WEEK ONE RECAP

The first week of the 2016 GSC season is in the books. The conference went 6-3 on the weekend, including a perfect Saturday slate where the five competing teams went 5-0.

West Florida picked up a dominant win in the program's first ever game, defeating Ave Maria 45-0. UWF allowed only 105 total yards of offense in the shutout.

Meanwhile, in their first game officially back in Division II, the Choctaws from Mississippi College earned a 28-16 win on their home turf. As a team, MC rushed for 279 yards last week, most in the GSC.

West Georgia lived up to its lofty national ranking, earning a 23-3 win over #22 Catawba. The Wolves were relentless on defense, collecting three interceptions and forcing nine punts.

For the first time in program history, Florida Tech was able to defeat Newberry; the Panthers have now won seven of their last eight games and are ranked in the AFCA Poll for the first time in school history.

Delta State's **Chris Robinson** racked up the most individual rushing yards in week one, helping lead his team to a resounding victory and earning individual laurels as the conference's offensive player of the week.

Valdosta State's **Dante Robinson** was also awarded with a conference honor. Robinson was named the GSC Defensive Player of the Week after playing an integral role in the Blazers' 17-6 win against Albany State.

UWA lost a heartbreaker to North Greenville, while Shorter and North Alabama were unable to upend their Division I-FCS opponents.

WEEK TWO PREVIEW

Conference play for the GSC starts this weekend, as Mississippi College will head to Melbourne for a night game with Florida Tech. The Panthers will look to stay unbeaten against the Choctaws.

West Florida will compete in front of a sold out crowd in Pensacola for its first ever home game. The Argonauts will welcome a Missouri S&T team that is fresh off a 48-point win.

The road does not get any easier for West Alabama, as the Tigers will travel to Stephen F. Austin and square off with the Division I-FCS Lumberjacks.

Delta State will host #8 Texas A&M Commerce this weekend. The Statesmen were victorious last year against the Lions, and a win this season could propel DSU into the national rankings.

UWG will look to continue its winning ways with a trip to Miles, while Shorter will travel to Mars Hill looking for its first victory of 2016.

Both Valdosta State and North Alabama have byes this week. Those two teams will play each other next weekend in Florence.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Delta State RB Chris Robinson

Robinson wins the award after rushing for 162 yards and scoring three touchdowns in the opening week win for the Statesmen. Robinson's 162 yards on the ground are the most for any DSU player since the 2011 season. The junior was able to accomplish all of this on just 13 carries, averaging 12.5 yards every time he took a handoff. Robinson had a touchdown run of 67 yards, the longest rush in the conference this weekend.


Robinson recorded six tackles on the week, and he was also grabbed two interceptions in the Blazer win against Albany State. Both interceptions were timely, as one occurred when ASU was backed up inside its own 20-yard line, setting up the Blazers for their first touchdown of the night. The second interception stopped a scoring opportunity for the Golden Rams, who were inside the VSU red zone.

Boone did not have to punt often in the big win for the Statesmen, but he made it count when he did get on the field. Of his four punts, two were downed inside the 20-yard line. He also had one punt that was a booming 62 yards. Overall, he averaged 50.5 yards per punt.



FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

West Florida RB Tim Bellinger

Bellinger was playing in not only his first college game, but the first football game in the history of the University of West Florida. Bellinger will forever be in the record books, scoring the first touchdown in UWF history. He would add another touchdown later in the game. Bellinger rushed for more than 100 yards on the day, despite playing sparingly in the second half of the 45-0 victory for West Florida.

Game Breakdown

West Georgia maintained its #2 ranking in both polls this week after a dominant performance against #22 Catawba. The Wolves' head coach Will Hall earned his 50th career win in the game, bringing his record to 50-15. The defense led the way for UWG in the first game, holding Catawba to just 235 total yards of offense. The Wolves were able to intercept three passes and force nine punts. Catawba's offense returned its quarterback from last season, a season in which the offense averaged more than 21 points per game. **Marcus Sayles** was able to block a kick in the game against Catawba; astoundingly, it is the 11th blocked kick of his career. Miles defeated Fort Valley State last weekend, and quarterback David Whipple was named the SIAC Offensive Player of the Week.
