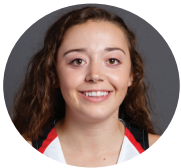

### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**JESS GENCO | NORTHEASTERN JUNIOR | GUARD | SCRANTON**

Junior Jess Genco averaged 17.0 points, 4.0 assists, 2.0 rebounds and 37.0 minutes during Northeastern's 2-0 week against UNCW and Delaware. She went a perfect 8-for-8 from the free throw line for the week and extended her double-digit scoring streak to 19 games. Against UNCW, she posted 17 points, including five three-pointers and her 900th career point. In the win over Delaware, which secured the season sweep of the Hens, Genco had 17 points, dished out seven assists and grabbed three rebounds while not turning the ball over in 36 minutes of action.



### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**MALAYA JOHNSON | ELON SENIOR | CENTER | MOUNT AIRY, N.C./NORTH SURRY**

Center Malaya Johnson powered Elon's offensive presence in a 2-0 weekend against College of Charleston and James Madison. The senior averaged 15.0 points per game while shooting 54.2 percent (14-for-24) from the floor. Against CofC, she scored all 16 of her points in the paint, going 8-for-11, and helped Elon to a 54-20 advantage down low in the 22-point road victory. Johnson, also blocked two shots and grabbed two boards. Versus the Dukes, Johnson went to work down low again with 10 of her 14 points coming in the paint while helping Elon again dominated down low to the tune of a 30-12 advantage. Johnson has now scored in double figures in six of the last seven games after opening conference play with a combined 23 points in the first four games. This is the second honor for Johnson in the last three weeks.



### ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

**HANNAH NIHILL | DREXEL FRESHMAN | GUARD | DREXEL HILL, PA./CARDINAL O'HARA**

Rookie Hannah Nihill averaged 10.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game to help Drexel to a 2-0 weekend. Against Towson on Friday, she matched a career high with 13 points on 5-of-7 shooting and added career highs of eight rebounds and six assists in the win. She followed that up with eight points and four assists with no turnovers at the College of Charleston on Sunday.

## #CAAHOOPS REWIND

- Charleston (5-18; 1-11):** The Cougars had a pair of home losses to Elon and Drexel. **Tanisha Brown** averaged 12.0 points and 8.0 rebounds.
- Delaware (13-8; 6-4):** The Blue Hens fell to Northeastern, 73-59, in their lone game of the week. Sophomore **Bailey Kargo** guided UD with 18 points while junior **Nicole Enabosi** registered 10 points and seven rebounds.
- Drexel (18-5; 10-1):** The Dragons pushed their winning streak to eight games with a victory at home against Towson and a road win at Charleston. Drexel moved into a first-place tie with James Madison in the CAA standings and improved to 10-0 at home this season. Sophomore **Bailey Greenberg** averaged 15.0 points and 6.5 rebounds while shooting 60.0 percent from the field. **Aubree Brown** delivered the CAA's third triple-double of the season and Drexel's second-ever with 10 points, 10 rebounds, and 11 assists.
- Elon (15-7; 7-4):** The Phoenix put together a 2-0 weekend with a win at Charleston and a big home win over James Madison. Elon improved to 10-0 at home and pushed its home winning streak to 14 games. Senior **Shay Burnett** averaged 10.5 points, 6.5 assists and 5.5 rebounds for the week, including 17 points, nine boards and eight assists against JMU. Senior **Malaya Johnson** averaged 15.0 points while **Ra'Shika White** averaged 11.5 points and 6.0 rebounds.
- Hofstra (10-12; 4-7):** The Pride fell to UNCW, 59-55, in their only game of the week. Four Hofstra players scored in double figures, including **Boogie Brozowski's** team-high 16 points and **Mikayah Croskey's** double-double (10pts, 10reb). Sophomore **Marianne Kalin** grabbed a game-high 12 caroms.
- James Madison (14-8; 10-1):** The Dukes split road games last weekend, downing William & Mary by 45 points, before falling at Elon for their first league loss of the season. **Kamiah Smalls** averaged 16.5 points and 5.0 rebounds while **Kelly Koshuta** averaged 14.0 points and 5.0 rebounds.
- UNCW (8-14; 1-10):** The Seahawks split road games, falling at Northeastern before coming-from-behind to defeat Hofstra, for UNCW's first league win of the season. **Madison Raque** averaged 11.5 points per game, including a 23-point effort against Hofstra, while **Jenny DeGraaf** averaged 11.0 points and 5.0 rebounds.
- Northeastern (12-10; 7-4):** The Huskies posted a pair of home wins, topping UNCW and Delaware. Northeastern took the series from the Blue Hens and moved into a tie for third place in the standings. Junior **Jess Genco** averaged 16.0 points and 4.0 assists while rookie **Jasmin Watson** averaged 5.0 points and 4.0 rebounds per game.
- Towson (8-14; 3-8):** The Tigers had a pair of tough losses on the road at Drexel and at home to William & Mary. **Nukiya Mayo** averaged a double-double with 19.5 points and 10.5 rebounds per game while **Raine Bankston** averaged 11.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game.
- William & Mary (15-7; 6-5):** The Tribe split games, falling at home to James Madison before clipping Towson on the road. Junior **Bianca Boggs** averaged 17.5 points and 4.0 rebounds while senior **Jenna Green** averaged 17.0 points and 4.5 assists per game.

## #CAAHOOPS IN THE RPI

- In the NCAA RPI released on February 5, three CAA teams were in the top-100. Drexel had an RPI of 56 followed by Elon (69) and James Madison (82).
- As a league, the CAA was rated tenth.

## #CAAHOOPS HOT SHOTS

- Northeastern's **Jess Genco** the CAA's longest double-digit scoring streak this season at 19 games. Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** had her 17-game streak stopped on January 21.
- Two CAA teams are in the top-11 nationally in blocks. William & Mary is the national leader in total blocks (183) and in blocks per game (8.3). Towson is 11th in total blocks (137) and tenth in blocks per game (6.2).
- Two teams in the CAA are in the top-20 nationally in rebounds per game. Towson is 15th (43.45) while Elon is 19th (43.23).
- Elon is also ninth in free throws attempted (505) and 14th in free throws made (349).
- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** leads the CAA in scoring (18.4ppg) and is nationally ranked in several categories. She's 15th in total rebounds (251), 11th in rebounds per game (12.0), fourth in defensive rebounds per game (9.0), fifth in double-doubles (14) and 11th in free throws attempted (155).
- There has only been one overtime game in CAA play this season, with William & Mary and Drexel going to the extra session on January 9. CAA teams have gone to overtime just six times this year with three of those contests belonging to the Tribe.
- Drexel is yielding just 56.3 points per game and held its last 13 opponents under 60 points.
- Drexel has held two opponents to just three points in a quarter this season, the lowest in the CAA. Most recently, the Dragons held Hofstra to three points in the first quarter on January 21. Drexel also held Lafayette to three points in the second quarter on December 1.
- Elon's **Malaya Johnson** is shooting 63.6 percent (49-77) from the field over her last seven games.
- Elon is 6-1 in games immediately following a loss.
- James Madison senior **Hailee Barron** has appeared in 123 consecutive games for the Dukes, which is sixth on the JMU all-time streak chart. She needs to appear in the next game in order to move into a tie for third all-time.
- In 11 league games, the Dukes have won the rebounding battle nine times.
- College of Charleston's **Deja Ford** has made 18 consecutive free throws since January 12.
- Delaware has reached 80+ points five times this season. The last time Delaware logged 80-plus points at least five times in a season came during the 2011-12 slate.
- William & Mary's senior class – **Jeanne Gaumont**, **Jenna Green** and **Abby Rendle** are the winningest class in school history with 65 victories.
- UNCW overcame a 14-point deficit to capture its first league win at Hofstra. The 14-point deficit is the largest overcome in a win by the Seahawks since January 8, 2013, at William & Mary, which was also a 14-point deficit.
- Senior **Madison Raque's** 15 points in the 4th quarter against Hofstra on February 4 were the most by a UNCW player in a single period since the NCAA instituted the 4-quarter system. Raque has scored 10 or more points in a quarter nine times over the last three years.

## #CAAHOOPS IN THE MID-MAJOR POLLS

- College Insider Mid-Major Poll:** Three CAA teams were recognized in the February 6 poll. Drexel moved up three spots to No. 17 while James Madison fell four spots to No. 22. Elon received votes for the second consecutive week.

## HOME SWEET HOME

- Drexel and Elon are both undefeated at home.
- The Dragons are 10-0 overall at the DAC and 6-0 in league play.
- The Phoenix is 9-0 overall at Alumni Gym and 6-0 in CAA action. Elon has a 14-game home winning streak dating back to last season.

## I'LL HAVE ANOTHER TRIPLE-DOUBLE

- There have been three triple-doubles in the CAA this season, the most-ever in a single season in league history.
- Drexel's **Aubree Brown** notched the third triple-double in the league with 10 points, 10 rebounds, and 11 assists on February 4 at Charleston. It was the second-ever triple-double in Drexel history with **Abby Redick** doing it for the Dragons in 2014.
- Elon senior **Shay Burnett** recorded the second triple-double in the CAA this season with 10 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists on November 27 against Coker. It was the first triple-double in Elon history.
- William & Mary center **Abby Rendle** notched her third career triple-double at East Carolina on November 21. Rendle finished with a 25 points, 17 rebounds and 10 blocks.
- This is the second consecutive season in which the CAA has had multiple triple-doubles. Former Hofstra guard **Krystal Luciano** and Rendle completed the feat last year.
- Rendle has all three points-rebounds-blocks triple-doubles since 2006. Rendle also had a triple-double against East Carolina last season (14pts, 11reb, 10blk). Rendle's first triple-double (and William & Mary's first) came in 2015-16, against UNCW (24pts, 15reb, 10blk).
- With three career triple-doubles, Rendle is tied with former ODU and WNBA standout **Ticha Penicheiro** for the most in CAA history.

## COACHES CORNER

- Head Coach **Denise Dillon** became Drexel's all-time winningest coach, notching her 265th career victory. Dillon stands fourth all-time in CAA victories, posting 179 wins in CAA regular season/tournament games.
- Hofstra Head Coach **Krista Kilburn-Steveskey** notched her 200th career coaching victory on January 14 with the Pride's win over Charleston. Kilburn-Steveskey is already the program's all-time wins leader and saw her record improve to 201-167 in her 12th season at Hofstra. Kilburn-Steveskey stands sixth all-time in CAA victories, posting 113 wins in CAA regular season/tournament games.

## CAREER MILESTONE WATCH

- Hofstra's **Ashunae Durant** is the CAA's career active leader in points (1418) and rebounds (993). She's on pace to become the 16th player in CAA history to have 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds and the first to reach the mark since 2012-13 when **Elena Delle Donne** (Delaware), **Danielle Parker** (Delaware) and **Shante Evans** (Hofstra) completed the feat.
- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** and Elon's **Malaya Johnson** both reached the 1,000 career point milestone. Enabosi's bucket came on January 19 at UNCW while Johnson's basket came against Enabosi and the Blue Hens on January 21.
- William & Mary's **Abby Rendle** (993) is closing in on her 1,000th career point.
- James Madison's **Kayla Cooper-Williams** became the eighth Duke in program history to reach 100 blocks her career doing so at College of Charleston on January 19. Cooper-Williams has 113 blocks.
- Senior guard **Jenna Green** stands second all-time at William & Mary with 496 assists needs just eight more to set the school record.
- Northeastern guard **Jess Genco** surpassed the 900-career point and has 927.

## BIG BLOCKER

- William & Mary center **Abby Rendle** blocked nine shots against Old Dominion on December 17 to surpass former Delaware Blue Hen and WNBA superstar **Elena Delle Donne** has the CAA's career blocks leader. Rendle brought her total to 275, breaking Delle Donne's record of 273 blocks.
- Rendle blocked her 300th shot against Elon on January 14. She currently has 329 blocks and is one of only four players in the NCAA that have 300 career blocks. She joins Duke's **Bego Faz Davalos** (365), South Carolina's **A'ja Wilson** (334) and South Alabama's **Chyna Ellis** (301) in the 300 club.
- This season, Rendle leads the nation with 4.86 blocks per game and 107 total blocks.
- Rendle's 107 total blocks is second most in CAA single season history. The league's single season record is 110 set by Richmond's Amy Dorsett in 1996-97.
- Rendle tied the CAA single game record for blocks with 11 against Charleston on January 26. She tied the mark originally set by Georgia State's **Marquitta Head** on December 3, 2006.
- William & Mary tied the CAA single game record with 17 blocks against Charleston on January 26. Elon set the standard of 17 against ETSU on November 29, 2015.

## HELPING THEM OUT

- William & Mary senior guard **Jenna Green** is 16th in the nation in assists per game (6.5) and 17th in total assists (142).
- Elon's **Shay Burnett** is 24th with 6.0 assists per game.
- There have been ten 10-assist games in the CAA this season.
- Northeastern's **Jess Genco** and William & Mary's **Jenna Green** have the most helpers in a single game this season with 12 assists. Genco did it against Houston on November 25 while Green did it against Elon on January 14.
- As a team, Drexel has the most assists in a single game this year with 25 against La Salle on November 16.

- The objectives of the "So" program are to increase the understanding and application of skills necessary to secure coaching positions in women's basketball, increase the understanding and awareness of competencies necessary for success in coaching, introduce female basketball players to coaches and administrators, and raise awareness of the existing talent pool of female basketball players who have a passion and interest in coaching the game of women's basketball.

## 20-20 CLUB

- Delaware's **Nicole Enabosi** recorded 23 points and 20 rebounds in the non-league final against Loyola on December 22. It was the first 20-20 game in the CAA since the 2012-13 season. That year, Hofstra's **Shante Evans** had 33 points and 23 boards against Mason while William & Mary's **Emily Correal** had 24 points and 21 rebounds in the season opener against East Carolina.

## #CAAHOOPS IN NON-LEAGUE PLAY

- The CAA went 63-48 in non-league play.
- The CAA had success against the A-10, going 10-4, the American (3-1), the Patriot League (8-3) and the NEC (5-0).
- The CAA went 34-14 at home in non-league play. Three teams (UNCW, Drexel, Elon) went unbeaten.
- The CAA averaged 67.7 points per game while opponents averaged 65.1 points a contest.
- The CAA averaged 38.9 rebounds per game and

held opponents to 37.5 boards.

## THE BIG 3-0

- There have been a pair of 30-point games in the CAA this season.
- William & Mary's **Bianca Boggs** tallied 33 points in the win over Saint Francis (PA) on December 2.
- Northeastern's **Claudia Ortiz** netted 31 points at Elon on January 7, including seven three-pointers.

## HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

- With its 106-54 win over Coker on November 27, Elon recorded the first 100-point game in the CAA since March 4, 2015 when James Madison scored 107 points against College of Charleston.
- Since 1998-99, there have been 21 games in which a CAA team has scored 100+ points.

## HEY ROOKIE!

- Northeastern's **Stella Clark** is the first player in CAA history to be awarded with the first three CAA Rookie of the Week honors of the year since the award's creation in 2002-03.
- Clark is only the second player in CAA history to earn three consecutive nods at any point in the year; **Elena Delle Donne** did it twice in 2009-10 en route to her record-setting 10 CAA Rookie of the Week honors.

## HELLO, COACHES

- There are three new coaches on the sidelines this season, two of which are familiar faces.
- Head Coach **Karen Barefoot** takes the helm of UNCW. She was previously in the league as the leader of ODU.
- Head Coach **Natasha Adair** returns to the CAA sidelines, taking over the helm of Delaware. Adair led CofC during its first CAA season.
- Head Coach **Diane Richardson** will guide Towson this season. Richardson was a longtime assistant coach at West Virginia.

## THANKSGIVING TOURNAMENT TIME

- Elon headed to the Puerto Rico Clasico which was relocated to Fort Lauderdale, Fla. The Phoenix opened action with a win over (RV/RV) Alabama but fell to (RV/RV) Iowa.
- Drexel traveled to Melbourne, Fla. for the relocated Paradise Jam. The Dragons fell to (RV) Virginia Tech in the opening round and No. 11/13 West Virginia on the second day but downed Butler on the final day. Sophomore **Aubree Brown** landed a spot on the All-Tournament Team, averaging 9.7 points and 4.0 assists per game.
- Northeastern split games at the UMass Thanksgiving Classic topping host UMass before being edged by Houston.
- James Madison headed north for the TD Bank Classic which was hosted by Vermont. The Dukes were edged by Villanova but downed the host Catamounts. Sophomore **Kamiah Smalls** was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 18.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.5 steals per game.
- Hofstra split games at the Lady Rebel Round-Up in Las Vegas. The Pride was clipped by host UNLV before knocking off Wake Forest. Senior **Aleana Leon** was named to the All-Tournament team after averaging 14.5 points and 6.5 rebounds.
- Delaware made a trip to Philadelphia for the Saint Joseph's Thanksgiving Tournament. After falling to Saint Peter's by a basket in double overtime, the Hens trounced Eastern Illinois. **Nicole Enabosi** was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 24.0 points and 14.0 rebounds.

## 2017 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- James Madison was predicted to capture the 2018 CAA Women's Basketball Championship while Elon senior **Shay Burnett** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in a vote of the league's 10 head coaches.
- The Dukes had 78 points, including six first-place votes while Elon, the defending champs, was second with 74 points, including three first-place votes.
