (RV/RV) Alabama but fell to (RV/RV) lowa.
- Drexel traveled to Melbourne, Fla. for the relocated Paradise Jam. The Dragons fell to (RV) Virginia Tech in the opening round and No. 11/13 West Virginia on the second day but downed Butler on the final day. Sophomore Aubree Brown landed a spot on the All-Tournament Team, averaging 9.7 points and 4.0 assists per game.
- Northeastern split games at the UMass Thanksgiving Classic topping host UMass before being edged by Houston.
- James Madison headed north for the TD Bank Classic which was hosted by Vermont. The Dukes were edged by Villanova but downed the host Catamounts. Sophomore Kamiah Smalls was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 18.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals per game.
- Hofstra split games at the Lady Rebel Round-Up in Las Vegas. The Pride was clipped by host UNLV before knocking off Wake Forest. Senior **Aleana** Leon was named to the All-Tournament team after averaging 14.5 points and 6.5 rebounds.

Delaware made a trip to Philadelphia for the Saint Joseph's Thanksgiving Tournament. After falling to Saint Peter's by a basket in double overtime, the Hens trounced Eastern Illinois. Nicole Enabosi was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 24.0 points and 14.0 rebounds.

#CAAHOOPS INTERNATIONALLY SPEAKING

- The are 15 international players hailing for 10 different countries in the CAA this season.
- Hofstra's roster features eight international player in sophomores Marianne Kalin and Sandra Karsten (Finland), Ana Hernandez Gil (Canary Islands) and Petja Krupenko (Slovenia); freshman Mie Hoff (Norway), junior transfer Sica Cuzic (Romania), junior Kayla Minott (Canada) and senior Aleana Leon (Puerto Rico).

KATRINA MCCLAIN AWARD WATCH LIST

- Hofstra senior Ashunae Durant was named one of 20 candidates for the Katrina McClain Award, which recognized the top power forward in women's basketball.
- The list will be fluid, with players able to be added a removed from the list throughout the season. It will be narrowed to 10 in mid-February before the five ultimate finalists are announced in March.

2017 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- James Madison was predicted to capture the 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship while Elon senior Shay Burnett was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in a vote of the league's 10 head coaches.
- The Dukes had 78 points, including six firstplace votes while Elon, the defending champs, was second with 74 points, including three first-place votes. Rounding out the top-seven was William & Mary (58), Drexel (51), Delaware (48), Northeastern (47) and Hofstra (43). Towson and UNCW were tied for eighth while CofC was tenth.
