THIS WEEK: Cal U continues divisional play this weekend with sole possession of first place in the PSAC West standings following a 41-0 win at Gannon last Saturday. Meanwhile, Slippery Rock posted a 38-31 Homecoming victory in overtime against Edinboro last week.



VULCANS CRUISE PAST GANNON, 41-0:

Cal U posted its second-straight shutout and rushed for four touchdowns last Saturday, registering a 41-0 victory at Gannon. The Vulcans rushed for 200 yards for the second-straight game, finishing with a season-high 226 yards. Senior **Lamont Smith** led the team with 96 rushing yards and sophomore **Cody Cook** added 74 yards and a touchdown. The Cal U defense allowed just 164 yards of total offense at Gannon. The Vulcans yielded only 11 rushing yards after registering six sacks and forced four turnovers. Senior **B.J. Stevens** led the defense with a career-high nine tackles (two solo), including 3.5 TFL and 1.5 sacks.

GAME NOTES

SLIPPERY ROCK HEAD COACH: One of the winningest active coaches in NCAA Division II, **Dr. George Mihalik** is in his 25th year as head coach of The Rock. A 2011 inductee into the Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame Western Chapter, he has posted a 165-102-4 record as a head coach. Mihalik was selected the PSAC West Coach of the Year for the fourth time in his career last season after leading Slippery Rock to an appearance in the PSAC Championship game.

SCOUTING THE ROCK: Slippery Rock returns 14 starters (six offense, six defense) from last year's team that made its first berth in the PSAC Championship since 1974. The Rock enters the weekend with the fifth-ranked scoring offense in the league, averaging 34.4 points per game. Junior quarterback **Nigel Barksdale** has passed for over 250 yards in three of the last four games and also ranks second on the team with 343 rushing yards. He has accounted for 14 touchdowns this season after transferring from Mt. San Jacinto (Calif.). Senior running back **Akeem Satterfield** leads the team with 587 rushing yards this year and ranks eighth in school history with over 2,800 career rushing yards. Junior **LaQuinn Stephens-Howling**, a former running back, leads the team with 28 receptions and five receiving touchdowns. Slippery Rock currently features the 10th-ranked scoring and total defenses in the PSAC. Junior linebacker **John Allen** leads the team with 65 tackles (25 solo), while fellow linebacker **Quindell Dean** has posted 56 stops (29 solo), 5.5 TFL and 3.0 sacks. Senior defensive lineman **Jeff Thompson**, the reigning PSAC West Defensive Player of the Week, leads the team with 9.0 TFL and 6.5 sacks this season. On special teams, junior **James McCombie** ranks third in the PSAC with an average of 41.2 yards per punt with eight punts of 50-plus yards.

READING THE NATIONAL POLLS: Cal U moved up one spot to Nos. 13 and 11 in the AFCA and D2Football.com Top 25 polls, respectively. The Vulcans have been ranked in the AFCA poll for 13-consecutive weeks and the D2Football.com poll every week since October 2009.

WITHIN THE REGION: The Vulcans were ranked fourth in the initial Super Region One rankings released on Monday. In the first edition of the regional rankings, Cal U was behind three undefeated teams and two of those teams are facing each other on Saturday. The two top teams in the regional rankings receive first-round byes in the NCAA Playoffs, while the third and fourth seeds host opening-round games on Nov. 17.

MOVE TO THE OUTSIDE: This weekend's contest will feature two junior wide receivers in **Trey Johnson** (Cal U) and **LaQuinn Stephens-Howling** (Slippery Rock) that started their collegiate careers as reserve running backs. Johnson ranks second on the team this year in all three major receiving categories, including five touchdown receptions. In his first two years, he posted 485 rushing yards and made only 10 catches. Stephens-Howling leads The Rock with 28 receptions and five touchdowns this year after rushing for 522 yards over the last two seasons.

LOOKING FOR SIX: Last season, the Vulcans became the fourth school in PSAC history, and the first since West Chester (2004-08), to reach the NCAA Playoffs in five-straight years. No program in the league has made six-consecutive berths in the NCAA Playoffs and IUP is the only school to have reached the postseason five-straight years on multiple separate occasions.

TOUGH YARDS: Over the last two weeks, the Vulcans have yielded just 280 yards of total offense while posting back-to-back shutouts. Cal U has recorded two-straight shutouts for the first time since the 2007 season. The Vulcans have limited their last two opponents to only 14 rushing yards on 44 attempts after tallying a combined 16.0 TFL.

GAME NOTES

MILES WATCH: Senior defensive back **Rontez Miles**, the 2011 PSAC West Defensive Player of the Year, is currently tied for the league lead with four interceptions. He also leads the team with 60 tackles (30 solo). A First-Team All-American last year, Miles is on pace to establish career highs in both tackles and interceptions. He ranks fifth in school history with 242 career tackles (143 solo) and is the first player with 10 career interceptions since **Terrence Johnson** (2006-09).

LONG RANGE: Behind five field goals in the last two weeks, sophomore kicker **Cody Nuzzo** now ranks third in the PSAC with a career-high nine field goals this season. He established a personal best with a 46-yard field goal last week at Gannon, becoming the first kicker since **Marc Domonkos** in 2010 to make a field goal of 45 yards or longer. Nuzzo has converted 81.8 percent (9-of-11) of his field goals this year and leads the team with 60 points.

SMITH 3K WATCH: Senior **Lamont Smith** has rushed for 290 yards over the last three weeks and is now only 83 yards shy of reaching 3,000 rushing yards for his career. A three-year starter, he would become just the fourth player in school history to reach the prolific milestone. Smith has surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in each of the last two seasons and leads the team with 638 rushing yards this year.

BLOCK PARTY: Last weekend against Gannon, the Vulcans registered a pair of blocked kicks on special teams for the third time in the last six years. In the first quarter, sophomore **Jeff Knox, Jr.** blocked a punt that was recovered at the Golden Knights' 19-yard line and led to a field goal. Later in the first half, junior **Darnell Harding** blocked a 35-yard field goal by Gannon. Over the last eight years, the Vulcans have posted 35 blocked kicks despite tallying only one in both 2008 and 2010.

BEHIND THE LINE: In his first year as a starter, junior defensive end **B.J. Stevens** ranks among the league and national leaders in TFL and sacks. He has recorded at least 1.0 sack in four-straight games and is tied for second in the PSAC this season with 9.0 sacks, which surpasses his previous career total. A former standout at Gateway, Stevens leads the league with 14.5 TFL after tying his career high with 3.5 TFL last week at Gannon.

NFL TIES: The Vulcans and Rock have a combined three players on NFL active rosters, including former Cal U cornerbacks **Tommie Campbell** (Tennessee) and **Terrence Johnson** (Atlanta). Former Slippery Rock center **Brandon Fusco** has started all seven games at guard this year with the Minnesota Vikings. Cal U defensive lineman **Noah Taylor** is the younger brother of former NFL All-Pro Jason Taylor and Slippery Rock wide receiver **LaQuinn Stephens-Howling** is the younger brother of Arizona Cardinals running back LaRod Stephens-Howling.

FIELD CHANGERS: This weekend's contest will feature two of the top punters in the PSAC in Cal U freshman **Andrew Cerett** and Slippery Rock junior **James McCombie**. Cerett currently leads the PSAC and is No. 15 in NCAA Division II with an average of 42.3 yards per punt. He has placed 11 of his 29 punts inside the opponents' 20-yard line, including two last week. McCombie averages 41.2 yards per punt with eight punts of 50-plus yards and 12 punts inside the opponents' 20-yard line.

IMPACT RETURN: In his first significant action since Sept. 22, junior **Darnell Harding** registered six tackles (five solo) and scored a touchdown on a 32-yard fumble return after forcing a fumble on a sack in the second quarter last week.

CALIFORNIA (Aug. 30) – Senior defensive back Rontez Miles broke up a potential touchdown as time expired on Thursday to help lift No. 11 Cal U to a 30-22 victory over No. 17 Hillsdale at Adamson Stadium.

The win was the first victory under head coach Mike Kellar and marked the Vulcans first home victory in a season-opener since 2008.

Senior quarterback Peter Lalich passed for 275 yards and four touchdowns on Thursday, while completing 24-of-31 attempts.

Junior wide receivers Trey Johnson and Mike Williams both finished with two touchdowns against the Chargers. Williams posted 80 yards on a career-high six receptions, while Johnson set career highs with both six catches and 49 yards.

After forcing a fumble on Hillsdale's initial drive of the second half, Lalich found Johnson for a seven-yard touchdown with 12:05 remaining in the third. The Vulcans added to the lead with a 25-yard field goal early in the fourth quarter before the Chargers mounted a 99-yard touchdown drive to trim the deficit to 30-22 with 3:56 left. On their next drive, the Chargers moved inside the 10-yard line before Miles tipped a fourth-down pass in the end zone as time expired.

Miles paced the defensive effort with 11 tackles, two pass break-ups and one forced fumble. Sophomore defensive back Jeff Knox, Jr. registered nine stops, one pass break-up and one fumble recovery in his first career start. Senior James Carr and junior Darnell Harding each added seven tackles in the victory.

Senior quarterback Peter Lalich registered his fifth career 300-yard game and established a career high with 398 passing yards, which ranks as the fifth-highest single-game total in school history. EDINBORO, Pa. (Sept. 15) – In their PSAC West-opener, the No. 6 Vulcans scored a pair of fourth-quarter touchdowns on Saturday night to secure a 24-14 victory at Edinboro.

Cal U has now won eight-consecutive and 10 of their last 13 PSAC West-opening games.

Senior quarter Peter Lalach posted his second-straight 300-yard game, finishing with 321 passing yards and two touchdowns. He completed 23-of-38 attempts against the Fighting Scots and tied his career high with three interceptions.

Junior wide receiver Mike Williams registered his second career 100-yard game, posting six receptions for 123 yards with one touchdown. Junior running back R.J. Thomas totaled five catches for 82 yards and senior tight end Blake Williamson also made five receptions.

After Edinboro cut the deficit to 17-14 with 10:34 remaining. Cal U responded with a quick three-play scoring drive capped by a six-yard touchdown run by senior Lamont Smith, who finished with 103 rushing yards. The play was set-up by a 54-yard reception by Thomas.

The ensuing Edinboro drive resulted in three-straight sacks by the Vulcans, all by juniors Paul Everson and B.J. Stevens. Cal U then worked over four-plus minutes off the clock before sealing the win with an interception by junior C.J. Townes with under one minute remaining.

Senior defensive back Greg Cochran led the team with a career-high 13 tackles (three solo) and classmate Brett Diamond finished with 11 stops (four solo). Townes added 10 tackles in his first career start, while Stevens set career highs with seven tackles, 3.5 TFL and 2.5 sacks.

CALIFORNIA (Sept. 22) – Redshirt junior Nadir Brown scored an 80-yard touchdown with 52.3 seconds left and sophomore Cody Nuzzo made the game-winning 30-yard field goal with 3.5 seconds left on Saturday, as the No. 6 Vulcans claimed a 26-24 victory over No. 14 IUP.

Senior quarterback Peter Lalach passed for the second-highest total in single-game school history, finishing with 438 yards. He completed 27-of-40 attempts with three touchdowns and one interception in the victory.

Leading 24-17 with just over a minute remaining, IUP missed a 30-yard field goal. After the missed field goal, Cal U assumed possession at its 20-yard line before Lalach connected with Brown for an 80-yard touchdown on the first play of the drive with just 57.3 seconds remaining. The ensuing PAT attempt failed which preserved the lead for the Crimson Hawks at 24-23.

The Vulcans successfully converted the onside kick attempt by Nuzzo with senior Rontez Miles recovering the ball after it was touched by a Crimson Hawk. The Vulcans recorded a first down following a pair of short completions from Lalach to senior running back Lamont Smith before Lalach found junior wide receiver Trey Johnson for a 20-yard gain to the IUP 13-yard line. After a quarterback spike stopped the clock, Nuzzo made the 30-yard field goal with just 3.5 seconds left.

Miles registered a team-high 13 tackles (six solo) with 0.5 TFL, while junior linebacker Brian Justice tied his career high with 12 stops.

CALIFORNIA (Sept. 29) – The No. 6 Vulcans rallied to tie the game after facing a 14-point halftime deficit on Saturday before suffering a 37-34 loss to West Chester in PSAC Crossover play at Adamson Stadium.

Senior quarterback Peter Lalich surpassed the 300-yard mark for the fourth-consecutive game, posting 342 yards and three touchdowns. He completed 29-of-47 attempts and threw two interceptions in the loss.

Junior wide receiver Trey Johnson posted his second-straight 100-yard game, totaling 120 yards and two touchdowns on a career-high 11 catches.

CALIFORNIA (Oct. 13) – Redshirt freshman Cody Schroeder passed for three touchdowns and the defense allowed just 116 yards of total offense on Saturday, as the No. 15 Vulcans registered a 30-0 Homecoming victory against Lock Haven in PSAC West action.

In his first career start, Schroeder finished with 252 passing yards and three touchdowns on 20-of-29 attempts. The Ohio native, who made his college debut a week earlier, passed for over 200 yards and two scores to help the Vulcans take a 17-0 halftime lead.

The Vulcans took a 17-0 lead at halftime after sophomore Cody Nuzzo made a 23-yard field goal with 1:47 left in the second quarter.

The Vulcans rushed for 200 yards for the second-straight game, finishing with a season-high 226 yards and four touchdowns.
