PLAYER OF THE WEEK

BOOGIE BROZOSKI | HOFSTRA JUNIOR | GUARD | CAMBRIA HEIGHTS, N.Y./LONG ISLAND LUTHERAN (MICHIGAN)

Junior guard Boogie Brozoski found her rhythm with the Pride this weekend, putting up two career performances to help Hofstra to its first two league wins of the season. Brozoski averaged 17.0 points, 6.5 assists and 5.5 rebounds while shooting 57.1 percent (12-for-21) from the field, 46.2 percent (6-for-13) from three-point range, and making all four free throws she attempted. She also had three steals on the week. She recorded her first career double-double in a 75-60 win at Charleston, posting 16 points, which tied a career high, and 10 assists, which was her all-time best. She then surpassed her points mark on Sunday, dropping 18 points, all in the pivotal second half, as the Pride took down UNCW, 69-61. The transfer, who became eligible five games ago, is averaging 10.6 points, 4.6 rebounds and 4.0 assists for the Pride.

Guard Stella Clark picked up her fourth Rookie of the Week nod by averaging 8.5 points, 4.5 rebounds during Northeastern's 1-1 week against UNCW and Elon. Clark led the Huskies bench in the win at UNCW with 11 points, for her sixth double-digit scoring game of the season. She also grabbed a season-best six boards against the Seahawks. Against Elon, Clark went 2-for-3 from the field for six points and grabbed three boards.

#CAAHOOPS REWIND

- Charleston (5-10; 1-2): The Cougars had a pair of home losses to Hofstra and Delaware. Bri Sullivan averaged 14.0 points on 61.9 percent shooting while Shiclasia Brown averaged 12.0 points and
- Delaware (9-5; 2-1): The Blue Hens went 2-0 topping Elon before picking up a road win at Charleston. Junior Nicole Enabosi averaged 18.5 points and 9.0 rebounds while sophomore Abby Gonzales averaged 15.5 points and 7.0 assists while shooting 61.5 percent from the field.
- Drexel (10-5; 2-1): After its game at William & Mary was postponed, the Dragons fell at James Madison, their first CAA loss of the season. Bailey Greenberg posted a career-best 19 points in the
- Elon (10-4; 2-1): The Phoenix split games, falling at Delaware before picking up a home win against Northeastern. Sophomore Ra'Shika White averaged 19.0 points and 8.0 rebounds on the
- Hofstra (8-7; 2-2): The Pride picked up a pair of road wins at Charleston and UNCW to even its record in CAA play. Transfer Boogie Brozoski averaged 17.0 points and 6.5 assists while rookie Mikiyah Croskey averaged 5.5 points and 3.0 rebounds.
- James Madison (8-7; 4-0): The Dukes remained undefeated in CAA play with wins over Towson and Drexel. Sophomore Kamiah Smalls averaged 12.0 points and 5.0 rebounds on the week as she extended her double-digit scoring streak to 15
- UNCW (7-8; 0-4): The Seahawks had a pair of home losses to Northeastern and Hofstra. Lacey Suggs averaged 16.0 points and 8.0 rebounds while Rebekah Banks averaged 13.0 rebounds per game. Banks has grabbed at least 10 boards in each of her last three games.
- Northeastern (8-7; 2-2): The Huskies split road games, picking up a win at UNCW before falling to Elon. Junior Jess Genco averaged 16.0 points, 6.0 assists and 5.5 steals for the week. Claudia Ortiz posted 31 points, including seven three-pointers, in the loss at Elon. Rookie **Stella Clark** averaged 8.5 points and 4.5 boards on the weekend.
- Towson (6-9; 1-3): The Tigers split road games, falling at James Madison before knocking off William & Mary. Mary Cuevas had another impressive week, averaging 16.5 points, 8.5 rebounds and 3.0 blocks per game. She notched 23 points and 14 boards in the win at William & Mary. Rookie Tess Borgosz averaged 5.0 points per game and was a perfect 6-for-6 from the charity stripe.
- William & Mary (11-3; 2-1): After their game against Drexel was postponed, the Tribe fell to Towson at home in its first CAA loss of the season. Abby Rendle nearly missed a triple-double, finishing with 16 points, nine blocks and eight rebounds.

#CAAHOOPS HOT SHOTS

- Head Coach Denise Dillon became Drexel's alltime winningest coach, notching her 265th career victory. Dillon stands fourth all-time in CAA victories, posting 171 wins in CAA regular season/ tournament games.
- Hofstra Head Coach Krista Kilburn-Steveskey is closing in on her 200th career coaching victory. She enters the week with 199.
- Two CAA teams are in the top-20 nationally in blocks. William & Mary is the national in total blocks (111) and in blocks per game (7.9). Towson is 15th in total blocks (92) and 11th in blocks per game (6.1).
- Elon has only been out-rebounded once this season (NC State on December 16 by a margin of 40-33). The Phoenix has a +10.9 rebounding margin which ranks them eighth in the nation. The Phoenix is also 15th in rebounds per game (44.36).
- Elon and Drexel are holding opponents to 60 points or fewer this season. The Phoenix is allowing just 58.5 points per game while the Dragons are yielding just 60.3 points per game. The Dragons have held their last five opponents under 60 points.
- Drexel held Lafayette to three points in the second quarter on December 1. It is the fewest points allowed in a quarter in the CAA this season.
- Delaware's Nicole Enabosi recorded 23 points and 20 rebounds in the non-league final against Loyola on December 22. It was the first 20-20 game in the CAA since the 2012-13 season. That year, Hofstra's Shante Evans had 33 points and 23 boards against Mason while William & Mary's Emily Correal had 24 points and 21 rebounds in the season opener against East Carolina.
- Enabosi leads the CAA in scoring (19.9ppg) and is nationally ranked in several categories. She's 15th in rebounds (168), tenth in rebounds per game (12.0), fifth in defensive rebounds per game (9.0), sixth in double-doubles (10), 16th in free throws made (81) and ninth in free throws attempted
- Five Huskies are averaging double figures in scoring, the only team in the CAA to do so this season: Stella Clark (10.5), Claudia Ortiz (13.6), Gabby Giacone (11.8), Jess Genco (14.4) and Shannon Todd (12.3).
- Hofstra's Olivia Askin went 6-for-6 from threepoint range at Charleston on January 5. It is just the seventh time in CAA history in which a player has gone a perfect 6-for-6 from beyond the arc.
- Drexel came away with a 20 steals against Lafayette on December 1, the most in the CAA this season. The Dragons have a league-best 157 steals this season.
- UNCW made a season-high 34 made field goals the win over N.C. Central. The 34 made field goals were the most since March 9, 2012, when the Seahawks were 34-of-71 against Hofstra.
- Northeastern made 15 three-pointers at Vermont on December 17, tying the Huskies for third alltime in CAA single game history.
- James Madison senior Hailee Barron appeared in her 116th consecutive game on January 7 against
- The Dukes' Kamiah Smalls has scored in double digits in all 15 games this season. She's second in the CAA in scoring, averaging 16.5 points per game.

#CAAHOOPS IN THE RPI

- In the NCAA RPI released on January 8, two CAA teams were in the top-100. Drexel had an RPI of 63 followed by Elon at 73.
- As a league, the CAA was rated tenth.

#CAAHOOPS IN THE POLLS

- USA Today WBCA Coaches Poll: Elon received votes in the Preseason Poll as well as the poll released on November 21.
- College Insider Mid-Major Poll: Elon moved up one spot to No. 5 while Drexel entered the poll at No. 22 on January 2. In addition, William & Mary and James Madison received votes.

#CAAHOOPS IN NON-LEAGUE PLAY

- The CAA went 63-48 in non-league play.
- The CAA had success against the A-10, going 10-4, the American (3-1), the Patriot League (8-3) and the NEC (5-0).
- The CAA went 34-14 at home in non-league play. Three teams (UNCW, Drexel, Elon) went unbeaten.
- The CAA averaged 67.7 points per game while opponents averaged 65.1 points a contest.
- The CAA averaged 38.9 rebounds per game and held opponents to 37.5 boards.

CAREER MILESTONE WATCH

- Hofstra's Ashunae Durant is the CAA's career active leader in points (1374) and rebounds (950). She's on pace to become the first player since 2012-2013 to reach 1,000 points and 1,000 boards. Elena Delle Donne (Delaware), Danielle Parker (Delaware) and Shante Evans (Hofstra) were the last two players to complete the feat.
- Delaware's Nicole Enabosi (951), Elon's Malaya Johnson (950) and William & Mary's Abby Rendle (945) are closing in on their 1,000th career points.
- James Madison's Kayla Cooper-Williams has 97 blocks. With three, she'll become the eighth Duke in program history to reach 100 blocks.

BIG BLOCKER

- William & Mary center Abby Rendle blocked nine shots against Old Dominion on December 17 to surpass former Delaware Blue Hen and WNBA superstar Elena Delle Donne has the CAA's career blocks leader. Rendle brought her total to 275, breaking Delle Donne's record of 273 blocks.
- Rendle leads the nation with 5.0 blocks per game and 70 total blocks.

HELPING THEM OUT

- William & Mary senior guard Jenna Green is ninth in the nation is assists per game (6.9) and 18th in total assists (92).
- Northeastern's **Jess Genco** is 23rd in assists (92) and assists per game (6.1) and third nationally in minutes per game (39.07)
- The Tribe is ranked 19th in assists per game (18.1).
- There have been seven 10-assist games in the CAA this season.
- Elon accounts for three of those efforts, with Shay Burnett doing it twice and rookie Saadia Munford registering one.
- Northeastern's Jess Genco has the most helpers in a single game this season with 12 assists against Houston on November 25.
- As a team, Drexel has the most assists in a single game this year with 25 against La Salle on November 16.

THF BIG 3-0

- There have been a pair of 30-point games in the CAA this season.
- William & Mary's Bianca Boggs tallied 33 points in the win over Saint Francis (PA) on December 2.
- Northeastern's Claudia Ortiz netted 31 points at Elon on January 7, a total which included seven three-pointers.

I'LL HAVE ANOTHER TRIPLE-DOUBLE

- Elon senior **Shay Burnett** recorded the second triple-double in the CAA this season with 10 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists. It was the first triple-double in Elon history.
- William & Mary center Abby Rendle notched her third career triple-double at East Carolina on November 21. Rendle finished with a 25 points, 17 rebounds and 10 blocks.
- This is the second consecutive season in which the CAA has had multiple triple-doubles. Former Hofstra guard Krystal Luciano and Rendle completed the feat last year.
- Rendle has all three points-rebounds-blocks triple-doubles since 2006. Rendle also had a triple-double against East Carolina last season (14pts, 11reb, 10blk). Rendle's first triple-double (and William & Mary's first) came in 2015-16, against UNCW (24pts, 15reb, 10blk).

HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

- With its 106-54 win over Coker on November 27, Elon recorded the first 100-point game in the CAA since March 4, 2015 when James Madison scored 107 points against College of Charleston.
- Since 1998-99, there have been 21 games in which a CAA team has scored 100+ points.

HEY ROOKIE!

- Northeastern's **Stella Clark** is the first player in CAA history to be awarded with the first three CAA Rookie of the Week honors of the year since the award's creation in 2002-03.
- Clark is only the second player in CAA history to earn three consecutive nods at any point in the year; Elena Delle Donne did it twice in 2009-10 en route to her record-setting 10 CAA Rookie of the Week honors.

HELLO, COACHES

- There are three new coaches on the sidelines this season, two of which are familiar faces.
- Head Coach Karen Barefoot takes the helm of UNCW. She was previously in the league as the leader of ODU.
- Head Coach Natasha Adair returns to the CAA sidelines, taking over the helm of Delaware. Adair led CofC during its first CAA season.
- Head Coach Diane Richardson will guide Towson this season. Richardson was a longtime assistant coach at West Virginia.

THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT TIME

- Elon headed to the Puerto Rico Clasico which was relocated to Fort Lauderdale, Fla. The Phoenix opened action with a win over (RV/RV) Alabama but fell to (RV/RV) lowa.
- Drexel traveled to Melbourne, Fla. for the relocated Paradise Jam. The Dragons fell to (RV) Virginia Tech in the opening round and No. 11/13 West Virginia on the second day but downed Butler on the final day. Sophomore Aubree Brown landed a spot on the All-Tournament Team, averaging 9.7 points and 4.0 assists per game.
- Northeastern split games at the UMass Thanksgiving Classic topping host UMass before being edged by Houston.
- James Madison headed north for the TD Bank Classic which was hosted by Vermont. The Dukes were edged by Villanova but downed the host Catamounts. Sophomore Kamiah Smalls was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 18.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals per game.
- Hofstra split games at the Lady Rebel Round-Up in Las Vegas. The Pride was clipped by host UNLV before knocking off Wake Forest. Senior Aleana Leon was named to the All-Tournament team after averaging 14.5 points and 6.5 rebounds.
- Delaware made a trip to Philadelphia for the Saint Joseph's Thanksgiving Tournament. After falling to Saint Peter's by a basket in double overtime, the Hens trounced Eastern Illinois. Nicole Enabosi was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 24.0 points and 14.0 rebounds.

#CAAHOOPS INTERNATIONALLY SPEAKING

- The are 15 international players hailing for 10 different countries in the CAA this season.
- Hofstra's roster features eight international player in sophomores Marianne Kalin and Sandra Karsten (Finland), Ana Hernandez Gil (Canary Islands) and Petja Krupenko (Slovenia); freshman Mie Hoff (Norway), junior transfer Sica Cuzic (Romania), junior Kayla Minott (Canada) and senior Aleana Leon (Puerto Rico).
- Drexel has the second most at three international players in sophomore Ana Ferariu (Romania) and juniors Tereza Kracikova (Czech Republic) and Eline Maesschalk (Belgium).

KATRINA MCCLAIN AWARD WATCH LIST

- Hofstra senior Ashunae Durant was named one of 20 candidates for the Katrina McClain Award, which recognized the top power forward in women's basketball.
- The list will be fluid, with players able to be added a removed from the list throughout the season. It will be narrowed to 10 in mid-February before the five ultimate finalists are announced in March.

2017 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- James Madison was predicted to capture the 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship while Elon senior Shay Burnett was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in a vote of the league's 10 head coaches.
- The Dukes had 78 points, including six first-place votes while Elon, the defending champs, was second with 74 points, including three first-place votes. Rounding out the top-seven was William & Mary (58), Drexel (51), Delaware (48), Northeastern (47) and Hofstra (43). Towson and UNCW were tied for eighth while CofC was tenth.
- Only six of the top-20 leading scorers from last season return for the respective teams. Yet, 11 of the top-20 leading rebounders from one year ago will be back to clean the glass.
- Only four of the 15 All-CAA honorees from last year return for the 2017-18 season.

2018 CAA CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

- The 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship tournament will be held March 7-10 at the Daskalakis Athletic Center (DAC) in Philadelphia, Pa. and will be hosted by Drexel.
- The opening round, quarterfinals and semifinals will be streamed exclusively on CAA.tv. The final will be aired on NBC Sports Washington & Philadelphia and SNY and streamed via CollegeSportsLive, as part of the conference's partnership with CBSi.
