PLAYER OF THE WEEK

REID BOWERING | DREXEL SOPHOMORE | ATTACK | COQUITLAM, BRITISH COLUMBIA

Sophomore Reid Bowering had a hat trick and two assists, including one on the double overtime game-winner, against Providence. He also added a ground ball and a caused turnover. In the first half, Bowering had a hat trick and assisted on a goal to pull the Dragons within three goals at the break. His final point of the day came in double overtime when he fed a streaking Marshal King for the game-winner. Bowering's caused turnover came at a pivotal momentum, returning the possession to Drexel with the final seconds of regulation and forcing overtime.



ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

CHRIS CONNOLLY | UMASS FRESHMAN | ATTACK | GLASTONBURY, CONN./TRINITY-PAWLING (N.Y.)

Freshman Chris Connolly provided five points on two goals and three assists, and scooped up two ground balls in Massachusetts' 14-12 win at Brown. His first ground ball of the day led to the opening UMass goal while Connolly assisted Ben Spencer in making it a 3-1 lead early. Connolly scooped up his second ground ball of the day and scored seconds later to make it 8-2 Minutemen early in the second quarter. In the third quarter, Connolly had a goal and two assists, helping the Minutemen turn a 10-6 lead into an insurmountable 13-7 advantage en route to the win.

#CAALAX WEEKLY ROUNDUP

- **Delaware (3-5):** The Blue Hens led No. 11 Rutgers 8-7 at halftime, but couldn't stop a second-half run, falling on the road, 15-10. Senior **Dean DiSimone** and sophomore **Charlie Kitchen** each a hat trick. Sophomore **Matt DeLuca** made 12 saves in cage. Junior **Jake Hervada** won 14 of 27 faceoffs while registering a career-high 12 ground balls.
- **Drexel (4-4):** The Dragons topped Providence, 11-10, in double overtime in their only game of the week. **Marshal King** rocketed home the game-winner on a pass from **Reid Bowering** less than a minute into the second OT. It was King's lone point of the day and Bowering's fifth point. Bowering finished the day with three goals and two assists. **Matthew Vairan** also had a five-point game with two goals and three assists. **Jimmeh Koita** went 15-of-26 at the X with eight ground balls. In between the pipes, **Chre Teitelbaum** posted 10 saves.
- **Fairfield (3-7):** The Stags split games last week, topping NJIT, 12-8, before being edged by No. 7 Villanova, 13-12, in overtime. Four different Stags put together four-goal weeks, including **Colin Burke**, who also had six assists, and **Joe Rodrigues**, who collected two assists and four ground balls, and rookie **Taylor Strough**. **Will Fox** went a combined 32-for-49 at the X with nine ground balls. **Sean McKee** got the win against NJIT, making nine saves.
- **Hofstra (4-4):** The Pride had a pair of tough losses, falling to No. 14 Lehigh, 13-8, before being edged at St. John's, 9-8, on a last second goal by the Red Storm. Freshman **Dylan McIntosh** tallied eight goals on the week, including six against St. John's. **Ryan Tierney** tallied 10 assists on the week, including seven against Lehigh.
- **UMass (5-4):** The Minutemen won their fourth straight game by rolling over Brown, 14-12. UMass was led by sophomore **Jeff Trainor's** career-best four goals and freshman **Chris Connolly's** five-point (2g, 3a) afternoon. Defensively, **Hampton Brannon**, **Isaac Paparo** and **Shane Rinkus** were key. Brannon set a career-high with 15 saves, including five in the pivotal fourth quarter. Paparo finished with three caused turnovers and as many ground balls from his spot on close defense. Rinkus also had three ground balls and added a pair of caused turnovers.
- **Towson (3-5):** The Tigers held the lead at halftime, but No. 5 Denver surged in the second half to edge Towson, 11-10, in overtime. Towson rallied and tied game with 29.8 seconds to play but the Pioneers scored midway through the overtime period for the win. **Jake McLean**, **Matt Sovero** and **Dylan Kinnear** all scored career-high goals with a pair apiece. Sovero tied the game in the final minute of regulation to force overtime. **Shane Brennan** continued his strong play in the cage, turning in a 13-save performance. **Zach Goodrich** posted four caused turnovers and had five ground balls.

THIS WEEK IN #CAALAX

- Conference play begins on March 31 with all six teams in action.
- Conference play continues each Saturday before wrapping up April 27-28.
- The 2018 CAA Men's Lacrosse Championship will be held May 3-5 and will be hosted by the highest seed in the CAA Standings at the conclusion of the regular season.
- Towson has the most regular season victories in CAA history with 59, while Hofstra is next with 57.
- **Fairfield at Delaware:** The Stags and the Blue Hens get things started at noon. Last season, Fairfield improved to 3-0 against UD in CAA action with an 11-7 win in the regular season finale. The Stags were led by **Colin Burke**, who had three goals and three assists. For the Hens, **Joe Eisele** had a hat trick while **Andrew Romagnoli** had four assists.
- **UMass at Drexel:** The Minutemen square off with the Dragons in the #CAALax Game of the Week on LSN. Last season, UMass posted a 14-8 victory in the regular season finale behind five goals from **Jesse Leung**. The Minutemen have won two of the last three meetings with the Dragons and are 5-4 against their league foe.
- **Towson at Hofstra:** It's a battle of the two winningest teams in CAA history. Last season, the Tigers held off a fourth-quarter rally by the Pride to pull out a 10-8 victory and secure the top seed in the CAA Championship. **Tyler Young** had four goals for Towson while **Dylan Alderman** had three goals and an assist for Hofstra. The two teams have split the last four meetings but since becoming CAA rivals, Towson holds the 10-9 advantage in the series.

#CAALAX IN THE RANKINGS

- **Inside Lacrosse Maverik Media Poll:** Hofstra and Towson each received votes.
- **USILA Coaches Poll:** Towson and Drexel each received votes.
- **Nike/US Lacrosse Magazine Top-20:** Towson received votes for the third straight week.

#CAALAX AGAINST THE REST

- The CAA is 22-29 in non-league play.
- Twenty-seven of the CAA's 51 opponents have been nationally ranked or receiving votes in the national polls this season.
- Last season, as a league, the CAA went 30-23 against non-league foes and was one of only four conferences to have winning non-league records.

FACING OFF

- Senior faceoff specialists **Noah Rak** (UMass) and **Will Fox** (Fairfield) have etched their names in the CAA recordbook.
- Rak is second all-time in faceoff percentage (.576). Rak has won 417 faceoffs which ranks ninth all-time. Rak is also 11th with 223 ground balls.
- Fox is sixth all-time in faceoff percentage at .567. Fox has won 475 faceoffs which ranks him seventh all-time. Fox is 16th with 207 ground balls.
- Towson faceoff specialist **Alex Woodall** has had an impressive career at the X. Woodall, who transferred from High Point, has a combined career percentage of .605 with 271 wins.

QUICK HITS

- UMass rookies **Kevin Tobin** (8g, 8a) and **Chris Connolly** (16g, 11a) have combined for 24 goals and 19 assists this season. Connolly has recorded three five-point efforts over the last five contests.
- Towson has the tenth-toughest schedule in NCAA Division I this season. Drexel's schedule is ranked 12th in toughness.
- Towson goalie **Shane Brennan** has made double-digit saves in all four March games against ranked opponents.
- Hofstra sophomore **Ryan Tierney** has posted 12 assists in his last three games and is on a six-game point streak. His seven assists against Lehigh on March 20 were the second-most in CAA single game history. The record is eight, set by Drexel's Sean Moloney on March 19, 2002
- Delaware's **Austin Haynes** is tenth in the country in caused turnovers per game (2.13) while UMass' **Isaac Paparo** is 13th (1.89).
- Hofstra is fourth nationally in scoring defense (7.50). They are also second in clearing percentage (.932).
- Hofstra goalie **Jack Concannon** is third in the nation in goals against average (7.39) and tenth in save percentage (.563).
- UMass is ranked sixth in assists per game (7.67), 11th in points (19.78), ninth in ground balls per game (32.11), tenth in caused turnovers per game (8.56), and tenth in faceoff percentage (.594).
- UMass faceoff specialist **Noah Rak** is eighth in winning percentage (.633) and sixth in the nation in ground balls per game (9.22). Fairfield's **Will Fox** is 15th in faceoff percentage (.597) and 14th in ground balls per game (6.50).

IN THE CAGE

- Hofstra senior **Jack Concannon** has reached the 400-career save milestone. Concannon is 15th all-time in CAA history with 415 saves.
- In addition, Concannon's career GAA of 8.44 ranks him seventh all-time in CAA history and his save percentage of .563 ties him for seventh.

TEWAARATON AWARD WATCH LIST

- Five CAA players have been placed on the watch list for the 2018 Tewaaraton Award.
- Hofstra midfielder **Dylan Alderman** and goalkeeper **Jack Concannon**, Towson short stick defensive midfielder and CAA Preseason Player of the Year **Zach Goodrich**, and UMass defenseman **Isaac Paparo** were included on the initial watch list.
- Towson midfielder **Jon Mazza** was included in the first round of additions announced on March 22.
- Watch list additions, will be announced again April 5. On April 26, the field will be narrowed to 25 men's nominees. Five men's finalists will be announced on May 10 and with the winner being announced on May 31.

USILA TEAM OF THE WEEK

- UMass faceoff specialist **Noah Rak** and Drexel attackman **Matthew Varian** were named to the USILA DI Team of the Week on March 20. Rak went 40-for-48 at the X in a 2-0 week for the Minutemen while Varian had a 10-point week for the Dragons, including seven points in the upset of No. 11 Georgetown.

WARRIOR/US LACROSSE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Towson goalie **Shane Brennan** was named the US Lacrosse Player of the Week on March 13. Brennan made a career-best 16 saves against No. 13 Ohio State in the Tigers' 7-6 overtime victory. Brennan made several saves in close while also snapping up seven ground balls. He made 10 of his saves across the second and third quarters. Brennan allowed a career-low six goals in his 64 minutes of action. He finished the contest with a 72.7 save percentage.

2018 PRESEASON RUNDOWN

- Towson was picked to four-peat as CAA Men's Lacrosse title. Towson collected 24 points and four first-place votes while Hofstra was picked second in the poll with 22 points and two first-place votes. They were followed by UMass in third with 15 points and Drexel in fourth with 14 points. Rounding out the order of finish was Fairfield (8) and Delaware (7).
- Towson junior **Zach Goodrich** was selected as the CAA Preseason Player of the Year in a vote of the league's six head coaches.
- Five CAA players earned Inside Lacrosse Media Preseason All-American recognition. Towson short stick defensive midfielder **Zach Goodrich** and Hofstra goalie **Jack Concannon** were named to the Preseason All-America First Team. Receiving honorable mention were Towson faceoff specialist **Alex Woodall**, Towson defender **Sid Ewell**, and Hofstra defender **Brett Osman**.
