PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KAMIAH SMALLS | JAMES MADISON SOPHOMORE | GUARD | PHILADELPHIA, PA./NEUMANN GORETTI

Guard Kamiah Smalls had a solid all-around week and even came away with a game-saving block to help James Madison to a 2-0 week. Smalls averaged 14.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists. In the 56-53 win at Delaware, Smalls blocked the Blue Hens' last-second three-point attempt to preserve the victory. She finished with 11 points, six rebounds, five assists and a career-best two blocks. In the win over UNCW, Smalls tallied 17 points, seven rebounds, four assists and two steals to help the Dukes to their fourth consecutive victory. Smalls has scored in double figures in nine straight games and in 25 of 26 this season. It is the second CAA Player of the Week honor for Smalls this season.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

STELLA CLARK | NORTHEASTERN FRESHMAN | GUARD | SEA GIRT, N.J./MANASQUAN

Rookie guard Stella Clark averaged 14.0 points, 3.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists, 2.0 steals and 30.5 minutes to help Northeastern to a 1-1 week. In the win over Towson, Clark returned to the starting lineup and posted 15 points. Against a surging Elon squad, she got the start once more and tallied a team-high 13 points, going 5-for-10 from the floor. It was her ninth double-digit scoring effort of the year. It is her fifth CAA Rookie of the Week nod this season.

#CAAHOOPS REWIND

- **Charleston (6-20; 2-13):** The Cougars had just one game last week, falling on the road to Delaware, 71-59. **Bri Boyd** led the Cougars with 12 points while **Tanisha Brown** grabbed a team-best 11 rebounds.
- **Delaware (16-9; 9-5):** The Blue Hens split games last week, falling by three points to James Madison before downing College of Charleston. Junior **Nicole Enabosi**, who has double-doubles in each of her last four games, averaged 19.5 points, 12.5 rebounds, 3.0 blocks and 3.0 assists per game. Rookie **Lizzie Oleary** averaged 5.5 points and 4.5 rebounds per game.
- **Drexel (19-6; 11-2):** The Dragon notched their 20th win over the season with a 54-34 win over William & Mary in their only game. Drexel also improved to 11-0 at the Daskalakis Athletic Center and completed the season sweep of the Tribe. Defensively, the Dragons held W&M to single digits in all four quarters. **Bailey Greenberg** scored 12 points to lead the team, going 6-for-11 inside the arc, while **Kelsi Lidge** scored 10 points to go along with eight rebounds, four assists, two steals and a block in a solid all-around effort.
- **Elon (19-7; 11-4):** The Phoenix pushed their winning streak to seven games with a pair of road victories at Hofstra and Northeastern. Senior **Malaya Johnson** posted 17.0 points on 72.7 percent shooting (16-for-22). Senior **Shay Burnett** dished out her 500th assist over the weekend, becoming the sixth player in CAA history to record 1,000 points, 500 assists, and 400 rebounds in a career.
- **Hofstra (11-15; 5-10):** The Pride opened the week with a tough loss to Elon, but rebounded with a victory over Towson to snap a seven-game slide. Senior **Aleanna Leon** averaged 18.0 points per game while **Marianne Kalin** averaged 13.0 points and 8.0 rebounds.
- **James Madison (18-8; 14-1):** The Dukes pushed their winning streak to four games with road win at Delaware and a home win at UNCW. **Kamiah Smalls** averaged 14.0 points while **Lexie Barrier** averaged 13.5 points and 2.5 assists per game.
- **UNCW (9-17; 2-13):** The Seahawks split road games, topping William & Mary before falling to first-place James Madison. Redshirt senior **Jenny DeGraaf** had a solid week, averaging 14.5 points and 11.5 rebounds per game.
- **Northeastern (13-13; 8-7):** The Huskies split home games, topping Towson before falling to Elon. Rookie **Stella Clark** averaged 14.0 points, 3.0 assists and 2.0 assists per game.
- **Towson (9-17; 4-11):** The Tigers dropped a pair of road contests to Northeastern and Hofstra. **Danielle Durjan** had a strong week, averaging 16.0 points per game while **Nukiya Mayo** averaged 12.5 points and 10.0 Rebounds per game.
- **William & Mary (16-10; 7-8):** The Tribe had a pair of losses to UNCW and Drexel last week. Senior **Abby Rendle** averaged 10.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game.

#CAAHOOPS IN THE MID-MAJOR POLLS

- **College Insider Mid-Major Poll:** Three CAA teams were recognized in the February 13 poll. James Madison moved up four spots to No. 18 while Drexel moved down five spots to No. 22. Elon checked back into the poll at No. 24.

#CAAHOOPS HOT SHOTS

- With a win at Drexel on Friday, James Madison would clinch the No. 1 seed and at least a share of the CAA Regular Season Championship.
- Elon's **Shay Burnett** joined an exclusive club last weekend. She became just the sixth player in CAA history to record 1,000 points, 500 assists and 400 rebounds in a career.
- Four CAA teams are in the top-25 nationally in blocking. William & Mary is the national leader in total blocks (203) and in blocks per game (7.8). Towson is 12th in total blocks (159) and ninth in blocks per game (6.1). James Madison is 18th in total blocks (147) and 16th in blocks per game (5.7). Delaware is 22nd in blocks per game (5.3).
- Three teams in the CAA are in the top-25 nationally in rebounds per game. Elon is 16th (43.04), UD is 17th (43.00) and Towson is 19th (42.96).
- Elon is also 15th in free throws attempted (586) and 24th in free throws made (401).
- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** leads the CAA in scoring (18.4ppg) and is nationally ranked in several categories. She's 11th in total rebounds (311), sixth in rebounds per game (12.4), fourth in defensive rebounds per game (9.0), fifth in double-doubles (19), 17th in free throws attempted (194) and 17th in free throws made (14.1).
- Enabosi has averaged 18.3 points and 15.0 rebounds in each of the last four games.
- Towson's **Nukiya Mayo** is third nationally in offensive rebounds per game (5.0).
- Drexel is yielding just 55.3 points per game and held its last 16 opponents under 60 points. They are 17th in the country in scoring defense.
- Drexel improved to 20-6 which marks the first time in program history that the Dragons, who went 22-11 last season, have won 20 or more games in back-to-back seasons.
- Drexel held William & Mary to single digits in all four quarters on February 18. It was the first time since the NCAA went to the quarter system three years ago that Drexel held an opponent to single-digit scoring in all four quarters of a game.
- Drexel has held two opponents to just three points in a quarter this season, the lowest in the CAA. Most recently, the Dragons held Hofstra to three points in the first quarter on January 21. Drexel also held Lafayette to three points in the second quarter on December 1.
- Elon's **Malaya Johnson** is shooting 62.5 percent (75-120) from the field over her last 11 games.
- Elon has won nine of its last 10 and is averaging 70.6 points per game while allowing just 52.6 points per contest during the run.
- Elon's seven game winning streak is the second-longest winning streak in the program's Division I era behind only last season's nine-game run.
- Elon's 97-44 win over CofC on February 11 marked the largest margin of victory (53) by the Phoenix in their DI history.
- James Madison senior **Hailee Barron** has appeared in 127 consecutive games for the Dukes, tying JMU Hall of Famer Tamara Young for the second longest streak in JMU history.
- In 15 league games, the Dukes have won the rebounding battle 12 times.
- William & Mary's senior class – **Jeanne Gaumont**, **Jenna Green** and **Abby Rendle** are the winningest class in school history with 66 victories.
- There has only been one overtime game in CAA play this season, with William & Mary and Drexel going to the extra session on January 9. CAA teams have gone to overtime just six times this year with three of those contests belonging to the Tribe.

#CAAHOOPS IN THE RPI

- Entering Friday's contests, three CAA teams were in the top-75 in the NCAA RPI. Elon had an RPI of 50 followed by Drexel (53) and James Madison (72).
- As a league, the CAA was rated tenth.

2018 CAA CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

- The 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship tournament will be held March 7-10 at the Daskalakis Athletic Center (DAC) in Philadelphia, Pa. and will be hosted by Drexel.
- Seeding will be announced upon the conclusion of the regular season. *For CAA tiebreaking procedures, please see page 12 of this report.*
- The opening round, quarterfinals and semifinals will be streamed exclusively on CAA.tv. The final will be aired on NBC Sports Washington & Philadelphia and SNY and streamed via CollegeSportsLive, as part of the conference's partnership with CBSi.

- The CAA Women's Basketball Championship returned to campus last season with James Madison hosting at the Convocation Center in Harrisonburg, Va. Delaware will host the 2019 CAA Championship at the Bob Carpenter Center in Newark.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Drexel and Elon are both undefeated at home on the year.
- The Dragons are 11-0 overall at the DAC and 7-0 in league play.
- The Phoenix is 10-0 overall at Alumni Gym and 7-0 in CAA action. Elon has a 15-game home winning streak dating back to last season.
- James Madison is 7-0 in league play at the Convo.

CAREER MILESTONE WATCH

- Hofstra's **Ashunae Durant** is the CAA's career active leader in points (1418) and rebounds (993). She's on pace to become the 16th player in CAA history to have 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds and the first to reach the mark since 2012-13 when **Elena Delle Donne** (Delaware), **Danielle Parker** (Delaware) and **Shante Evans** (Hofstra) completed the feat.
- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi**, Elon's **Malaya Johnson** and William & Mary's **Abby Rendle** have all reached the 1,000 career point milestone. Enabosi's bucket came on January 19 at UNCW while Johnson's basket came against Enabosi and the Blue Hens on January 21. Rendle scored her milestone point at Delaware on February 9.
- Elon's **Shay Burnett** currently has 1,487 points and is closing in on her 1,500th.
- Northeastern's **Jess Genco** is six three-pointers away from the 200th made of her career.
- Elon's **Malaya Johnson** has 162 career blocks and is 14 away for the CAA's all-time top-10.
- James Madison's **Kayla Cooper-Williams** became the eighth Duke in program history to reach 100 blocks her career doing so at College of Charleston on January 19. Cooper-Williams has 129 blocks.

COACHES CORNER

- Head Coach **Denise Dillon** became Drexel's all-time winningest coach, notching her 265th career victory. Dillon stands fourth all-time in CAA victories, posting 181 wins in CAA regular season/tournament games.
- Hofstra Head Coach **Krista Kilburn-Steveskey** notched her 200th career coaching victory on January 14 with the Pride's win over Charleston. Kilburn-Steveskey is already the program's all-time wins leader and saw her record improve to 201-167 in her 12th season at Hofstra. Kilburn-Steveskey stands sixth all-time in CAA victories, posting 114 wins in CAA regular season/tournament games.

BIG BLOCKER

- William & Mary center **Abby Rendle** blocked nine shots against Old Dominion on December 17 to surpass former Delaware Blue Hen and WNBA superstar **Elena Delle Donne** has the CAA's career blocks leader. Rendle brought her total to 275, breaking Delle Donne's record of 273 blocks.
- Rendle blocked her 300th shot against Elon on January 14. She currently has 339 blocks and is one of only four players in the NCAA that have 300 career blocks. She joins Duke's **Bego Faz Davalos** (369), South Carolina's **A'ja Wilson** (343) and South Alabama's **Chyna Ellis** (313) in the 300 club.
- This season, Rendle leads the nation with 4.58 blocks per game and 119 total blocks.
- Rendle's 119 total blocks, set a new standard in CAA history. On February 9, Rendle had six blocks, breaking the record of 110 set by Richmond's Amy Dorsett in 1996-97.
- Rendle tied the CAA single game record for blocks with 11 against Charleston on January 26. She tied the mark originally set by Georgia State's **Marquitta Head** on December 3, 2006.
- William & Mary tied the CAA single game record with 17 blocks against Charleston on January 26. Elon set the standard of 17 against ETSU on November 29, 2015.
- The Tribe has 203 blocks this season, the second most in CAA history. They need seven more to break the record of 209 held by the 2008-09 Hofstra Pride.
- Towson set multiple institutional records with 14 blocks against Hofstra on February 9. It was a program record, a SECU Arena record (men's or women's), and was the fifth-most blocks in CAA history, tied for second-most in a CAA game and was the fifth-most blocks in a single Division I game this season.

HELPING THEM OUT

- William & Mary senior guard **Jenna Green** became the Tribe's career assist leader on February 11. She has 508 helpers for her career.
- Green is currently 19th in the nation in assists per game (6.42) and 20th total assists (161).
- Elon's **Shay Burnett** is 21st with 6.1 assists per game.
- There have been ten 10-assist games in the CAA this season.
- Northeastern's **Jess Genco** and William & Mary's **Jenna Green** have the most helpers in a single game this season with 12 assists. Genco did it against Houston on November 25 while Green did it against Elon on January 14.
- As a team, Drexel has the most assists in a single game this year with 25 against La Salle on November 16.

I'LL HAVE ANOTHER TRIPLE-DOUBLE

- There have been three triple-doubles in the CAA this season, the most-ever in a single season in league history.
- Drexel's **Aubree Brown** notched the third triple-double in the league with 10 points, 10 rebounds, and 11 assists on February 4 at Charleston. It was the second-ever triple-double in Drexel history with **Abby Redick** doing it for the Dragons in 2014.
- Elon senior **Shay Burnett** recorded the second triple-double in the CAA this season with 10 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists on November 27 against Coker. It was the first triple-double in Elon history.
- William & Mary center **Abby Rendle** notched her third career triple-double at East Carolina on November 21. Rendle finished with a 25 points, 17 rebounds and 10 blocks.
- This is the second consecutive season in which the CAA has had multiple triple-doubles. Former Hofstra guard **Krystal Luciano** and Rendle completed the feat last year.
- Rendle has all three points-rebounds-blocks triple-doubles since 2006. Rendle also had a triple-double against East Carolina last season (14pts, 11reb, 10blk). Rendle's first triple-double (and William & Mary's first) came in 2015-16, against UNCW (24pts, 15reb, 10blk).
- With three career triple-doubles, Rendle is tied with former ODU and WNBA standout **Ticha Penicheiro** for the most in CAA history.

WBCA'S 'SO YOU WANT TO BE A COACH'

- Elon's **Shay Burnett** and UNCW's **Jenny DeGraaf** were selected for the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's (WBCA) 16th annual "So You Want To Be A Coach" program.
- Burnett and DeGraaf will participate in the three-day workshop with speakers provided by the Alliance on March 28-30 in conjunction with the WBCA Convention in Columbus, Ohio.
- The objectives of the "So" program are to increase the understanding and application of skills necessary to secure coaching positions in women's basketball, increase the understanding and awareness of competencies necessary for success in coaching, introduce female basketball players to coaches and administrators, and raise awareness of the existing talent pool of female basketball players who have a passion and interest in coaching the game of women's basketball.

- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** recorded 23 points and 20 rebounds in the non-league final against Loyola on December 22. It was the first 20-20 game in the CAA since the 2012-13 season. That year, Hofstra's **Shante Evans** had 33 points and 23 boards against Mason while William & Mary's **Emily Correal** had 24 points and 21 rebounds in the season opener against East Carolina.

#CAAHOOPS IN NON-LEAGUE PLAY

- The CAA went 63-48 in non-league play.
- The CAA had success against the A-10, going 10-4, the American (3-1), the Patriot League (8-3) and the NEC (5-0).
- The CAA went 34-14 at home in non-league play. Three teams (UNCW, Drexel, Elon) went unbeaten.
- The CAA averaged 67.7 points per game while opponents averaged 65.1 points a contest.
- The CAA averaged 38.9 rebounds per game and held opponents to 37.5 boards.

THE BIG 3-0

- There have been a pair of 30-point games in the CAA this season.
- William & Mary's **Bianca Boggs** tallied 33 points in the win over Saint Francis (PA) on December 2.
- Northeastern's **Claudia Ortiz** netted 31 points at Elon on January 7, including seven three-pointers.

HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

- With its 106-54 win over Coker on November 27, Elon recorded the first 100-point game in the CAA since March 4, 2015 when James Madison scored 107 points against College of Charleston.
- Since 1998-99, there have been 21 games in which a CAA team has scored 100+ points.

HEY ROOKIE!

- Northeastern's **Stella Clark** is the first player in CAA history to be awarded with the first three CAA Rookie of the Week honors of the year since the award's creation in 2002-03.
- Clark is only the second player in CAA history to earn three consecutive nods at any point in the year; **Elena Delle Donne** did it twice in 2009-10 en route to her record-setting 10 CAA Rookie of the Week honors.
- Clark leads the CAA with five Rookie of the Week nods.
- Drexel's **Hannah Nihill** has collected four CAA rookie of the Week honors.

HELLO, COACHES

- There are three new coaches on the sidelines this season, two of which are familiar faces.
- Head Coach **Karen Barefoot** takes the helm of UNCW. She was previously in the league as the leader of ODU.
- Head Coach **Natasha Adair** returns to the CAA sidelines, taking over the helm of Delaware. Adair led CofC during its first CAA season.
- Head Coach **Diane Richardson** will guide Towson this season. Richardson was a longtime assistant coach at West Virginia.

THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT TIME

- Elon headed to the Puerto Rico Clasico which was relocated to Fort Lauderdale, Fla. The Phoenix opened action with a win over (RV/RV) Alabama but fell to (RV/RV) Iowa.
- Drexel traveled to Melbourne, Fla. for the relocated Paradise Jam. The Dragons fell to (RV) Virginia Tech in the opening round and No. 11/13 West Virginia on the second day but downed Butler on the final day. Sophomore **Aubree Brown** landed a spot on the All-Tournament Team, averaging 9.7 points and 4.0 assists per game.
- Northeastern split games at the UMass Thanksgiving Classic topping host UMass before being edged by Houston.
- James Madison headed north for the TD Bank Classic which was hosted by Vermont. The Dukes were edged by Villanova but downed the host Catamounts. Sophomore **Kamiah Smalls** was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 18.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals per game.
- Hofstra split games at the Lady Rebel Round-Up in Las Vegas. The Pride was clipped by host UNLV before knocking off Wake Forest. Senior **Aleana Leon** was named to the All-Tournament team after averaging 14.5 points and 6.5 rebounds.
- Delaware made a trip to Philadelphia for the Saint Joseph's Thanksgiving Tournament. After falling to Saint Peter's by a basket in double overtime, the Hens trounced Eastern Illinois. **Nicole Enabosi** was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 24.0 points and 14.0 rebounds.

#CAAHOOPS INTERNATIONALLY SPEAKING

- There are 15 international players hailing for 10 different countries in the CAA this season.
- Hofstra's roster features eight international players in sophomores **Marianne Kalin** and **Sandra Karsten** (Finland), **Ana Hernandez Gil** (Canary Islands) and **Petja Krupenko** (Slovenia); freshman **Mie Hoff** (Norway), junior transfer **Sica Cuzic** (Romania), junior **Kayla Minott** (Canada) and senior **Aleana Leon** (Puerto Rico).
- Drexel has the second most at three international players in sophomore **Ana Ferariu** (Romania) and juniors **Tereza Kracikova** (Czech Republic) and **Eline Maesschalk** (Belgium).

KATRINA MCCLAIN AWARD WATCH LIST

- Hofstra senior **Ashunae Durant** was named one of 20 candidates for the Katrina McClain Award, which recognized the top power forward in women's basketball.

2017 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- James Madison was predicted to capture the 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship while Elon senior **Shay Burnett** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in a vote of the league's 10 head coaches.
- The Dukes had 78 points, including six first-place votes while Elon, the defending champs, was second with 74 points, including three first-place votes. Rounding out the top-seven was William & Mary (58), Drexel (51), Delaware (48), Northeastern (47) and Hofstra (43). Towson and UNCW were tied for eighth while CofC was tenth.
- Only six of the top-20 leading scorers from last season return for the respective teams. Yet, 11 of the top-20 leading rebounders from one year ago will be back to clean the glass.
- Only four of the 15 All-CAA honorees from last year return for the 2017-18 season.

CAA TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

If ties exist in the conference standings, the following procedure will be utilized to establish seeding for all CAA championships.

1) All ties will be broken 1st through 10th places in descending order.

2) Once one team gains an advantage in the case of a multiple-team tie, revert to the beginning of the tie-breaking policies with the remaining teams.

A. Two Team Ties

1) Regular season conference record.

2) Head-to-head competition.

3) If two tied teams split their two games during the regular season, compare each tied team's record against the team occupying the highest position in the standings and continue down through the standings until one team gains the advantage, thereby earning the higher seed. When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against a team or group is unequal. If the winning percentage of the tied teams is equal against a team, or a group of tied teams, continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

a) When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tie-breaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.

4) If a tie still exists, the Ratings Percentage Index (RPI), as computed from the RPI Report by 9:00 a.m., on the day following the last scheduled conference game, will be used to break the tie. The team with the better RPI will earn the higher seed.

B. Multiple (3 or more teams) Ties

1) Head to head competition as determined by the combined record of games among the tied teams involved. Ties will be broken and seeds will be based on the winning percentage of games amongst the tied teams, even if the number of games played against the group is unequal;

2) If procedure B1 fails to break the tie, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage by a higher winning percentage as described in B1.

3) If the tie is broken by B1 or B2 regarding one or more teams, but three or more teams remain tied, then procedures B1 and B2 will be re-applied among those tied teams only. If two teams remain tied, revert to the two-tied team procedure.

4) If a tie still exists, the RPI, as computed from the RPI Report by 9:00 a.m., on the day following the last scheduled conference game, will be used to break the tie. The team with the better RPI will earn the higher seed.
