### WEEK NINE RECAP

In the first set of regional rankings, there were five GSC teams that were put in the top 10. This past weekend, three of those teams faced non-regionally ranked opponents, while there was one game that pitted two ranked teams against one another. The three ranked teams (West Alabama, West Georgia, and North Alabama) were able to defeat their non-ranked counterparts, and No. 9 Florida Tech was able to pull the upset at home over No. 2 Valdosta State.

West Alabama was able to win its fifth straight game with another dominant showing from quarterback **Austin Grammer**. Grammer was named the GSC Offensive Player of the Week for the second time in four weeks after throwing for 493 yards and three touchdowns in the game. All three of Grammer's scoring strikes went to **Barnard McGhee**.

West Georgia recorded its second shutout of the season in the 44-0 win over Shorter. The Wolves are now 2-0 with **Willie Candler** starting at quarterback. Candler has thrown five touchdown passes in his two weeks at the helm to go along with no interceptions. Candler has been named the GSC's Freshman of the Week for two straight weeks.

**Jacob Tucker** had four more touchdowns for North Alabama, as the Lions won their sixth straight game, defeating Delta State, 49-19. UNA was leading 14-13 before going on a 28-0 run in less than four minutes of game time, scoring quick offensive touchdowns and securing a defensive TD. In the game, Delta State's **Chris Robinson** tied the GSC record for most touchdowns in a season, scoring for the 24th time.

Florida Tech was able to severely help its playoff chances with a win over Valdosta State, 38-20. The Panthers jumped out to a 10-0 lead in the game, and although the Blazers were able to tie it, VSU was never able to get ahead. The Blazers came into the game averaging 44.8 points in their last five games, all wins. On Saturday night, FIT held VSU without an offensive touchdown and just 256 yards of total offense.

### WEEK TEN PREVIEW

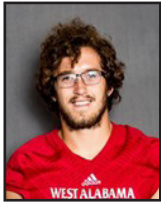
After tying the conference's total touchdowns in a season mark last week, DSU's **Chris Robinson** will be on a bye this week. He will have one game left to break the record, as the Statesmen travel to Florida Tech the final week of the season.

A pair of matchups between regionally ranked teams highlights the slate of games this week, as No. 5 West Alabama will host No. 7 Valdosta State in the GSC Game of the Week, and No. 6 Florida Tech will visit No. 8 West Georgia. With all four of those teams on the regional bubble, those games will all be critical for potential postseason opportunities.

West Florida will make the trip to Florence to battle the GSC frontrunners in North Alabama.

Mississippi College and Shorter will face off with both teams looking for their first conference wins. MC is coming off of a bye week, while SU is hosting its final home game of the season.

### OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### **West Alabama QB Austin Grammer**

Grammer completed 41 of his 56 passes for 493 yards and three touchdowns in just three quarters of play in West Alabama's 45-21 win at West Florida. Grammer was 30-for-36 at the half. During the Tigers' five game winning streak, Grammer is completing 70% of his passes. This is the second time that Grammer has won the GSC Offensive Player of the Week Award this season.



### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### **Florida Tech S Tyler Rosenblatt**

Rosenblatt intercepted two passes in the upset win for the Panthers over #14 Valdosta State. It was a critical game for FIT, who came in ranked ninth in the region, while the Blazers were ranked second. Rosenblatt was a key cog in the defense that allowed just six offensive points to Valdosta State. VSU came into the game having won its last five games, averaging 44.8 points per game during that streak.



### SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

#### **North Alabama PR Philbert Martial**

In the North Alabama win over Delta State, Martial had four returns totaling 140 yards. He had two punt returns of more than 50 yards, one for 52 yards and one for 65 yards. Martial leads the GSC in average yards per punt return at 19.1 yards per return.



### FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

#### **West Georgia QB Willie Candler**

Candler wins GSC Freshman of the Week for the second straight week in his second career start. He has led UWG to back-to-back wins, throwing a pair of touchdowns in the shutout win for the Wolves. He also ran for 51 yards. He has now thrown for five touchdowns and no interceptions in the last two games.

Mississippi College will enter Saturday's game off of a bye week, looking to win its first conference game of the year after close calls in the previous two games. The Choctaws fell to regionally ranked Valdosta State and West Georgia by a combined nine points the last two times on the field. MC's **Marcel Newson** is the conference's leading receiver, averaging 109.1 yards receiving per game. He is also a dynamic returner, earning GSC Special Teams Player of the Week earlier this season. The Shorter defense that will be looking to slow down the explosive Choctaw attack will be led by **Jevaris Jones**, the conference's leading tackler.

#### Game Breakdown

In a pivotal game for the regional rankings, there will also be some individual history on the line, as West Georgia's **Dylan Donahue** is just a half sack away from tying the GSC record for most sacks in a season, and, therefore, just one sack away from breaking the record. Donahue is currently tied for third in the nation in sacks. His contributions would be timely this week, as FIT and UWG square off in a game with major postseason implications. The Panthers average more yards per game than anyone else in the league, putting up 513.0 yards in each contest. That's nearly 50 yards more than any other team in the conference. On the flip side, West Georgia only allows 316.3 yards per game, best in the GSC.

In the first batch of regional rankings, Valdosta State was ranked second. After last week's loss to Florida Tech, the Blazers now find themselves ranked seventh, the very last team that would be in if the playoffs were to start today. This week will be pivotal in the determination as to who qualifies for postseason play, as the No. 5 Tigers battle the Blazers. UWA is led by quarterback **Austin Grammer**, who has thrown for 2,448 yards this year, ranking second in the league. He has thrown 17 touchdowns to just four interceptions, and the red hot Tigers are averaging 43.6 points per game during their current five-game winning streak. This week, Grammer will have to face the best passing defense in the league, as VSU allow just 209.1 yards through the air per contest.

## 2016 FLORIDA'S SPACE COAST GSC-TV ON ESPN

The Gulf South Conference has officially announced the schedule for the 12th edition of its Florida's Space Coast GSC Football Game of the Week featured live on ESPN 3.

ESPN3 serves as the exclusive carrier of the league's package for the third consecutive season. This year's 10-game slate includes nine Saturday games and one Thursday night contest and kicks off on September 17 when Shorter University hosts Florida Tech in Rome, Ga.

"The Gulf South Conference's Game of the Week package has been a leader in Division II since its inception. Continuing our relationship with ESPN provides unparalleled exposure and distribution for the GSC," said Commissioner Matt Wilson. "We believe the ESPN3 and WatchESPN digital platforms are ideal for our fans, student-athletes and future recruits. Play-by-play commentator Don Russell and color commentator Rick Rhodes will continue to lead the coverage from the booth and Gulf Coast Mobile, L.L.C. will produce the package for the fifth year in a row.

The network is currently available nationwide at no additional cost to fans who receive their high-speed Internet connection or video subscription from an affiliated service provider. It is also available at no cost to U.S. college students and U.S.-based military personnel via computers, smartphones and tablets connected to on-campus educational and on-base military broadband and Wi-Fi networks.
