THE SERIES: This weekend marks only the fifth all-time meeting between the Vulcans and Lakers. Prior to Mercyhurst joining the PSAC in 2008, the two teams had never faced each other.

THIS WEEK: Cal U finishes divisional play this weekend with its second trip to Erie in three weeks. The Vulcans suffered a 28-26 loss at Adamson Stadium last Saturday. Meanwhile, Mercyhurst scored 10-straight points in the fourth quarter to earn a 24-20 victory at Edinboro last week.

VULCANS FALL TO SLIPPERY ROCK, 28-26:

Despite a pair of fourth-quarter touchdowns, the Vulcans suffered a 28-26 loss to Slippery Rock on Saturday. The Vulcans forced three turnovers and blocked a pair of punts in the loss. Junior **Ja'wan Bryant** blocked a punt midway through the fourth quarter that was recovered by sophomore **Jeff Knox, Jr.** in the end zone to trim the deficit to 28-26. Redshirt senior linebacker **Brett Diamond** led the team with a career-high 12 tackles. Junior linebacker **Brian Justice** finished with nine stops, 1.0 TFL and one forced fumble, while classmate **B.J. Stevens** registered seven tackles, 3.0 TFL, 1.0 sack and one forced fumble.

GAME NOTES

MERCYHURST HEAD COACH: After guiding the Lakers to their first post-season berth two years ago, **Marty Schaetzle** is in his 11th season as head coach at Mercyhurst. The school's all-time wins leader, he holds a 53-66 overall record and was named the PSAC West Coach of the Year in 2010 after Mercyhurst captured its first-ever conference championship. Prior to his time with the Lakers, Schaetzle worked five years as an offensive assistant at Bucknell.

SCOUTING THE LAKERS: Mercyhurst returns 14 starters (seven offense, five defense) from last year's team that finished 4-7 overall and tied for sixth in the divisional standings with a 2-5 mark. The Lakers enter the weekend with the third-ranked rushing offense in the league, averaging 215.2 yards per game. Redshirt freshman **Brandon Brown-Dukes** ranks fourth in the PSAC with 1,097 rushing yards and is also fourth with 13 rushing touchdowns. Junior quarterback **Anthony Vendemia** has passed for over 1,350 yards with 13 touchdowns in his second year as the starter. Senior wide receiver **Paris Bruner** has developed into a big-play threat, averaging nearly 22 yards per reception, while redshirt freshman wide receiver **Devyn Woods** leads the team with six receiving touchdowns. Mercyhurst boasts the league's top-ranked passing defense at 153.3 yards per game and is also among the top three in the PSAC in scoring and total defense. Sophomore linebacker **Aaron McGee** leads the team with 58 tackles (23 solo) and has added 4.0 TFL and 2.0 sacks. Redshirt sophomore defensive back **Keith Polson** has collected 50 stops (29 solo), while senior **Serge Augustin** anchors the defensive line with team-best marks of 10.0 TFL and 6.5 sacks. On special teams, junior **Steven Wakefield** ranks among the league leaders in both field goals and punting. He has converted seven-of-eight field goals and is also averaging 42.0 yards per punt with nine of his 31 punts downed inside the opponents' 20-yard line.

READING THE NATIONAL POLLS: Following its home loss last weekend, Cal U fell to No. 22 in both the AFCA and D2Football.com Top 25 polls. The Vulcans have been ranked in the AFCA poll for 14-consecutive weeks and the D2Football.com poll every week since October 2009.

WITHIN THE REGION: The Vulcans dropped to fifth in the latest Super Region One rankings released on Monday. Cal U is one of five PSAC teams ranked in the top 10 in the region. The two top teams in the regional rankings receive first-round byes in the NCAA Playoffs, while the third and fourth seeds host opening-round games on Nov. 17.

HOW THE WEST WAS WON: Entering the final weekend of divisional play, Cal U is tied with IUP and Mercyhurst for first place in the PSAC West standings. With a win on Saturday, the Vulcans would advance to the PSAC Championship Game on Nov. 10. IUP would represent the PSAC West in the league title game with a win at Gannon on Saturday and Cal U loss. Mercyhurst advances to the PSAC Championship Game with a victory and a loss by IUP at Gannon. Shippensburg has already secured a berth in the title game from the PSAC East.

LOOKING FOR SIX: Last season, the Vulcans became the fourth school in PSAC history, and the first since West Chester (2004-08), to reach the NCAA Playoffs in five-straight years. No program in the league has made six-consecutive berths in the NCAA Playoffs and IUP is the only school to have reached the postseason five-straight years on multiple separate occasions.

NEW TEAMS IN THE WEST: Since the PSAC expanded with the addition of Gannon and Mercyhurst in 2008, Cal U has posted an 8-1 combined record against the two 'new' teams. The Vulcans have won three of the four meetings versus the Lakers, including a 32-26 overtime victory on Homecoming last season.

GAME NOTES

MILES WATCH: Senior defensive back **Rontez Miles**, the 2011 PSAC West Defensive Player of the Year, is currently tied for the league lead with four interceptions. He also leads the team with 65 tackles (35 solo) this season. A First-Team All-American last year, Miles ranks fifth in school history with 247 career tackles (148 solo). He posted his second career touchdown last week on a 31-yard fumble return and also registered his fourth career blocked kick against Slippery Rock.

SMITH 3K WATCH: Senior **Lamont Smith** enters the weekend just 28 yards shy of reaching 3,000 rushing yards for his career. A three-year starter, he would become only the fourth player in school history to reach the prolific milestone. Smith has surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in each of the last two seasons and leads the team with 693 rushing yards this year.

SEEING DOUBLE: Last weekend against Slippery Rock, the Vulcans registered a pair of blocked kicks on special teams for the second-straight game and the fourth time in the last six years. In the second quarter, senior **Rontez Miles** blocked a punt that was recovered at The Rock's 3-yard line. Midway through the fourth, junior **Ja'wan Bryant** blocked a punt by Slippery Rock that was recovered in the end zone by sophomore **Jeff Knox, Jr.** for a touchdown. Over the last eight years, the Vulcans have posted 37 blocked kicks despite tallying only one in both 2008 and 2010.

WITHIN REACH: In his first year as a starter, junior defensive end **B.J. Stevens** is within reach of the single-season school records for TFL and sacks. He leads the league and is tied for seventh in the country with 17.5 TFL and also ranks seventh in the nation with 10.0 sacks. Former linebacker **Gary Butler** set the single-season school records of 19.0 TFL and 12.0 sacks in 2007 when he was selected the PSAC West Defensive Player of the Year. A former standout at Gateway, Stevens has recorded at least 1.0 sack in five-consecutive games.

FLIP THE FIELD: This weekend's contest will feature the top two punters in the PSAC in Cal U freshman **Andrew Cerett** and Mercyhurst junior **Steven Wakefield**. Cerett currently leads the PSAC with an average of 43.2 yards per punt, including a long of 65 last week. He has placed 13 of his 32 punts inside the opponents' 20-yard line, including two last Saturday. Wakefield averages 42.0 yards per punt with four punts of 50-plus yards and nine punts inside the opponents' 20-yard line. Both punters are just shy of the minimum to qualify for the national rankings.

RETURN TO FORM: After missing all of last season due to injury, redshirt senior linebacker **Brett Diamond** ranks second on the team with 64 tackles (29 solo) and is tied for first on the team with 41 career starts. He set a career high with 12 tackles (seven solo) in last week's loss to Slippery Rock. Diamond, who has equaled his career high for tackles in a season, ranks sixth in school history with 235 career tackles (120 solo).

LONG RANGE: Sophomore kicker **Cody Nuzzo** has made a 40-plus yard field goal in each of the last two weeks after previously boasting a career long of 30 yards. He ranks third in the PSAC this year with a career-high 11 field goals on 14 attempts (78.6 percent). Nuzzo has also converted 29-of-35 PAT attempts, including 10-straight attempts over the last three weeks.

BIG-PLAY SCOTT: Redshirt freshman wide receiver **Kowan Scott** has demonstrated big-play ability this season, averaging a 20.4 yards per reception. He ranks fourth on the team with 327 receiving yards on only 16 catches, including a season-high five receptions last week.

CALIFORNIA (Aug. 30) – Senior defensive back Rontez Miles broke up a potential touchdown as time expired on Thursday to help lift No. 11 Cal U to a 30-22 victory over No. 17 Hillsdale at Adamson Stadium.

The win was the first victory under head coach Mike Kellar and marked the Vulcans first home victory in a season-opener since 2008.

Senior quarterback Peter Lalich passed for 275 yards and four touchdowns on Thursday, while completing 24-of-31 attempts.

Junior wide receivers Trey Johnson and Mike Williams both finished with two touchdowns against the Chargers. Williams posted 80 yards on a career-high six receptions, while Johnson set career highs with both six catches and 49 yards.

After forcing a fumble on Hillsdale's initial drive of the second half, Lalich found Johnson for a seven-yard touchdown with 12:05 remaining in the third. The Vulcans added to the lead with a 25-yard field goal early in the fourth quarter before the Chargers mounted a 99-yard touchdown drive to trim the deficit to 30-22 with 3:56 left. On their next drive, the Chargers moved inside the 10-yard line before Miles tipped a fourth-down pass in the end zone as time expired.

Miles paced the defensive effort with 11 tackles, two pass break-ups and one forced fumble. Sophomore defensive back Jeff Knox, Jr. registered nine stops, one pass break-up and one fumble recovery in his first career start. Senior James Carr and junior Darnell Harding each added seven tackles in the victory.

Trailing 28-13 entering the fourth quarter, Cal U capped a 14-play drive with a two-yard touchdown pass from redshirt freshman Cody Schroeder to junior Mike Williams with 14:00 left in the game. Schroeder finished with 223 yards and one touchdown on 23-of-46 attempts in his third career start.

On the ensuing possession, senior Greg Cochrane recovered a fumble when Slippery Rock went for a fourth-and-one near midfield. The Vulcans then moved inside the red zone before turning the ball over on downs at the Rock 14-yard line. The Cal U defense limited Slippery Rock to only one first down on the next drive before junior Ja'wan Bryant blocked a punt that was recovered by sophomore Jeff Knox, Jr. in the end zone to trim the deficit to 28-26. However, the Vulcans were unsuccessful on the two-point conversion attempt with 7:06 remaining.

Redshirt senior linebacker Brett Diamond led the team and established a career high with 12 tackles (seven solo). Junior Brian Justice finished with nine stops, 1.0 TFL and one forced fumble.
