Center Malaya Johnson came alive in Elon's 2-0 weekend against Towson and Delaware. In two home games, Johnson notched 16 points in both contests while missing just four of 19 shots all weekend, hitting 15-of-19 to shoot .789 from the floor. The senior also had a big double-double against Delaware with 13 rebounds, polishing off a special day in which she became the 24th member of Elon's 1,000-career point club. She has now scored 16 points in each of Elon's last three games after not reaching double figures in any of Elon's first four CAA games.

Guard Saadia Munford helped Elon to a 2-0 week by averaging 10.5 points, 4.0 rebounds, 3.0 steals and 2.5 assists last week. She was also a perfect 10-for-10 from the free throw line. In the win over Towson, she posted a season-high 15 points on 5-of-9 shooting to go with four assists and three steals. In the win against Delaware, she went 6-for-6 from the charity stripe, collected five rebounds and three steals and did not commit a turnover in 27 minutes of play. This is the second CAA Rookie of the Week honor for Munford.

Forward Lizzie Oleary helped Delaware to a split last week, averaging 9.5 points and 4.5 rebounds per game. Oleary shot .615 (8-for-13) from the field in two games. In the win over UNCW, Oleary tallied six points and grabbed two rebounds. She led Delaware with a season-high 13 points for the Hens while tying a season-best with seven rebounds in loss at Elon.

#CAAHOOPS REWIND

- Charleston (5-14; 1-7): The Cougars had a pair of home losses to James Madison and Towson. Deja **Ford** averaged 14.5 points per game and went a perfect 12-for-12 from the free throw line.
- Delaware (12-6; 5-2): The Blue Hens extended their winning streak to five games with a victory at UNCW before seeing the streak snap at Elon. Junior Nicole Enabosi averaged a double-double last week with 17.0 points and 11.5 rebounds and scored her 1,000th career point on Friday night. Rookie Lizzie Oleary averaged 9.5 points and 4.5 rebounds in 16.0 minutes and shot .615 from the field in two games.
- Drexel (14-5; 6-1): The Dragons pushed their winning streak to four games with a pair of road victories at Northeastern and Hofstra. Senior Kelsi Lidge averaged 15.0 points, 7.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists, including a 21-point effort in the win over Northeastern. Lidge went 8-for-15 from the floor against the Huskies and also dished out five assists while grabbing nine rebounds.
- Elon (12-6; 4-3): The Phoenix posed back-to-back league wins for the first time this season with a pair of home victories against Towson and Delaware. Senior **Malaya Johnso**n, who scored her 1,000th career point on Sunday, averaged 16.0 points per game while shooting an impressive .789 from the field for the week, connecting on 15 of the 19 shots she took. Rookie **Saadia Munford** averaged 10.5 points and 3.0 steals and went 10-for-10 from the free throw line.
- Hofstra (10-9; 4-4): The Pride split games, knocking off William & Mary before falling to Drexel. Senior Aleana Leon averaged 15.0 points, 8.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists for the week, including a gamehigh 19 points in the victory over William & Mary.
- James Madison (11-7; 7-0): The Dukes remained undefeated in CAA play with a pair of road wins at Charleston and UNCW. **Kayla Cooper-Williams** averaged 12.5 rebounds and 8.0 points, including a season-high 16 boards at CofC. Cooper-Williams also blocked the 100th shot of her career against the Cougars and finished the week with seven blocks. Devon Merritt tied a season-high with 10 points in each game, shooting 61.5 percent, and turned the ball over just once.
- UNCW (7-12; 0-8): The Seahawks had a pair of home losses, falling to James Madison and Delaware. Moriah Crisp averaged 9.0 points while Timber Tate averaged 8.5 points and 4.5 rebounds.
- Northeastern (9-9; 4-3): The Huskies split home games, falling to Drexel before topping William & Mary. Junior **Gabby Giacone** averaged a double-double with 14.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game while classmate Jess Genco averaged 17.0 points, 5.0 assists and 4.5 rebounds per game.
- Towson (8-11; 3-5) The Tigers split games on the road, falling at Elon before downing Charleston. Three Tigers averaged double digits in scoring for the week, including **Mary Cuevas** who averaged 16.5 points and Raine Bankston who delivered 16.0 points per game.
- William & Mary (12-6; 3-4): The Tribe went 0-2 on the road with losses Hofstra and Northeastern. Bianca Boggs averaged 15.0 points and 5.0 rebounds while Victoria Reynolds averaged 13.0 points and 5.0 rebounds.

#CAAHOOPS IN THE POLLS

College Insider Mid-Major Poll: Elon remained in poll for the 12th consecutive week on January 23, coming in No. 19. James Madison moved up two spots to No. 22 while Drexel received votes.

#CAAHOOPS HOT SHOTS

- The CAA's longest double-digit scoring streaks of the year came to end over the weekend. JMU's Kamiah Smalls had her 16-game scoring streak stopped on Friday while Delaware's Nicole Enabosi had her 17-game streak stopped on Sunday.
- Towson's Mary Cuevas and Northeastern's Jess Genco now enter the week with the longest doubledigit scoring streaks at 15 games.
- Two CAA teams are in the top-20 nationally in blocks. William & Mary is the national leader in total blocks (142) and in blocks per game (7.9). Towson is eighth in total blocks (122) and ninth in blocks per game (6.4).
- Three teams in the CAA are in the top-25 nationally in rebounds per game. Towson is 15th at 44.00, Elon is 16th (43.94) and Delaware in 22nd (43.28).
- Elon is also 19th in rebound margin (+8.8) while Delaware is ninth in defensive rebounds per game (30.0) and Towson is fifth in offensive rebounds per game (18.0).
- Drexel is yielding just 57.0 points per game. The Dragons have held their last nine opponents under 60 points.
- Drexel has held two opponents to just three points in a quarter this season, the lowest in the CAA. Most recently, the Dragons held Hofstra to three points in the first quarter on January 21. Drexel also held Lafayette to three points in the second quarter on December 1.
- Delaware's Nicole Enabosi leads the CAA in scoring (18.8ppg) and is nationally ranked in several categories. She's 13th in rebounds (216), 11th in rebounds per game (12.0), fourth in defensive rebounds per game (9.0), fifth in double-doubles (13), 17th in free throws made (99) and tenth in free throws attempted (140).
- Northeastern has generated 20 or more turnovers from four of its first seven CAA opponents this season. The Huskies have also kept three of their first seven CAA opponents to less than 50 points of offense.
- Hofstra has held all of its CAA opponents to under 61 points.
- James Madison senior Hailee Barron has appeared in 119 consecutive games for the Dukes, which is tied for the eighth-longest streak in JMU history
- James Madison has blocked at least six shots in eight of the last nine games.
- Delaware reached 80+ points Friday for the fourth time this season. The last time Délaware logged 80-plus points at least four times in a season came during the 2011-12 slate.
- With 51 rebounds at UNCW and 57 rebounds versus Eastern Illinois, the Hens have reached 50+ rebounds twice in a season for the first time since the 2013-14 campaign. The 57 rebounds against EIU were the most for Delaware since logging 60 at Lafayette on November 14, 2014.

- Charleston and Towson came away with a split.
- Delaware swept UNCW and split with Elon.
- Drexel swept Hofstra.

#CAAHOOPS IN THE RPI

- In the NCAA RPI released on January 22, three CAA teams were in the top-100. Drexel had an RPI of 50 followed by Elon (80) and James Madison (87).
- As a league, the CAA was rated tenth.

WBCA'S 'SO YOU WANT TO BE A COACH'

- Elon's Shay Burnett and UNCW's Jenny DeGraaf were selected for the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's (WBCA) 16th annual "So You Want To Be A Coach" program.
- Burnett and DeGraaf will participate in the threeday workshop with speakers provided by the Alliance on March 28-30 in conjunction with the WBCA Convention in Columbus, Ohio.
- The objectives of the "So" program are to increase the understanding and application of skills necessary to secure coaching positions in women's basketball, increase the understanding and awareness of competencies necessary for success in coaching, introduce female basketball players to coaches and administrators, and raise awareness of the existing talent pool of female basketball players who have a passion and interest in coaching the game of women's basketball.

CAREER MILESTONE WATCH

- Hofstra's Ashunae Durant is the CAA's career active leader in points (1418) and rebounds (993). She's on pace to become the 16th player in CAA history to have 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds and the first to reach the mark since 2012-13 when Elena Delle Donne (Delaware), Danielle Parker (Delaware) and Shante Evans (Hofstra) completed the feat.
- Delaware's Nicole Enabosi and Elon's Malaya Johnson both reached the 1,000 career point milestone last weekend. Enabosi's bucket came on January 19 at UNCW while Johnson's basket came against Enabosi and the Blue Hens on January 21.
- William & Mary's Abby Rendle (979) is closing in on her 1,000th career point.
- James Madison's Kayla Cooper-Williams became the eighth Duke in program history to reach 100 blocks her career doing so at College of Charleston on January 19. Cooper-Williams has 105 blocks.
- Senior guard Jenna Green stands second all-time at William & Mary with 472 career assists. She needs 32 more to break the school record.
- Elon senior guard Shay Burnett is five rebounds away from the 800th of her career.

- William & Mary center Abby Rendle blocked nine shots against Old Dominion on December 17 to surpass former Delaware Blue Hen and WNBA superstar Elena Delle Donne has the CAA's career blocks leader. Rendle brought her total to 275, breaking Delle Donne's record of 273 blocks.
- Rendle blocked her 300th shot against Elon on January 14. She currently has 310 blocks and is one of only three players in the NCAA that have 300 career blocks. She joins Duke's Bego Faz Davalos (357) and South Carolina's A'ja Wilson (315) in the 300 club.
- This season, Rendle leads the nation with 4.89 blocks per game and 88 total blocks.
- Rendle's 88 total blocks are fifth all-time in CAA history. The league's single season record is 110 set by Richmond's Amy Dorsett in 1996-97.

HELPING THEM OUT

- William & Mary senior guard Jenna Green is 12th in the nation is assists per game (6.6) and 19th in total assists (118).
- Northeastern's Jess Genco and Elon's Shay Burnett are 24th and 25th, respectively, with 5.9 assists per game.
- There have been eight 10-assist games in the CAA this season
- Elon accounts for three of those efforts, with Shay

- Burnett doing it twice and rookie Saadia Munford registering one.
- Northeastern's Jess Genco and William & Mary's Jenna Green have the most helpers in a single game this season with 12 assists. Genco did it against Houston on November 25 while Green did it against Elon on January 14.
- As a team, Drexel has the most assists in a single game this year with 25 against La Salle on November 16.

COACHES CORNER

- Head Coach Denise Dillon became Drexel's alltime winningest coach, notching her 265th career victory. Dillon stands fourth all-time in CAA victories, posting 175 wins in CAA regular season/ tournament games.
- Hofstra Head Coach Krista Kilburn-Steveskey notched her 200th career coaching victory on January 14 with the Pride's win over Charleston. Kilburn-Steveskey is already the program's all-time wins leader and saw her record improve to 201-165 in her 12th season at Hofstra. Kilburn-Steveskey stands sixth all-time in CAA victories, posting 113 wins in CAA regular season/ tournament games.

20-20 CLUB

 Delaware's Nicole Enabosi recorded 23 points and 20 rebounds in the non-league final against Loyola on December 22. It was the first 20-20 game in the CAA since the 2012-13 season. That year, Hofstra's Shante Evans had 33 points and 23 boards against Mason while William & Mary's Emily Correal had 24 points and 21 rebounds in the season opener against East Carolina.

THE BIG 3-0

- There have been a pair of 30-point games in the CAA this season.
- William & Mary's Bianca Boggs tallied 33 points in the win over Saint Francis (PA) on December 2.
- Northeastern's Claudia Ortiz netted 31 points at Elon on January 7, including seven three-pointers.

I'LL HAVE ANOTHER TRIPLE-DOUBLE

- Elon senior Shay Burnett recorded the second triple-double in the CAA this season with 10 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists. It was the first triple-double in Elon history.
- William & Mary center Abby Rendle notched her third career triple-double at East Carolina on November 21. Rendle finished with a 25 points, 17 rebounds and 10 blocks.
- This is the second consecutive season in which the CAA has had multiple triple-doubles. Former Hofstra guard **Krystal Luciano** and Rendle completed the feat last year.
- Rendle has all three points-rebounds-blocks triple-doubles since 2006. Rendle also had a triple-double against East Carolina last season (14pts, 11reb, 10blk). Rendle's first triple-double (and William & Mary's first) came in 2015-16, against UNCW (24pts, 15reb, 10blk).

#CAAHOOPS IN NON-LEAGUE PLAY

- The CAA went 63-48 in non-league play.
- The CAA had success against the A-10, going 10-4, the American (3-1), the Patriot League (8-3) and the NEC (5-0).
- The CAA went 34-14 at home in non-league play. Three teams (UNCW, Drexel, Elon) went unbeaten.
- The CAA averaged 67.7 points per game while opponents averaged 65.1 points a contest.
- The CAA averaged 38.9 rebounds per game and held opponents to 37.5 boards.

WEEKLY REPORT

HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

- With its 106-54 win over Coker on November 27, Elon recorded the first 100-point game in the CAA since March 4, 2015 when James Madison scored 107 points against College of Charleston.
- Since 1998-99, there have been 21 games in which a CAA team has scored 100+ points.

- Northeastern's **Stella Clark** is the first player in CAA history to be awarded with the first three CAA Rookie of the Week honors of the year since the award's creation in 2002-03.
- Clark is only the second player in CAA history to earn three consecutive nods at any point in the year; **Elena Delle Donne** did it twice in 2009-10 en route to her record-setting 10 CAA Rookie of the

HELLO, COACHES

- There are three new coaches on the sidelines this season, two of which are familiar faces.
- Head Coach Karen Barefoot takes the helm of UNCW. She was previously in the league as the leader of ODU.
- Head Coach Natasha Adair returns to the CAA sidelines, taking over the helm of Delaware. Adair led CofC during its first CAA season.
- Head Coach Diane Richardson will guide Towson this season. Richardson was a longtime assistant coach at West Virginia.

THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT TIME

- Elon headed to the Puerto Rico Clasico which was relocated to Fort Lauderdale, Fla. The Phoenix opened action with a win over (RV/RV) Alabama but fell to (RV/RV) lowa.
- Drexel traveled to Melbourne, Fla. for the relocated Paradise Jam. The Dragons fell to (RV) Virginia Tech in the opening round and No. 11/13 West Virginia on the second day but downed Butler on the final day. Sophomore **Áubree Brown** landed a spot on the All-Tournament Team, averaging 9.7 points and 4.0 assists per game.
- Northeastern split games at the UMass Thanksgiving Classic topping host UMass before being edged by Houston.
- James Madison headed north for the TD Bank Classic which was hosted by Vermont. The Dukes were edged by Villanova but downed the host Catamounts. Sophomore Kamiah Smalls was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 18.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals per game.
- Hofstra split games at the Lady Rebel Round-Up in Las Vegas. The Pride was clipped by host UNLV
