## #CAAHOOPS WEEKLY HONORS



### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**BIANCA BOGGS | WILLIAM & MARY JUNIOR | GUARD | WALDORF, MD./ST. MARY'S RYKEN**

Guard Bianca Boggs led the Tribe to back-to-back victories with a stellar week averaging 25.0 points, 7.5 rebounds, 5.0 steals, 4.5 assists and 3.0 blocks per game. The junior finished the week shooting 21-of-39 (.538) from the floor and 7-of-17 (.410) from three-point range. On Friday night, Boggs sparked the Tribe's second-half comeback with 26 points, seven rebounds, six assists, two blocks and seven steals, playing all 40 minutes. She again led the Tribe with 24 points in its win versus Hofstra scoring 24 points, eight rebounds, three assists, four blocks, and three steals. Boggs is the Tribe's leading scorer averaging 17.1 points per game, along with 4.8 rebounds, and 2.9 assists per game. She has led the Tribe in scoring in 12 games and has been in double-figures in each of W&M's last 11 contests.



### ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

**HANNAH NIHILL | DREXEL FRESHMAN | GUARD | DREXEL HILL, PA./CARDINAL O'HARA**

Rookie Hannah Nihill averaged 7.0 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game to help Drexel to 2-0 weekend against Elon and Northeastern. The guard scored eight in the win over Elon, including the go-ahead three-pointer with 3:19 remaining in the fourth quarter after the Dragons had trailed by 10 with under seven minutes to play. She also dished out three assists against the Phoenix. Nihill had six points, three assists and matched a season high with six rebounds in the win over Northeastern that extended Drexel's winning streak to six games. This is the third CAA Rookie of the Week honor for Nihill this season.

## #CAAHOOPS REWIND

- Charleston (5-16; 1-9):** The Cougars had a pair of road losses at William & Mary and James Madison. **Tanisha Brown** averaged a double-double with 10.5 points and 10.5 rebounds while **Deja Ford** averaged 11.0 points per game and pushed her double-digit scoring streak to five games.
- UD (13-7; 6-3):** The Blue Hens split games at home, falling to Northeastern before topping UNCW. Junior **Nicole Enabosi** averaged a double-double with 18.5 points and 14.0 rebounds to go along with 3.0 steals and 1.5 blocks per game. Enabosi has 15 double-doubles in 20 games this season to lead all CAA players. Freshman **Justina Mascaro** averaged 6.5 points and 4.5 rebounds.
- Drexel (16-5; 8-1):** The Dragons pushed their winning streak to six games with a pair of home wins against Elon and Northeastern. Senior **Kelsi Lidge** averaged 14.0 points and 6.5 rebounds last week, including 17 points and eight rebounds in the win over Elon. Rookie **Hannah Nihill** averaged 7.0 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game.
- Elon (13-7; 5-4):** The Phoenix split road games, falling at Drexel by a basket before topping Towson. Senior **Shay Burnett** averaged 17.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 6.5 assists for the week while shooting 50 percent (12-for-24) from the field.
- Hofstra (10-11; 4-6):** The short-handed Pride dropped a pair of hard-fought road games to James Madison and William & Mary. **Boogie Brozowski** averaged 13.0 points and 6.0 assists while **Mikayah Croskey** averaged 13.0 points and 5.5 rebounds. Croskey had a career night against JMU with 18 points and six rebounds.
- James Madison (13-7; 9-0):** The Dukes remained undefeated in CAA play with a pair of home wins against Hofstra and Charleston. Center **Kayla Cooper-Williams** averaged a double-double for the week with 10.0 points and 10.5 rebounds per game to go along with six total blocks. Cooper-Williams went 6-for-7 from the field (.857) and 8-for-10 (.800) from the free throw line.
- UNCW (7-13; 0-9):** The Seahawks dropped their only game of the week at Delaware, 80-62. Senior guard **Madison Raque** paced the Seahawks with a game-high 21 points, making 9-of-17 shots from the floor, while contributing four assists. Senior center **Rebekah Banks** added her second double-double (11pts, 12reb).
- Northeastern (10-10; 5-4):** The Huskies split road games, topping Delaware before falling at Drexel. Junior **Jess Genco** turned in another impressive week, averaging 15.5 points, with seven three-pointers, 5.5 assists and 39.5 minutes per game. Rookie **Stella Clark** came off the bench to average 4.0 points per game.
- Towson (8-12; 3-6):** The Tigers dropped their only game of the week, a 71-45 decision to Elon. Senior **Raine Bankston** paced Towson with 16 points while **Nukiya Mayo** had a game-high 10 rebounds.
- William & Mary (14-6; 5-4):** The Tribe posted a pair of home wins against Charleston and Hofstra. Guard **Bianca Boggs** had a stellar week averaging 25.0 points, 7.5 rebounds, 5.0 steals, 4.5 assists and 3.0 blocks per game.

## #CAAHOOPS IN THE RPI

- In the NCAA RPI released on January 29, three CAA teams were in the top-100. Drexel had an RPI of 43 followed by Elon (77) and James Madison (91).
- As a league, the CAA was rated tenth.

## #CAAHOOPS HOT SHOTS

- Northeastern's **Jess Genco** has tied the CAA's longest double-digit scoring streak this season at 17 games. Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** had her 17-game streak stopped on January 21.
- Two CAA teams are in the top-11 nationally in blocks. William & Mary is the national leader in total blocks (168) and in blocks per game (8.4). Towson is 11th in total blocks (127) and tenth in blocks per game (6.4).
- Three teams in the CAA are in the top-25 nationally in rebounds per game. Towson and Delaware are tied for 18th (43.55) while Elon is 21st (43.15).
- Elon is also 24th in rebound margin (+8.4) while Delaware is ninth in defensive rebounds per game (30.0) and Towson is fifth in offensive rebounds per game (18.0).
- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** leads the CAA in scoring (18.8ppg) and is nationally ranked in several categories. She's 14th in total rebounds (244), ninth in rebounds per game (12.2), fourth in defensive rebounds per game (9.0), fourth in double-doubles (14), 22nd in free throws made (106) and 13th in free throws attempted (150).
- There has only been one overtime game in CAA play this season, with William & Mary and Drexel going to the extra session on January 9. CAA teams have gone to overtime just six times this year with three of those contests belonging to the Tribe.
- Drexel is yielding just 56.6 points per game. The Dragons have held their last 11 opponents under 60 points.
- Drexel has held two opponents to just three points in a quarter this season, the lowest in the CAA. Most recently, the Dragons held Hofstra to three points in the first quarter on January 21. Drexel also held Lafayette to three points in the second quarter on December 1.
- Elon's **Malaya Johnson** is shooting 66.0 percent (35-53) from the field over her last five games.
- Elon is 6-1 in games immediately following a loss.
- James Madison senior **Hailee Barron** has appeared in 121 consecutive games for the Dukes, which is tied for the eighth-longest streak in JMU history.
- The Dukes have blocked at least six shots in eight of the last nine games.
- James Madison's **Kayla Cooper-Williams** has gone 14-for-18 from the free throw line over the last five games.
- College of Charleston's **Deja Ford** has made 16 consecutive free throws since January 12. Ford also is averaging 14.0 points over her last five games.
- Delaware has reached 80+ points five times this season. The last time Delaware logged 80-plus points at least five times in a season came during the 2011-12 slate.
- William & Mary's senior class – **Jeanne Gaumont**, **Jenna Green** and **Abby Rendle** are the winningest class in school history with 64 victories.

## #CAAHOOPS IN THE MID-MAJOR POLLS

- College Insider Mid-Major Poll: Three CAA teams were recognized in this week's poll.
- James Madison jumped up four spots to No. 18.
- Drexel re-entered the poll at No. 20, it's highest ranking of the season and first since January 2.
- Elon fell out of the poll for the first time all year, but still received votes.

## HOME SWEET HOME

- Drexel and Elon are both undefeated at home.
- The Dragons are 9-0 overall at the DAC and 5-0 in league play.
- The Phoenix is 8-0 overall at Alumni Gym and 5-0 in CAA action.

## CAREER MILESTONE WATCH

- Hofstra's **Ashunae Durant** is the CAA's career active leader in points (1418) and rebounds (993). She's on pace to become the 16th player in CAA history to have 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds and the first to reach the mark since 2012-13 when **Elena Delle Donne** (Delaware), **Danielle Parker** (Delaware) and **Shante Evans** (Hofstra) completed the feat.
- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** and Elon's **Malaya Johnson** both reached the 1,000 career point milestone. Enabosi's bucket came on January 19 at UNCW while Johnson's basket came against Enabosi and the Blue Hens on January 21.
- William & Mary's **Abby Rendle** (991) is closing in on her 1,000th career point.
- James Madison's **Kayla Cooper-Williams** became the eighth Duke in program history to reach 100 blocks her career doing so at College of Charleston on January 19. Cooper-Williams has 105 blocks.
- Senior guard **Jenna Green** stands second all-time at William & Mary with 487 assists needs just 17 more to set the school record.
- Northeastern guard **Jess Genco** needs seven points for the 900th of her career.

## BIG BLOCKER

- William & Mary center **Abby Rendle** blocked nine shots against Old Dominion on December 17 to surpass former Delaware Blue Hen and WNBA superstar **Elena Delle Donne** has the CAA's career blocks leader. Rendle brought her total to 275, breaking Delle Donne's record of 273 blocks.
- Rendle blocked her 300th shot against Elon on January 14. She currently has 323 blocks and is one of only three players in the NCAA that have 300 career blocks. She joins Duke's **Bego Faz Davalos** (363) and South Carolina's **A'ja Wilson** (326) in the 300 club.
- This season, Rendle leads the nation with 5.05 blocks per game and 101 total blocks.
- Rendle's 101 total blocks are tied for third all-time in CAA single season history, a mark which Rendle posted last year. The league's single season record is 110 set by Richmond's Amy Dorsett in 1996-97.
- Rendle tied the CAA single game record for blocks with 11 against Charleston on January 26. She tied the mark originally set by Georgia State's **Marcquitta Head** on December 3, 2006.
- William & Mary tied the CAA single game record with 17 blocks against Charleston on January 26. Elon set the standard of 17 against ETSU on November 29, 2015.

## HELPING THEM OUT

- William & Mary senior guard **Jenna Green** is 12th in the nation in assists per game (6.7) and 15th in total assists (133).
- Elon's **Shay Burnett** is 23rd with 5.9 assists per game.
- There have been nine 10-assist games in the CAA this season.
- Northeastern's **Jess Genco** and William & Mary's **Jenna Green** have the most helpers in a single game this season with 12 assists. Genco did it against Houston on November 25 while Green did it against Elon on January 14.
- As a team, Drexel has the most assists in a single game this year with 25 against La Salle on November 16.

## COACHES CORNER

- Head Coach **Denise Dillon** became Drexel's all-time winningest coach, notching her 265th career victory. Dillon stands fourth all-time in CAA victories, posting 177 wins in CAA regular season/tournament games.
- Hofstra Head Coach **Krista Kilburn-Steveskey** notched her 200th career coaching victory on January 14 with the Pride's win over Charleston. Kilburn-Steveskey is already the program's all-time wins leader and saw her record improve to 201-167 in her 12th season at Hofstra. Kilburn-Steveskey stands sixth all-time in CAA victories, posting 113 wins in CAA regular season/tournament games.

- The 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship tournament will be held March 7-10 at the Daskalakis Athletic Center (DAC) in Philadelphia, Pa. and will be hosted by Drexel.

## WBCA'S 'SO YOU WANT TO BE A COACH'

- Elon's **Shay Burnett** and UNCW's **Jenny DeGraaf** were selected for the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's (WBCA) 16th annual "So You Want To Be A Coach" program.
- Burnett and DeGraaf will participate in the three-day workshop with speakers provided by the Alliance on March 28-30 in conjunction with the WBCA Convention in Columbus, Ohio.
- The objectives of the "So" program are to increase the understanding and application of skills necessary to secure coaching positions in women's basketball, increase the understanding and awareness of competencies necessary for success in coaching, introduce female basketball players to coaches and administrators, and raise awareness of the existing talent pool of female basketball players who have a passion and interest in coaching the game of women's basketball.

## 20-20 CLUB

- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** recorded 23 points and 20 rebounds in the non-league final against Loyola on December 22. It was the first 20-20 game in the CAA since the 2012-13 season. That year, Hofstra's **Shante Evans** had 33 points and 23 boards against Mason while William & Mary's **Emily Correal** had 24 points and 21 rebounds in the season opener against East Carolina.

## THE BIG 3-0

- There have been a pair of 30-point games in the CAA this season.
- William & Mary's **Bianca Boggs** tallied 33 points in the win over Saint Francis (PA) on December 2.
- Northeastern's **Claudia Ortiz** netted 31 points at Elon on January 7, including seven three-pointers.

## I'LL HAVE ANOTHER TRIPLE-DOUBLE

- Elon senior **Shay Burnett** recorded the second triple-double in the CAA this season with 10 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists on November 27 against Coker. It was the first triple-double in Elon history.
- William & Mary center **Abby Rendle** notched her third career triple-double at East Carolina on November 21. Rendle finished with a 25 points, 17 rebounds and 10 blocks.
- This is the second consecutive season in which the CAA has had multiple triple-doubles. Former Hofstra guard **Krystal Luciano** and Rendle completed the feat last year.
- Rendle has all three points-rebounds-blocks triple-doubles since 2006. Rendle also had a triple-double against East Carolina last season (14pts, 11reb, 10blk). Rendle's first triple-double (and William & Mary's first) came in 2015-16, against UNCW (24pts, 15reb, 10blk).
- With three career triple-doubles, Rendle is tied with former ODU and WNBA standout **Ticha Penicheiro** for the most in CAA history.

## #CAAHOOPS IN NON-LEAGUE PLAY

- The CAA went 63-48 in non-league play.
- The CAA had success against the A-10, going 10-4, the American (3-1), the Patriot League (8-3) and the NEC (5-0).
- The CAA went 34-14 at home in non-league play. Three teams (UNCW, Drexel, Elon) went unbeaten.
- The CAA averaged 67.7 points per game while opponents averaged 65.1 points a contest.
- The CAA averaged 38.9 rebounds per game and held opponents to 37.5 boards.

## HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

- With its 106-54 win over Coker on November 27, Elon recorded the first 100-point game in the CAA since March 4, 2015 when James Madison scored 107 points against College of Charleston.
- Since 1998-99, there have been 21 games in which a CAA team has scored 100+ points.

## HEY ROOKIE!

- Northeastern's **Stella Clark** is the first player in CAA history to be awarded with the first three CAA Rookie of the Week honors of the year since the award's creation in 2002-03.
- Clark is only the second player in CAA history to earn three consecutive nods at any point in the year; **Elena Delle Donne** did it twice in 2009-10 en route to her record-setting 10 CAA Rookie of the Week honors.

## HELLO, COACHES

- There are three new coaches on the sidelines this season, two of which are familiar faces.
- Head Coach **Karen Barefoot** takes the helm of UNCW. She was previously in the league as the leader of ODU.
- Head Coach **Natasha Adair** returns to the CAA sidelines, taking over the helm of Delaware. Adair led CofC during its first CAA season.
- Head Coach **Diane Richardson** will guide Towson this season. Richardson was a longtime assistant coach at West Virginia.

## THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT TIME

- Elon headed to the Puerto Rico Clasico which was relocated to Fort Lauderdale, Fla. The Phoenix opened action with a win over (RV/RV) Alabama but fell to (RV/RV) Iowa.
- Drexel traveled to Melbourne, Fla. for the relocated Paradise Jam. The Dragons fell to (RV) Virginia Tech in the opening round and No. 11/13 West Virginia on the second day but downed Butler on the final day. Sophomore **Aubree Brown** landed a spot on the All-Tournament Team, averaging 9.7 points and 4.0 assists per game.
- Northeastern split games at the UMass Thanksgiving Classic topping host UMass before being edged by Houston.
- James Madison headed north for the TD Bank Classic which was hosted by Vermont. The Dukes were edged by Villanova but downed the host Catamounts. Sophomore **Kamiah Smalls** was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 18.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals per game.
- Hofstra split games at the Lady Rebel Round-Up in Las Vegas. The Pride was clipped by host UNLV before knocking off Wake Forest. Senior **Aleana Leon** was named to the All-Tournament team after averaging 14.5 points and 6.5 rebounds.
- Delaware made a trip to Philadelphia for the Saint Joseph's Thanksgiving Tournament. After falling to Saint Peter's by a basket in double overtime, the Hens trounced Eastern Illinois. **Nicole Enabosi** was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 24.0 points and 14.0 rebounds.

- James Madison was predicted to capture the 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship while Elon senior **Shay Burnett** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in a vote of the league's 10 head coaches.
- The Dukes had 78 points, including six first-place votes while Elon, the defending champs, was second with 74 points, including three first-place votes.
