Jr., DH, Southborough, Mass./Algonquin Regional Solomon batted .500 (8-for-16) with two homers, a double, five runs scored and eight RBI's in Northeastern's 3-1 week. The junior had three multi-hit games, including a career-best 3-for-5 effort with a homer and five RBI's in a win over Rhode Island. He was 5-for-11 and drove in a run in each game as NU won 2-of-3 in its CAA series at JMU. Solomon is batting .313 for the season.



CAA BASEBALL PITCHERS OF THE WEEK: Michael Adams, Towson

Sr., RHP, Mechanicsburg, Pa./Cumberland Valley Adams (2-2) threw a complete-game, 3-hit shutout and tied his career-high with 10 strikeouts in Towson's series-clinching 1-0 victory over Hofstra on Sunday. The senior only allowed one runner to reach second base and fanned a batter in six of nine frames. It was the first complete-game shutout by a TU hurler since 2014.

DIAMOND NOTES:

Charleston (21-8, 4-2 in CAA) - The 30th-ranked Cougars rolled past #20 Coastal Carolina, 11-4, last Tuesday but dropped two-of-three at Elon over the weekend. Logan McRae went 3-for-4 with a double, homer and five RBI's vs. Coastal, while Clay Hunt was sensational out of the bullpen, holding the Chants without a hit over the final 6.1 innings and striking out a career-high 11. Hunt (3-0) also picked up a win at Elon on Sunday and Nathan Ocker recorded his sixth save with 3.0 hitless frames. Danny Wondrack homered twice last week and leads the CAA with 10 for the season. Dupree Hart and Luke Manzo were a combined 5-for-9 with three runs scored at the top of the CofC lineup in Sunday's 5-3 triumph at Elon. Hart continues to lead the Cougars with a .366 average. Luke Morgan also had three hits in the win to up his average to .347.

Delaware (13-12, 2-1 in CAA) - The Blue Hens beat La Salle 7-3 last Tuesday to advance to the semifinals of the Liberty Bell Classic before suffering three losses in a weekend series at Big Ten foe Michigan. **Calvin Scott** blasted a clutch 3-run homer in the 8th at La Salle and finished with four RBI's. **Kevin Mohollen** went 3-for-5 in Sunday's 4-2 setback at Michigan. He raised his average to .292 and scored his team-leading 20th run. Freshman **Billy Sullivan** (3-1) took his first loss of the year on Sunday despite a solid effort, giving up three runs over 5.1 innings. **James Meeker** threw the final 2.2 frames and is 3-0 with a team-high three saves and a 3.28 ERA for the season. **Nick Patten** was 2-for-4 and hit his third homer of the season in Friday's 6-2 setback at UM.

Elon (16-12, 4-2 in CAA) - The Phoenix had an impressive 3-1 week, winning 10-9 at Wake Forest before taking two-of-three from Charleston. Kyle Brnovich moved to 4-0 and lowered his ERA to 1.53 after limiting CofC to one run on two hits over 7.1 innings and fanning a season-high 14 in Friday's 7-3 victory. He leads the nation with 75 K's. Robbie Welhaf didn't allow an earned run over the final 3.1 innings to earn his 3rd save in Saturday's 7-5 win. Jared Wetherbee didn't give up a hit in two relief outings over 2.1 IP. Ryne Ogren batted .412 (7-17) for the week with a double, homer and five RBI's. He had three multi-hit games, including a 3-for-5 effort with two RBI's at Wake. Ogren is 4th in the CAA with a .364 average. Josh Broughton homered twice and drove in four in Friday's win over CofC. Joe Satterfield has reached base in 18 straight games.

Hofstra (12-8, 2-4 in CAA) - The Pride split four games last week, including a 1-2 mark in their CAA series at Towson. John Rooney improved to 4-0 and dropped his ERA to 1.58 after giving up just two hits and striking out nine over 7.0 shutout innings in Hofstra's 11-0 win at Towson last Friday. It was the Pride's fourth shutout of the season, tying a school record set in 2012. Hofstra didn't commit an error in 102 chances in the TU series and hasn't committed a miscue in CAA play. Steven Foster had all three Hofstra hits in Sunday's 1-0 setback. Teddy Cillis took the loss despite allowing only three hits and fanning 10 in 8.0 innings of work. Matt Siedem was 2-for-3 and drove in three in Friday's victory. Hofstra hosts Manhattan and entertains Delaware in CAA play this week.

James Madison (14-12, 2-4 in CAA) - The Dukes suffered a pair of setbacks in their three-game set with Northeastern. JMU earned a 6-3 win on Saturday as Kevin Kelly (2-2) held the Huskies to two runs on seven hits over 6.2 innings while striking out a career-high nine. Matt Dipasupil was 3-for-4 with a double and two RBI's in the victory. Michael Morgan batted .455 (5-11) in the series, including a career-best three hits on Sunday. Adam Sisk had his 21-game on base streak snapped on Sunday. Freshman Josh Jones is batting a team-best .361 for the season, which leads all CAA rookies and ranks 8th overall. The

Dukes committed four errors in both losses to NU, but didn't have any in Saturday's win. The errors led to six unearned runs in the two games.

UNCW (19-8, 4-2 in CAA) - The Seahawks went 3-1 on the road last week, beating Campbell 8-3 before claiming the final two games of their series at William & Mary. **Cole Weiss** went 3-for-5 with two homers and four RBI's in Sunday's 7-2 triumph. **Ryan Jeffers**, who was 3-for-5 with a homer and two RBI's in the game, leads UNCW in batting (.364) and homers (8) and tops the CAA in doubles (14) and RBI's (29). **Mason Berne**, who also has 29 RBI's, has reached base in 21 straight games. **Clark Cota** worked the final 1.1 innings and earned his CAA-best 8th save in Saturday's 3-2 victory. **Zack Canada** had three hits and scored twice in the contest. Relievers **Austin Warren** and **Justin Welke** both improved to 4-0 over the weekend as UNCW's bullpen has recorded 14 of the team's 19 wins, which leads the nation.

Northeastern (14-10, 2-1 in CAA) - The Huskies posted a 3-1 mark on the road last week, including winning their opening CAA series at JMU. Ryan Solomon had a hit in all four games and batted .500 (8-16) for the week with eight RBI's, five of which came in a 15-8 win at Rhode Island. Jake Farrell was 2-for-4 with a double, his team-leading 5th homer and three RBI's in Sunday's 8-1 triumph over the Dukes. He's batting .362 with a team-high 24 RBI's. Sean Mellen upped his record to 6-1 on Sunday after giving up just one run over 5.2 frames. Andrew Misiaszek threw 5.0 shutout innings in three relief appearances last week. He dropped his ERA to 2.52 for the year. Scott Holzwasser was 2-for-4 with two RBI's in a 10-2 win at JMU on Friday. Charlie McConnell is batting . 362 and leads the CAA with 16 stolen bases.

Towson (6-19, 3-3 in CAA) - The Tigers captured the final two games of their CAA series with Hofstra for a 2-2 week. Towson rallied past the Pride 5-3 on Saturday as **Richie Palacios** delivered a walk-off grand slam with two outs in the ninth to cap a five-run frame. Palacios also scored the lone run in Sunday's 1-0 triumph as he singled, stole his team-high 12th base and then came around on two wild pitches. Palacios tops Towson in batting (.333), runs (27), homers (4) and RBI's (19). **Michael Adams** (2-2) threw a complete-game, 3-hit shutout and tied a career-high with 10 strikeouts on Sunday. It was the first complete-game shutout by a Tigers' hurler since 2014. **David Marriggi** held HU to two runs over 7.0 innings and fanned seven on Saturday. **Colin Gimblet** has reached base in 14 consecutive games. **Andrew Cassard** was 4-for-9 vs. HU.

William & Mary (10-18, 1-5 in CAA) - The Tribe topped UNCW 7-3 last Friday for their first CAA victory of the season but lost the final two contests. Zach Pearson went 2-for-4 with two runs scored and three RBI's in the victory. He batted .400 in the series. Ryan Hall hit .444 (4-for-9) with a double and triple vs. the Seahawks and also walked four times. Chris Farrell gave up just one run over 4.1 innings and struck out six on Friday. Reliever Charlie Fletcher threw in the first two games of the series and now has 91 career appearances, which is seven shy of the school record. He leads the CAA with 15 apperances this year. Bodie Sheehan gave up three runs over 7.2 innings on Saturday. It was the sixth time in seven starts that he's gone at least seven innings.
