PLAYER OF THE WEEK

ALEX WOODALL | TOWSON JUNIOR | FACEOFF SPECIALIST | ANNAPOLIS, MD./ST. MARY'S HIGH SCHOOL

Junior faceoff specialist Alex Woodall had a career day on Saturday in Towson's 15-13 win over visiting Mount St. Mary's. Woodall won 21 of his 31 draws (67%) while snapping up 14 ground balls. Entering last weekend's games, no Division I faceoff man had won more than 19 faceoffs in a single game and only one player had more than 14 ground balls in a single game. Woodall added a goal to his afternoon, the seventh of his career.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

CHRIS CONNOLLY | UMASS FRESHMAN | ATTACK | GLASTONBURY, CONN./TRINITY-PAWLING (N.Y.)

Rookie Chris Connolly made a spectacular Garber Field debut with four goals, including the eventual game-winner, and three ground balls as Massachusetts downed Sacred Heart, 13-9, for its first win of the spring. His first ground ball of the day directly led to UMass' second goal as he won the team its second faceoff before Jake Lisauskas scored 30 seconds later. He teamed with Buddy Carr to thwart the Sacred Heart comeback attempt as Connolly converted for three of his four goals during the pivotal second half. His hat trick-sealing goal came on a highlight-reel play where Connolly caught a feed from Dom St. Laurent in-stride at the Sacred Heart crease, pivoted over his right shoulder and, with his back to the cage, shoveled an underhand goal behind his trailing defender but inside the left post.

#CAALAX WEEKLY ROUNDUP

- **No. RV Delaware (2-0):** The Blue Hens improved to 2-0 with an 11-6 win over NJIT. Senior **Will Hirschmann** posted his second-straight hat trick, finishing with three goals and an assist. **Austin Haynes** notched two caused turnovers and came away with four ground balls. In the cage, **Matt DeLuca** posted 14 saves.
- **Drexel (0-1):** The Dragons opened the year with a 13-8 loss to No. 11 Virginia at Vidas Field. **Will Manganiello** put together his second career hat trick, adding an assist for a career-best four points. **Matthew Varian**, seeing his first action since 2016 after missing last year due to injury, chipped in two goals and an assist.
- **Fairfield (1-1):** The Stags picked up their first win of the season with an 11-6 victory at Saint Joseph's. In addition to scoring his first career goal, **Will Fox** was dominant at the faceoff X, going 17-for-21 (.810) and collecting 14 ground balls to match the known program record. He also had a goal. Adding to the offense was **Brendan Quinn** who had a hat trick while **Dylan Beckwith** had three assists.
- **No. RV/RV Hofstra (0-1):** The Pride battled it out with No. 6/6 Ohio State but fell on the road to the Buckeyes, 9-7. Hofstra rallied from a 5-0 first quarter deficit to get within one goal at 7-6, before the sixth-ranked Buckeyes tallied two of the final three scores. Hofstra got three goals in the game from **Jimmy Yanes**, while **Ryan Tierney** added two goals and an assist. **Alex Moeser** posted two assists in the game for the Pride as well. **Jack Concannon** made nine saves in goal.
- **UMass (1-1):** The Minutemen scored the opening four goals and led by as many as five in the second half en route to a 13-9 victory over Sacred Heart at Garber Field on Tuesday afternoon. **Buddy Carr** had hat trick and dished out four assists for a career-high seven points. Freshman **Chris Connolly** potted four goals for his first collegiate hat trick. In total, 11 Minutemen notched at least one point. On the defensive end, **Sean Sconone** picked up his first win as a starting goalie, making 15 saves. Sophomore **Dan O'Brien** accounted for four of the team's nine caused turnovers, which was a career best.
- **No. RV/19 Towson (1-1):** **Jon Mazza** and **Brendan Sunday** each recorded hat tricks to lead Towson to a 15-13 victory over Mount St. Mary's at Johnny Unitas Stadium. Towson gained control of the contest by scoring seven consecutive goals in the second period after Mount St. Mary's tied the game, 5-5. **Alex Woodall** won 21 face-offs for the Tigers. In the cage, **Josh Miller** played the final 45 minutes, making eight saves to notch the win.

#CAALAX AGAINST THE REST

- The CAA is off to a 5-5 start in non-league play.
- Last season, as a league, the CAA went 30-23 against non-league foes and was one of only four conferences to have winning non-league records.

QUICK HITS

- Towson played 40 consecutive games as a ranked program, the longest run since 41 games from 2001-March 21, 2004 (excluding preseason). This week will be the first week in which Towson has not appeared in the USILA Coaches Poll.
- Delaware junior **Andrew Romagnoli** has now registered a point in 21 straight games dating back to the 2016 season. The streak is currently the 14th longest active streak in the country.
- **Spencer Noonan** potted Fairfield's first man-down goal since April 4, 2015 when Colin McLinden converted while the Stags were shorthanded in a win at UMass.
- With three assists at Saint Joseph's, Fairfield's **Dylan Beckwith** extended his team-high point streak to 13 consecutive games. In addition, **Joe Rodrigues** has now scored a goal in seven straight contests.
- Delaware is off to 2-0 start for the first time since 2012.

#CAALAX IN THE RANKINGS

- **Inside Lacrosse Maverik Media Poll:** In the second poll of the season, Towson remained at No. 19 while Hofstra and Delaware received votes.
- **USILA Coaches Poll:** Towson fell out of the poll in week two but received votes as did Hofstra.
- **Nike/US Lacrosse Magazine Top-20:** In the second weekly poll, Hofstra checked into the No. 156 slot while Towson and Delaware received consideration.

#CAALAX GAME OF THE WEEK ON LSN

- The CAA and Lax Sports Network extended their partnership for two more seasons, bringing unprecedented coverage of the league.
- The 2018 CAA Game of the Week package includes 11 men's and five women's regular-season lacrosse contests. In addition to the 16 regular season contests, the network will provide live coverage of both the CAA Men's Lacrosse Championship and the CAA Women's Lacrosse Championship.
- The CAA Men's Lacrosse Game of the Week schedule will feature four non-league games in addition to seven league games, with each team appearing three times. Action begins on February 24 with Towson hosting Georgetown. Other non-league contests include: Villanova at Delaware on March 3, North Carolina at Hofstra on March 10 and Penn State at Fairfield on March 17. Drexel and UMass kick off league play with a March 31 contest in Philadelphia.
- LSN is also launching a new 30-minute show called "CAA Press Pass" which is a weekly look at CAA lacrosse with highlights of the week's previous games, previews of the Game of the Week on LSN, a look at standings and rankings and additional feature content.

HELLO, COACH

- Delaware has a new face patrolling the sidelines as **Ben DeLuca** becomes just the ninth coach in the 67-year history of the sport at Delaware, replacing legendary mentor Bob Shillinglaw
- DeLuca, who spent the last two seasons as associate head coach at Harvard DeLuca comes to Delaware with an impressive history of success as a student-athlete and coach at three of the nation's top academic and NCAA Division I lacrosse-playing institutions: Cornell, Duke, and Harvard. During that time he led teams to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances, including a national championship title as an assistant at Duke, a national runner-up finish as an assistant at Cornell, and three other NCAA semifinal appearances as a head coach and as an assistant.

2018 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- Towson was picked to four-peat as CAA Men's Lacrosse title. Towson collected 24 points and four first-place votes while Hofstra was picked second in the poll with 22 points and two first-place votes. They were followed by UMass in third with 15 points and Drexel in fourth with 14 points. Rounding out the order of finish was Fairfield (8) and Delaware (7).
- Towson junior **Zach Goodrich** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in a vote of the league's six head coaches.
- Five CAA players earned Inside Lacrosse Media Preseason All-American recognition. Towson short stick defensive midfielder **Zach Goodrich** and Hofstra goalie **Jack Concannon** were named to the Preseason All-America First Team. Receiving honorable mention were Towson faceoff specialist **Alex Woodall**, Towson defender **Sid Ewell**, and Hofstra defender **Brett Osman**.

LOOKING BACK AT 2017

- Towson became just the second CAA squad to advance to the NCAA Championship Semifinal. The Tigers knocked off No. 7 Seed Penn State, 12-8, in the first round and then clipped No. 2 Seed Syracuse, 10-7, in the quarterfinals to advance to Gillette Stadium. In the semifinals, Ohio State used a second-half comeback to edge the Tigers, 11-10. Ryan Drenner was named to the NCAA Championship All-Tournament Team as he record four points in every NCAA contest.
- Towson made its third-straight NCAA appearance and its seventh overall by knocking off UMass in the CAA Championship final. Towson won their seventh conference title overall and became the first CAA program to three-peat as champions twice. The Tigers' seven CAA titles are more than current membership has combined.
- As a league, the CAA went 30-23 against non-league foes in 2017 and was one of only four conferences to have winning non-league records. The CAA had the third best winning percentage (.566) behind the Big Ten (.836) and the ACC (.704). Eleven of the CAA's 30 wins were against opponents receiving recognition.
- In the final NCAA RPI, CAA was rated third as a league behind the Big Ten and the ACC. Three teams were rated in the top-20: Towson (8), Hofstra (14) and UMass (19).
- In the Maverik Media Poll: Towson continued to climb, finishing the year at No. 4 while Hofstra finished at No. 18.
- In the USILA/Nike Coaches Poll Towson finished the year at No. 11 while Hofstra finished No. 16 and UMass received votes
- Hofstra's No. 2 ranking in the USILA Poll on April 10 was its highest since 2006 when they were rated as the second best team in the nation for the final six weeks of the season. It was the highest ranking for a CAA team since 2012 when Penn State earned the No. 1.
- Seven CAA players were taken in the 2017 Major League Lacrosse Draft. The selections were the most for the CAA since 2013 when eight of the league's players were selected. Towson's Jack Adams was the 15th pick overall as selected by the Charlotte Hounds in the second round while Hofstra's Josh Byrne was the 19th overall pick, taken in the third round by the Chesapeake Bayhawks. Byrne went on to win MLL Rookie of the Year honors.
- Five CAA players were named to 2017 Inside Lacrosse Division I Media All-America teams. Towson had its entire defensive midfield earn honors while two members of the Hofstra Pride earned recognition. Hofstra goalie Jack Concannon and Towson defensive middle Zach Goodrich landed spots the IL Media All-America Second Team while the Tigers' Jack Adams landed a spot on the Third Team. Hofstra senior attack Josh Byrne and Towson longstick midfielder Tyler Mayes were honorable mentions.
- Eight CAA players received USILA/Nike All-American recognition. It is the most selections for the CAA since 2014 when the league had eight recognized and it is the most combined Second and Third Team selections since 2012.
