## ASHLAND'S JODI JOHNSON NAMED 2018 RON LENZ NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE YEAR



**RUSSELLVILLE, Ark.** On Tuesday, the Division II Conference Commissioners Association announced Ashland's Jodi Johnson as the 2018 Women's Basketball Ron Lenz National Player of the Year as she headlined the All-American selections. The NCAA Division II sports information directors from institutions and conference offices voted for the teams.

Johnson's teammate, Laina Snyder, plus Montana State -Billing's Alisha Breen, Lewis' Jessica Kelliher and Union's Chelsey Shumpert made the First Team.

Johnson, who averaged 12.0 points per game last year as a freshman when the Eagles went 37-0 and claimed the program's second national title, has increased her scoring to 19.1 per game and enters the national semifinals ranked first in the nation in steals per game, 3.89 and on pace to set the Division II record for 3-point field goal percentage, 60.2. She ranks fourth in the country in field-goal percentage, making 61.6 percent of her attempts.

Snyder became a two-time D2CCA First-Team All-American. She leads the team in scoring, averaging 19.6 points per game and rebounding, grabbing 8.0 per game, while shooting 52.4 percent from the field.

Breen, the D2CCA West Region Player of the Year, led the Yellowjackets to the Elite Eight for the second time in team history. She broke the school's record for career scoring with 2,001 points with her final two points of her career and her season total of 791 points set school and Great Northwest Athletic Conference single-season records.

Kelliher, an Honorable Mention D2CCA All-American in 2017, joined Johnson and Snyder on the D2CCA All-Midwest Region First Team. She leads the nation in scoring at 24.7 points per game and ranks second in field-goal percentage at 66.9 percent. She added 9.0 rebounds per game and tallied 15 double-doubles.

Shumpert, the South Region Player of the Year, led her Lady Bulldogs to the DII National Semifinals for the first time in program history. She ranked fourth in the country in scoring at 24.1 points per game and second with 107 3-point field goals.
