THIS WEEK: Cal U returns to PSAC West play this weekend when it travels to Clarion. Last weekend, the Vulcans suffered a 37-34 loss to West Chester after trailing by 14 points at halftime. Meanwhile, the Golden Eagles rallied from a 10-point, fourth-quarter deficit to earn a 31-27 victory over East Stroudsburg.

VULCANS EDGED BY WEST CHESTER, 37-34: Cal U rallied to tie the game after facing a 14-point deficit at halftime before suffering a 37-34 loss to West Chester. Senior quarterback **Peter Lalich** passed for 342 yards and three touchdowns on 29-of-47 attempts. Junior wide receiver **Trey Johnson** registered his second-straight 100-yard game, totaling 120 yards and two touchdowns on 11 receptions. After halftime, the Vulcans scored touchdowns on two-straight drives after the defense forced a turnover. Defensively, junior **C.J. Townes** led the team with a career-high 13 tackles (six solo) and senior **Rontez Miles** added 12 stops (five solo) and two interceptions.

GAME NOTES

CLARION HEAD COACH: After nearly guiding the program to the NCAA Playoffs in 2009, **Jay Foster** has posted a 22-49 record in seven seasons with the Golden Eagles. He was named the PSAC West Coach of the Year in 2009 before finishing 3-8 last season with the three wins coming in the last six weeks of the year. Foster took the helm at Clarion after serving as the long-time defensive coordinator at Slippery Rock.

SCOUTING THE GOLDEN EAGLES: Clarion returns 19 starters (nine offense, eight defense) from a team that finished 3-8 overall and tied for sixth in the divisional standings. The Golden Eagles enter the weekend with the fourth-ranked rushing offense in the PSAC behind the tandem of sophomore running back **Bobby Thomas** and junior quarterback **Ben Fiscus**. A former safety, Thomas ranks sixth in the league with 100.4 rushing yards per game and Fiscus is 10th in the conference at 90.0 rushing yards/game. Fiscus, a three-year starter, has also posted 885 passing yards and tied his career high with seven touchdown passes this season. Junior wide receiver **Jon Reid** ranks among the league leaders with a career-high 384 receiving yards on 23 catches. Clarion boasts one of the top defenses in the PSAC this season, allowing 20.4 points and 320.6 yards per game. Senior linebacker **Nate Sipes** anchors the defense with 38 tackles (11 solo) after finishing third in the league with nearly 100 stops last season. Fellow linebacker **Brian Palmiere** is tied for the team lead with 38 tackles (18 solo) and has added 3.5 TFL in his second year as a starter. Sophomore defensive end **Julian Howsare** leads the Golden Eagles with 5.5 sacks this year after missing the season-opener. On special teams, junior **Nathan Conway** is averaging 35.8 yards per punt with three blocked punts this season.

READING THE POLLS: Followings its loss last week, Cal U fell to Nos. 16 and 15 in the AFCA and D2Football.com Top 25 polls, respectively. The Vulcans have been ranked in the AFCA poll for 11-consecutive weeks dating back to last season.

BOUNCING BACK: Since 2005, Cal U has posted an impressive 14-3 record in games following a loss. The Vulcans have lost back-to-back three times during that span with two occasions being a loss in the NCAA Playoffs and the season-opener the following year.

LOOKING FOR SIX: Last season, the Vulcans became the fourth school in PSAC history, and the first since West Chester (2004-08), to reach the NCAA Playoffs in five-straight years. No program in the league has made six-consecutive berths in the NCAA Playoffs and IUP is the only school to have reached the postseason five-straight years on multiple separate occasions.

GROUND NOTES: Over the last two weeks, the Vulcans have been out-gained on the ground by a staggering 495-101 margin. Cal U has allowed its opponents to rush for over 200 yards in consecutive weeks for the first time since 2008, and for the first time recent program history it has allowed an individual player to total over 200 rushing yards (Harvie Tuck, Rondell White) in back-to-back games. The Vulcans were limited to under 100 rushing yards in back-to-back games last year before totaling 229 yards on the ground in a victory at IUP.

MOVE TO THE SLOT: Junior wide receiver **Trey Johnson** has recorded 100-yard games in two-straight games, totaling 120 yards both times. Last week, he tied his career high with two touchdown receptions and established a career best with 11 catches, which ranks as the third-highest single-game total in school history. Johnson, who was a reserve running back the last two years, is tied for the team lead with four touchdown receptions and ranks second on the team with 24 catches for 293 yards this season.

GAME NOTES

PROLIFIC PETER: Senior **Peter Lalich** is the first quarterback in recent program history to throw for over 300 yards in four-consecutive games. In fact, he is the first player in recent years to eclipse the 300-yard mark more than three times in a season. Lalich has recorded eight 300-yard games (6-2) over the last two years, including 350 yards last season against Clarion.

MEMORIAL HISTORY: Cal U has won seven-straight and eight of the last 10 meetings against Clarion. However, both of the losses in the series came at Memorial Stadium (2002, 2004). In the last meeting at Memorial Stadium, the Golden Eagles took a 7-3 lead at halftime after throwing a touchdown pass as time expired in the second quarter. Cal U answered with three touchdowns in the second half to earn a 24-9 victory.

EAGLE HUNTER: Senior running back **Lamont Smith** has surpassed the 100-yard mark against Clarion in each of the last two years. He has totaled 340 rushing yards on 56 carries in two career meetings against the Golden Eagles, including 185 yards on a career-high 39 attempts in 2010. Smith, who has 14 career 100-yard games, leads the team with 348 rushing yards this season.

HE GOT GAME: Cal U junior defensive back **C.J. Townes** led the team and set a career high with 13 tackles (six solo) last weekend. He ranks fifth on the team with 32 stops (14 solo) and has posted 2.5 TFL and one interception this season. Townes was a guard on the Vulcans' basketball team the last two years, averaging 4.9 points, 2.2 assists and 1.2 steals per game.

LITTLE LAUNDRY: The Vulcans were whistled for just two penalties in last week's loss against West Chester, marking the fewest penalties in a game since 2009. Cal U has been flagged only seven times in the last two games after being whistled for 35 penalties in the first three weeks. Cal U is tied for third in the PSAC with 42 penalties behind only Cheyney (47) and IUP (44).

TRIPLE DUTY: Sophomore **Jeff Knox, Jr.** has split time at defensive back, running back and on special teams this season. Last week, he rushed for two touchdowns, recorded six tackles (four solo) and posted 123 yards on five kickoff returns. Knox, who led the team with 10 rushing touchdowns last year, has started three games at safety this year.

MR. DURABILITY: Senior **Chet Welc** is the only offensive lineman to start all five games at the same position this season. A former tight end, he is a second-year starter at right tackle and is tied for the team lead among offensive players with 18-consecutive starts. Welc became the fourth Academic All-American in program history last year, and the first since 2006.

DUAL THREAT: Clarion quarterback **Ben Fiscus** has developed into the top dual-threat quarterback in the PSAC. He leads all quarterbacks and ranks eighth overall in the league with 450 rushing yards, while also passing for 885 yards and seven touchdowns. In last year's meeting, the Vulcans limited Fiscus to 45 rushing yards on 15 carries and 122 passing yards. The last quarterback to rush for over 50 yards against Cal U was Phillip Klaphake of St. Cloud State.

MILES WATCH: Senior defensive back **Rontez Miles** recorded the first multi-interception game of his career last week. He was the first Cal U player to post multiple interceptions in a game since **Tommie Campbell** in the 2010 NCAA Playoffs. A preseason All-American, Miles leads the team with 46 tackles (23 solo) this season with three double-digit tackle games.

CALIFORNIA (Aug. 30) – Senior defensive back Rontez Miles broke up a potential touchdown as time expired on Thursday to help lift No. 11 Cal U to a 30-22 victory over No. 17 Hillsdale at Adamson Stadium.

The win was the first victory under head coach Mike Kellar and marked the Vulcans first home victory in a season-opener since 2008.

Senior quarterback Peter Lalich passed for 275 yards and four touchdowns on Thursday, while completing 24-of-31 attempts.

The Vulcans added to the lead with a 25-yard field goal early in the fourth quarter before the Chargers mounted a 99-yard touchdown drive to trim the deficit to 30-22 with 3:56 left. On their next drive, the Chargers moved inside the 10-yard line before Miles tipped a fourth-down pass in the end zone as time expired.

Miles paced the defensive effort with 11 tackles, two pass break-ups and one forced fumble. Sophomore defensive back Jeff Knox, Jr. registered nine stops, one pass break-up and one fumble recovery in his first career start. Senior James Carr and junior Darnell Harding each added seven tackles in the victory.

After Edinboro cut the deficit to 17-14 with 10:34 remaining. Cal U responded with a quick three-play scoring drive capped by a six-yard touchdown run by senior Lamont Smith, who finished with 103 rushing yards. The play was set-up by a 54-yard reception by Thomas.

The ensuing Edinboro drive resulted in three-straight sacks by the Vulcans, all by juniors Paul Everson and B.J. Stevens. Cal U then worked over four-plus minutes off the clock before sealing the win with an interception by junior C.J. Townes with under one minute remaining.

Senior defensive back Greg Cochrane led the team with a career-high 13 tackles (three solo) and classmate Brett Diamond finished with 11 stops (four solo). Townes added 10 tackles in his first career start, while Stevens set career highs with seven tackles, 3.5 TFL and 2.5 sacks.

CALIFORNIA (Sept. 22) – Redshirt junior Nadir Brown scored an 80-yard touchdown with 52.3 seconds left and sophomore Cody Nuzzo made the game-winning 30-yard field goal with 3.5 seconds left on Saturday, as the No. 6 Vulcans claimed a 26-24 victory over No. 14 IUP.

Senior quarterback Peter Lalach passed for the second-highest total in single-game school history, finishing with 438 yards. He completed 27-of-40 attempts with three touchdowns and one interception in the victory.

Leading 24-17 with just over a minute remaining, IUP missed a 30-yard field goal. After the missed field goal, Cal U assumed possession at its 20-yard line before Lalach connected with Brown for an 80-yard touchdown on the first play of the drive with just 57.3 seconds remaining. The ensuing PAT attempt failed which preserved the lead for the Crimson Hawks at 24-23.

The Vulcans successfully converted the onside kick attempt by Nuzzo with senior Rontez Miles recovering the ball after it was touched by a Crimson Hawk. The Vulcans recorded a first down following a pair of short completions from Lalach to senior running back Lamont Smith before Lalach found junior wide receiver Trey Johnson for a 20-yard gain to the IUP 13-yard line. After a quarterback spike stopped the clock, Nuzzo made the 30-yard field goal with just 3.5 seconds left.

Miles registered a team-high 13 tackles (six solo) with 0.5 TFL, while junior linebacker Brian Justice tied his career high with 12 stops.
