PLAYER OF THE WEEK

ABBY RENDLE | WILLIAM & MARY SENIOR | CENTER | RESTON, VA./SOUTH LAKES

Senior Abby Rendle helped William & Mary to a 2-0 start in league play for the second time in three seasons as she averaged 21.0 points, 7.0 rebounds, and 3.0 blocks per game. In the CAA opener at Charleston, Rendle scored a career-high 26 points, added seven rebounds, and a block in the victory. On Sunday, Rendle was in double figures as she chipped in 16 points, seven more rebounds, and five rejections. For the week she shot 20-of-26 from the floor, shooting 76.9 percent. She added three assists and three steals as well. This is the third CAA Player of the Week honor for Rendle this season.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

HANNAH NIHILL | DREXEL FRESHMAN | GUARD | DREXEL HILL, PA./CARDINAL O'HARA

In her first weekend of conference play, Drexel's Hannah Nihill averaged 8.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game. In the league opener against Delaware, Nihill had five points, tied a season high with five assists, grabbed four rebounds, and came away with two steals in the win. In the victory against Hofstra, Nihill scored 11 points one shy of her season high and added a season-best six rebounds, two assists and a block in the game as well. This is the second CAA Rookie of the Week honor for Nihill this season.

#CAAHOOPS REWIND

- **Charleston (5-8; 1-1):** The Cougars split games, falling to William & Mary before bouncing back with a victory over Towson. Senior forward **Tanisha Brown** had back-to-back double-doubles, averaging 15.0 points and 11.0 rebounds per game.
- **Delaware (7-5; 0-1):** The Blue Hens opened league play with a tough 74-53 loss at Drexel. **Nicole Enabosi** tallied 18 points and eight rebounds, snapping her streak of eight-straight double-doubles, while **Samone DeFreese** added 13 points and eight boards.
- **Drexel (10-4; 2-0):** The Dragons opened CAA play with a 2-0 record, topping Delaware and Hofstra to improve to 6-0 at home this season. With the win against the Pride on Sunday, Head Coach **Denise Dillon** became Drexel's all-time winningest coach, notching her 265th career victory. Senior **Sara Woods** averaged 11.0 points and 8.5 rebounds per game, including his first career double-double (14pts, 10reb) against Hofstra. Rookie **Hannah Nihill** averaged 8.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game.
- **Elon (9-3; 1-0):** The Phoenix began defense of their CAA title with a 75-67 win over UNCW. Senior **Shay Burnett** delivered 24 points, 11 rebounds and six assists, and turned in a 13-for-17 performance from the charity stripe. **Ra'Shika White** added 13 points and nine rebounds.
- **Hofstra (6-7; 0-2):** The Pride had a pair of tough losses to James Madison and Drexel to open league play. **Marianne Kalin** averaged 10.0 points per game last weekend.
- **James Madison (6-7; 2-0):** The Dukes got off to a 2-0 start in league play with road wins over Hofstra and Northeastern. Sophomore **Kamiah Smalls** led JMU in scoring (18.0ppg), rebounding (7.5rpg), steals (3.5spg) and tied for assists (2.5apg). She also extended her double-digit scoring streak to 13 games.
- **UNCW (7-6; 0-2):** The Seahawks opened CAA play with a road loss to Elon before dropping its first home game of the year to William & Mary. **Madison Raque** averaged 12.0 points and 5.0 rebounds in the two games.
- **Northeastern (6-7; 1-1):** The Huskies split games to open conference play, topping Towson before falling to James Madison. Junior **Jess Genco** averaged 14.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 6.5 assists while playing all 80 minutes.
- **Towson (5-8; 0-2):** The Tigers had a pair of home losses, falling to Northeastern and Charleston to begin league play. **Mary Cuevas** averaged 22.0 points and 9.5 rebounds while **Nukiya Mayo** averaged a double-double with 13.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game.
- **William & Mary (11-2; 2-0):** The Tribe got off to a 2-0 start in league play for the second time in three seasons with road wins at Charleston and UNCW. Senior **Abby Rendle** led the charge, averaging 21.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 3.0 blocks while going 20-for-26 from the field.

IN THE RPI

- In the NCAA RPI released on January 1, two CAA teams were in the top-100. Drexel had an RPI of 58 followed by Elon (70).

#CAAHOOPS HOT SHOTS

- Head Coach **Denise Dillon** became Drexel's all-time winningest coach, notching her 265th career victory. Dillon stands fourth all-time in CAA victories, posting 171 wins in CAA regular season/tournament games.
- Two CAA teams are in the top-20 nationally in blocks. William & Mary is third in total blocks (100) and second in blocks per game (7.7). Towson is 17th in total blocks (80) and ninth in blocks per game (6.2).
- Elon has only been out-rebounded once this season (NC State on December 16 by a margin of 40-33). The Phoenix has a +12.3 rebounding margin which ranks them seventh in the nation. The Phoenix is also ninth in rebounds per game (45.83).
- Elon and Drexel are holding opponents under 60 points this season. The Phoenix is allowing just 57.8 points per game while the Dragons are yielding just 58.7. Only Iowa and NC State have scored more than 60 points against Elon while the Dragons have held their last four opponents under 60 points.
- Drexel held Lafayette to three points in the second quarter on December 1. It is the fewest points allowed in a quarter in the CAA this season.
- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** recorded 23 points and 20 rebounds in the non-league final against Loyola on December 22. It was the first 20-20 game in the CAA since the 2012-13 season. That year, Hofstra's Shante Evans had 33 points and 23 boards against Mason while William & Mary's Emily Correal had 24 points and 21 rebounds in the season opener against East Carolina.
- **Enabosi** leads the CAA in scoring (20.2ppg) and is nationally ranked in several categories. She's 15th in rebounds (150), seventh in rebounds per game (12.5), fifth in defensive rebounds per game (9.0), sixth in double-doubles (9), 11th in free throws made (74) and eighth in free throws attempted (101).
- Hofstra's **Ashunae Durant** is the CAA's career active leader in points (1355) and rebounds (939). She's on pace to become the first player since 2012-2013 to reach 1,000 points and 1,000 boards. **Elena Delle Donne** (Delaware), **Danielle Parker** (Delaware) and **Shante Evans** (Hofstra) were the last two players to complete the feat.
- Five Huskies are averaging double figures in scoring, the only team in the CAA to do so this season: **Stella Clark (10.9)**, **Claudia Ortiz (12.3)**, **Gabby Giaccone (12.4)**, **Jess Genco (14.2)** and **Shannon Todd (13.0)**.
- Drexel came away with a 20 steals against Lafayette on December 1, the most in the CAA this season. The Dragons have a league-best 147 steals this season.
- UNCW made a season-high 34 made field goals the win over N.C. Central. The 34 made field goals were the most since March 9, 2012, when the Seahawks were 34-of-71 against Hofstra.
- Northeastern made 15 three-pointers at Vermont on December 17, tying the Huskies for third all-time in CAA single game history.
- James Madison senior **Hailee Barron** appeared in her 114th consecutive game on December 31 at Northeastern
- The Dukes' **Kamiah Smalls** has scored in double digits in all 13 games this season. She's second in the CAA in scoring, averaging 17.2 points per game.

IN THE POLLS

- **USA Today WBCA Coaches Poll:** Elon received votes in the Preseason Poll as well as the poll released on November 21.
- **College Insider Mid-Major Poll:** Elon remained at No. 6 for the sixth straight week according to the poll released on December 26. In addition, William & Mary, Drexel and James Madison all received votes.

CAA IN NON-LEAGUE PLAY

- The CAA went 63-48 in non-league play.
- The CAA had success against the A-10, going 10-4, the American (3-1), the Patriot League (8-3) and the NEC (5-0).
- The CAA went 34-14 at home in non-league play. Three teams (UNCW, Drexel, Elon) went unbeaten.
- The CAA averaged 67.7 points per game while opponents averaged 65.1 points a contest.
- The CAA averaged 38.9 rebounds per game and held opponents to 37.5 boards.

BIG BLOCKER

- William & Mary center **Abby Rendle** blocked nine shots against Old Dominion on December 17 to surpass former Delaware Blue Hen and WNBA superstar **Elena Delle Donne** has the CAA's career blocks leader. Rendle brought her total to 275, breaking Delle Donne's record of 273 blocks.
- Rendle leads the nation with 4.69 blocks per game and total blocks (61).

HELPING THEM OUT

- William & Mary senior guard **Jenna Green** is 13th in the nation in assists per game (6.7) and 15th in total assists (87). Northeastern's **Jess Genco** is 23rd in total assists (80).
- The Tribe is ranked 24th in assists per game (17.9).
- There have been six 10-assist games in the CAA this season.
- Elon accounts for three of those efforts, with **Shay Burnett** doing it twice and rookie **Saadia Munford** registering one.
- Northeastern's **Jess Genco** has the most helpers in a single game this season with 12 assists against Houston on November 25.
- As a team, Drexel has the most assists in a single game this year with 25 against La Salle on November 16.

I'LL HAVE ANOTHER TRIPLE-DOUBLE

- Elon senior **Shay Burnett** recorded the second triple-double in the CAA this season with 10 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists. It was the first triple-double in Elon history.
- William & Mary center **Abby Rendle** notched her third career triple-double at East Carolina on November 21. Rendle finished with a 25 points, 17 rebounds and 10 blocks.
- This is the second consecutive season in which the CAA has had multiple triple-doubles. Former Hofstra guard **Krystal Luciano** and Rendle completed the feat last year.
- Rendle has all three points-rebounds-blocks triple-doubles since 2006. Rendle also had a triple-double against East Carolina last season (14pts, 11reb, 10blk). Rendle's first triple-double (and William & Mary's first) came in 2015-16, against UNCW (24pts, 15reb, 10blk).

HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

- With its 106-54 win over Coker on November 27, Elon recorded the first 100-point game in the CAA since March 4, 2015 when James Madison scored 107 points against College of Charleston.
- Since 1998-99, there have been 21 games in which a CAA team has scored 100+ points.

HEY ROOKIE!

- Northeastern's **Stella Clark** is the first player in CAA history to be awarded with the first three CAA Rookie of the Week honors of the year since the award's creation in 2002-03.
- Clark is only the second player in CAA history to earn three consecutive nods at any point in the year; **Elena Delle Donne** did it twice in 2009-10 en route to her record-setting 10 CAA Rookie of the Week honors.

HELLO, COACHES

- There will be three new coaches on the sidelines, two of which are familiar faces.
- Head Coach **Karen Barefoot** takes the helm of UNCW. She was previously in the league as the leader of ODU.
- Head Coach **Natasha Adair** returns to the CAA sidelines, taking over the helm of Delaware. Adair led CofC during its first CAA season.
- Head Coach **Diane Richardson** will guide Towson this season. Richardson was a longtime assistant coach at West Virginia.

THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT TIME

- Elon headed to the Puerto Rico Clasico which was relocated to Fort Lauderdale, Fla. The Phoenix opened action with a win over (RV/RV) Alabama but fell to (RV/RV) Iowa.
- Drexel traveled to Melbourne, Fla. for the relocated Paradise Jam. The Dragons fell to (RV) Virginia Tech in the opening round and No. 11/13 West Virginia on the second day but downed Butler on the final day. Sophomore **Aubree Brown** landed a spot on the All-Tournament Team, averaging 9.7 points and 4.0 assists per game.
- Northeastern split games at the UMass Thanksgiving Classic topping host UMass before being edged by Houston.
- James Madison headed north for the TD Bank Classic which was hosted by Vermont. The Dukes were edged by Villanova but downed the host Catamounts. Sophomore **Kamiah Smalls** was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 18.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals per game.
- Hofstra split games at the Lady Rebel Round-Up in Las Vegas. The Pride was clipped by host UNLV before knocking off Wake Forest. Senior **Aleana Leon** was named to the All-Tournament team after averaging 14.5 points and 6.5 rebounds.
- Delaware made a trip to Philadelphia for the Saint Joseph's Thanksgiving Tournament. After falling to Saint Peter's by a basket in double overtime, the Hens trounced Eastern Illinois. **Nicole Enabosi** was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 24.0 points and 14.0 rebounds.

KATRINA MCCLAIN AWARD WATCH LIST

- Hofstra senior **Ashunae Durant** was named one of 20 candidates for the Katrina McClain Award, which recognized the top power forward in women's basketball.
- The list will be fluid, with players able to be added a removed from the list throughout the season. It will be narrowed to 10 in mid-February before the five ultimate finalists are announced in March.

#CAAHOOPS INTERNATIONALLY SPEAKING

- There are 15 international players hailing for 10 different countries in the CAA this season.
- Hofstra's roster features eight international player in sophomores **Marianne Kalin** and **Sandra Karsten** (Finland), **Ana Hernandez Gil** (Canary Islands) and **Petja Krupenko** (Slovenia); freshman **Mie Hoff** (Norway), junior transfer **Sica Cuzic** (Romania), junior **Kayla Minott** (Canada) and senior **Aleana Leon** (Puerto Rico).
- Drexel has the second most at three international players in sophomore **Ana Ferariu** (Romania) and juniors **Tereza Kracikova** (Czech Republic) and **Eline Maesschalk** (Belgium).

2017 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- James Madison was predicted to capture the 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship while Elon senior **Shay Burnett** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in a vote of the league's 10 head coaches.
- The Dukes had 78 points, including six first-place votes while Elon, the defending champs, was second with 74 points, including three first-place votes. Rounding out the top-seven was William & Mary (58), Drexel (51), Delaware (48), Northeastern (47) and Hofstra (43). Towson and UNCW were tied for eighth while CofC was tenth.
- Only six of the top-20 leading scorers from last season return for the respective teams. Yet, 11 of the top-20 leading rebounders from one year ago will be back to clean the glass.
- Only four of the 15 All-CAA honorees from last year return for the 2017-18 season.

2018 CAA CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

- The 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship tournament will be held March 7-10 at the Daskalakis Athletic Center (DAC) in Philadelphia, Pa. and will be hosted by Drexel.
- The opening round, quarterfinals and semifinals will be streamed exclusively on CAA.tv. The final will be aired on NBC Sports Washington & Philadelphia and SNY and streamed via CollegeSportsLive, as part of the conference's partnership with CBSi.
- All-Session tickets are on sale now by visiting DrexelTickets.com.
- The CAA Women's Basketball Championship returned to campus last season with James Madison hosting at the Convocation Center in Harrisonburg, Va. Delaware will host the 2019 CAA Championship at the Bob Carpenter Center in Newark.
