CAA BASEBALL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK: Mason Berne, UNCW

Sr., 1B, Southport, N.C./Spartanburg Methodist JC Berne batted .455 (5-for-11) with four home runs and six RBI's in UNCW's three-game series with Hofstra. The senior first baseman smacked a two-run homer in each game of the Seahawks' double-header sweep of the Pride on Saturday and also delivered a pair of solo shots in Friday's opener. For the season, Berne is batting .376 with seven homers and a CAA-best 26 RBI's.



Dupree Hart, Charleston

Jr., 2B. Rock Hill, S.C./Northwestern

Hart batted .556 (10-for-18) with five runs scored and two RBI's in Charleston's 4-0 week. The junior second baseman had three hits in all three games of the Cougars' sweep of William & Mary, going 9-for-14 (.643) in the series. Hart has reached base in 26 consecutive games dating back to last season and raised his team-best batting average to .385, which ranks third in the CAA.



CAA BASEBALL PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Billy Sullivan IV, Delaware

Fr., RHP, New Castle, Del./St. Mark's

Sullivan gave up just three hits over 6.0 shutout innings and struck out a career-high 10 in Delaware's 2-1 victory over Towson on Saturday. The freshman didn't allow a runner past 2nd base and fanned at least one batter in all six frames. Sullivan, who is 3-0 with a 1.52 ERA, has given up one run or fewer in 4 of his 5 starts.



CAA BASEBALL ROOKIE OF THE WEEK: Gage Herring, UNCW

Fr., RHP, Newton Grove, N.C./Hobton

Herring received his first collegiate start due to an injury and responded by allowing only two hits in 5.0 shutout innings as UNCW defeated Hofstra, 6-2, in Saturday's series finale. The freshman right-hander faced just two batters over the minimum and struck out four to earn his first career victory. He's 1-0 with a 2.31 ERA.

DIAMOND NOTES:

Charleston (19-6, 3-0 in CAA) - The Cougars took the early lead atop the CAA standings after three straight wins over William & Mary capped a 4-0 week.

Dupree Hart had three hits in all three games against the Tribe and batted .556 (10-for-18) for the week with five runs scored. He raised his season average to .385, which ranks 3rd in the CAA. Charleston belted five homers in a 15-6 win over Furman, including a grand slam and a solo shot from Danny Wondrack.

Logan McRae had a hit in all four games and finished the week with seven RBI's to up his season total to 20. Evan Sisk improved to 5-1 after holding W&M to one run on three hits in Friday's 5-1 victory. Nathan Ocker saved the first two games of the series after tossing 4.0 shutout frames. Jakob Frishmuth ran his record to 4-1 after giving up two runs over 6.0 frames in the finale.

Delaware (12-9, 2-1 in CAA) - The Blue Hens swept a doubleheader from Towson to start CAA play, but fell to the Tigers on Sunday. Kyle Hinton (3-1) gave up two earned runs over 6.1 innings as UD won the opener, 6-3. Colman Vila struck out the side in the ninth to earn his second save. Vila appeared in his 76th career game, breaking the school record. Freshman Billy Sullivan improved to 3-0 and lowered his ERA to 1.52 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings and strking out a career-best 10 as the Hens took the nightcap, 2-1. Calvin Scott was 3-for-4 with two RBI's in Game 1, while Kyle Baker drove in the Hens' first run and then scored the eventual game-winning run on Diaz Nardo's triple in Game 2. Kevin Mohollen has reached base in 16 consecutive games, while Zack Miller has a seven-game hitting streak.

Elon (13-11, 2-1 in CAA) - The Phoenix won two-of-three at JMU in their opening CAA series to cap a 2-2 week. **Cam Devanney** had a hit in all four games last week and batted .375 (6-for-16) with five RBI's. He was 2-for-3 and drove in three as Elon won Sunday's finale, 6-4. **Zach Evers** was 7-for-15 (.467) from the leadoff spot at JMU and contributed three hits in each victory. The Phoenix stole six bases in the final two games of the series. **George Kirby** improved to 4-1 after limiting the Dukes to two runs over a career-long 7.2 innings in Saturday's 8-2 triumph. **Brandon Justice** threw 2.2 shutout innings in a pair of relief efforts at JMU and earned his second save on Sunday. **Kyle Brnovich** had nine strikeouts in 6.0 innings on Friday to increase his league-best total to 61.

Hofstra (10-6, 1-2 in CAA) - The Pride went 1-2 in their opening CAA series at UNCW, rallying for a 5-3 win in the opener before losing a doubleheader on Saturday. Vito Friscia batted .364 in the series but had his 10-game hitting streak end in the finale. He continues to lead the CAA with a .424 batting average. Vinnie Costello also hit .364 at UNCW, including a game-tying 2-run homer on Friday. John Rooney improved to 3-0 after giving up three runs over 7.0 innings and fanning seven on Friday. Chris Weiss picked up his fourth save by striking out six over the final two frames. The win was the 10th of Rooney's career, while the save was the 10th of Weiss' career. Michael James hasn't allowed a run in 7.1 innings this season after 2.1 frames of scoreless relief on Saturday.

James Madison (13-10, 1-2 in CAA) - The Dukes got past Elon 4-3 in 10 innings in their CAA opener, but dropped the final two contests. Freshman Josh Jones batted .500 (6-for-12) in the series and extended his hitting streak to 12 games. The Dukes' shortstop was also perfect in 17 chances defensively. He ranks 4th in the CAA with a .380 batting average. Fox Semones was 4-for-10 in the series and Conor Hartigan also contributed four hits over the three games. Matt Colon didn't allow a run over 4.0 innings in two relief appearances last week, while Shelton Perkins (2-0) gave up just one hit over the final 3.0 innings

to earn the victory over EU on Friday. **Colton Harlow** gave up one run over 5.0 innings on Friday and is 2-1 with a 2.56 ERA for the season. JMU is back at home this weekend to face Northeastern.

UNCW (16-7, 2-1 in CAA) - The Seahawks swept a Saturday doubleheader to capture their opening CAA series with Hofstra. UNCW's pitching staff held the Pride to a .170 batting average in the series and recorded 39 strikeouts. Justin Walke fanned a career-high seven in 3.1 shutout innings of relief and Clark Cota recorded his league-leading 7th save in Saturday's opener. Freshman Gage Herring tossed 5.0 shutout innings in his first career start to get the win in the nightcap. Alex Royalty had a season-high 10 K's on Friday. Offensively, Mason Berne batted .455 with four homers and six RBI's in the series. He's driven in a CAA-best 26 runs this season. Ryan Jeffers was 2-for-4 with a double, homer and four RBI's in the finale. Jackson Meadows was 4-for-7 in Saturday's doubleheader.

Northeastern (11-9, 0-0 in CAA) - The Huskies beat Hartford (3-1) and Boston College (7-4 in 18 inn.) before losing four games at nationally ranked Texas Tech over the weekend. Charlie McConnell batted .379 (11-for-29) with a pair of triples and two RBI's last week. He was 5-for-9 and scored the game-winning run vs. BC and recorded a pair of multi-hit games at TTU. He's second in the CAA with a .388 average. Jake Farrell had a hit in all four games of the TTU series, including a homer on Sunday. On the mound, Kyle Murphy allowed three earned runs over 9.1 innings in three relief appearances. He earned a save vs. Hartford and tossed 5.0 innings against BC. Freshman Brandon Dufault contributed 2.0 shutout innings in a pair of outings from the pen at Texas Tech.

Towson (4-17, 1-2 in CAA) - The Tigers picked up a 10-2 victory at Delaware on Sunday after losing twice to the Hens on Saturday. Michael Adams (1-2) limited UD to two runs on five hits over 8.0 innings and fanned a career-high 10. It was the most strikeouts by a Towson pitcher in a CAA game since 2012. Colin Gimblet provided much of the offense by going 4-for-5 with a career-high five RBI's and he also stole two bases. Richie Palacios was 5-for-9 in the series and Trey Martinez went 5-for-10. Palacios continues to lead the Tigers with a .372 average, 15 RBI's and a CAA-best 25 runs scored. David Marriggi turned in another solid start in Game 2 of the UD series, giving up just two runs on five hits over 6.2 innings and striking out five. Towson hosts Hofstra this weekend.

William & Mary (8-16, 0-3 in CAA) - The Tribe dropped all three games in their opening CAA series at Charleston. W&M had 15 hits in Game 2 of the series but suffered an 8-7 setback. Jason Waldman belted a 3-run homer and finished 2-for-5 with four RBI's, while Hunter Smith and Matt McDermott each went 3-for-5. McDermott, Zach Pearson and Colin Lipke had at least one hit in all three games of the series. Pearson raised his batting average to a team-best .302 for the season. Charlie Fletcher tossed 3.0 shutout innings out of the bull-pen in two appearances. Ryan Hall was selected as one of 30 candidates for the Senior CLASS Award, which honors student-athletes who excel both on and off the field. W&M hosts UNCW this weekend.
