PLAYER OF THE WEEK

AUBREE BROWN | DREXEL SOPHOMORE | GUARD | PHILADELPHIA, PA./ARCHBISHOP WOOD

Sophomore Aubree Brown led the Dragons in scoring in each of their two victories during the week, against first-place James Madison and at Towson. Brown averaged 21.0 points, 4.0 assists and 4.0 rebounds per game. Brown netted a career-high 26 points in the win over the Dukes, her first career game with 20 or more points. Twenty of her 26 points came after halftime, including 10 points in the two overtime sessions. At Towson, Brown led the way with 16 points on 5-for-10 shooting and dished out five assists.

Rookie Kayla Bacon took over late in the second half to jumpstart Drexel's offense and power them to victory at Towson. Bacon played 15 minutes, and scored eight points on 4-for-8 shooting all in the fourth quarter, setting season bests in all facets. Bacon was credited with one steal, but deflected two other passes to create Towson turnovers in the fourth quarter that allowed Drexel to overcome a three-point fourth-quarter deficit and pull away for a double-digit lead late. Drexel had not gotten a single bench point for the first 33:03 of play until Bacon sparked a late 6-0 run in the fourth quarter.

#CAAHOOPS REWIND

- **Charleston (6-21; 2-14):** The Cougars had a pair of home losses to UNCW and Northeastern. **Tanisha Brown** averaged 14.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 6.0 assists on the week.
- **Delaware (17-10; 10-6):** The Blue Hens split road games, topping William & Mary before falling to first-place James Madison. Junior **Nicole Enabosi** averaged a double-double with 25.0 points and 13.0 rebounds. Enabosi has posted double-doubles in each of her last six games.
- **Drexel (22-6; 14-2):** The Dragons went 2-0 on the week, downing James Madison, 73-71 in double overtime before posting a victory at Towson. With the wins, Drexel has a program-best 22 victories. **Aubree Brown** had a solid week, averaging 21.0 points and 4.0 assists. Rookie **Kayla Bacon** came through in the clutch at Towson, posting a season-best eight points, all in the fourth quarter, and playing strong defense to help the Dragons to the win.
- **Elon (20-7; 12-4):** The Phoenix rolled to their eighth straight win with an 80-55 victory over the Pride in their only game of the week. Elon improved to 20-7 overall, marking its second-straight 20-win season. The Phoenix, which is 12-0 at home, shot 52.5 percent from the field and 46.2 percent from three-point range. Senior **Shay Burnett** narrowly missed a triple-double, finishing with 12 points, 11 assists and eight boards.
- **Hofstra (11-17; 5-12):** The Pride had a pair of tough losses, falling at home to Northeastern before falling at Elon. **Boogie Brozowski** averaged 19.5 points 4.0 rebounds and 3.0 assists.
- **James Madison (19-9; 15-2):** The Dukes split games, falling at Drexel, 73-71, in double overtime before returning home to defeated Delaware. **Kamiah Smalls** averaged 13.5 points and 7.0 rebounds while **Kelly Koshuta** averaged 13.0 points. **Logan Reynolds** averaged 4.0 steals and 5.0 assists per game.
- **UNCW (10-17; 3-13):** UNCW received career efforts from **Timber Tate** and **Jenny DeGraaf** as both Seahawks finished with 22 points to lead UNCW to a 76-60 series-clinching win at Charleston. It was the only game of the week for the Seahawks. Tate went 5-for-9 from three-point range to help set her career best and added three steals. DeGraaf went 10-for-14 from the field and grabbed eight rebounds while **Rebekah Banks** pulled in 10 rebounds to lead all players.
- **Northeastern (15-13; 10-7):** The Huskies went 2-0 last week with wins at Hofstra and at Charleston. Junior **Gabby Giacone** averaged 18.0 points and 8.0 rebounds, including a 24-point effort against the Cougars.
- **Towson (9-18; 4-12):** The Tigers suffered a tough loss to Drexel in their only game of the week. Towson led at the half and held a late lead, but Drexel was able to pull out the win. Senior **Mary Cuevas** posted a double-double with 14 points and 14 rebounds to lead the Tigers.
- **William & Mary (16-11; 7-9):** The Tribe fell at home to Delaware in their only game of the week. **Jenna Green** and **Abby Rendle** each tallied 12 points on Senior Night at Kaplan Arena. Green added four assists and three steals while Rendle swatted four shots.

#CAAHOOPS IN THE MID-MAJOR POLL

- Three CAA teams were recognized in the February 27 poll. Drexel moved up five spots to No.17 while James Madison fell one spot to No. 18. Elon jumped up four spots to No. 20.

#CAAHOOPS IN THE RPI

- In the NCAA RPI released on February 26, three CAA teams were in the top-75 in the NCAA RPI. Drexel had an RPI of 47 followed by Elon (51) and James Madison (67).
- As a league, the CAA was rated tenth.

USBWA NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Drexel sophomore guard **Aubree Brown** was named the Ann Meyers Drysdale National Player of the Week by the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) on February 27
- Brown averaged 21.0 points, 4.0 assists and 4.0 rebounds per game in a 2-0 week for the Drags. She netted a career-high 26 points in the win over the Dukes, her first career game with 20 or more points. Twenty of her 26 points came after halftime, including 10 points in the two overtime sessions. At Towson, Brown led the way with 16 points on 5-for-10 shooting and had five assists.

#CAAHOOPS HOT SHOTS

- Elon's **Shay Burnett** joined an exclusive club last weekend. She became just the sixth player in CAA history to record 1,000 points, 500 assists and 400 rebounds in a career.
- Four CAA teams are in the top-25 nationally in blocking. William & Mary is the national leader in total blocks (211) and in blocks per game (7.8). Towson is 13th in total blocks (163) and ninth in blocks per game (6.0). James Madison is 16th in total blocks (157) and 16th in blocks per game (5.6). Delaware is 23rd in blocks per game (5.2).
- Three teams in the CAA are in the top-25 nationally in rebounds per game. Elon is 14th (42.93), UD is 16th (42.78) and Towson is 21st (42.63).
- Elon is also 12th in field goal percentage defense (.353) and 23rd in scoring margin (+14.8).
- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** leads the CAA in scoring (18.9ppg) and is nationally ranked in several categories. She's ninth in total rebounds (337), sixth in rebounds per game (12.5), fourth in defensive rebounds per game (9.0), fifth in double-doubles (21), eighth in free throws attempted (212) and 13th in free throws made (152).
- Enabosi has averaged 18.3 points and 15.0 rebounds in each of the last four games.
- Towson's **Nukiya Mayo** is fourth nationally in offensive rebounds per game (5.0).
- Drexel is yielding just 55.9 points per game and held its last 17 opponents of its last 18 opponents under 60 points. James Madison posted 71 points against the Dragons, the most allowed since December 9 when Syracuse had 72.
- Elon's **Malaya Johnson** is shooting 62.1 percent (82-132) from the field over her last 12 games.
- Elon's eight game winning streak is the second-longest winning streak in the program's Division I era behind only last season's nine-game run.
- Elon's 97-44 win over CofC on February 11 marked the largest margin of victory (53) by the Phoenix in their DI history.
- In 17 league games, the Dukes have won the rebounding battle 14 times.
- William & Mary's senior class – **Jeanne Gaumont**, **Jenna Green** and **Abby Rendle** are the winningest class in school history with 66 victories.
- There have only been two overtime games in CAA play. Both games involved Drexel and resulted in wins for the Dragons.

2018 CAA CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

- James Madison, Drexel, Elon, Delaware Northeastern, and William & Mary have clinched CAA Championship Quarterfinal berths.
- James Madison and Drexel will have a top-two seed.
- Elon has locked up the No. 3 seed.
- Delaware and Northeastern will have either a fourth or a fifth seed.
- William & Mary has locked into the sixth seed.
- Towson, Hofstra, UNCW and Charleston are vying for seeds seven through ten.
- Seeding will be announced upon the conclusion of the regular season. *For CAA tiebreaking procedures, please see page 12 of this report.*
- The 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship tournament will be held March 7-10 at the Daskalakis Athletic Center (DAC) in Philadelphia, Pa. and will be hosted by Drexel.
- The opening round, quarterfinals and semifinals will be streamed exclusively on CAA.tv. The final will be aired on NBC Sports Washington & Philadelphia and SNY and streamed via CollegeSportsLive, as part of the conference's partnership with CBSi.
- All-Session tickets are on sale now by visiting DrexelTickets.com.
- The CAA Women's Basketball Championship returned to campus last season with James Madison hosting at the Convocation Center in Harrisonburg, Va. Delaware will host the 2019 CAA Championship at the Bob Carpenter Center in Newark.

COSIDA ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT

- William & Mary senior **Jenna Green** was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District Team First Team.
- In the classroom, Green is on pace to graduate with her degree in finance this May. She has won three Provost Awards for having a 3.5 GPA, or better, and has been a two-time CAA All-Academic selection.
- As a first-team honoree, Green, advances to the CoSIDA Academic All-America Team ballot with First, Second, and Third Team All-Americans being announced in March.

20-20

- At 22-6, Drexel has set the program record for regular season victories. The previous record had been held by the 2008-09 team, which went 21-8 in the regular season. Drexel, which who went 22-11 last season, has won 20 or more games in back-to-back seasons.
- At 20-7, Elon has posted back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time as a Division I program and just the second time in program history. The 1979-80 and 1980-81 teams won 25 and 29 games, respectively, under Mary Jackson.

STINGY D

- Drexel held William & Mary to single digits in all four quarters on February 18. It was the first time since the NCAA went to the quarter system three years ago that Drexel held an opponent to single-digit scoring in all four quarters of a game.
- Drexel has held two opponents to just three points in a quarter this season, the lowest in the CAA. Most recently, the Dragons held Hofstra to three points in the first quarter on January 21. Drexel also held Lafayette to three points in the second quarter on December 1.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Drexel and Elon are both undefeated at home.
- The Dragons are 12-0 overall at the DAC and 8-0 in league play.
- The Phoenix is 12-0 overall at Alumni Gym and 8-0 in CAA action. Elon has a 17-game home winning streak dating back to last season.
- James Madison is 9-0 in league play at the Convo and have won 10-straight home games.

CAREER MILESTONE WATCH

- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi**, Elon's **Malaya Johnson** and William & Mary's **Abby Rendle** have all reached the 1,000 career point milestone. Enabosi's bucket came on January 19 at UNCW while Johnson's basket came against Enabosi and the Blue Hens on January 21. Rendle scored her milestone point at Delaware on February 9.
- Elon's **Shay Burnett** currently has 1,499 points and is closing in on her 1,500th.
- Northeastern's **Jess Genco** is six three-pointers away from the 200th made of her career.
- Elon's **Malaya Johnson** has 163 career blocks and is 13 away for the CAA's all-time top-10.

COACHES CORNER

- Head Coach **Denise Dillon** became Drexel's all-time winningest coach, notching her 265th career victory. Dillon stands fourth all-time in CAA victories, posting 183 wins in CAA regular season/tournament games.
- Hofstra Head Coach **Krista Kilburn-Steveskey** notched her 200th career coaching victory on January 14 with the Pride's win over Charleston. Kilburn-Steveskey is already the program's all-time wins leader and saw her record improve to 201-167 in her 12th season at Hofstra. Kilburn-Steveskey stands sixth all-time in CAA victories, posting 114 wins in CAA regular season/tournament games.

BIG BLOCKER

- William & Mary center **Abby Rendle** blocked nine shots against Old Dominion on December 17 to surpass former Delaware Blue Hen and WNBA superstar **Elena Delle Donne** has the CAA's career blocks leader. Rendle brought her total to 275, breaking Delle Donne's record of 273 blocks.
- Rendle blocked her 300th shot against Elon on January 14. She currently has 345 blocks and is one of only four players in the NCAA that have 300 career blocks. She joins Duke's **Bego Faz Davalos** (369), South Carolina's **A'ja Wilson** (344) and South Alabama's **Chyna Ellis** (317) in the 300 blocks club.
- This season, Rendle leads the nation with 4.56 blocks per game and 123 total blocks.
- Rendle's 123 total blocks, set a new standard in CAA history. On February 9, Rendle had six blocks, breaking the record of 110 set by Richmond's Amy Dorsett in 1996-97.
- Rendle tied the CAA single game record for blocks with 11 against Charleston on January 26. She tied the mark originally set by Georgia State's **Marquitta Head** on December 3, 2006.
- William & Mary tied the CAA single game record with 17 blocks against Charleston on January 26. Elon set the standard of 17 against ETSU on November 29, 2015.
- The Tribe has 211 blocks this season setting a CAA single season record. They broke the mark held by the 209 held by the 2008-09 Hofstra Pride.

HELPING THEM OUT

- William & Mary senior guard **Jenna Green** became the Tribe's career assist leader on February 11. She has 519 helpers for her career.
- Green is currently 21st in the nation in assists per game (6.1) and 22nd total assists (165).
- Elon's **Shay Burnett** is 20th with 6.3 assists per game.
- Northeastern's **Jess Genco** and William & Mary's **Jenna Green** have the most helpers in a single game this season with 12 assists. Genco did it against Houston on November 25 while Green did it against Elon on January 14.
- As a team, Drexel has the most assists in a single game this year with 25 against La Salle on November 16.

I'LL HAVE ANOTHER TRIPLE-DOUBLE

- There have been three triple-doubles in the CAA this season, the most-ever in a single season in league history.
- Drexel's **Aubree Brown** notched the third triple-double in the league with 10 points, 10 rebounds, and 11 assists on February 4 at Charleston. It was the second-ever triple-double in Drexel history with **Abby Redick** doing it for the Dragons in 2014.
- Elon senior **Shay Burnett** recorded the second triple-double in the CAA this season with 10 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists on November 27 against Coker. It was the first triple-double in Elon history.
- William & Mary center **Abby Rendle** notched her third career triple-double at East Carolina on November 21. Rendle finished with a 25 points, 17 rebounds and 10 blocks.
- This is the second consecutive season in which the CAA has had multiple triple-doubles. Former Hofstra guard **Krystal Luciano** and Rendle completed the feat last year.
- Rendle has all three points-rebounds-blocks triple-doubles since 2006. Rendle also had a triple-double against East Carolina last season (14pts, 11reb, 10blk). Rendle's first triple-double (and William & Mary's first) came in 2015-16, against UNCW (24pts, 15reb, 10blk).
- With three career triple-doubles, Rendle is tied with former ODU and WNBA standout **Ticha Penicheiro** for the most in CAA history.

20-20 CLUB

- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** recorded 23 points and 20 rebounds in the non-league final against Loyola on December 22. It was the first 20-20 game in the CAA since the 2012-13 season. That year, Hofstra's Shante Evans had 33 points and 23 boards against Mason while William & Mary's Emily Correal had 24 points and 21 rebounds in the season opener against East Carolina.

HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

- With its 106-54 win over Coker on November 27, Elon recorded the first 100-point game in the CAA since March 4, 2015 when James Madison scored 107 points against College of Charleston.
- Since 1998-99, there have been 21 games in which a CAA team has scored 100+ points.

HEY ROOKIE!

- Northeastern's **Stella Clark** is the first player in CAA history to be awarded with the first three CAA Rookie of the Week honors of the year since the award's creation in 2002-03.
- Clark is only the second player in CAA history to earn three consecutive nods at any point in the year; **Elena Delle Donne** did it twice in 2009-10 en route to her record-setting 10 CAA Rookie of the Week honors.
- Clark leads the CAA with five Rookie of the Weeks.
- Drexel's **Hannah Nihill** has collected four CAA rookie of the Week honors.

- The annual #CAAHoops On Campus series takes the crew to James Madison, Charleston, Drexel, William & Mary and UNCW this season.
- In addition to game day behind-the-scenes social media content, the CAA produces video features.

WBCA'S 'SO YOU WANT TO BE A COACH'

- Elon's **Shay Burnett** and UNCW's **Jenny DeGraaf** were selected for the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's (WBCA) 16th annual "So You Want To Be A Coach" program.
- Burnett and DeGraaf will participate in the three-day workshop with speakers provided by the Alliance on March 28-30 in conjunction with the WBCA Convention in Columbus, Ohio.
- The objectives of the "So" program are to increase the understanding and application of skills necessary to secure coaching positions in women's basketball, increase the understanding and awareness of competencies necessary for success in coaching, introduce female basketball players to coaches and administrators, and raise awareness of the existing talent pool of female basketball players who have a passion and interest in coaching the game of women's basketball.

#CAAHOOPS IN NON-LEAGUE PLAY

- The CAA went 63-48 in non-league play.
- The CAA had success against the A-10, going 10-4, the American (3-1), the Patriot League (8-3) and the NEC (5-0).
- The CAA went 34-14 at home in non-league play. Three teams (UNCW, Drexel, Elon) went unbeaten.
- The CAA averaged 67.7 points per game while opponents averaged 65.1 points a contest.
- The CAA averaged 38.9 rebounds per game and held opponents to 37.5 boards.

HELLO, COACHES

- There are three new coaches on the sidelines this season, two of which are familiar faces.
- Head Coach **Karen Barefoot** takes the helm of UNCW. She was previously in the league as the leader of ODU.
- Head Coach **Natasha Adair** returns to the CAA sidelines, taking over the helm of Delaware. Adair led CofC during its first CAA season.
- Head Coach **Diane Richardson** will guide Towson this season. Richardson was a longtime assistant coach at West Virginia.

THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT TIME

- Elon headed to the Puerto Rico Clasico which was relocated to Fort Lauderdale, Fla. The Phoenix opened action with a win over (RV/RV) Alabama but fell to (RV/RV) Iowa.
- Drexel traveled to Melbourne, Fla. for the relocated Paradise Jam. The Dragons fell to (RV) Virginia Tech in the opening round and No. 11/13 West Virginia on the second day but downed Butler on the final day. Sophomore **Aubree Brown** landed a spot on the All-Tournament Team, averaging 9.7 points and 4.0 assists per game.
- Northeastern split games at the UMass Thanksgiving Classic topping host UMass before being edged by Houston.
- James Madison headed north for the TD Bank Classic which was hosted by Vermont. The Dukes were edged by Villanova but downed the host Catamounts. Sophomore **Kamiah Smalls** was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 18.0 points, 9.0 board, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals.
- Hofstra split games at the Lady Rebel Round-Up in Las Vegas. The Pride was clipped by host UNLV before knocking off Wake Forest. Senior **Aleana Leon** was named to the All-Tournament team after averaging 14.5 points and 6.5 rebounds.
- Delaware made a trip to Philadelphia for the Saint Joseph's Thanksgiving Tournament. After falling to Saint Peter's by a basket in double overtime, the Hens trounced Eastern Illinois. **Nicole Enabosi** was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 24.0 points and 14.0 rebounds.

#CAAHOOPS INTERNATIONALLY SPEAKING

- There are 15 international players hailing for 10 different countries in the CAA this season.
- Hofstra's roster features eight international players in sophomores **Marianne Kalin** and **Sandra Karsten** (Finland), **Ana Hernandez Gil** (Canary Islands) and **Petja Krupenko** (Slovenia); freshman **Mie Hoff** (Norway), junior transfer **Sica Cuzic** (Romania), junior **Kayla Minott** (Canada) and senior **Aleana Leon** (Puerto Rico).
- Drexel has the second most at three international players in sophomores **Ana Ferariu** (Romania) and juniors **Tereza Kracikova** (Czech Republic) and **Eline Maesschalk** (Belgium).

2017 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- James Madison was predicted to capture the 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship while Elon senior **Shay Burnett** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in a vote of the league's 10 head coaches.
- The Dukes had 78 points, including six first-place votes while Elon, the defending champs, was second with 74 points, including three first-place votes. Rounding out the top-seven was William & Mary (58), Drexel (51), Delaware (48), Northeastern (47) and Hofstra (43). Towson and UNCW were tied for eighth while CofC was tenth.
- Only six of the top-20 leading scorers from last season return for the respective teams. Yet, 11 of the top-20 leading rebounders from one year ago will be back to clean the glass.
- Only four of the 15 All-CAA honorees from last year return for the 2017-18 season.

CAA TIEBREAKING PROCEDURE

If ties exist in the conference standings, the following procedure will be utilized to establish seeding for all CAA championships.

1) All ties will be broken 1st through 10th places in descending order.

2) Once one team gains an advantage in the case of a multiple-team tie, revert to the beginning of the tie-breaking policies with the remaining teams.

A. Two Team Ties

1) Regular season conference record.

2) Head-to-head competition.

3) If two tied teams split their two games during the regular season, compare each tied team's record against the team occupying the highest position in the standings and continue down through the standings until one team gains the advantage, thereby earning the higher seed. When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against a team or group is unequal. If the winning percentage of the tied teams is equal against a team, or a group of tied teams, continue down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

a) When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tie-breaking procedures), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams.

4) If a tie still exists, the Ratings Percentage Index (RPI), as computed from the RPI Report by 9:00 a.m., on the day following the last scheduled conference game, will be used to break the tie. The team with the better RPI will earn the higher seed.

B. Multiple (3 or more teams) Ties

1) Head to head competition as determined by the combined record of games among the tied teams involved. Ties will be broken and seeds will be based on the winning percentage of games amongst the tied teams, even if the number of games played against the group is unequal;

2) If procedure B1 fails to break the tie, then each tied team's record shall be compared to the team occupying the highest position in the standings, continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage by a higher winning percentage as described in B1.

3) If the tie is broken by B1 or B2 regarding one or more teams, but three or more teams remain tied, then procedures B1 and B2 will be re-applied among those tied teams only. If two teams remain tied, revert to the two-tied team procedure.

4) If a tie still exists, the RPI, as computed from the RPI Report by 9:00 a.m., on the day following the last scheduled conference game, will be used to break the tie. The team with the better RPI will earn the higher seed.
