WEEK FOUR RECAP

The fourth week on the conference schedule saw an undefeated run for GSC teams in non-conference play, going 3-0. In the three matchups across the league, North Alabama remained undefeated in conference play, while Delta State and Valdosta State were able to pick up their first wins in the GSC this season.

North Alabama continued to impress in conference play, defeating West Alabama 45-7 in Livingston. Lions' QB **Jacob Tucker** had a total of four touchdowns in the game and was named the GSC Offensive Player of the Week. In two conference games this season, UNA is outscoring its opponents 89-26.

Mississippi College needed some late game heroics from kicker **Matt Brasher** to earn its second win of the season and boost the record back to .500. Brasher hit a 37-yard field goal as time expired to give the Choctaws a 27-26 win. Wide receiver Marcel Newson continued to be electric, scoring touchdowns on two big plays: a 64-yard reception and a 75-yard run.

Delta State rebounded from back-to-back losses to two national powers with a big win over Shorter. DSU put up 47 points and 480 yards, while limiting the Hawks to just 141 yards of total offense. **Chris Robinson** ran for two more touchdowns in the game, bumping his league leading total up to eight on the year. Robinson's eight rushing touchdowns are twice as many as anyone else in the GSC.

Valdosta State was able to earn its first conference win at the expense of West Florida and the Argonauts' first ever conference game. VSU forced seven turnovers in the game, including five interceptions from GSC leading passer **Kaleb Nobles**. Freshman RB **Cedric Hollingshed** ran for two touchdowns for the Blazers in the first game of his collegiate career.

West Georgia continued its unbeaten season with a win at Albany State. The Wolves were aided by the first kickoff return for a touchdown in the league this season, as **Devontae Jackson** took a kick 97 yards after Albany State had tied the score. **Dylan Donahue** now ranks fourth in the country in sacks after bring down the ASU quarterback three times, bringing his season total to league-high six.

Florida Tech went on the road to face Division I-FCS's Presbyterian, and the Panthers were more than impressive in their 28-7 win. Down 21-7, the Blue Hose were driving to cut the deficit to just a single touchdown when **Jo Jackson** was able to intercept a pass and bring it all the way back 83 yards for a touchdown. PC would be unable to get on the board again, and FIT now sits 16th nationally, the highest ranking in program history.

WEEK FIVE PREVIEW

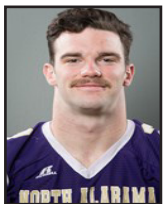

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

North Alabama QB Jacob Tucker

Tucker rushed for three touchdowns and threw for one more in a 45-7 GSC road win for North Alabama over West Alabama. He threw for 271 yards and, if you take out yards lost on sacks, ran for 71 yards. This contest was the first road conference game in Tucker's career, and with the win, the Lions stay unbeaten in conference play. The UNA QB is currently fourth in the conference in rushing yards per game (65.0).



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Florida Tech DB Jo Jackson

Jo Jackson became the first player in FIT history to intercept two passes in a single game in the win at Division I-FCS Presbyterian. His second interception of the night helped seal the victory. After PC's touchdown drew them to within two scores, Jackson returned an interception 83 yards for a touchdown, bumping the Panther lead up to three scores in the fourth quarter. It was FIT's first pick six since its inaugural season in 2013. He also added four tackles and a pair of pass breakups.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

West Georgia KR Devontae Jackson

Devontae Jackson becomes the second straight player from West Georgia to earn this award. After Albany State scored a touchdown to tie the game, Jackson returned the ensuing kickoff 97 yards for a touchdown. This proved to be the difference in the game, as the Wolves won by four points. It's the first kickoff return for a touchdown in the GSC this season. The sophomore is UWG's record holder for kickoff return average.



FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Valdosta State RB Cedric Hollingshed

Hollingshed made his collegiate debut on Saturday night, helping spark the Blazer offense and lead VSU to its first conference win of 2016. Hollingshed ran for a total of 78 yards in the game against West Florida, averaging more than seven yards per carry and scoring a pair of touchdowns.

Game Breakdown

The first of two GSC Games of the Week will take place on Thursday, September 29, as Delta State and Mississippi College take the field for the 37th Heritage Bell Classic. This rivalry took a nearly 20-year hiatus after MC reclassified to Division III after 1995. Currently, the Statesmen own a 19-15-2 advantage in the series and go into this week's game after a massive conference win last week, beating Shorter 47-7. DSU has two losses on the year, both to Top 10 teams nationally. **Chris Robinson** leads the league in both rushing yards (395) and rushing touchdowns (8). The biggest weapon for the Choctaws is wide receiver **Marcel Newson**, who is third in the league in receiving yards per game at 85.5 yards. He also had a 75 yard touchdown run in the win last weekend.

On Shorter's last Thursday night conference game, the Hawks gave nationally ranked Valdosta State a close call, staying within one touchdown until the final minutes of the contest. Game Breakdown

This Top 25 clash is the second GSC Game of the Week and may be the most anticipated game on the Gulf South schedule up to this point. North Alabama will host West Georgia in a game sure to have postseason implications. Both teams are Super Region 2 powers and both have expectations for competing for a national championship. In its two conference games, UNA has outscored its opponents 89-26. The Lions offense will be led by **Jacob Tucker**, the reigning GSC Offensive Player of the Week. Tucker is fourth in the league in rushing and averages 186.0 yards per game through the air. He will face a staunch UWG defense that allows just 12.5 points per game. **Dylan Donahue** has 6.0 sacks through four games, which leads the league is tied for fourth highest in the country.

Game Breakdown

A season of firsts continues for the inaugural West Florida football team, as the Argonauts will host their first conference home game by welcoming in Florida Tech. These two teams sit atop the league in offensive yards per game and both are in the top three of defensive yards allowed in each game. Sitting at 16th, FIT has the highest ranking in program history and just defeated a Division I-FCS team for the third time in its four-year existence. The Panthers currently average 37.8 points per game and surrender just 8.8 points per game, both are top marks in the league. UWF boasts the top passer in the GSC in **Kaleb Nobles**, and his two favorite targets (**Ishmel Morrow** and **Anas Hasic**) are the only two receivers in the conference to average more than 100 yards receiving per game.

The Gulf South Conference has officially announced the schedule for the 12th edition of its Florida's Space Coast GSC Football Game of the Week featured live on ESPN 3.

ESPN3 serves as the exclusive carrier of the league's package for the third consecutive season. This year's 10-game slate includes nine Saturday games and one Thursday night contest and kicks off on September 17 when Shorter University hosts Florida Tech in Rome, Ga.

All nine Conference squads are featured at least twice. Florida Tech and West Alabama lead the way with three appearances, followed by Delta State, Mississippi College, North Alabama, Shorter, Valdosta State, West Florida and West Georgia.

Play-by-play commentator Don Russell and color commentator Rick Rhodes will continue to lead the coverage from the booth and Gulf Coast Mobile, L.L.C. will produce the package for the fifth year in a row.
