CAA BASEBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Teddy Cillis, Hofstra

Sr., OF/P, Latham, N.Y./Blair Academy

Cillis excelled at the plate and on the mound in Hofstra's four games last week. The senior batted .727 (8-for-11) with four doubles, three runs scored and two RBI's, including going 7-for-8 as the Pride won the first two games of their CAA series vs. Delaware. He started on the mound in Sunday's finale and held the Hens to two runs on six hits over 7.0 innings with four strikeouts. Cillis is batting .317 for the season and has a 2.91 ERA in 34.0 innings on the hill.



CAA BASEBALL PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

John Rooney, Hofstra

Jr., LHP, Melrose, N.Y./Hoosic Valley

Rooney fired his first career complete-game shutout in Hofstra's 9-0 victory over Delaware last Friday. The junior left-hander surrendered just a pair of singles and didn't allow a runner to reach second base. He struck out 11, walked only one and recorded at least one K in seven of the nine frames. Rooney improved to 5-0 on the season and lowered his ERA to a CAA-best 1.29. He's 2nd in the CAA with 63 strikeouts and opponents are batting just .143.



CAA BASEBALL ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:

Nick Stewart, James Madison

Fr., RHP, Ashburn, Va./Rock Ridge

Stewart held Charleston to only two hits and one earned run over a career-long 7.1 innings while striking out nine in JMU's 3-2 setback on Sunday. The freshman right-hander, who didn't get a decision in the game, didn't allow a walk and sat the Cougars down in order in five of the first seven frames. He's 2-3 with a 3.11 ERA for the season.

DIAMOND NOTES:

Charleston (25-8, 7-2 in CAA) - The Cougars played five games that were decided by a total of six runs last week and came away with a 4-1 record, including a CAA sweep of JMU. CofC had a pair of walk-off wins on Sunday vs. the Dukes as **Danny Wondrack** had an RBI single to win the opener and **Bradley Dixon's** infield single led to the winning run coming across in the nightcap. Wondrack hit his league-leading 11th homer in Friday's 6-4 win over JMU. **Carter Love**, who became CofC's career leader in appearances with 88, earned his fourth save on Friday and threw the final 4.0 innings on Sunday to improve his record to 4-0 with a 1.64 ERA. **Nathan Ocker** fanned seven in 3.2 shutout innings of relief in Game 2 of the series and earned his first win. **Evan Sisk** is now 6-2 after allowing three earned over 7.2 innings on Friday and striking out a career-best 13.

Delaware (14-14, 3-3 in CAA) - The Blue Hens topped Hofstra 5-2 in 10 innings on Sunday to claim the finale of their three-game series. Reliever **James Meeker** moved his record to 4-0 after giving up only two hits and no runs over the final 5.1 innings. Freshman starter **Billy Sullivan** took a no-hitter into the fifth on Sunday and recorded eight strikeouts, but also had seven walks. **Erik Bowren** snapped a 2-2 tie with a two-run triple in the 10th and then came home to score on a passed ball. **Calvin Scott** was 2-for-5 with two RBI's in the game. **Nick Patten** has a six-game hitting streak and has reached base in 15 consecutive contests. **Kevin Mohollen** scored his team-best 21st run and is a perfect 11-for-11 in stolen bases. Pitcher **Kyle Hinton** recorded 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings on Saturday and has a team-high 50 for the season.

Elon (17-15, 4-5 in CAA) - The Phoenix opened a four-game road swing with a 13-9 victory at High Point last Tuesday, but were swept at CAA foe Northeastern. **Ryne Ogren** was 3-for-4 with three RBI's and **Garrett Stonehouse** was 3-for-5 with four runs scored at HPU. Elon had only 14 hits in the three games at NU. **Liam O'Regan** was 2-for-4 with two RBI's in Game 2 and **Ty Adcock** was 3-for-3 with a double and two RBI's in Sunday's finale. **Kyle Brnovich** gave up just one earned run over 6.2 innings and fanned 10, but suffered his first loss of the year (4-1) in the opener at NU. The Phoenix committed a season-high four errors in Sunday's loss and had seven in the series which led to 12 unearned runs. **Joe Satterfield** (21 games) and **Cam Devanney** (18 games) had lengthy consecutive on-base streaks come to an end on Sunday.

Hofstra (14-10, 4-5 in CAA) - The Pride earned their first CAA series win of the season, taking two-of-three from Delaware. **John Rooney** threw a complete-game, 2-hit shutout with 11 strikeouts as Hofstra won Friday's opener 9-0. He's now 5-0 with a league-best 1.29 ERA. Hofstra's five shutouts this season are a school record. The Pride picked up an 11-1 victory on Saturday as **Matt Weis-sheier** gave up just one run over 6.0 innings and **Chris Weiss** threw 3.0 shutout frames for his fifth save. **Teddy Cillis** was 7-for-8 at the plate in the two wins and batted .727 for the week with four doubles. Freshman **Austin Gauthier** batted .333 (6-18) for the week with six runs scored. He had a hit in all four games last week, including his second career homer against Manhattan, and has reached base in nine consecutive games.

James Madison (15-15, 2-7 in CAA) - The Dukes were involved in three walk-off finishes last week, beating VMI 4-3 last Wednesday before dropping three games by a total of four runs at Charleston. JMU got a pair of strong starts on Sunday as **Kevin Kelly** limited CofC to six hits and one earned run over a career-long 7.2 innings while fanning six in a 2-1 setback and freshman **Nick Stewart** allowed only two hits and one earned run in a season-high 7.1 frames while striking out nine in a 3-2 loss. Outfielder **DaVonn Griffin** batted .417 (5-

12) for the week with four runs scored and two RBI's. He was a perfect 3-for-3 in the win over VMI, falling just a double shy of the cycle. Freshman **Anthony Piccolino II** delivered the walk-off RBI single against the Keydets. **Fox Semones** (22 RBI's) knocked in five of JMU's seven runs in the Charleston series.

UNCW (20-11, 4-2 in CAA) - The Seahawks ended a 1-3 week on a positive note by edging Wofford, 4-3, on Sunday. **Jackson Meadows** provided the game-winning hit with a RBI single in the ninth. Closer **Clark Cota**, who tops the CAA with 8 saves, moved to 3-0 with a 1.23 ERA after striking out the side in the ninth. **Mason Berne** drove in the game-tying run vs. Wofford, which extended his hitting streak to 12 games and his on base streak to 25 contests. He leads the CAA with a .375 average and 33 RBI's. **Ryan Jeffers**, who added a 2-run homer, ranks among the CAA's top six in batting, runs, homers, doubles, walks, RBI's, on base percentage and slugging percentage. Freshman **Brycen Braswell** made his collegiate debut at #12 East Carolina and was 2-for-3. UNCW hosts #2 NC State on Wednesday night.

Northeastern (18-10, 5-1 in CAA) - The Huskies are off to their best CAA start in school history following a three-game sweep of Elon to cap a 4-0 week. **Charlie McConnell** extended his hitting streak to six games after batting .429 (6-14) with seven runs scored and four RBI's last week. He doubled and hit a game-tying homer as NU edged Elon 6-5 in Game 2 of the series. McConnell is 2nd in the CAA with a .370 average and has a league-best 17 stolen bases. Freshman **Ian Fair** hit .364 (4-11) for the week with two RBI's and two runs scored vs. Elon. Lefty **Sean Mellen** improved to 7-1 after giving up just two hits over 6.0 shutout innings and striking out six as NU beat Elon 9-3 on Sunday. Mellen hasn't allowed more than two earned runs in seven of his eight starts and dropped his ERA to 2.09. NU faces Harvard in Beanpot title game on Tuesday.

Towson (7-22, 4-5 in CAA) - The Tigers beat William & Mary 6-1 on Sunday to stop a three-game slide. Senior pitcher **Michael Adams** came up big once again, allowing just three hits and an unearned run over 7.0 innings while striking out eight. Adams (3-2) hasn't given up an earned run over his last 18.2 frames and is 3-0 with a 0.75 ERA in CAA play with 28 K's in 24.0 innings. **Dean Stramara** picked his first save on Sunday, after holding the Tribe without a hit over the final 2.0 innings and striking out three. Offensively, **Richie Palacios** batted .500 (8-16) with three doubles, two homers and five RBI's last week. He leads the CAA in runs (30) and is among the league's top 10 in batting, homers, doubles, RBI's, stolen bases, walks, on base percentage and slugging percentage. Freshman **Dirk Masters** hit .385 (5-13) for the week and drove in three.

William & Mary (13-20, 3-6 in CAA) - The Tribe went 3-2 last week, defeating Maryland (6-3) before taking two-of-three from CAA foe Towson. **Colin Lipke** batted .389 (7-18) for the week with two doubles, two homers and seven RBI's. His two-RBI single drove in the winning runs at Maryland, he belted a 3-run homer in an 8-7 victory over Towson in Friday's opener and doubled twice as the Tribe won the nightcap, 5-4. Freshman **Matt McDermott** hit .316 (6-19) for the week with a double, triple and five RBI's. He was 3-for-4 and knocked in three in Game 2 of the Towson series. **Wade Strain** saved all three W&M victories last week with 2.2 shutout innings and has six saves for the season. **Bodie Sheehan** (2-3) held Towson to two runs on seven hits over 6.0 innings in Game 1.
