**THE SERIES:** The Vulcans and Marauders are playing for first time since the 2006 season and only the second time in the last 25 years. Cal U won the first seven all-time meetings before Millersville won three-straight times with its last win coming in 1986.

**THIS WEEK:** Cal U finishes the regular season this weekend following two-straight losses in divisional play. The Vulcans trailed by 24 points at halftime last Saturday before suffering a 40-7 loss at Mercyhurst. Meanwhile, Millersville dropped a 62-14 contest to East Stroudsburg after allowing 41-unanswered points.



#### VULCANS FALL AT MERCYHURST, 40-7:

Entering play in a three-way tie for first place in the PSAC West standings, Cal U suffered a 40-7 loss at Mercyhurst last Saturday. The Vulcans were limited to a season-low 244 yards of total offense and committed four turnovers, including two fumbles on special teams. Redshirt freshman quarterback **Cody Schroeder** finished with 133 passing yards on 15-of-34 attempts with two interceptions. Cal U rushed for 111 yards on 28 attempts in the loss. Redshirt senior linebacker **Brett Diamond** finished with eight tackles (five solo) and senior defensive lineman **Jason Kates** set a career high with eight stops (four solo).

## GAME NOTES

**MILLERSVILLE HEAD COACH:** A veteran of 25-plus years as a college coach, **Greg Colby** is in his fifth season as head coach of the Marauders. While with the program, he has posted an 11-43 overall record with three wins in both 2009 and 2011. Prior to joining Millersville, Colby spent six seasons as the defensive coordinator at Northwestern and also was as assistant coach under Nick Saban at Michigan State from 1995-97.

**SCOUTING THE MARAUDERS:** Millersville returns 21 starters (nine offense, nine defense) from last year's team that finished 3-8 overall and fifth in the PSAC East standings with a 2-5 mark. The Marauders enter the weekend averaging just 15.6 points and 265.0 yards of total offense, which both rank 14th in the league. True freshman quarterback **Connor Casey** leads the team with 665 passing yards while primarily playing only three games. Senior running back **Mike Jones** and junior wide receiver **Dominic Sanders** both rank among the top 20 in the PSAC with over 40 receptions. Jones has posted 413 receiving yards and a team-high four touchdowns. Redshirt freshman **Myron Myles** leads the team with 384 rushing yards, while junior **Ian Sadon** averages 6.6 yards per carry on 54 attempts. Millersville ranks last in the PSAC in both rushing and total defense, yielding over 500 yards per game. Linebacker **Pat Maloney** is the team's leading tackler for the third-consecutive year, registering 68 stops (18 solo) as a senior. Redshirt freshman defensive back **Rasheed Johnson** and sophomore defensive lineman **Reggie Slaton** both have made 58 tackles this season and Slaton leads the team with 9.5 TFL. On special teams, sophomore **David Coates** leads the PSAC with a staggering 1,029 yards on kickoff returns. Senior punter **Jeff Lawson** averages 38.9 yards on a league-high 73 punts, including a career-best 81-yard punt.

**READING THE NATIONAL POLLS:** With its second-straight loss, Cal U fell out of both the AFCA and D2Football.com Top 25 polls. The Vulcans had been ranked in the AFCA poll for 14-consecutive weeks and the D2Football.com poll every week since October 2009.

**WITHIN THE REGION:** The Vulcans dropped to 10th in the latest Super Region One rankings released on Monday. Cal U is one of five PSAC teams ranked in the top 10 in the region. The two top teams in the regional rankings receive first-round byes in the NCAA Playoffs, while the third and fourth seeds host opening-round games on Nov. 17.

**LOOKING BACK:** In the preseason, the league coaches selected IUP and Cal U as co-favorites in the PSAC West and defending-league champion Kutztown as the favorite in the PSAC East. The Crimson Hawks are hosting Shippensburg, who was fifth in the preseason poll, on Saturday in the PSAC Championship Game. In addition, Mercyhurst earned a share of the divisional title with IUP after being tabbed fifth in the PSAC West by the coaches in the preseason.

**MILES WATCH:** Senior defensive back **Rontez Miles**, the 2011 PSAC West Defensive Player of the Year, is currently tied for second in the league with four interceptions. He also leads the team with a career-high 72 tackles (40 solo) this season. A First-Team All-American last year, Miles ranks fifth in school history with 254 career tackles (153 solo). He is the first player with at least 250 tackles in a career since former linebacker **Josh Zunic** (2004-07) tallied 258 stops.

**SMITH 3K MILESTONE:** Last week at Mercyhurst, senior running back **Lamont Smith** became the fourth player in school history to rush for at least 3,000 yards in a career. A three-year starter, he is the first player to reach the milestone since **Brandon Lombardy** (2005-08). Smith, who has rushed for a team-high 744 yards this season, ranks fourth in school history with 3,023 rushing yards.

## GAME NOTES

**SEEING DOUBLE:** Over the last two years, sophomore **Jeff Knox, Jr.** has made an impact while playing on offense, defense and special teams. Last week at Mercyhurst, he made his first career start at running back and scored his 18th career rushing touchdown. Knox is the first player in recent years at Cal U to start a game on both offense and defense in the same season, as he made three starts at defensive back earlier this year.

**AGAINST THE EAST:** In the last 10 seasons, the Vulcans hold a 24-6 record (.800) against PSAC East opponents. During that span, Cal U earned a 41-10 victory over Millersville in 2006, which marked the first meeting between the two teams since the 1987 season.

**RECORD SETTER:** In his first year as a starter, junior defensive lineman **B.J. Stevens** leads the PSAC and has tied the single-season school record with 19.0 TFL. He also leads the league with 11.5 sacks, which is only 0.5 sack shy of tying the school record set by former linebacker **Gary Butler** in 2007 when he was selected the PSAC West Defensive Player of the Year. A former standout at Gateway, Stevens has recorded at least 1.0 sack in six-consecutive games.

**NATIONAL ELITE:** Freshman **Andrew Cerett** leads the PSAC and ranks ninth in the country with an average of 42.8 yards per punt. He has placed 14 of his 38 punts inside the opponents' 20-yard line and has recorded five punts of at least 50 yards. Last year, the Vulcans averaged 36.9 yards per punt which was their lowest season average since 2006.

**RETURN TO FORM:** After missing all of last season due to injury, redshirt senior linebacker **Brett Diamond** is tied for the team lead with a career-high 72 tackles (34 solo) this season. He also is the team's active leader with 42 career starts, as he made 33 starts from 2008-10. Diamond ranks sixth in school history with 243 career tackles (125 solo) and has also added 22.0 TFL, 7.0 sacks and five interceptions while with the Vulcans.

**MOVING UP:** In just two seasons, sophomore kicker **Cody Nuzzo** already is tied with **Gary Amos** (2002-04) for fourth place in school history with 17 career field goals. Nuzzo also ranks fifth among kickers in school history with 128 career points, including a team-high 63 points this year. He is tied with former All-American **Tyler Lorenz** (2006) for third place in single-season school history with 11 field goals this year.

**AERIAL ASSAULT:** While primarily using two quarterbacks due to injury, the Vulcans enter this weekend with the fourth-most passing yards in single-season school history. Senior **Peter Lalich** and redshirt freshman **Cody Schroeder** have combined to pass for 2,871 yards this year. Cal U is within reach of surpassing 3,000 yards for only the fourth time in school history, all since 2008.

**BUSY RETURN:** Cal U sophomore **Jeff Knox, Jr.** and Millersville sophomore **David Coates** enter the weekend among the most active kick returners in the PSAC. Coates leads the nation with 1,029 yards on a league-high 39 kickoff returns, including a 97-yard return for touchdown against West Chester. Knox ranks fourth in the league with both 446 return yards and 19 kickoff returns.

**SENIORITY:** The Vulcans feature a special group of 16 seniors in 2012. The class has collectively posted a 38-12 overall record (.760) over the last four years and an impressive 24-4 mark (.857) in PSAC West games. Combined, the 2012 seniors have started 292 career games.

CALIFORNIA (Aug. 30) – Senior defensive back Rontez Miles broke up a potential touchdown as time expired on Thursday to help lift No. 11 Cal U to a 30-22 victory over No. 17 Hillsdale at Adamson Stadium.

The win was the first victory under head coach Mike Kellar and marked the Vulcans first home victory in a season-opener since 2008.

Senior quarterback Peter Lalich passed for 275 yards and four touchdowns on Thursday, while completing 24-of-31 attempts.

Junior wide receivers Trey Johnson and Mike Williams both finished with two touchdowns against the Chargers. Williams posted 80 yards on a career-high six receptions, while Johnson set career highs with both six catches and 49 yards.

After forcing a fumble on Hillsdale's initial drive of the second half, Lalich found Johnson for a seven-yard touchdown with 12:05 remaining in the third. The Vulcans added to the lead with a 25-yard field goal early in the fourth quarter before the Chargers mounted a 99-yard touchdown drive to trim the deficit to 30-22 with 3:56 left. On their next drive, the Chargers moved inside the 10-yard line before Miles tipped a fourth-down pass in the end zone as time expired.

Miles paced the defensive effort with 11 tackles, two pass break-ups and one forced fumble. Sophomore defensive back Jeff Knox, Jr. registered nine stops, one pass break-up and one fumble recovery in his first career start. Senior James Carr and junior Darnell Harding each added seven tackles in the victory.

ERIE, Pa. (Oct. 20) – The No. 14 Vulcans posted their second-straight shutout and rushed for four touchdowns on Saturday afternoon, registering a 41-0 victory at Gannon in PSAC West play.

The Vulcans rushed for 200 yards for the second-straight game, finishing with a season-high 226 yards and four touchdowns. Senior Lamont Smith led the team with 96 rushing yards on 19 attempts and sophomore Cody Cook added 74 yards and a touchdown on 12 carries. Fellow sophomore Jeff Knox, Jr. finished with 40 rushing yards and two scores, while redshirt freshman Jake Forsythe posted 30 yards and one touchdown.

The Cal U defense allowed just 164 yards of total offense on Saturday. The Vulcans yielded only 11 rushing yards on 29 attempts after registering six sacks, which ties a season high. Cal U also forced four turnovers in the victory, as the Golden Knights managed just 10 first downs on 63 plays.

With Cal U leading 6-0, senior Rontez Miles returned an interception 33 yards before Knox posted a three-yard score with 3:24 left in the first half. On the ensuing Gannon possession, junior Darnell Harding posted a 32-yard fumble return for a touchdown after registering a sack and forced fumble to give the Vulcans a 20-0 lead.

Senior B.J. Stevens anchored the defense with a career-high nine tackles, including 3.5 TFL and 1.5 sacks. Redshirt junior Noah Taylor added seven stops, 2.5 TFL and 1.5 sacks, while Harding made six tackles, 1.0 TFL, 1.0 sack, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery.

CALIFORNIA (Oct. 27) – Despite a pair of fourth-quarter touchdowns, the No. 13 Vulcans suffered a 28-26 loss to Slippery Rock during Senior Day on Saturday afternoon at Adamson Stadium in PSAC West play.

The Vulcans forced three turnovers and blocked a pair of punts in the loss. Cal U has now forced nine turnovers over the last three weeks and registered two blocked kicks in two-straight games.

Trailing 28-13 entering the fourth quarter, Cal U capped a 14-play drive with a two-yard touchdown pass from redshirt freshman Cody Schroeder to junior Mike Williams with 14:00 left in the game. Schroeder finished with 223 yards and one touchdown on 23-of-46 attempts in his third career start.

On the ensuing possession, senior Greg Cochrane recovered a fumble when Slippery Rock went for a fourth-and-one near midfield. The Vulcans then moved inside the red zone before turning the ball over on downs at the Rock 14-yard line. The Cal U defense limited Slippery Rock to only one first down on the next drive before junior Ja'wan Bryant blocked a punt that was recovered by sophomore Jeff Knox, Jr. in the end zone to trim the deficit to 28-26. However, the Vulcans were unsuccessful on the two-point conversion attempt with 7:06 remaining.

Redshirt senior linebacker Brett Diamond led the team and established a career high with 12 tackles (seven solo). Junior Brian Justice finished with nine stops, 1.0 TFL and one forced fumble.

ERIE, Pa. (Nov. 3) – Entering play in a three-way tie for first place in the PSAC West standings, No. 22 Cal U suffered a 40-7 loss to Mercyhurst at Tullio Field on Saturday afternoon.

Senior running back Lamont Smith became just the fourth different player in school history to post at least 3,000 rushing yards in a career. He led the team with 51 rushing yards on nine carries on Saturday. Smith ranks fourth all-time in school history with 3,023 rushing yards and is the first player to reach the milestone since Brandon Lombardy (2005-08).

Junior defensive lineman B.J. Stevens recorded 1.5 tackles for loss (TFL) at Mercyhurst to tie the single-season school record of 19.0 TFL set by Gary Butler in 2007. Stevens now ranks second in single-season school history with 11.5 sacks, which is only 0.5 sack shy of the record set by Butler.

Cal U was limited to a season-low 244 yards of total offense and committed four turnovers, including two fumbles on special teams. Redshirt freshman quarterback Cody Schroeder finished with 133 passing yards on 15-of-34 attempts with two interceptions. The Vulcans rushed for 111 yards on 28 attempts in the loss.

Redshirt senior linebacker Brett Diamond finished with eight tackles (five solo) and senior defensive lineman Jason Kates set a career high with eight stops (four solo). Defensive backs Rontez Miles and C.J. Townes both added seven tackles in the loss.
